DESCRIPTION

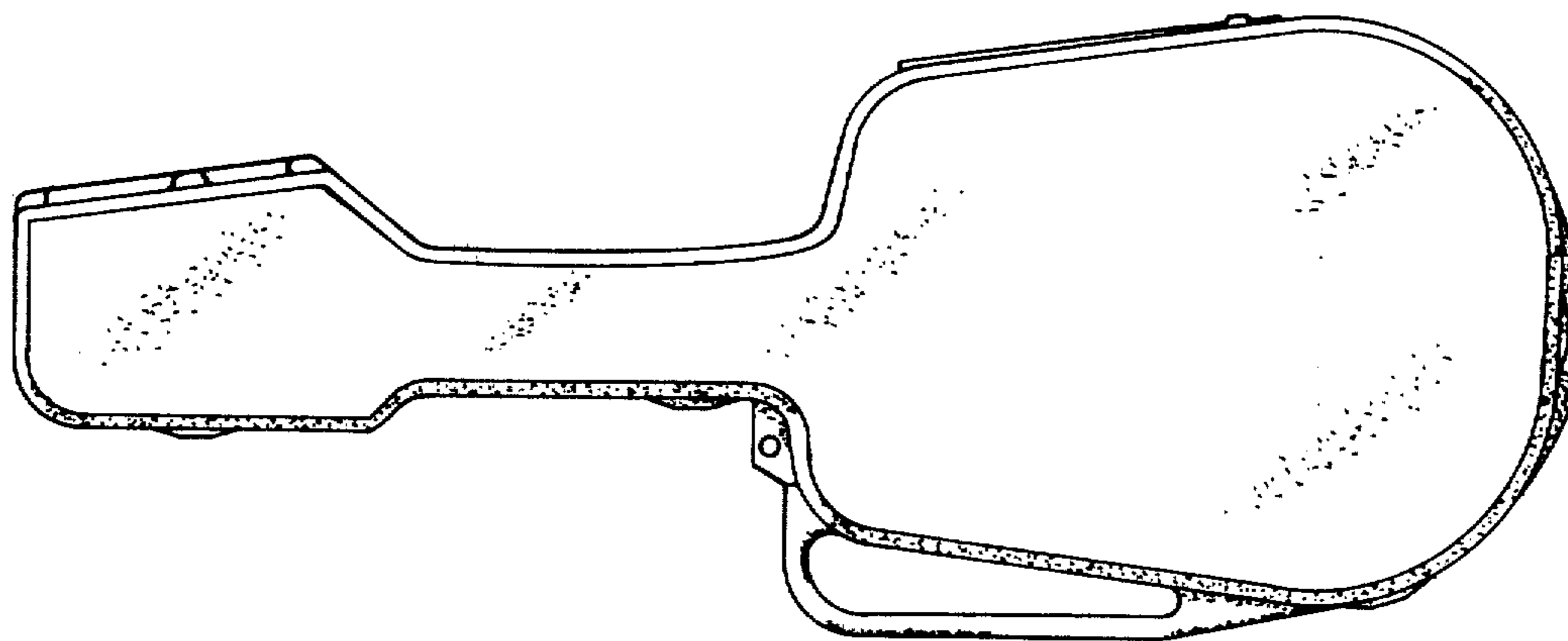
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a musical instrument case or the like showing my new design, the bottom being substantially a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



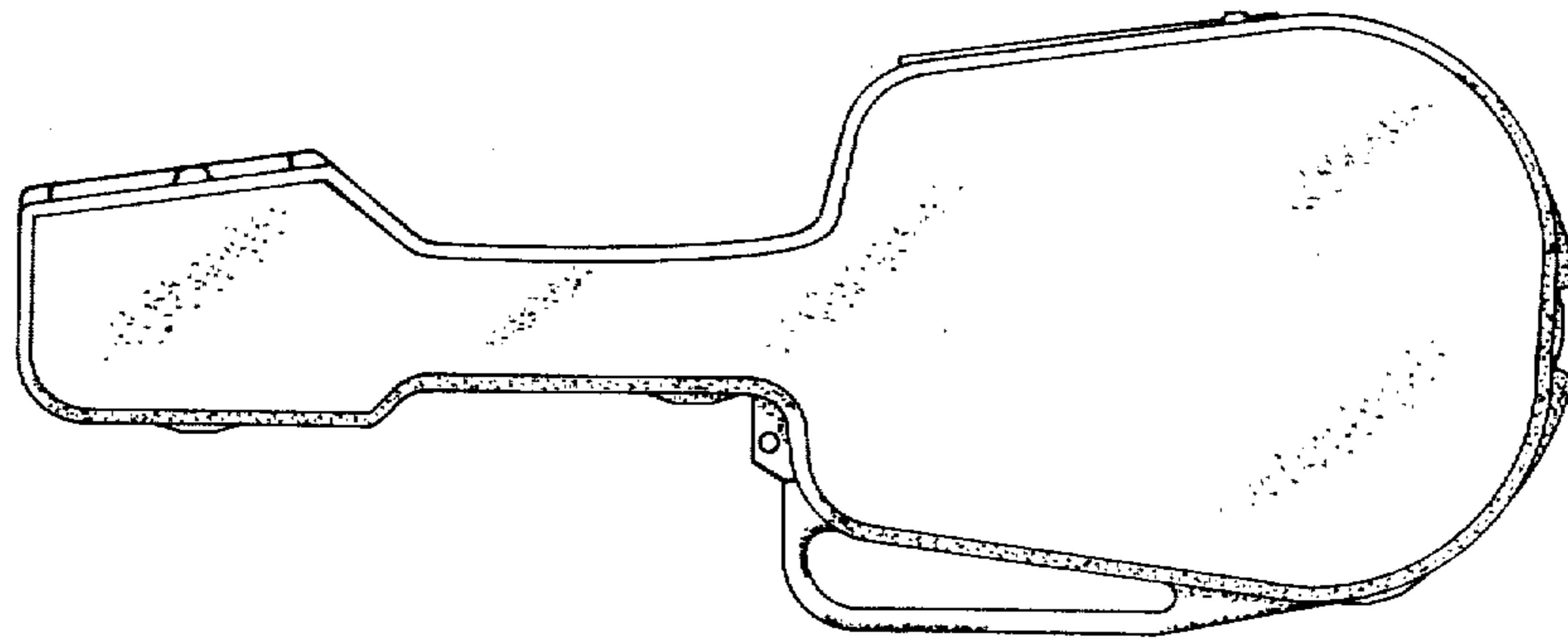

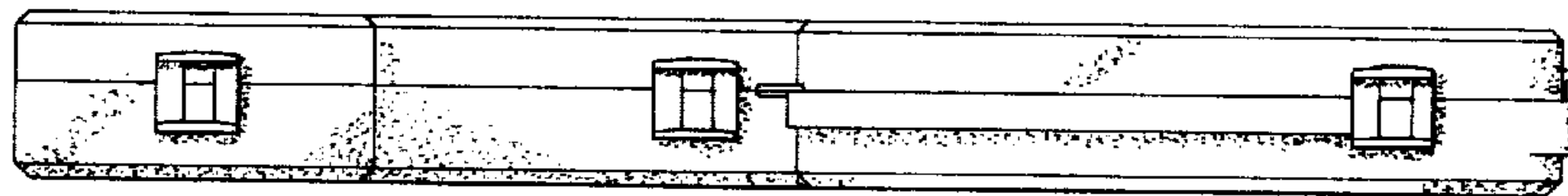

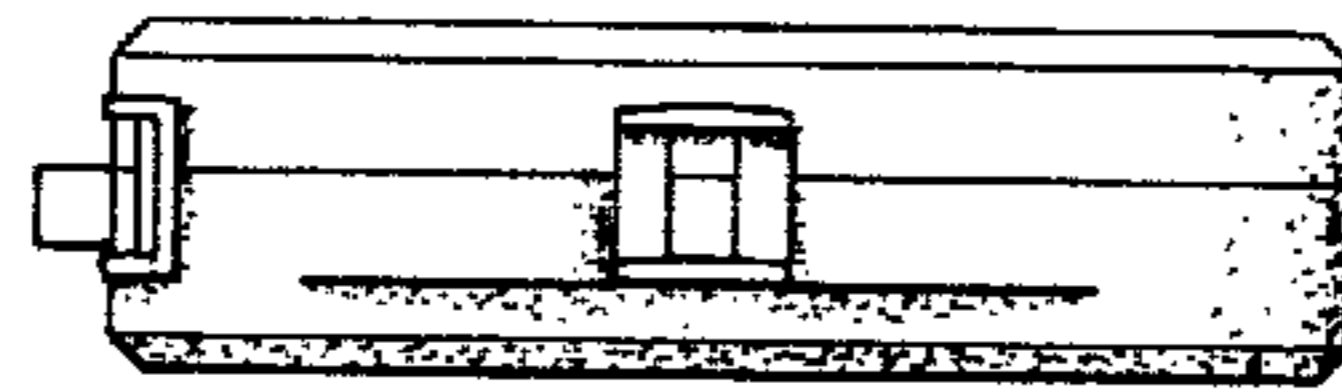

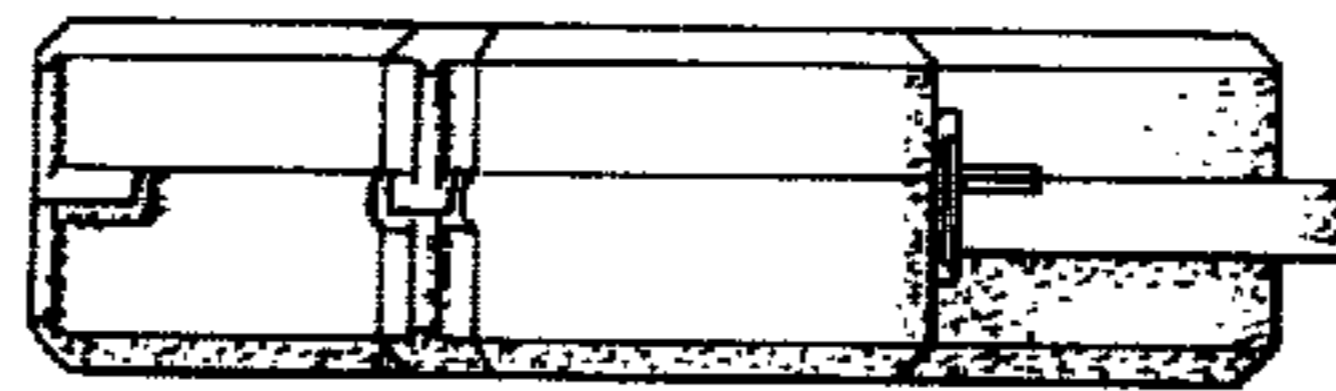

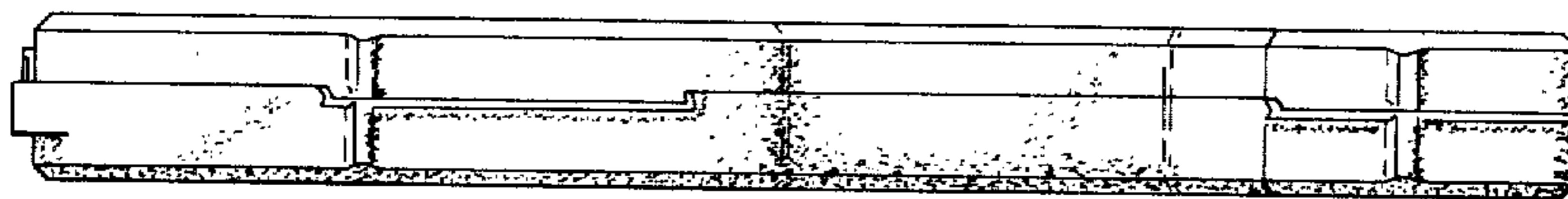
