DESCRIPTION

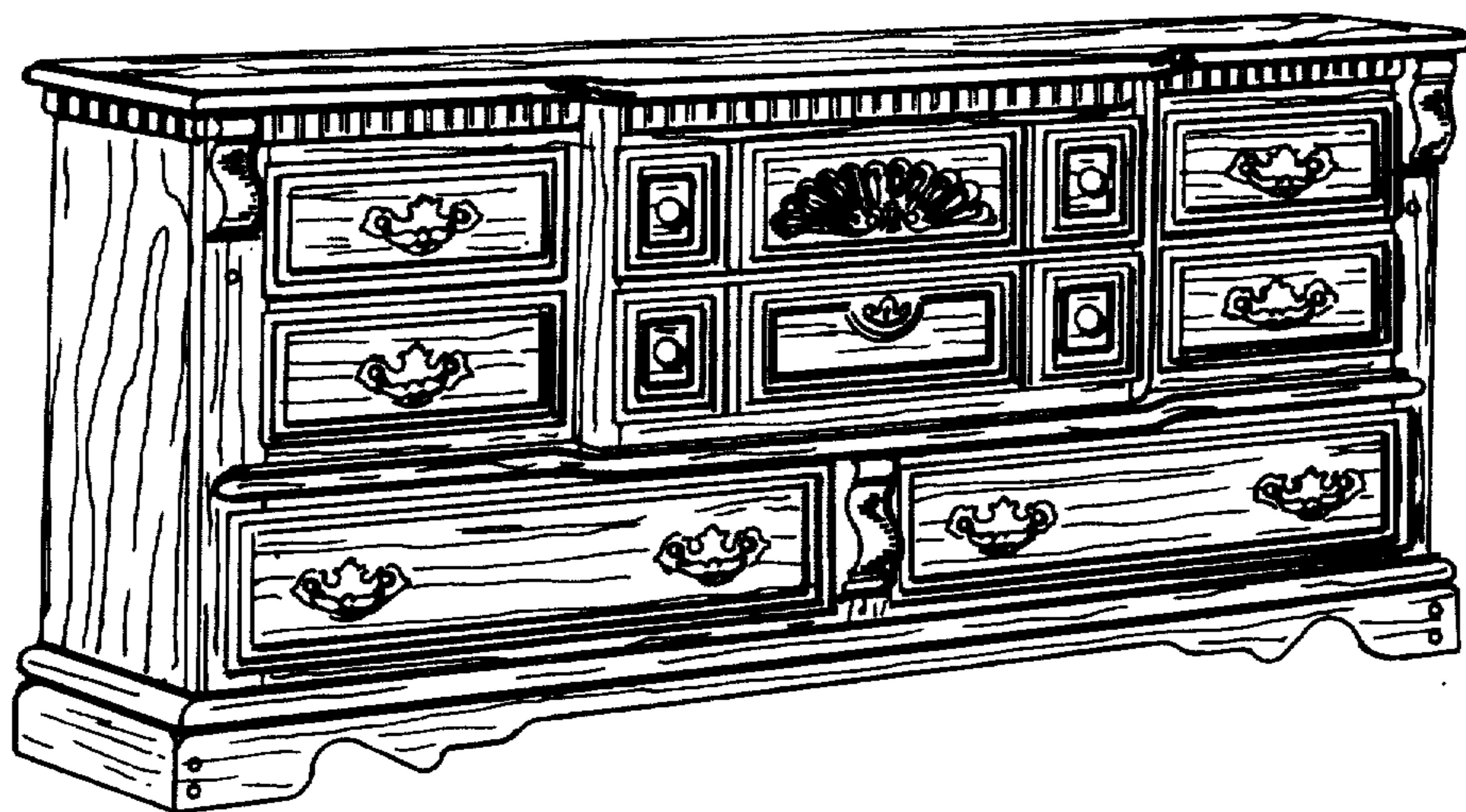
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dresser or the like embodying our new design;

The rear and bottom of the dresser or the like are substantially plain and unornamented.



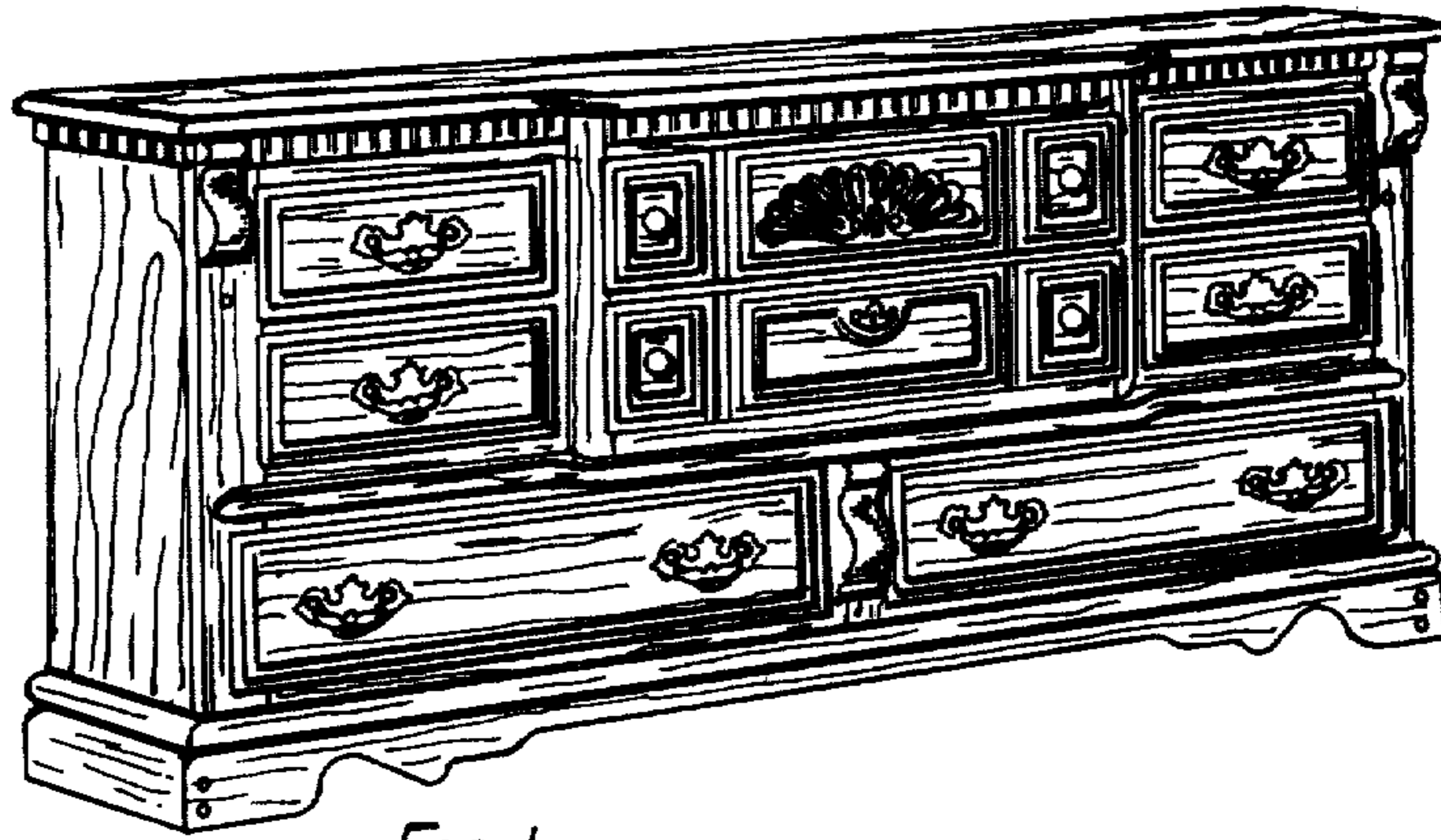

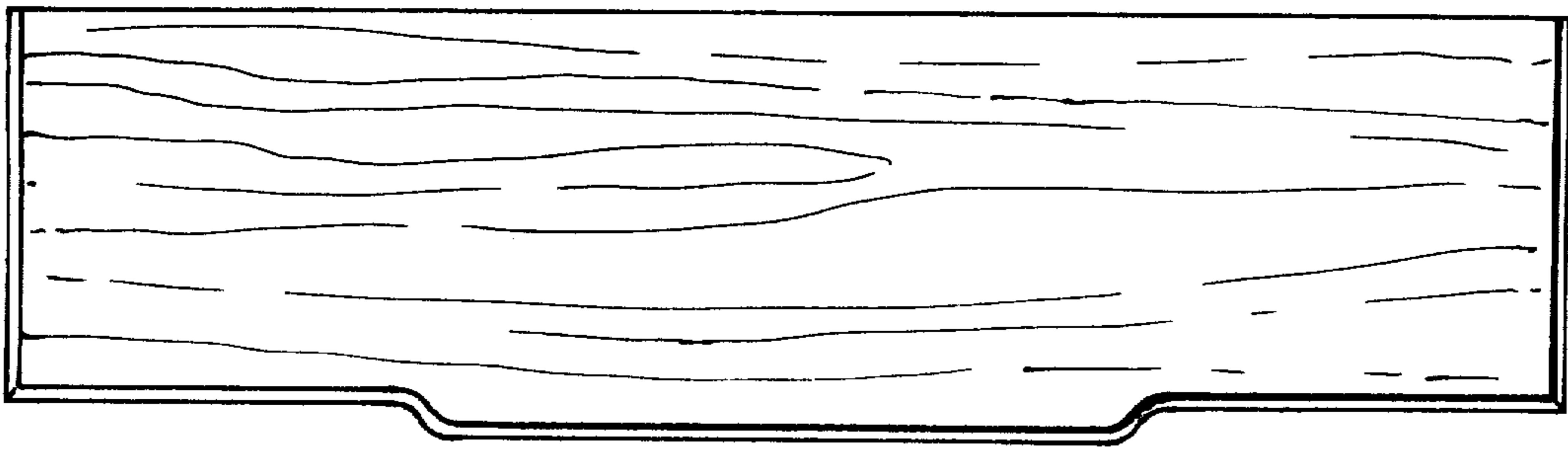

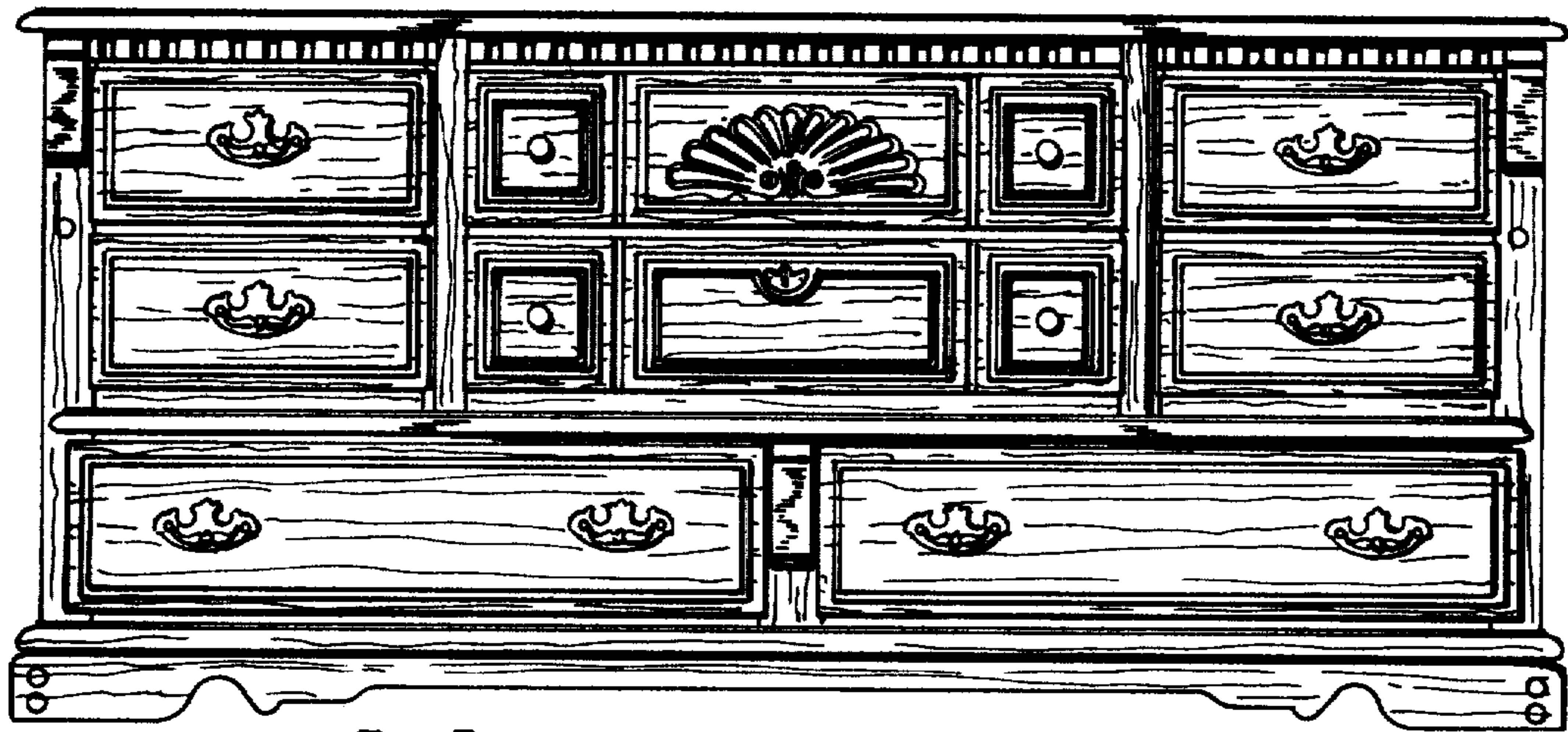

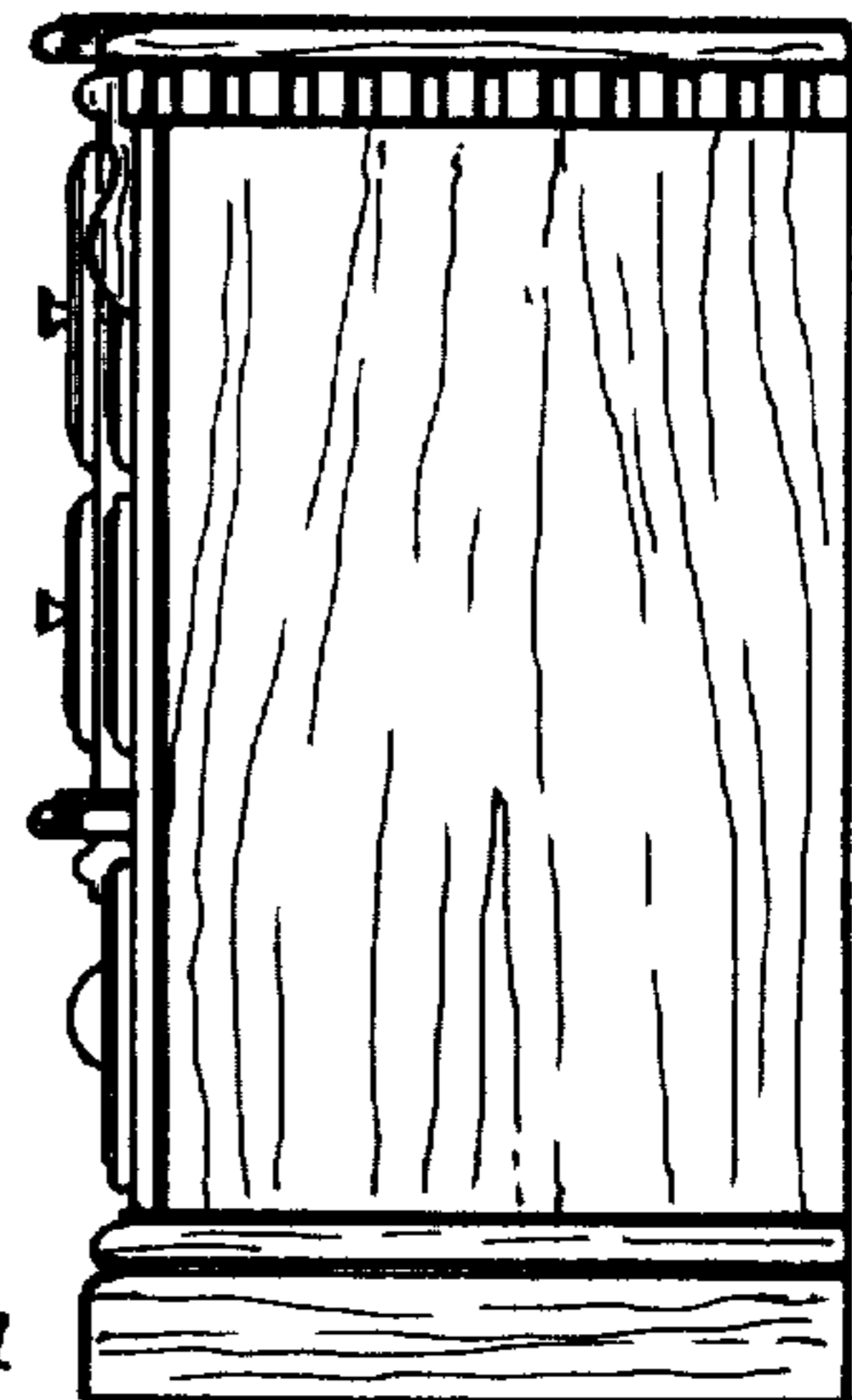
