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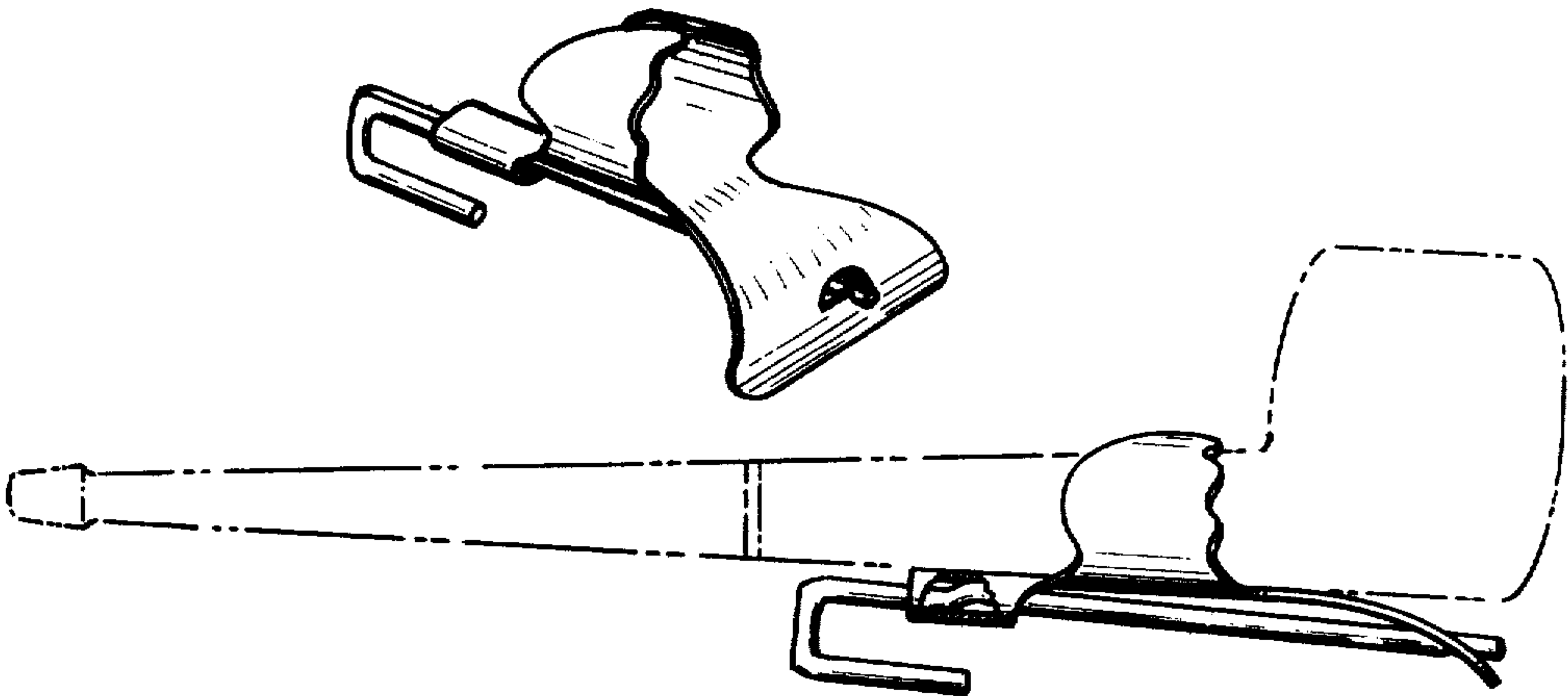

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combination support and tool for a smoker's pipe, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.  
The front, rear, top and bottom views of FIGS. 7 and 8 will be substantially as shown in FIGS. 3-6.  
The broken line disclosure of a pipe in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



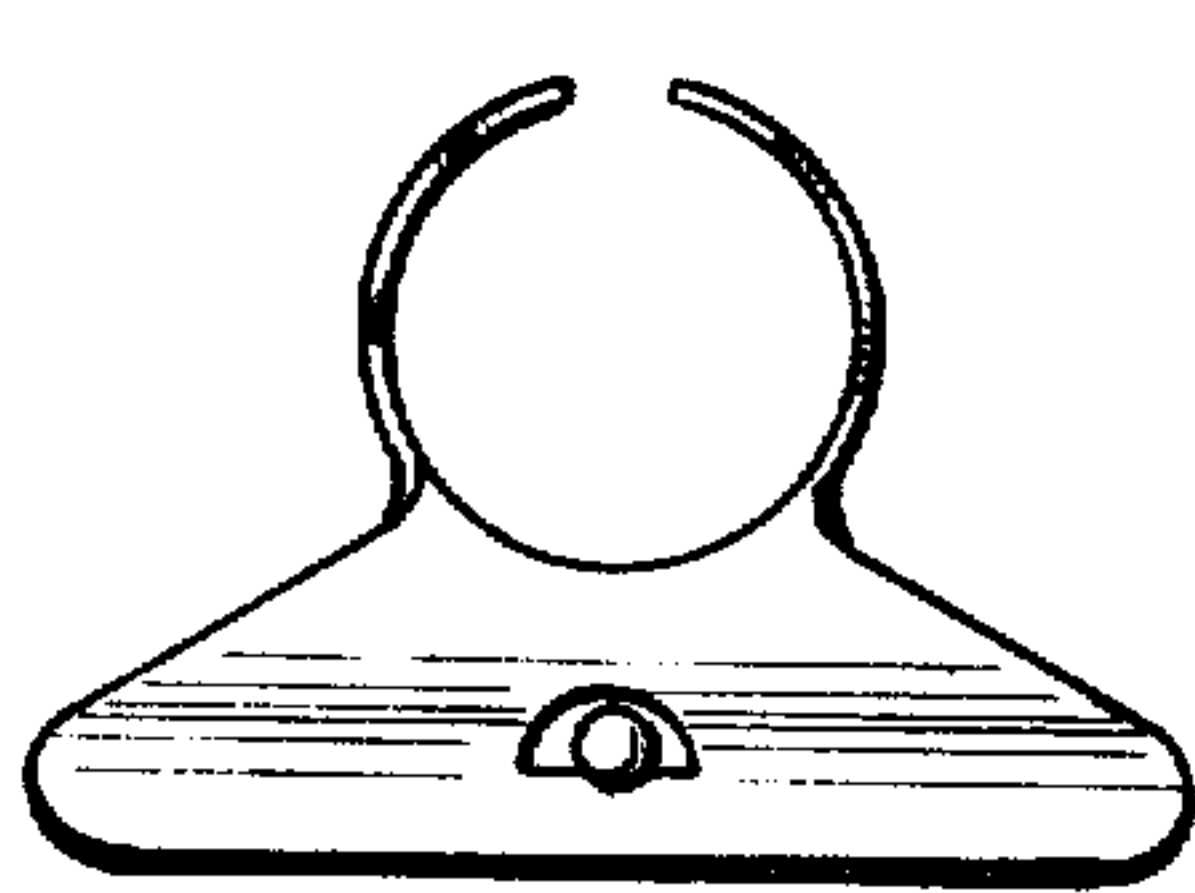

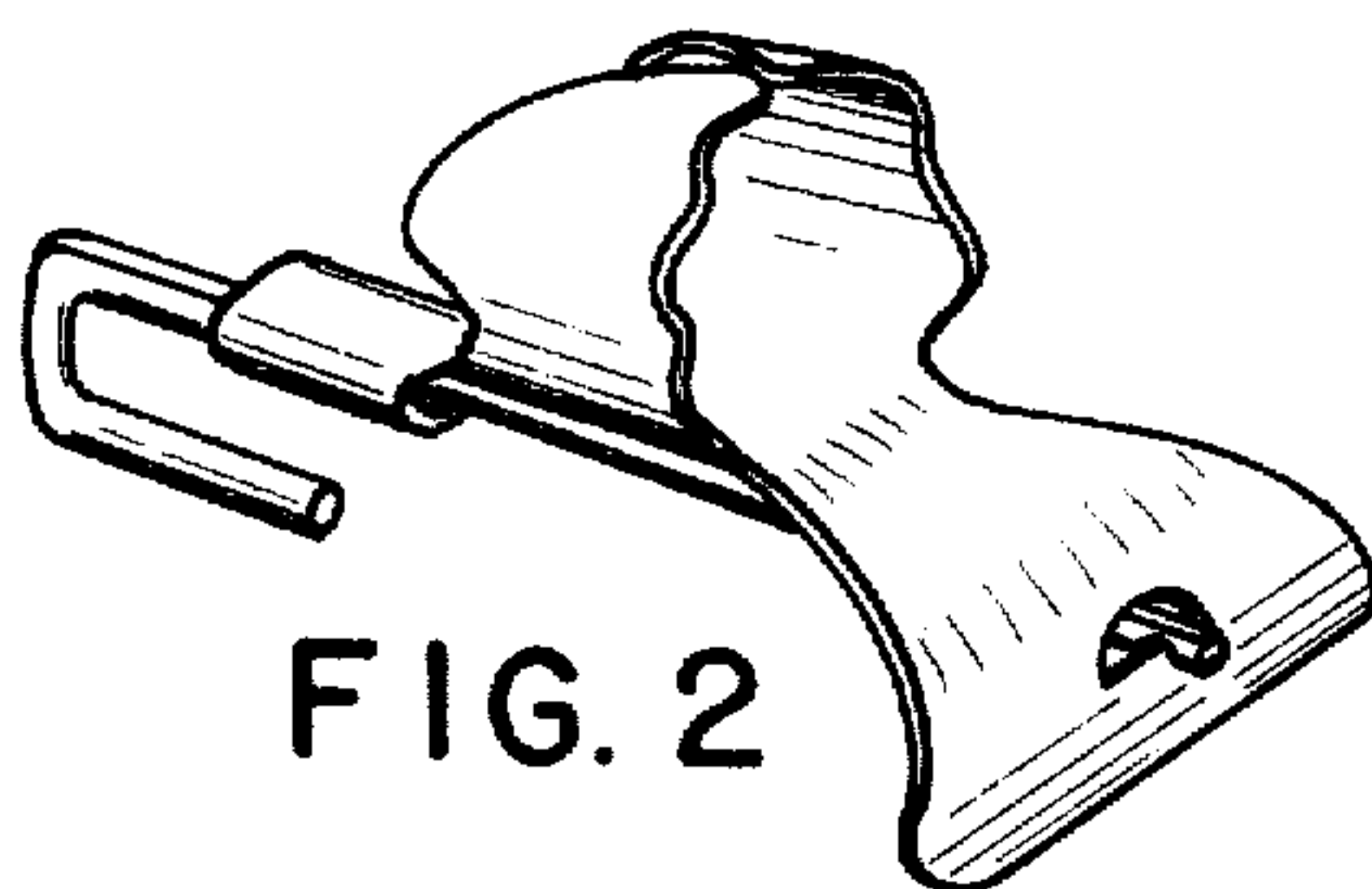

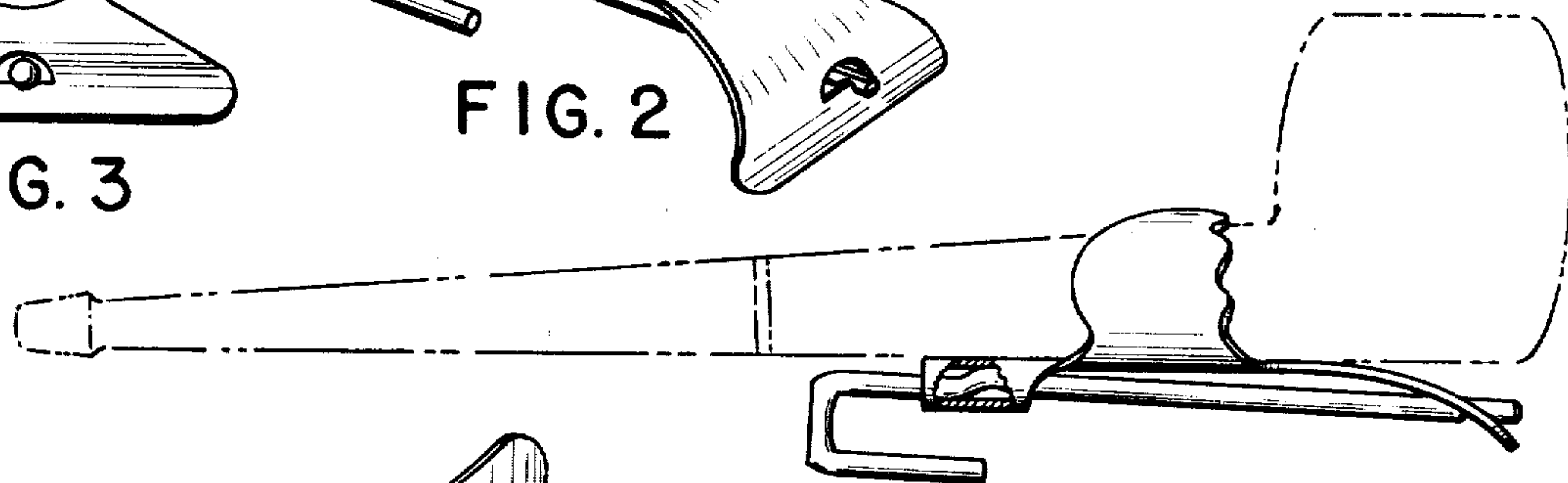

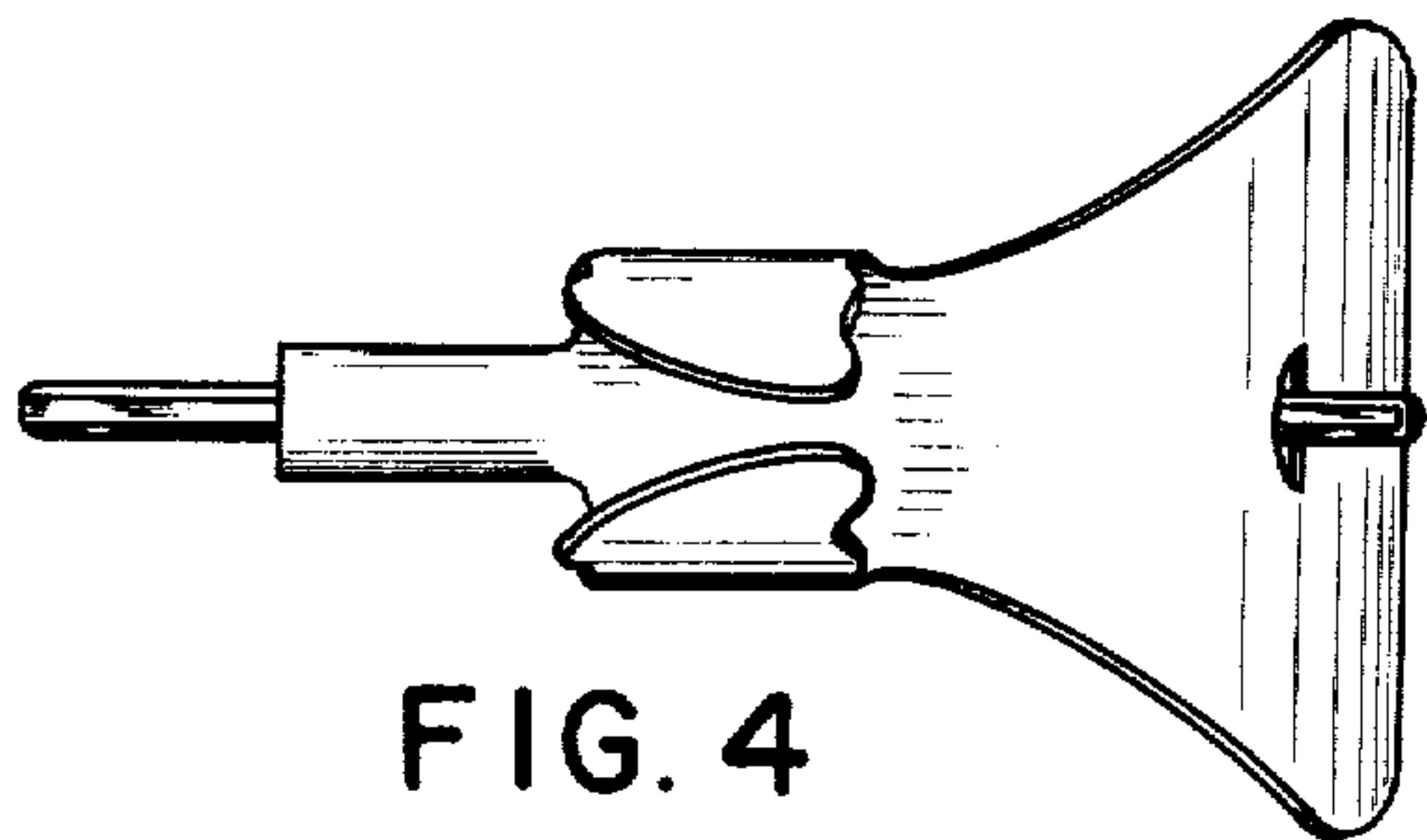

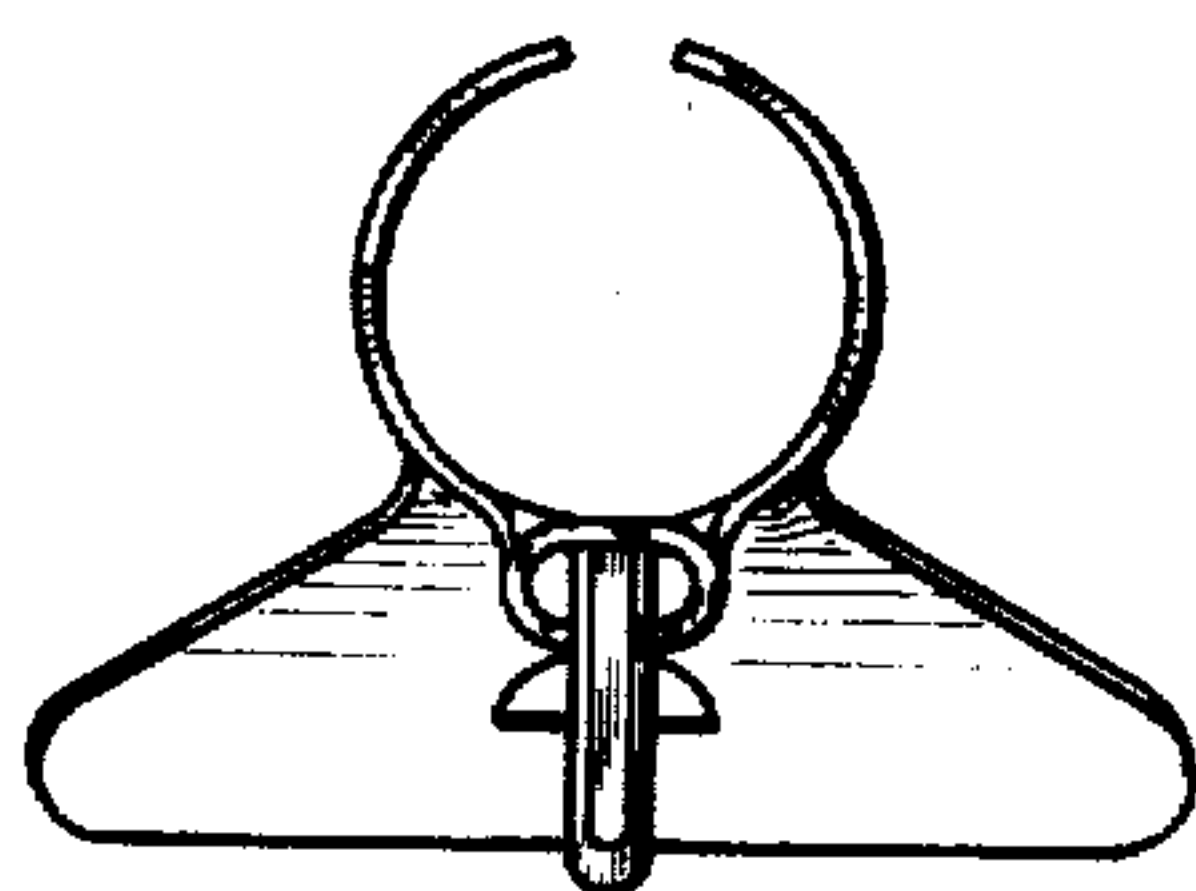

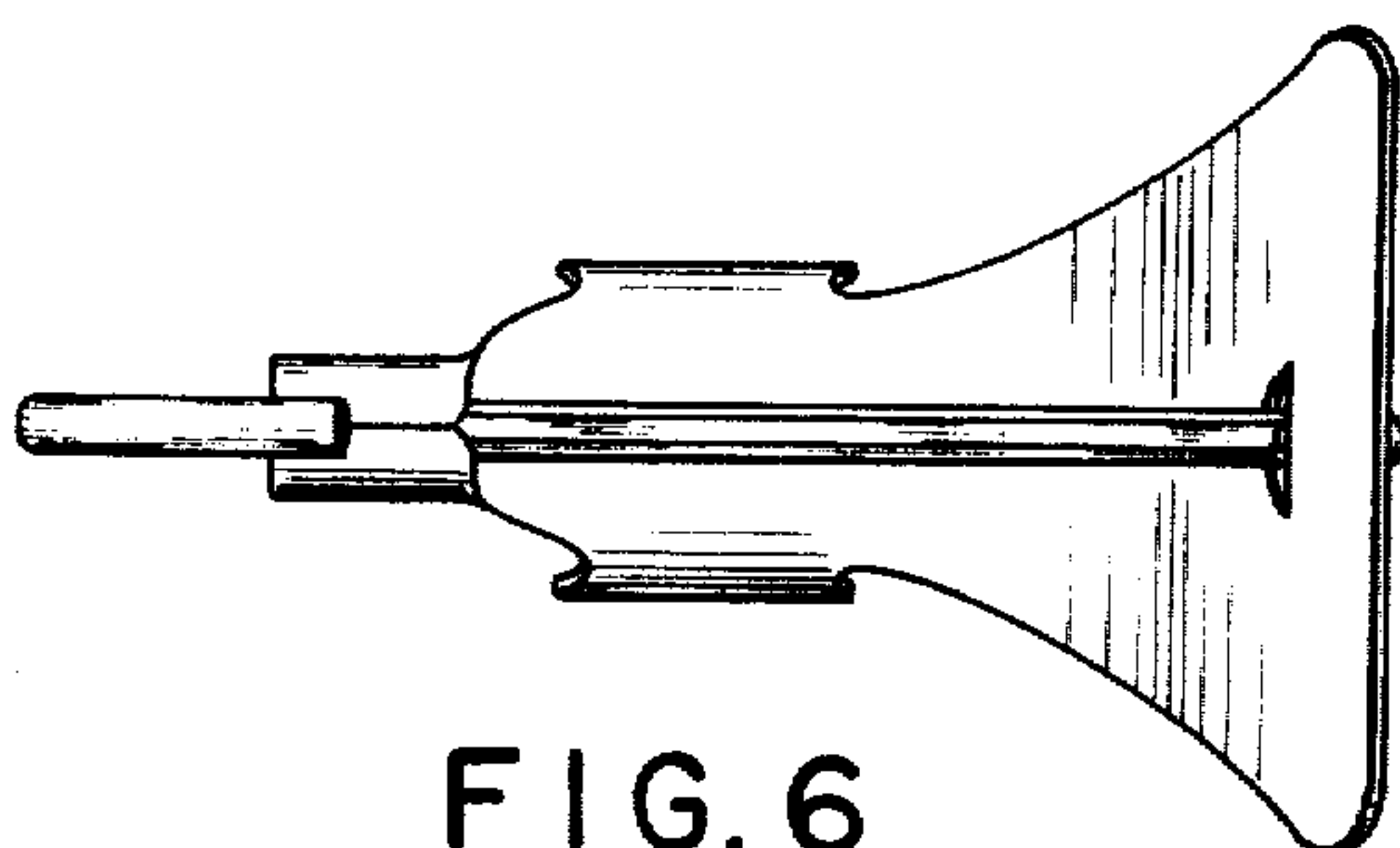
