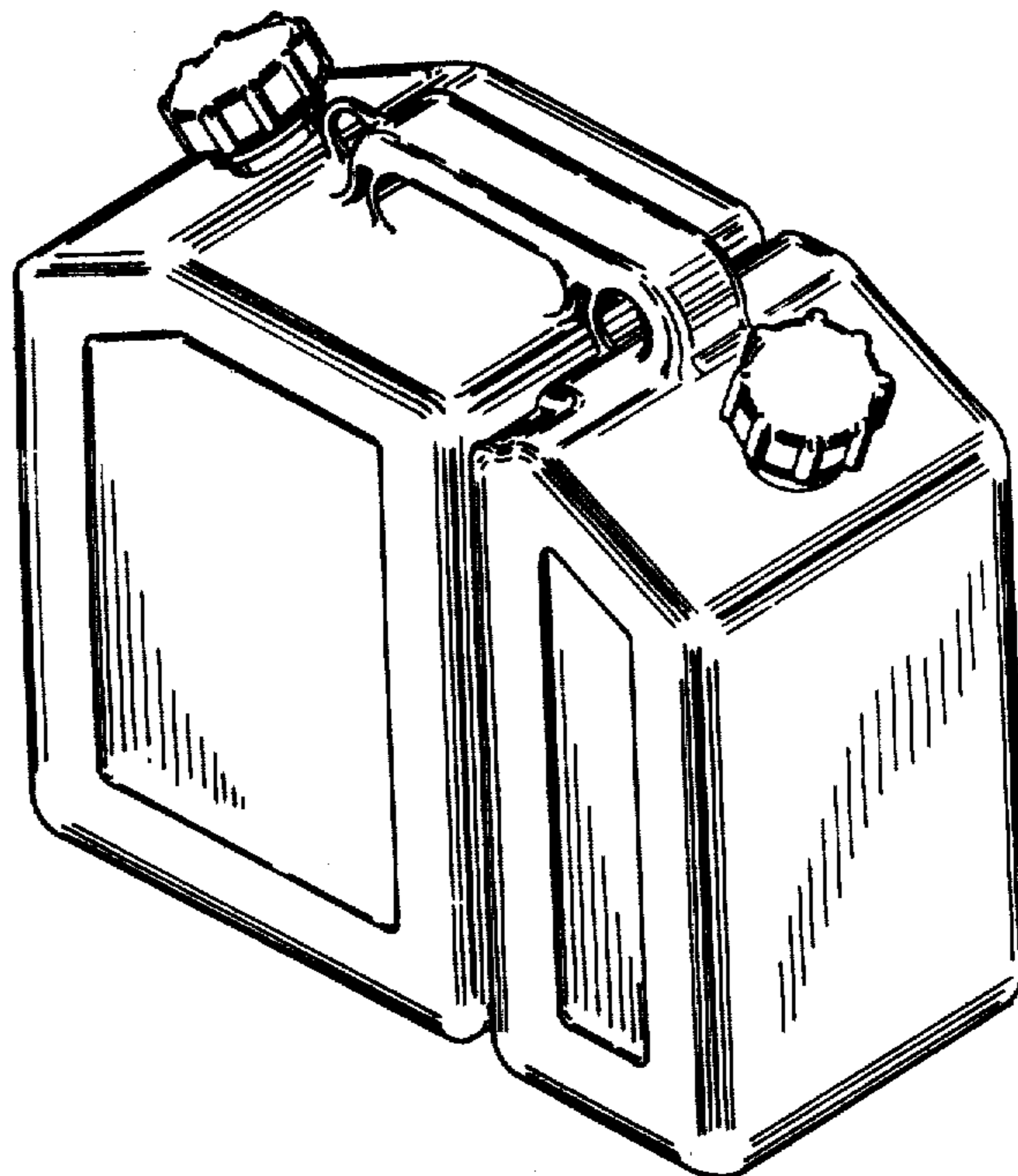

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a dual compartment portable container showing my new design.

 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof looking from the left side of FIG. 4.



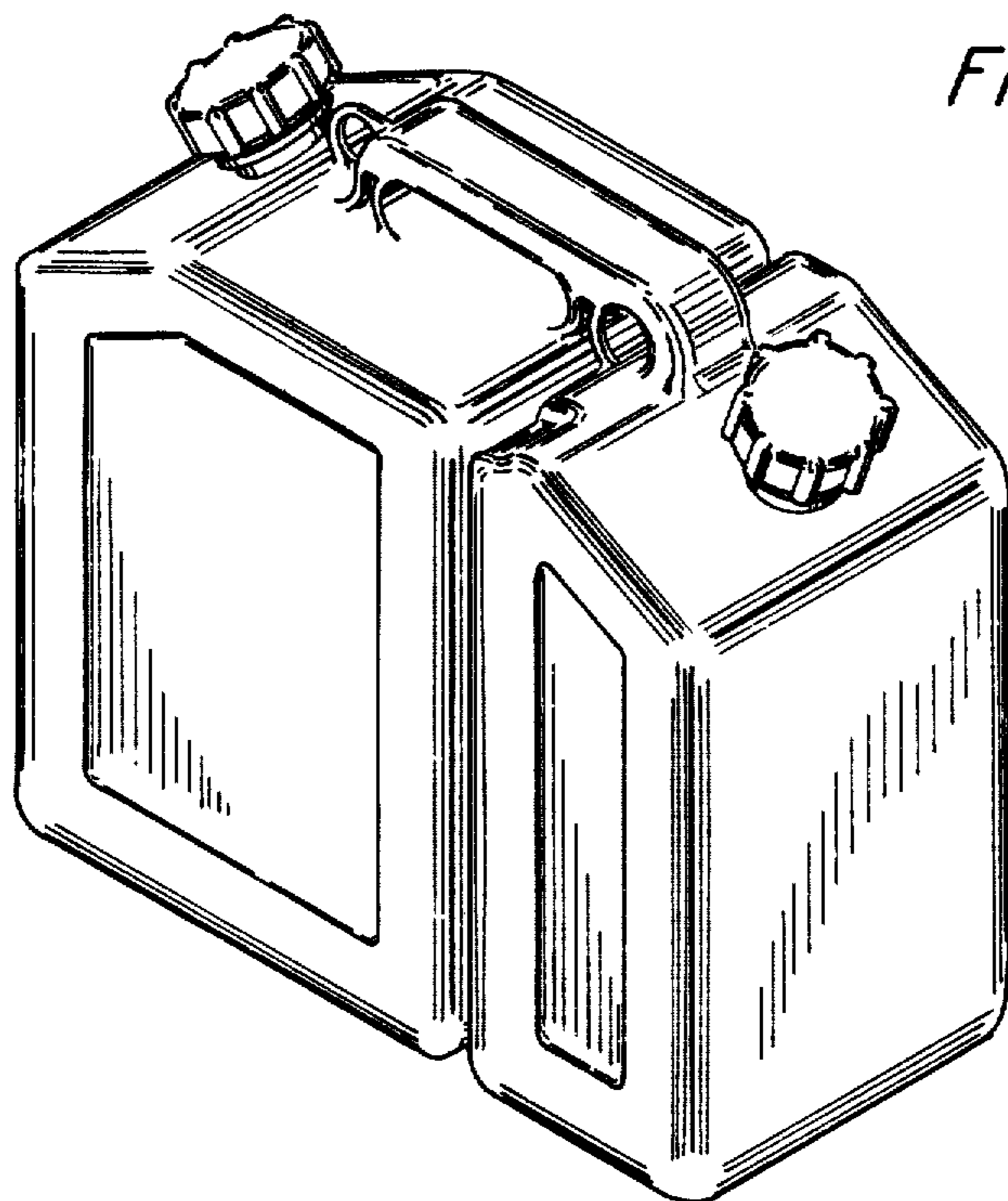

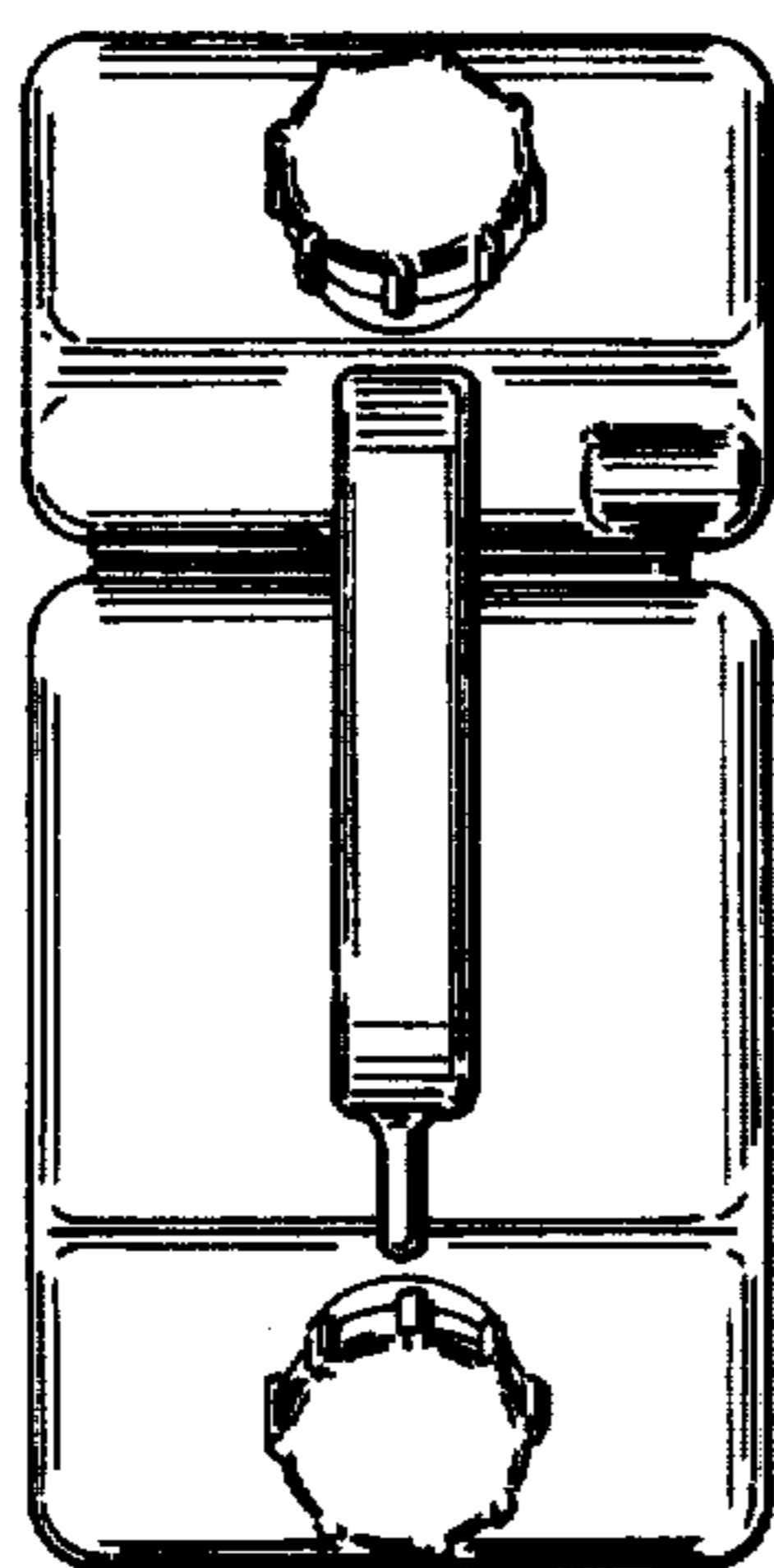

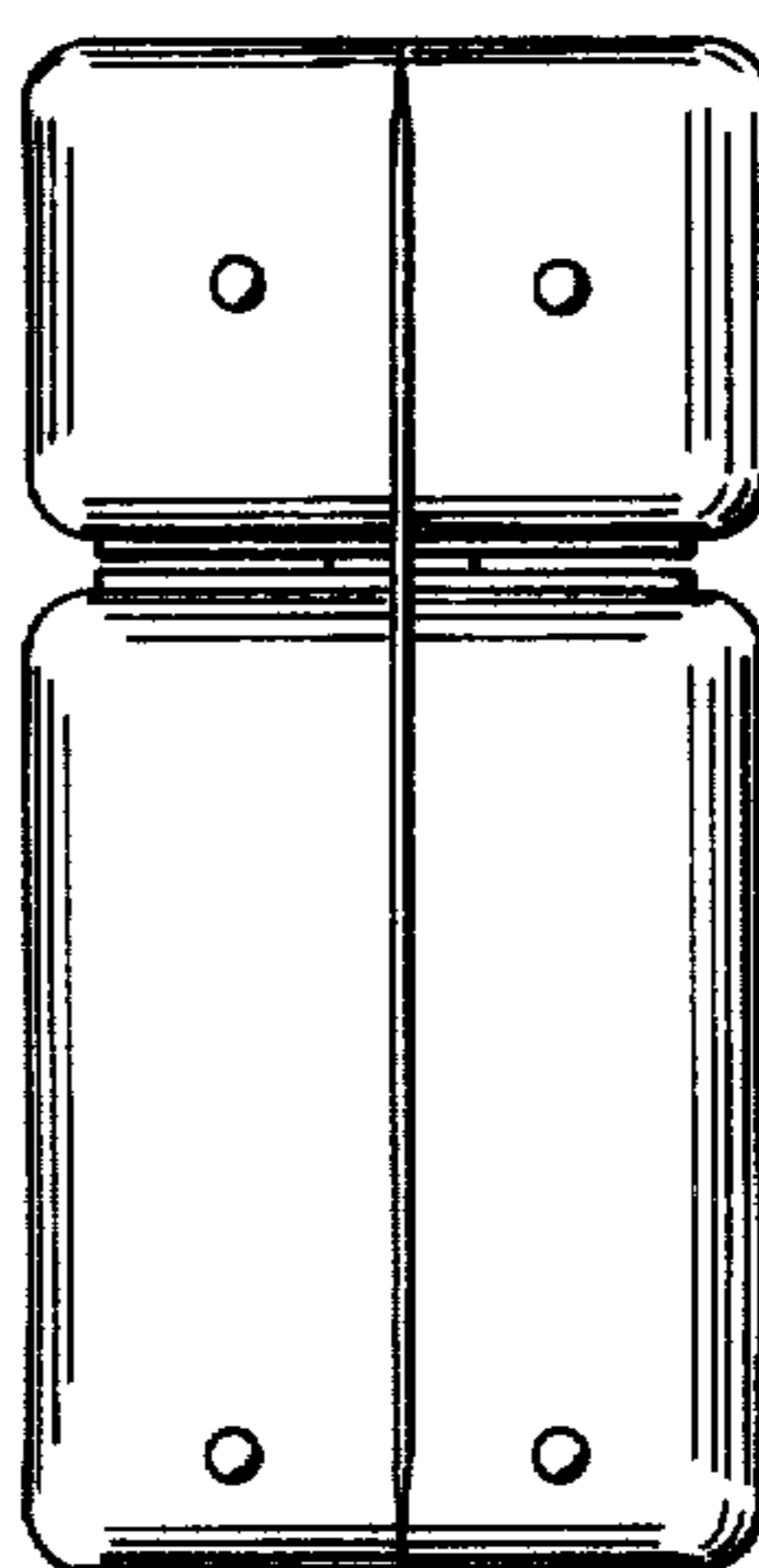

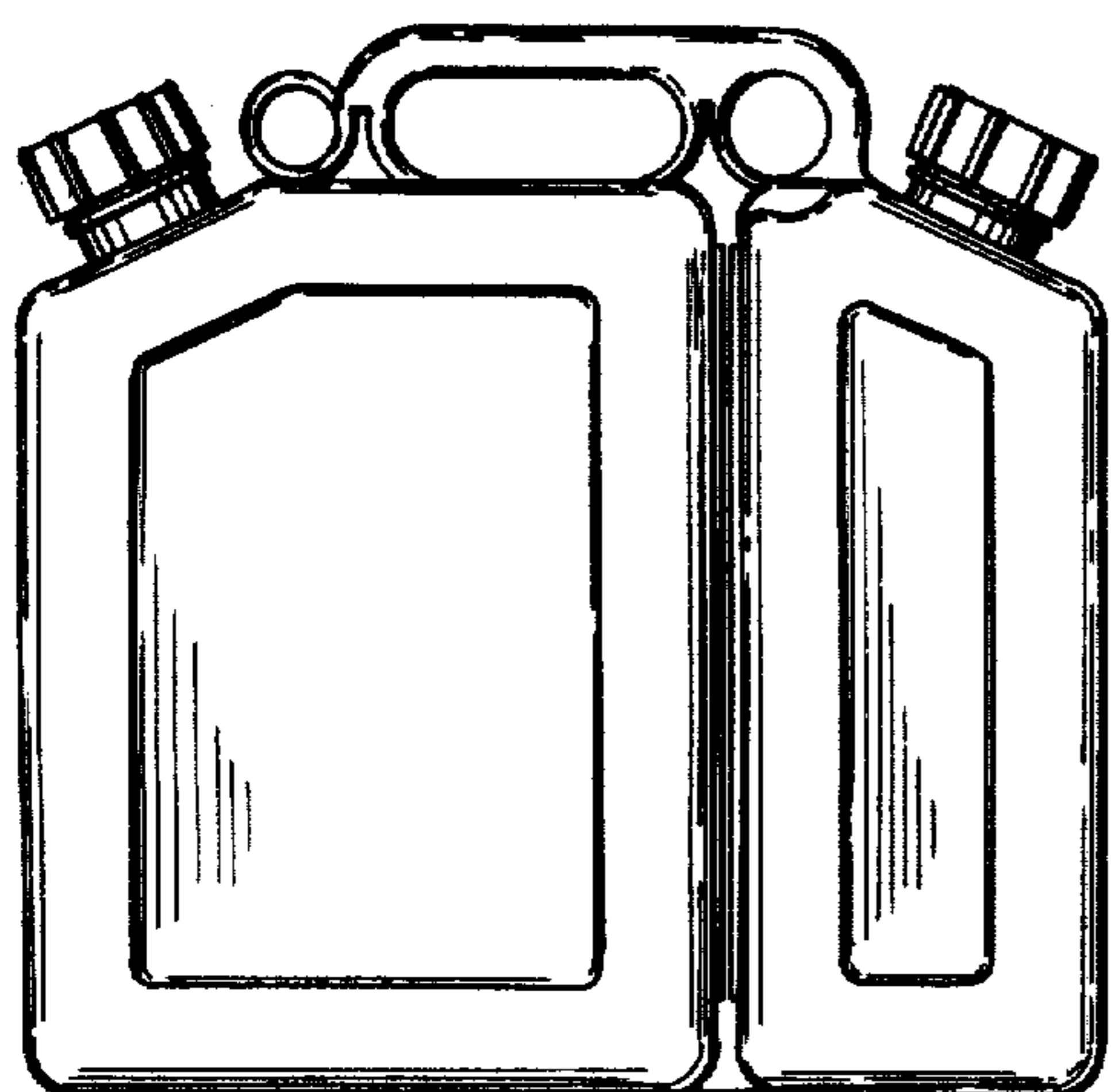

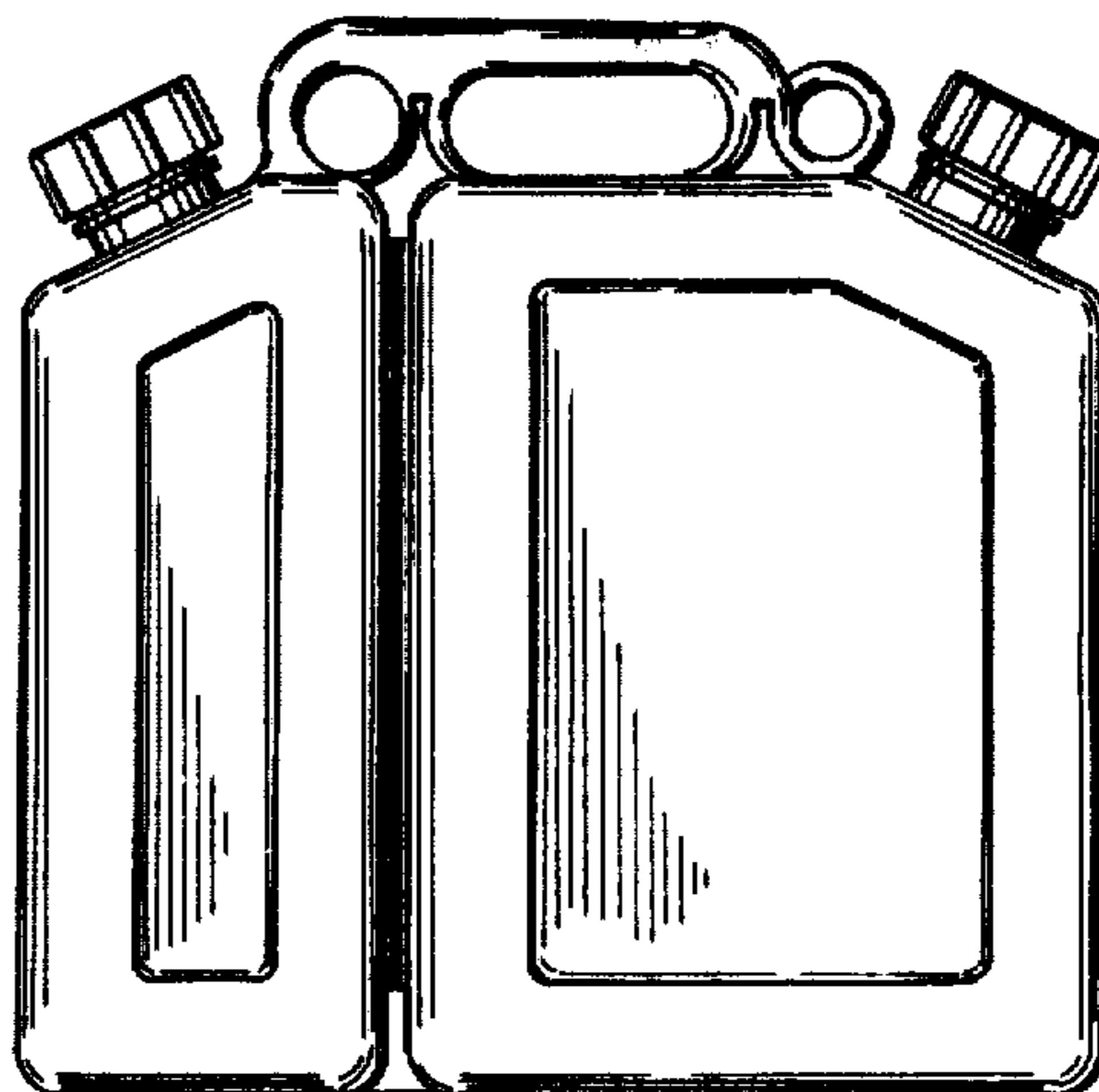

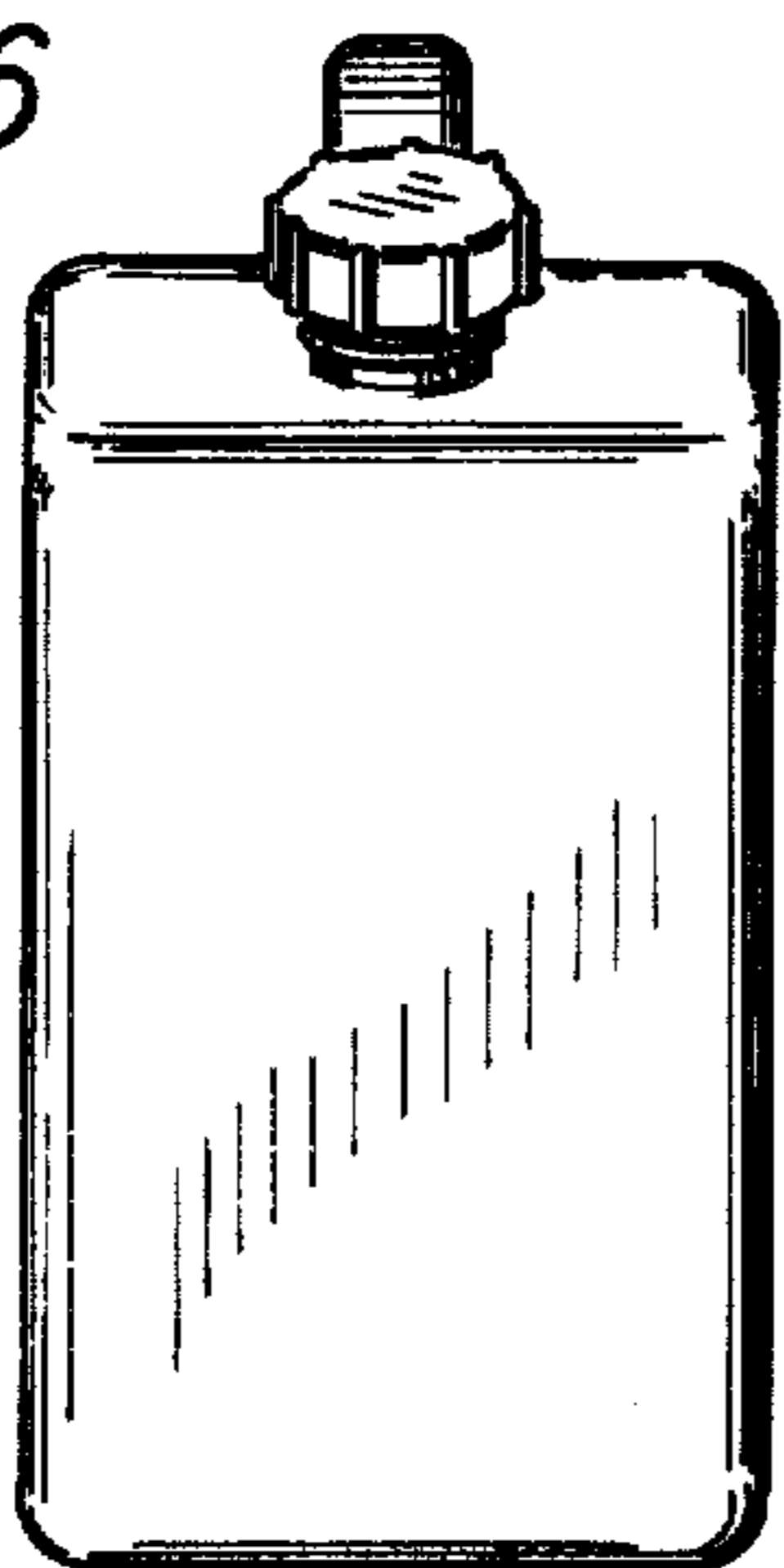
