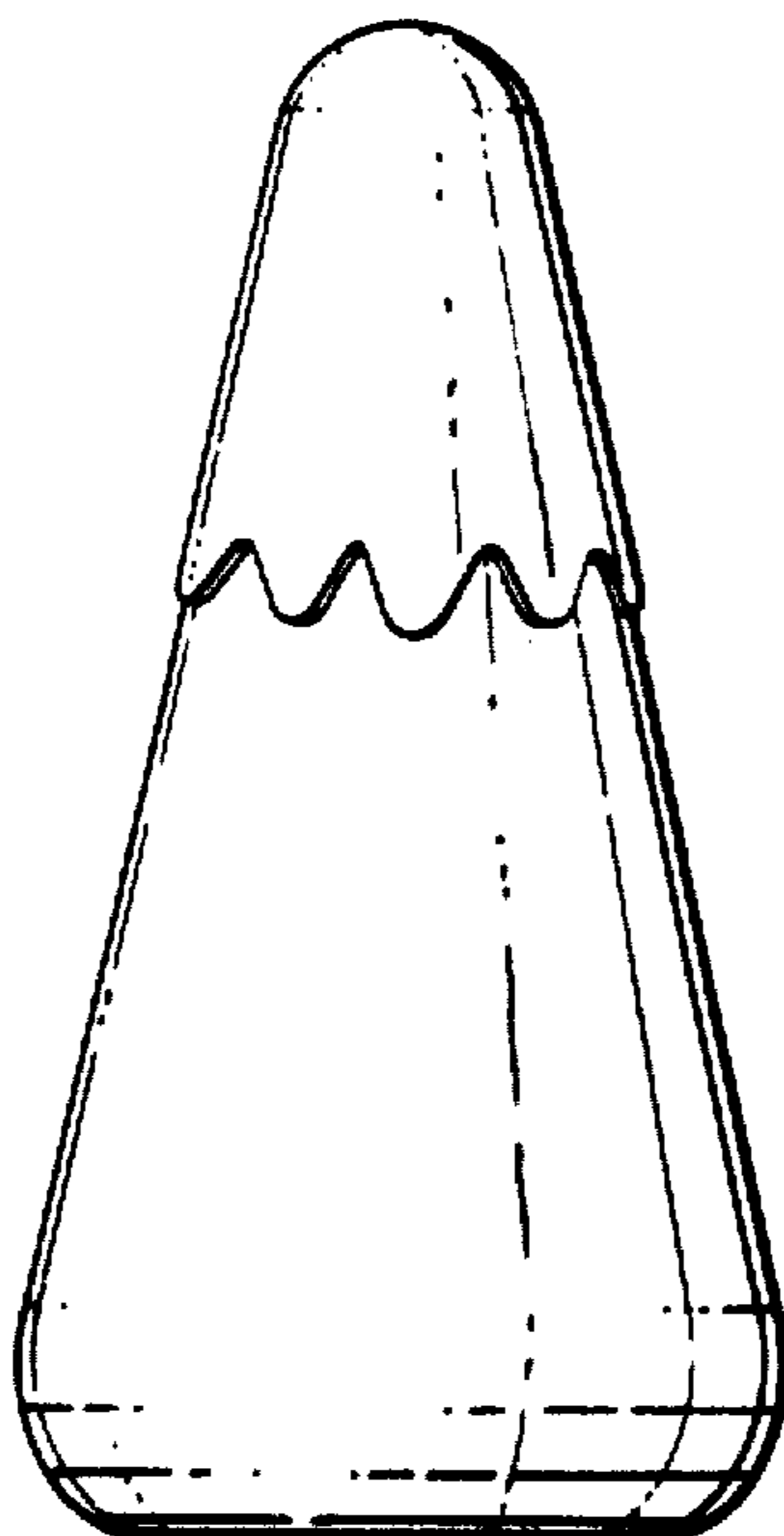

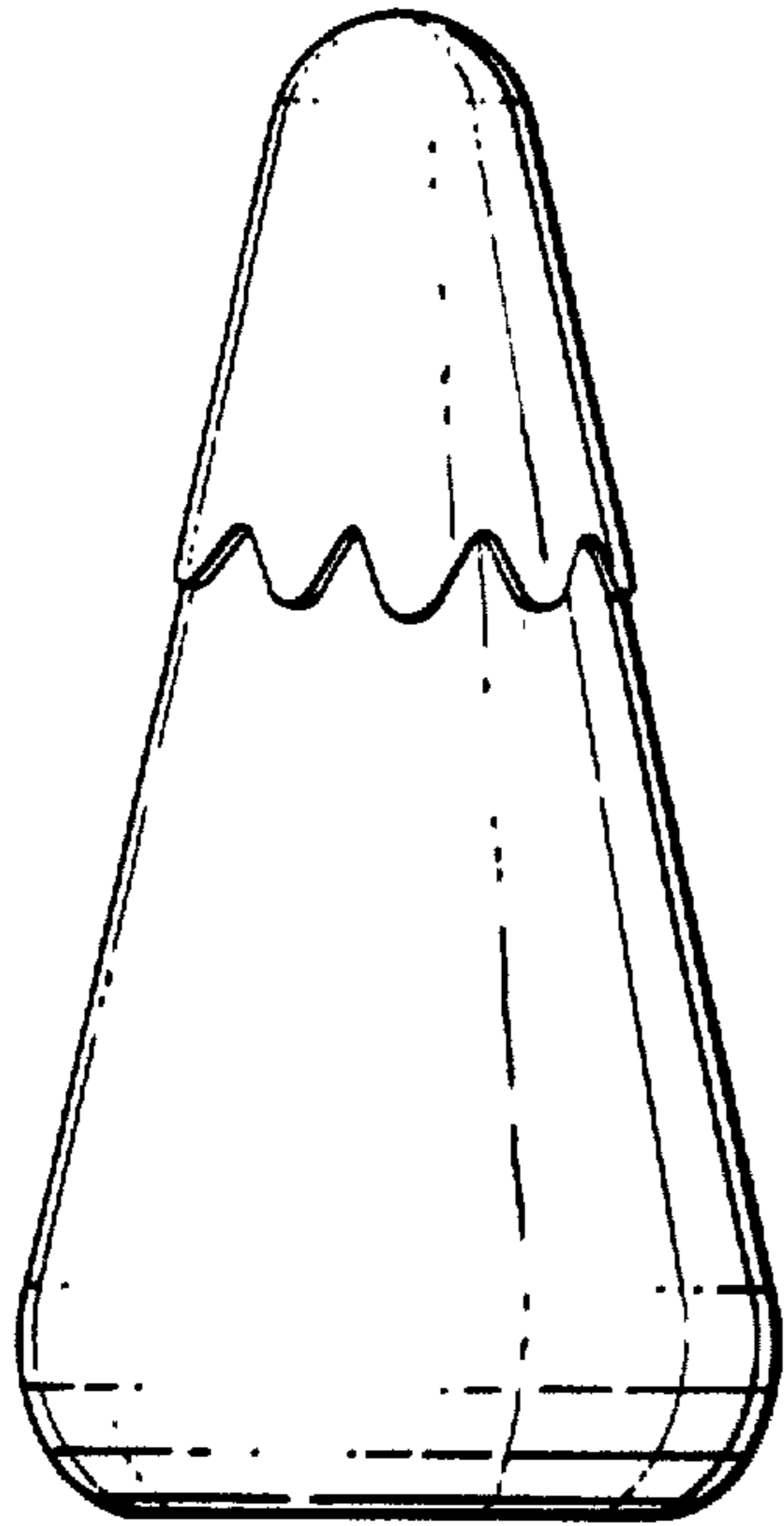
The ornamental design for a combined bottle and cap, substantially as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

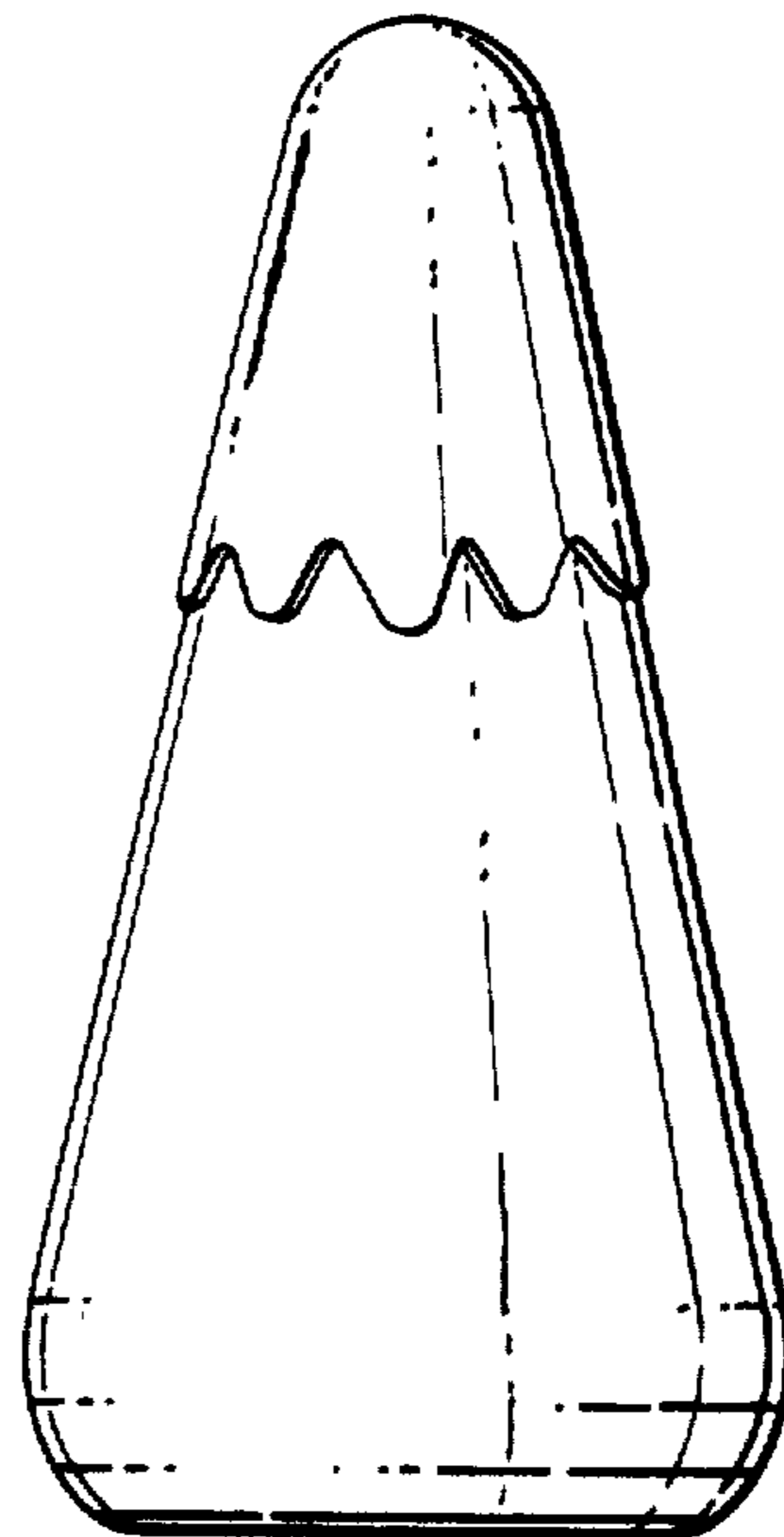
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a combined bottle and cap showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



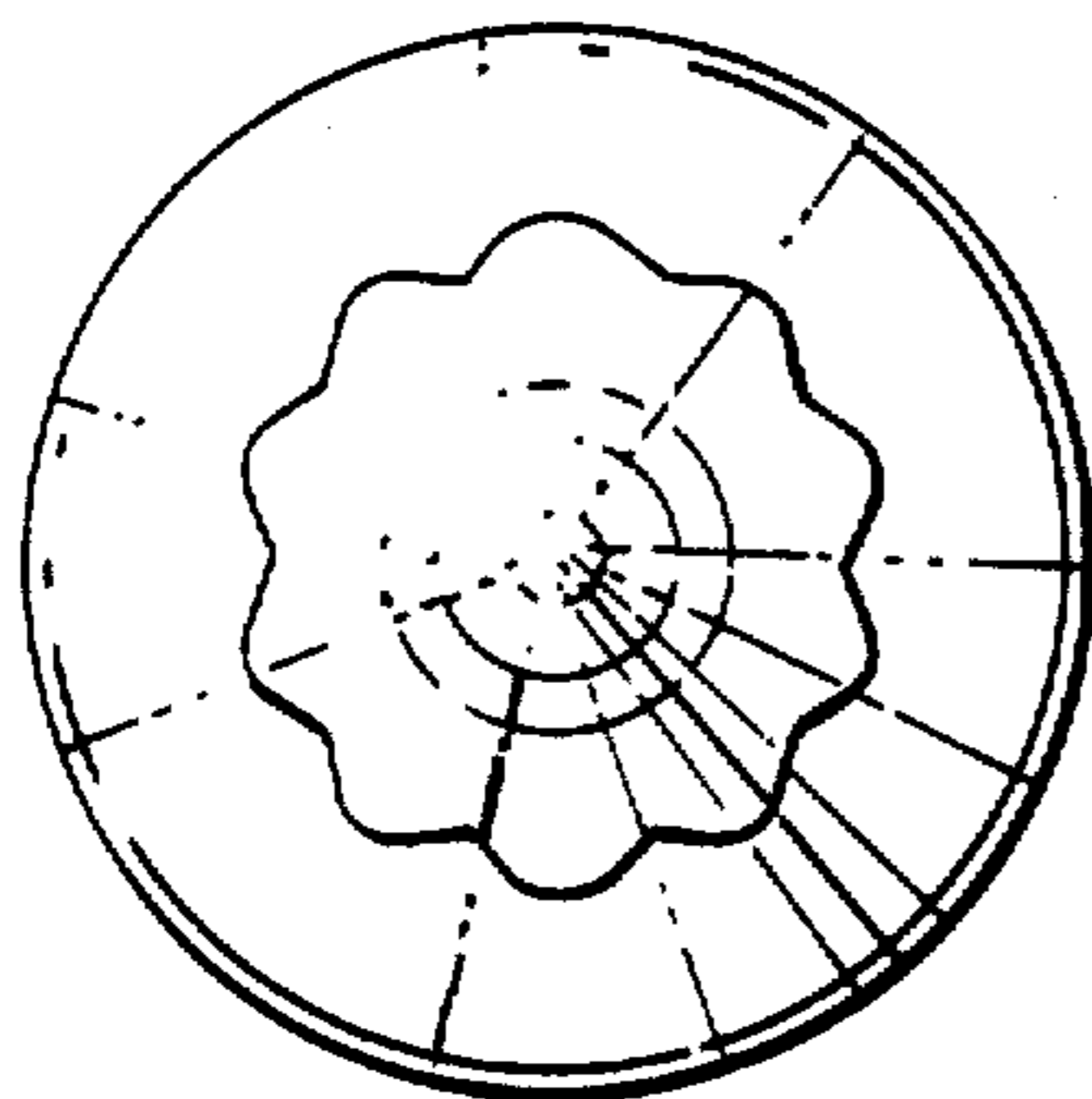
