DESCRIPTION

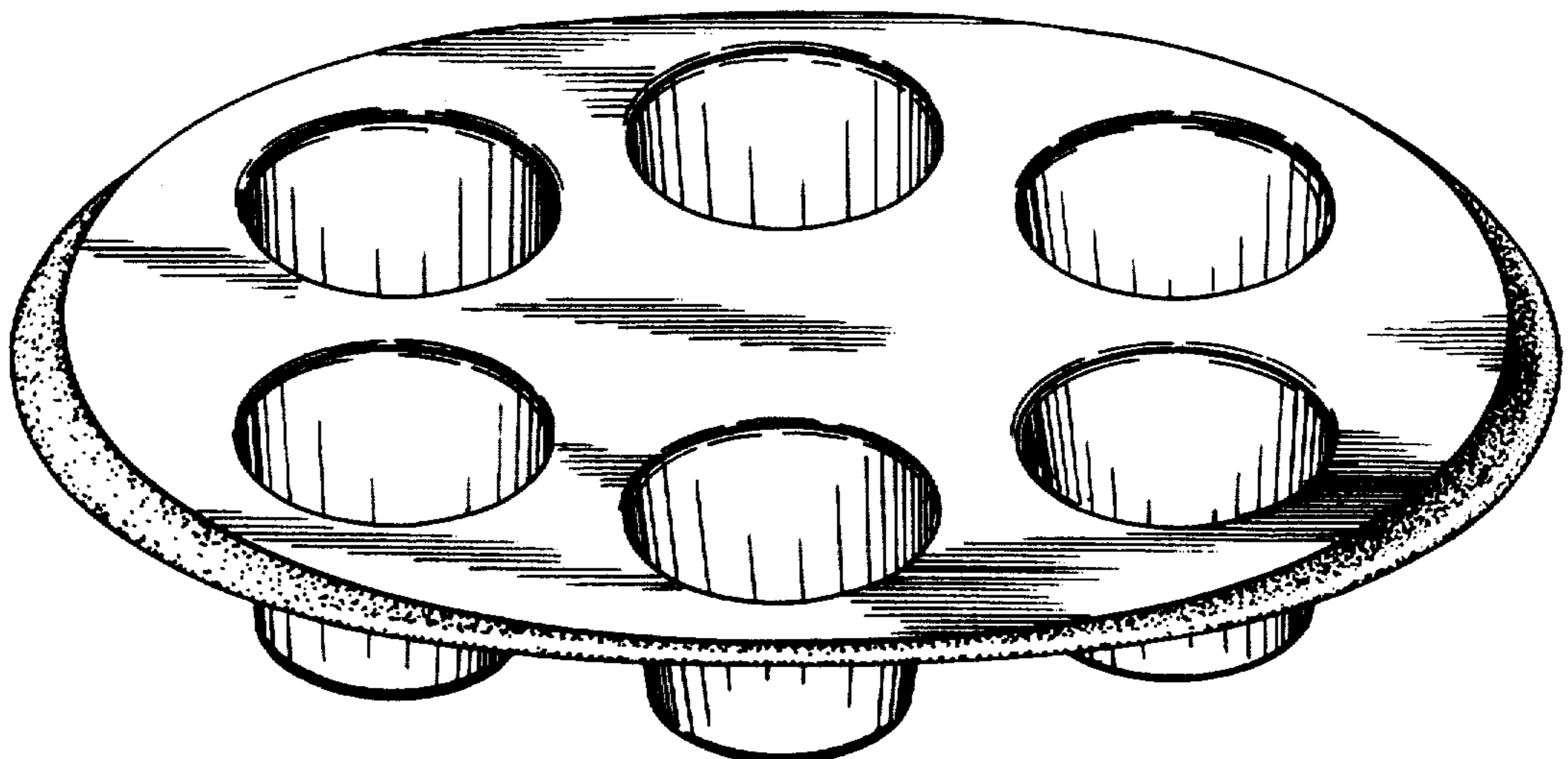
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a muffin pan showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof.



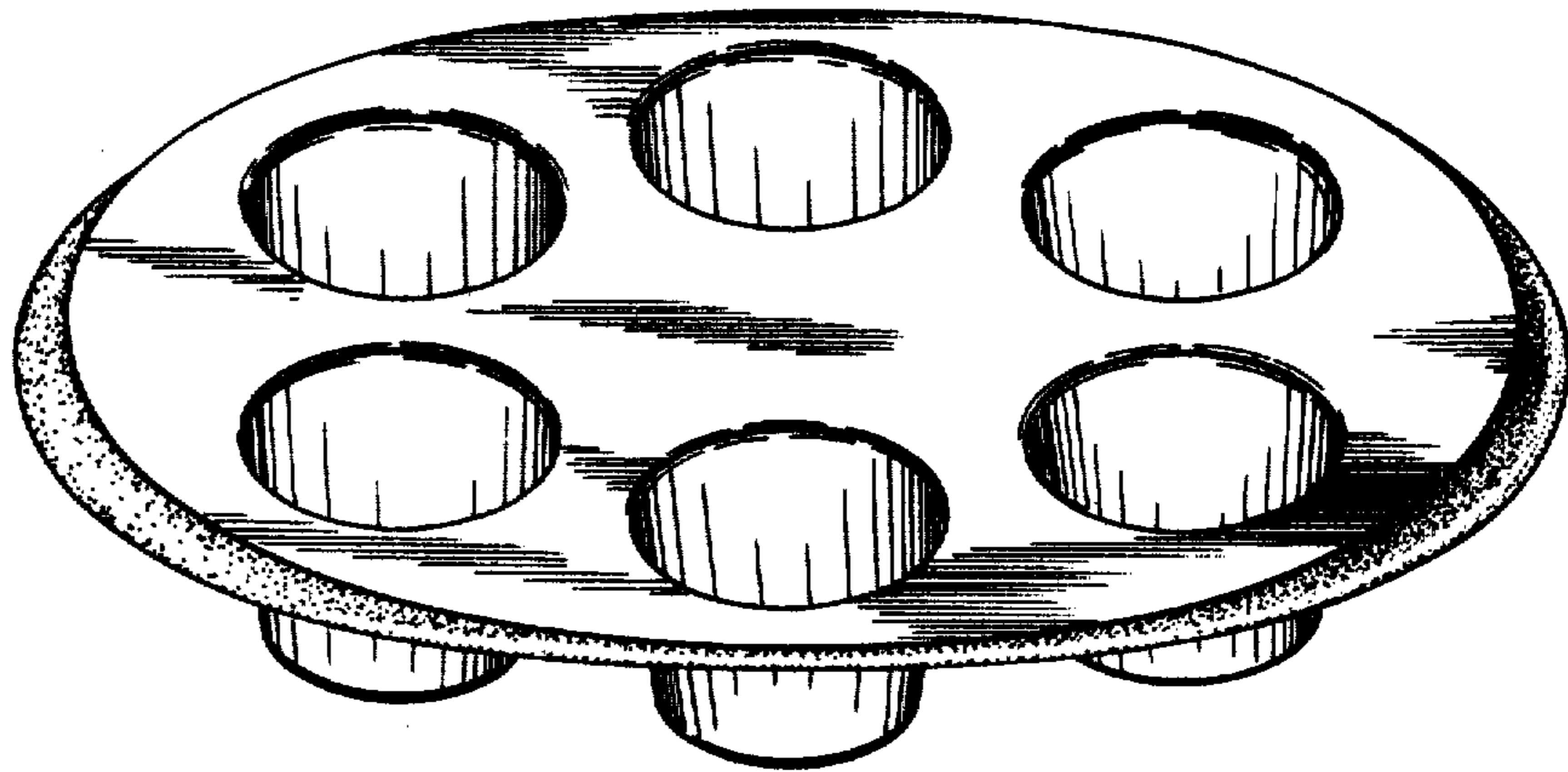

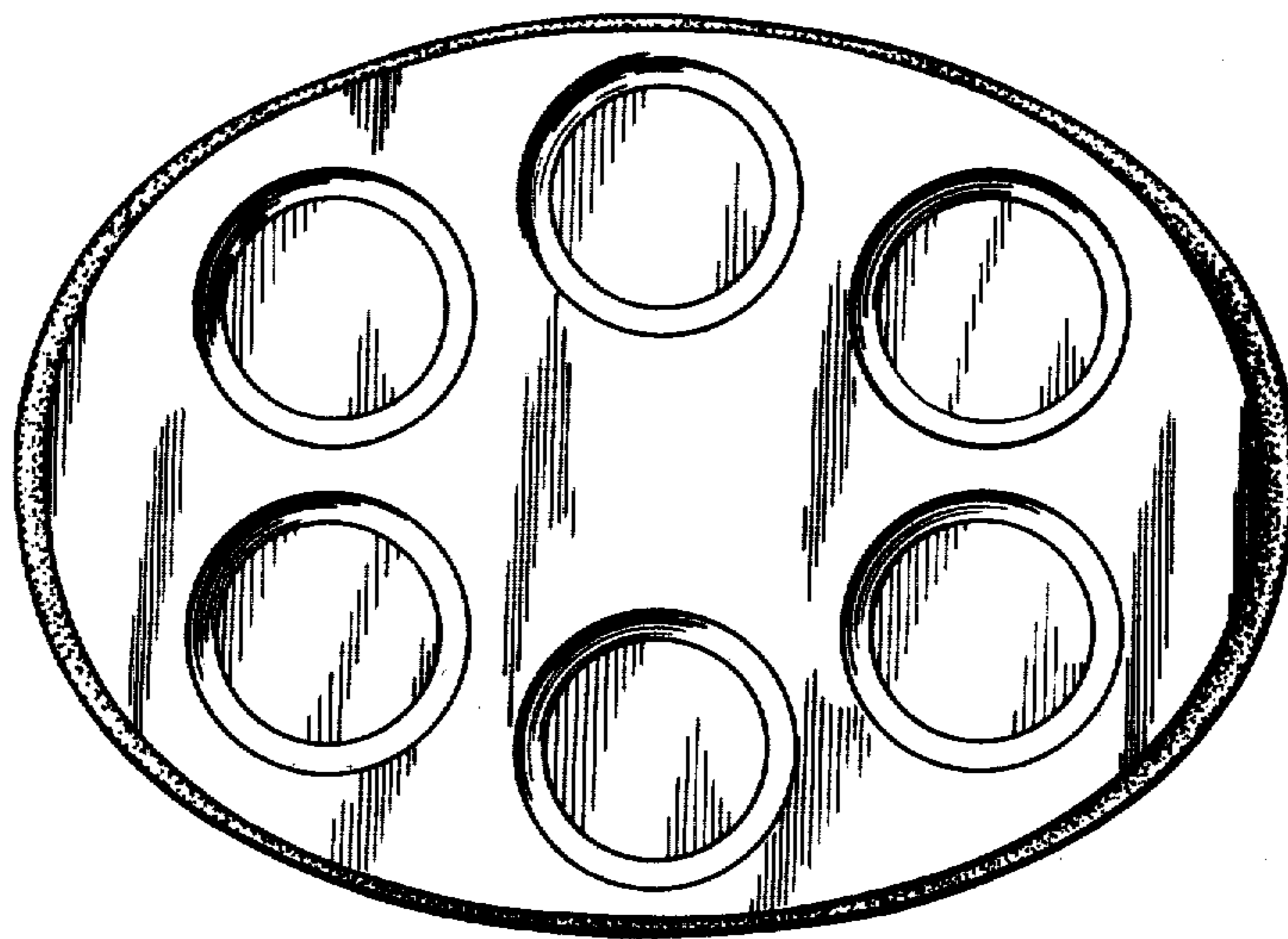

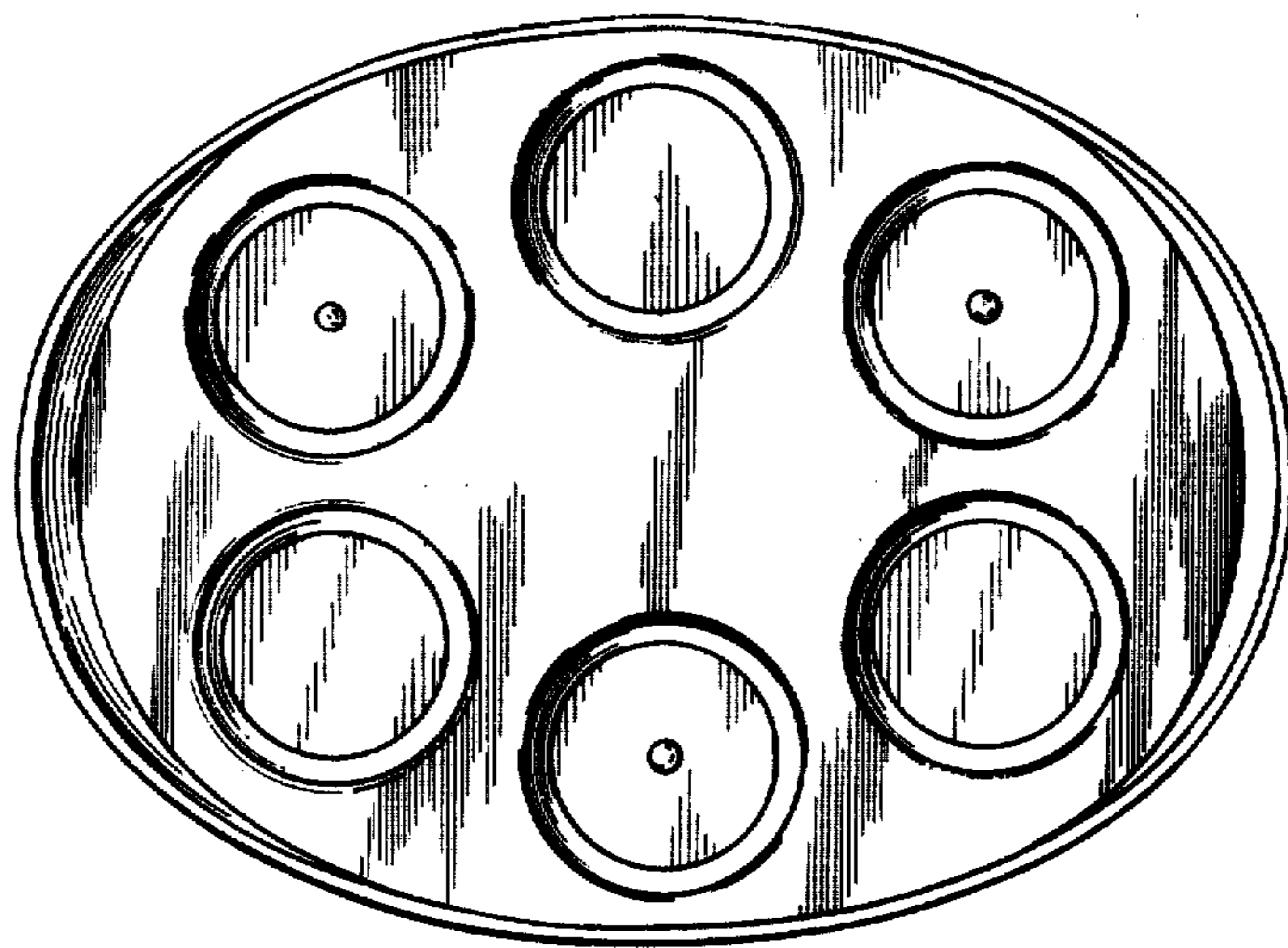
