DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 2, the opposite side being the same in appearance; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

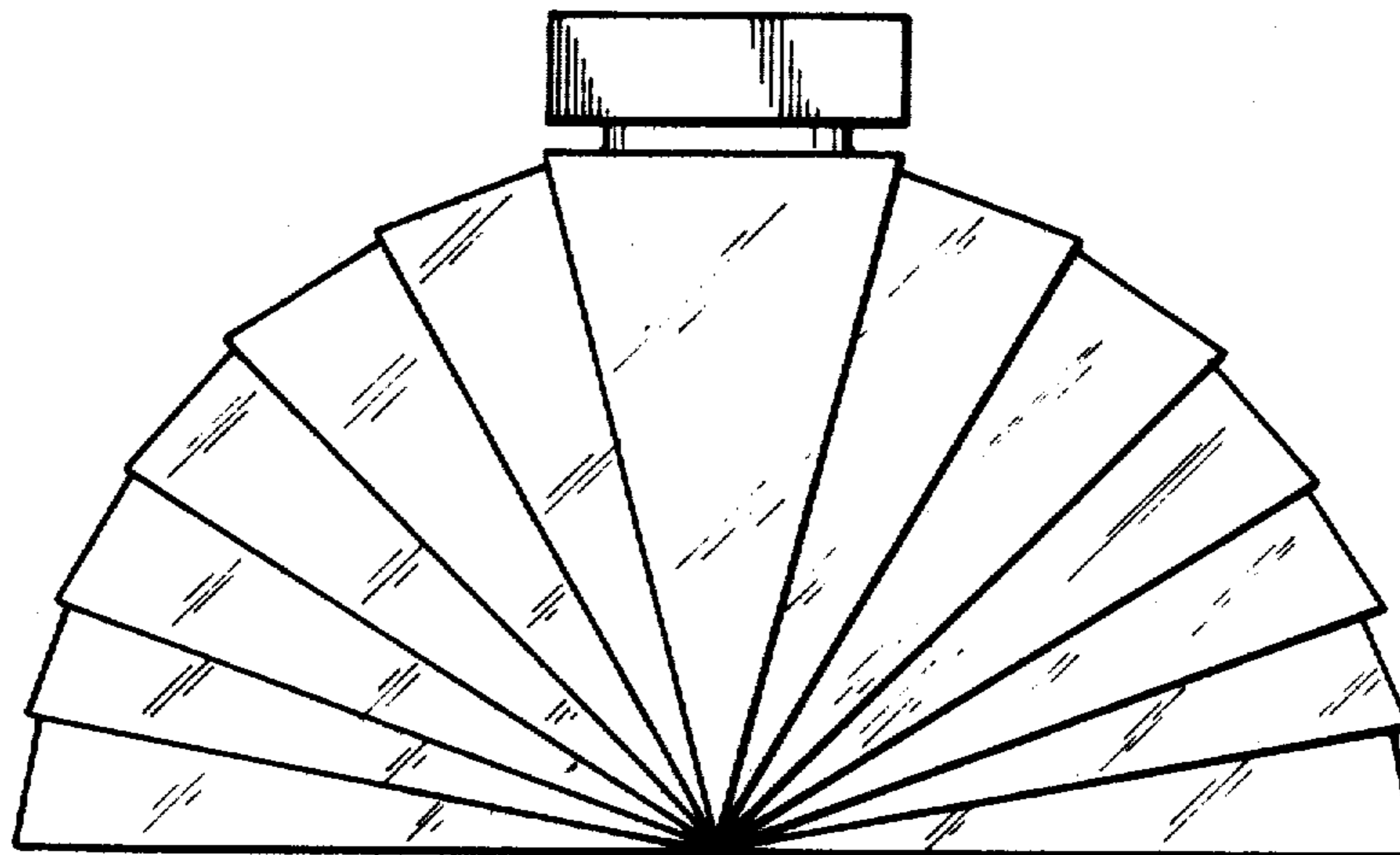

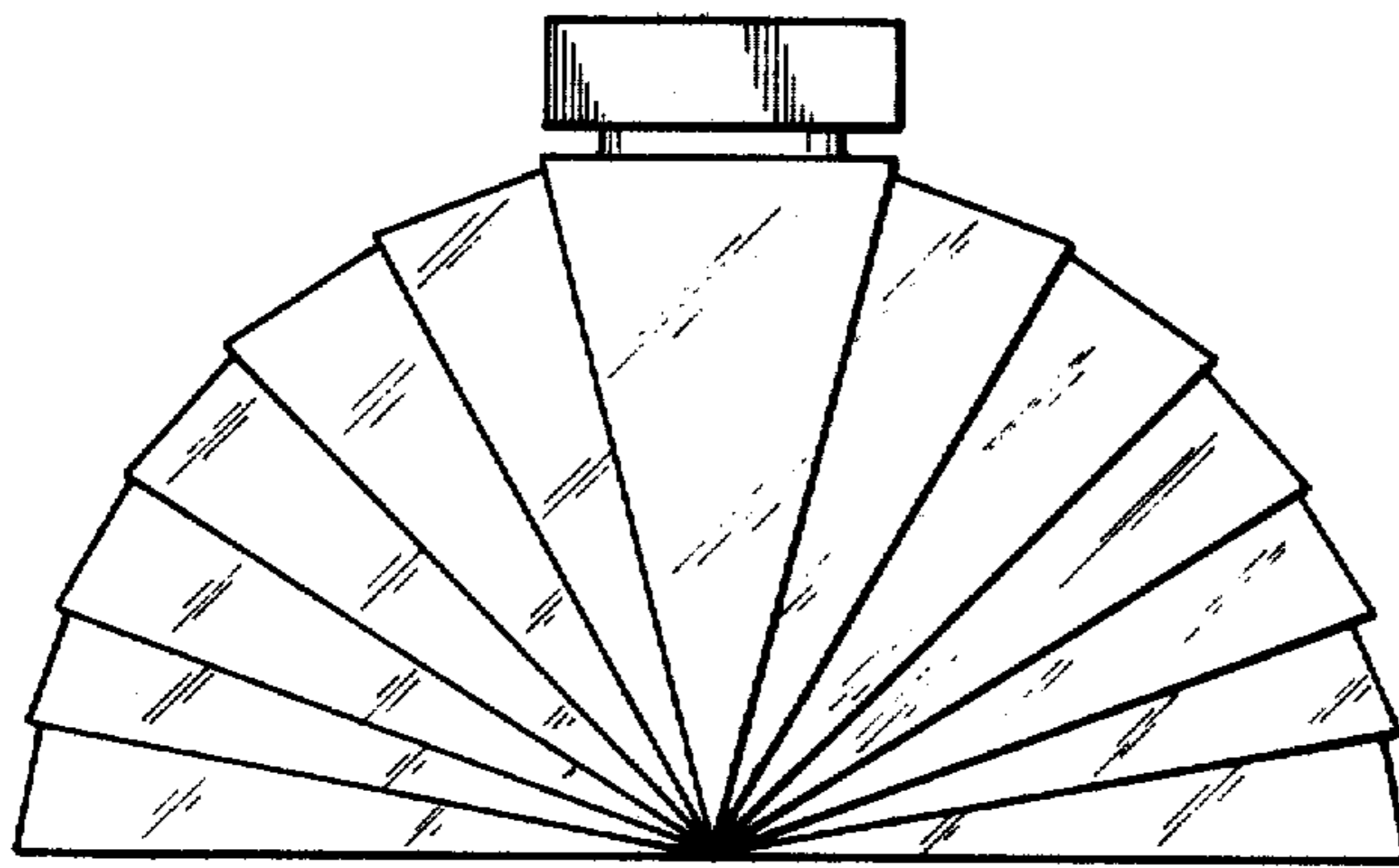

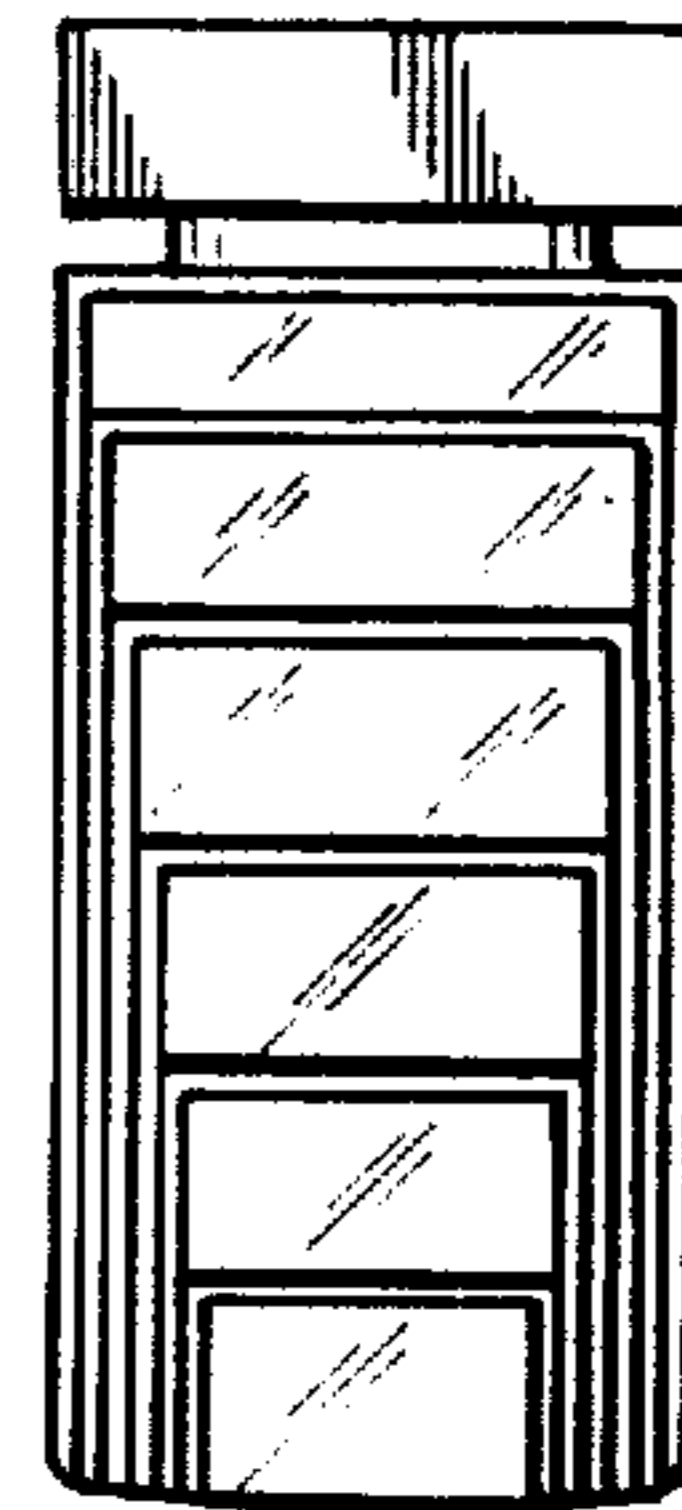

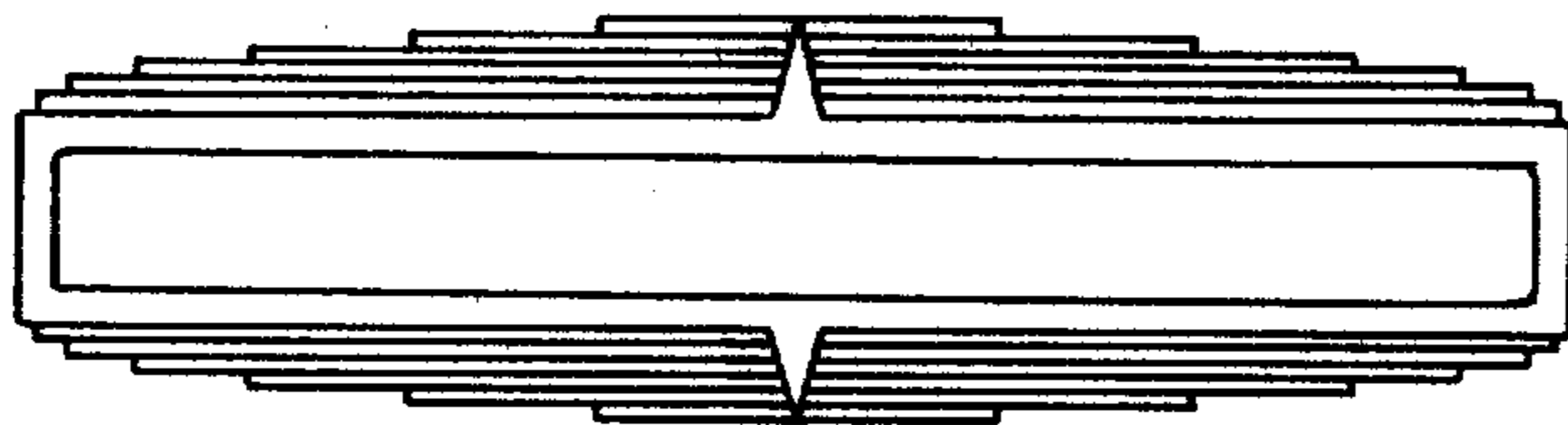
