DESCRIPTION

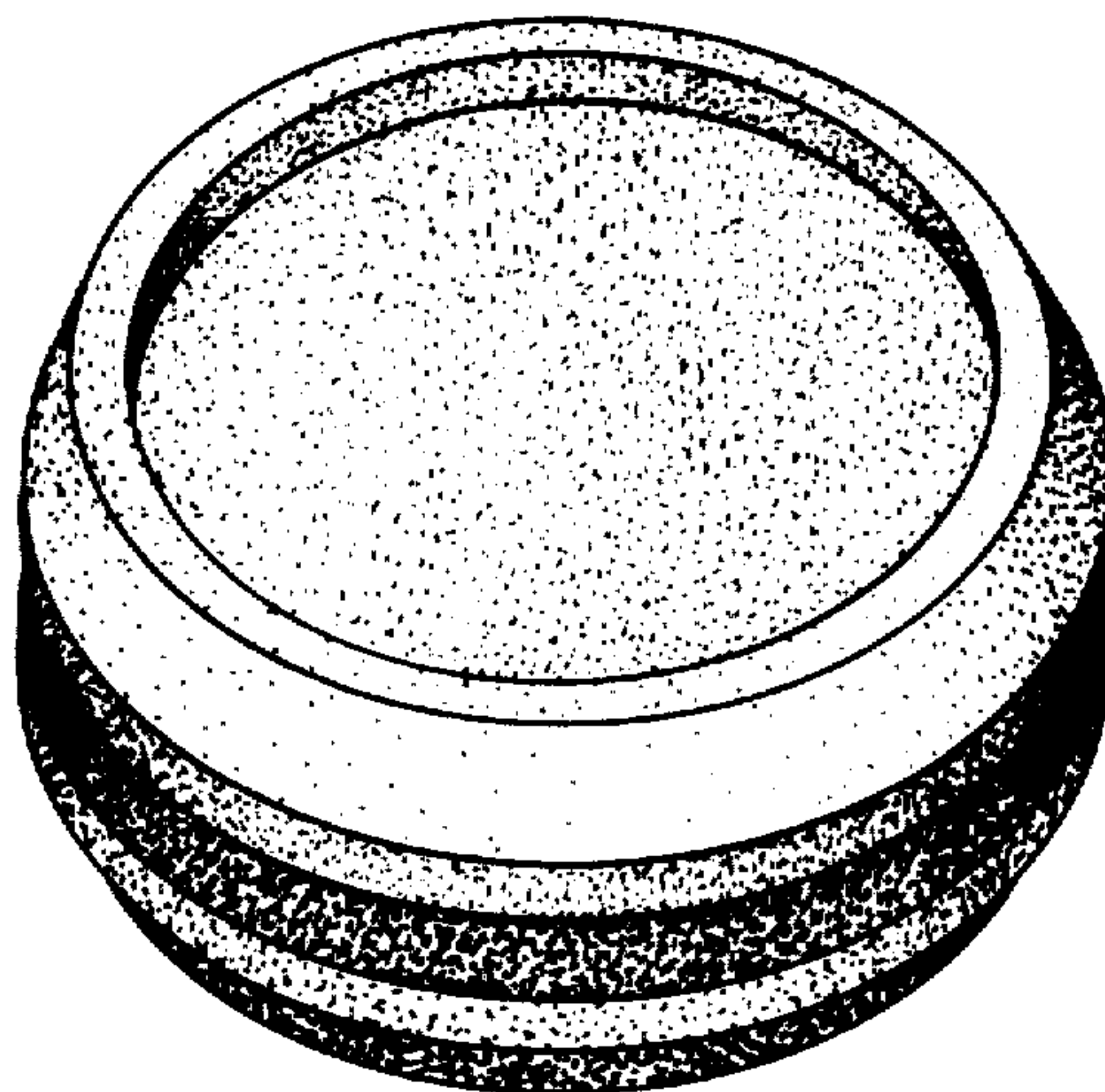
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the medallion showing

of the side shown.



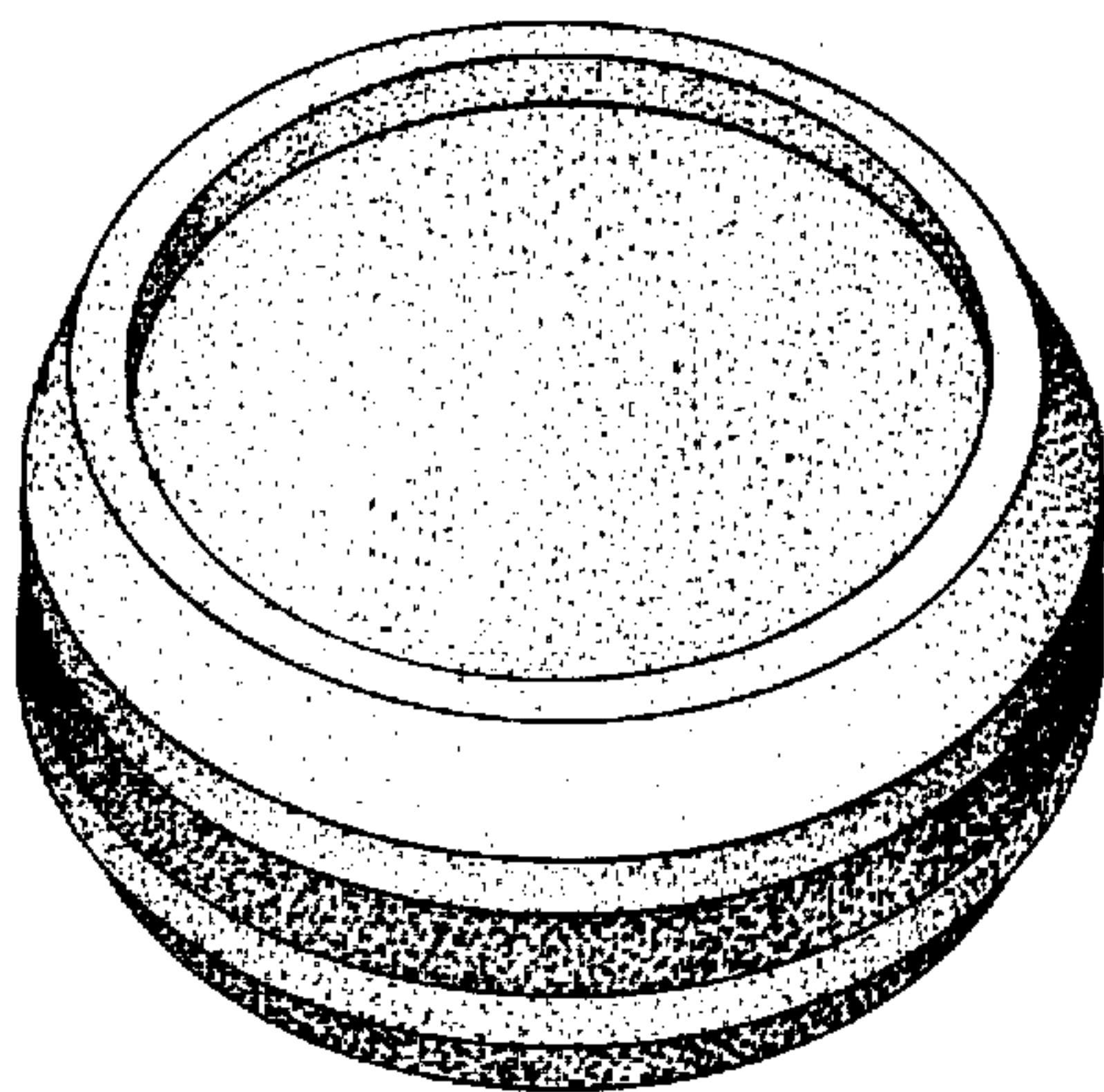

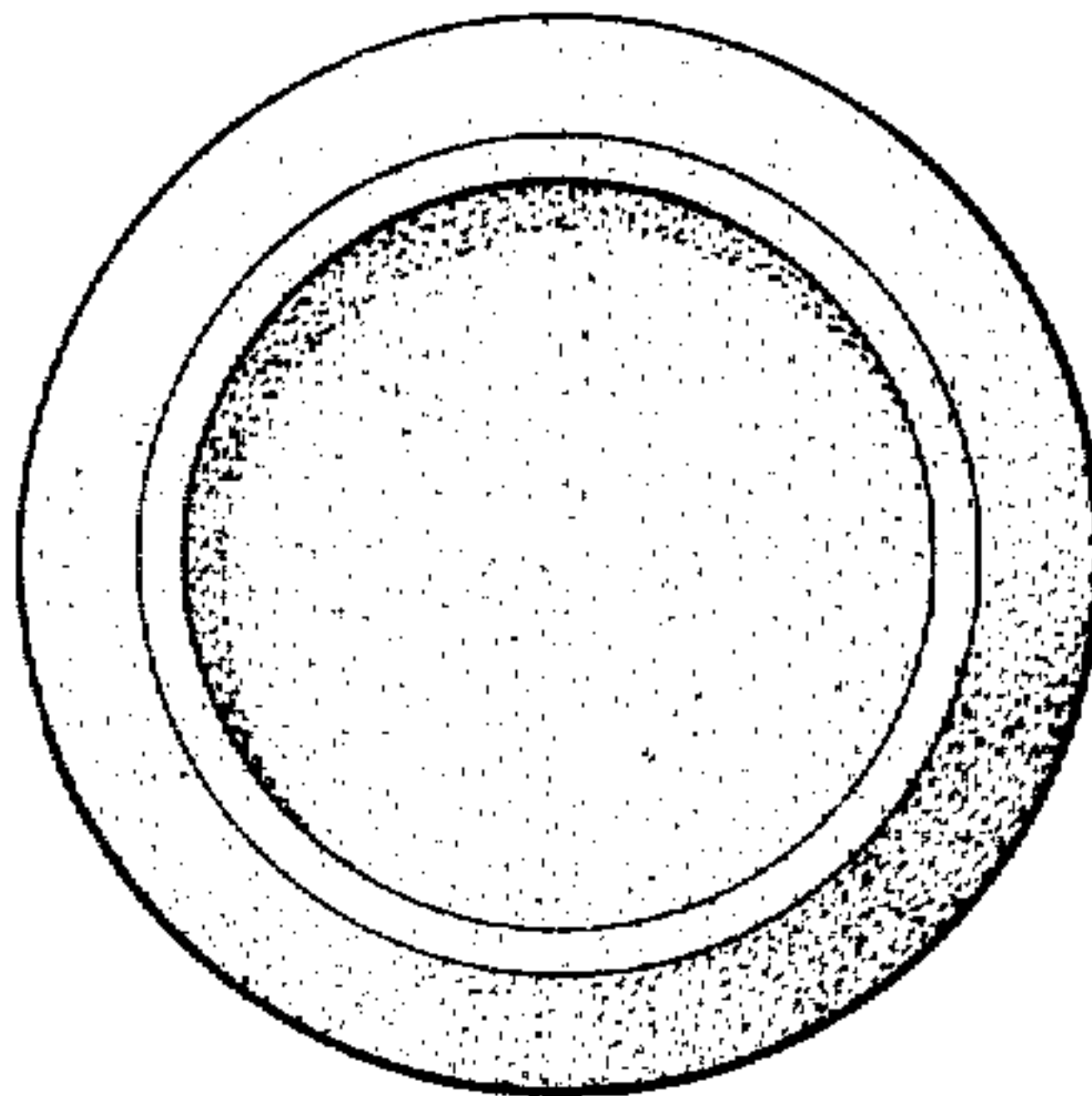

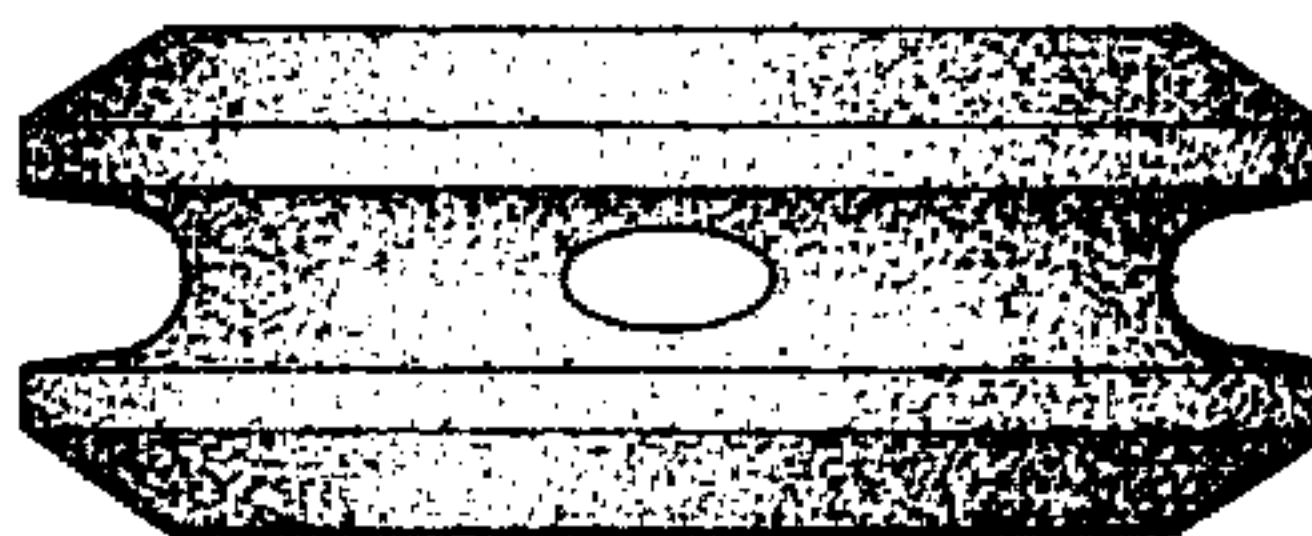

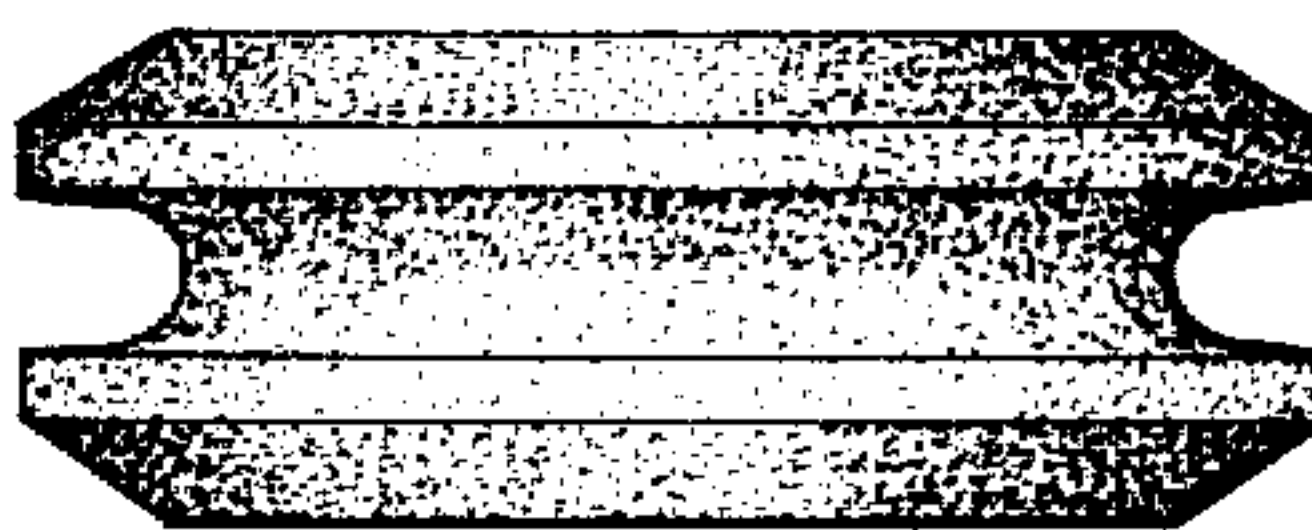
