The ornamental design for a detachable top mount base  
for mounting a telescopic pistol sight, as shown and  
described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the mount base;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a top elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a right side view; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.

The broken lines in FIG. 6 are not part of the design of  
the article sought to be patented, but show the manner  
in which a telescopic pistol sight is carried by the mount  
of this invention and the manner in which the mount is  
carried by a pistol frame.

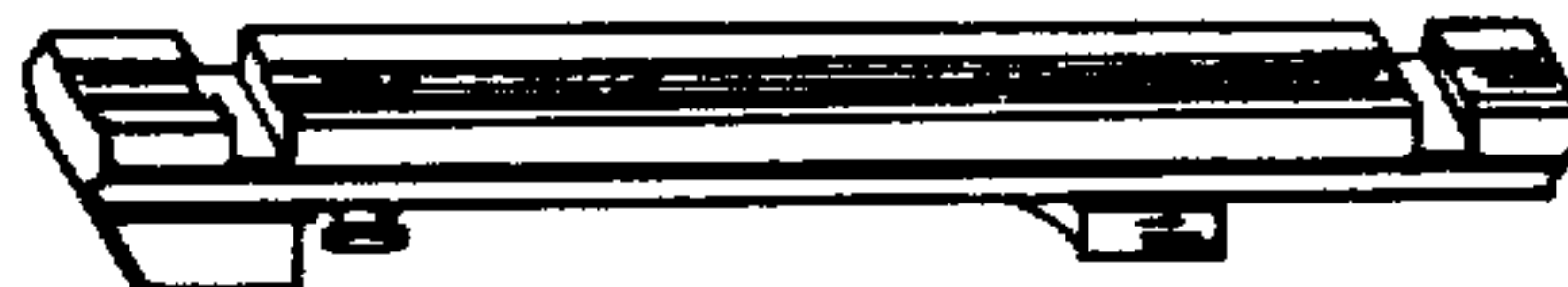

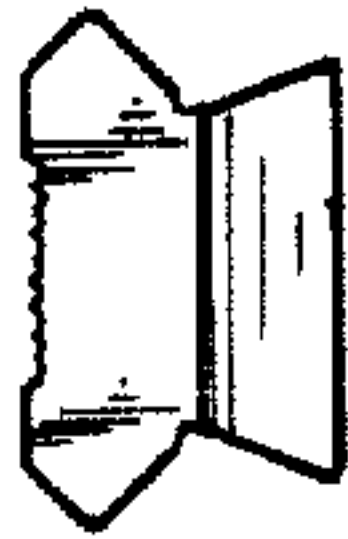

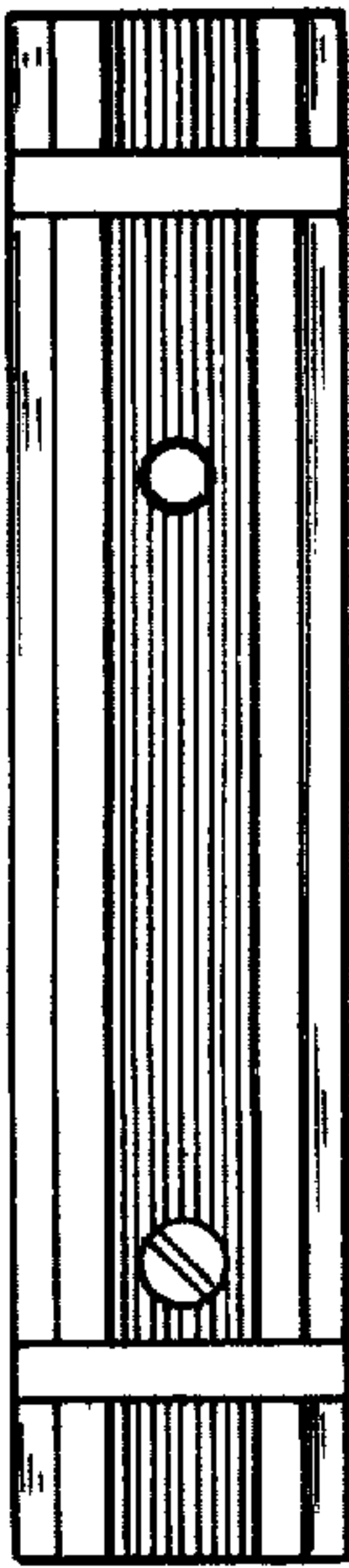

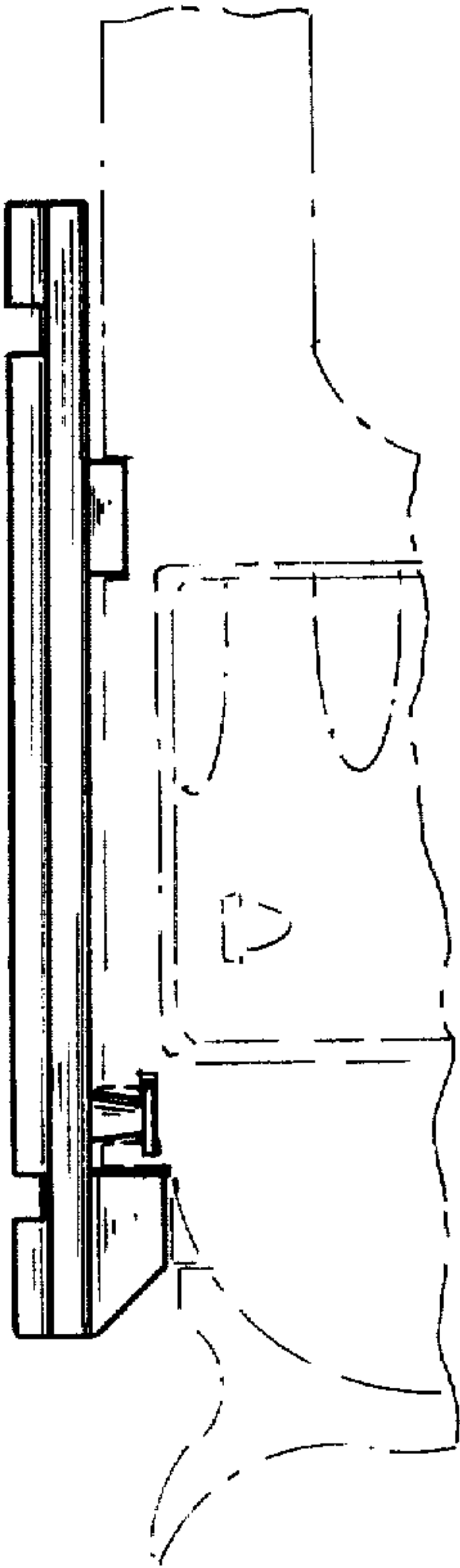

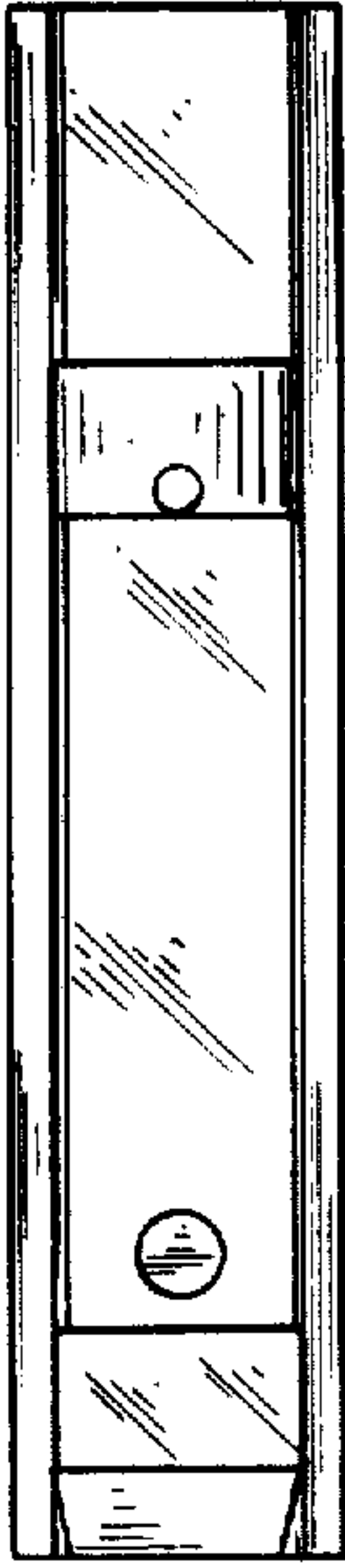
