DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a typewriter showing my new design, the continuous aperture grid beneath the viewing window being indicated by dot-dash lines for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view;

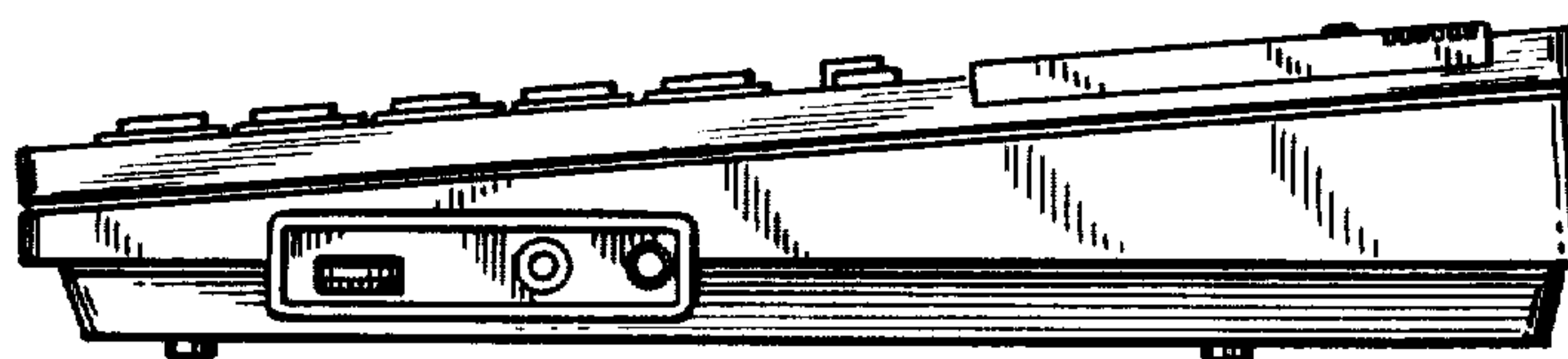
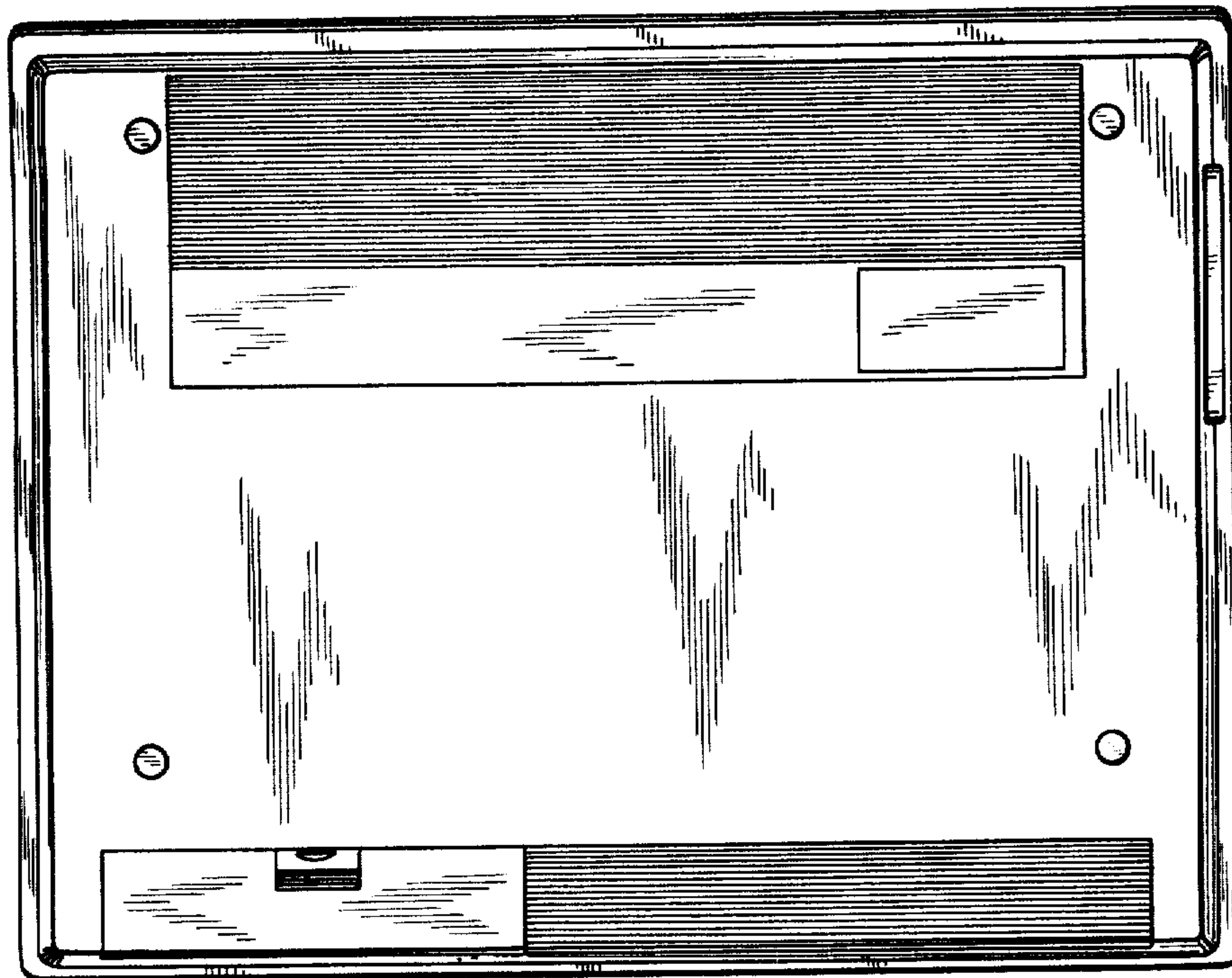


FIG. 6*FIG. 7*

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view.

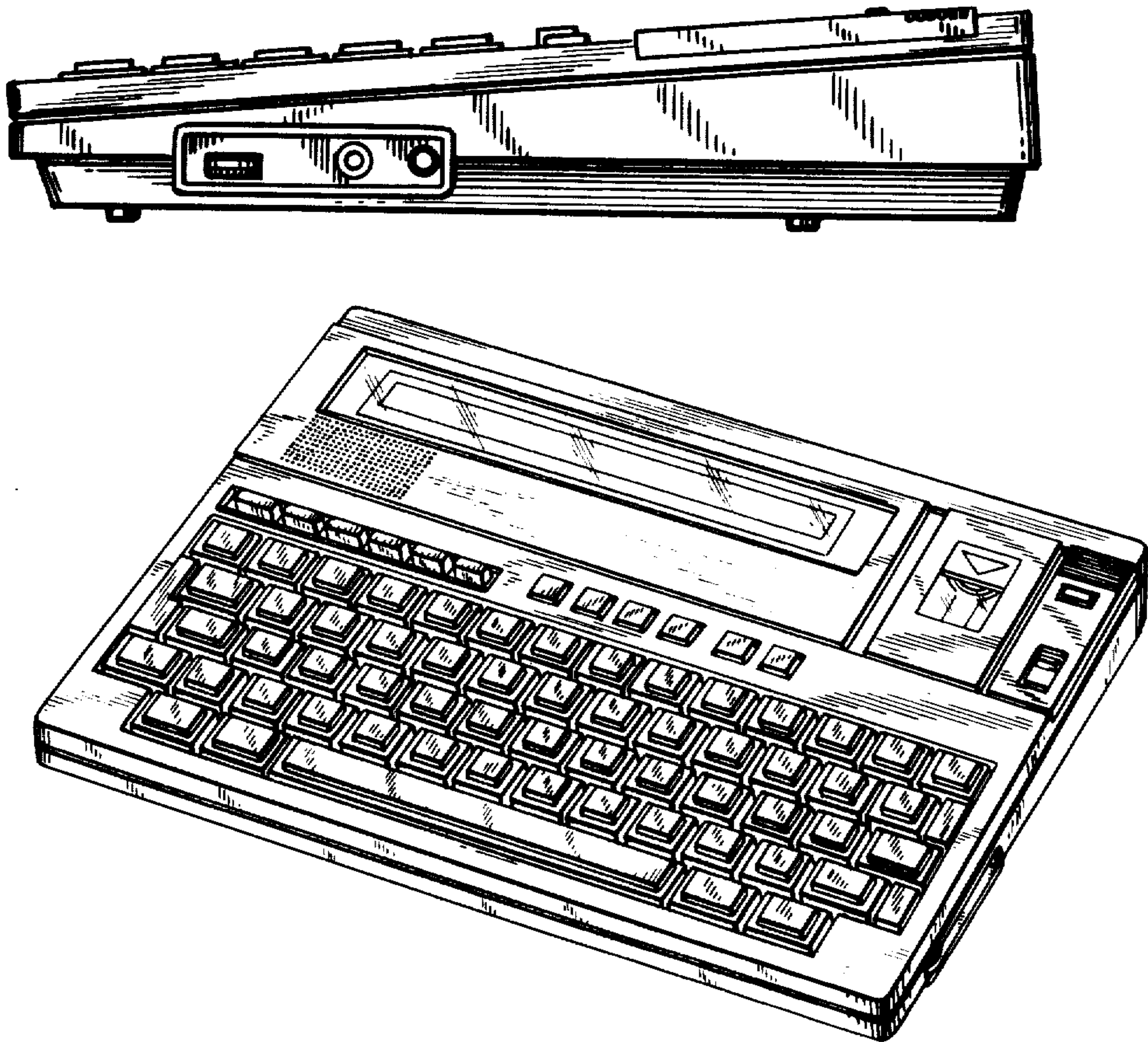

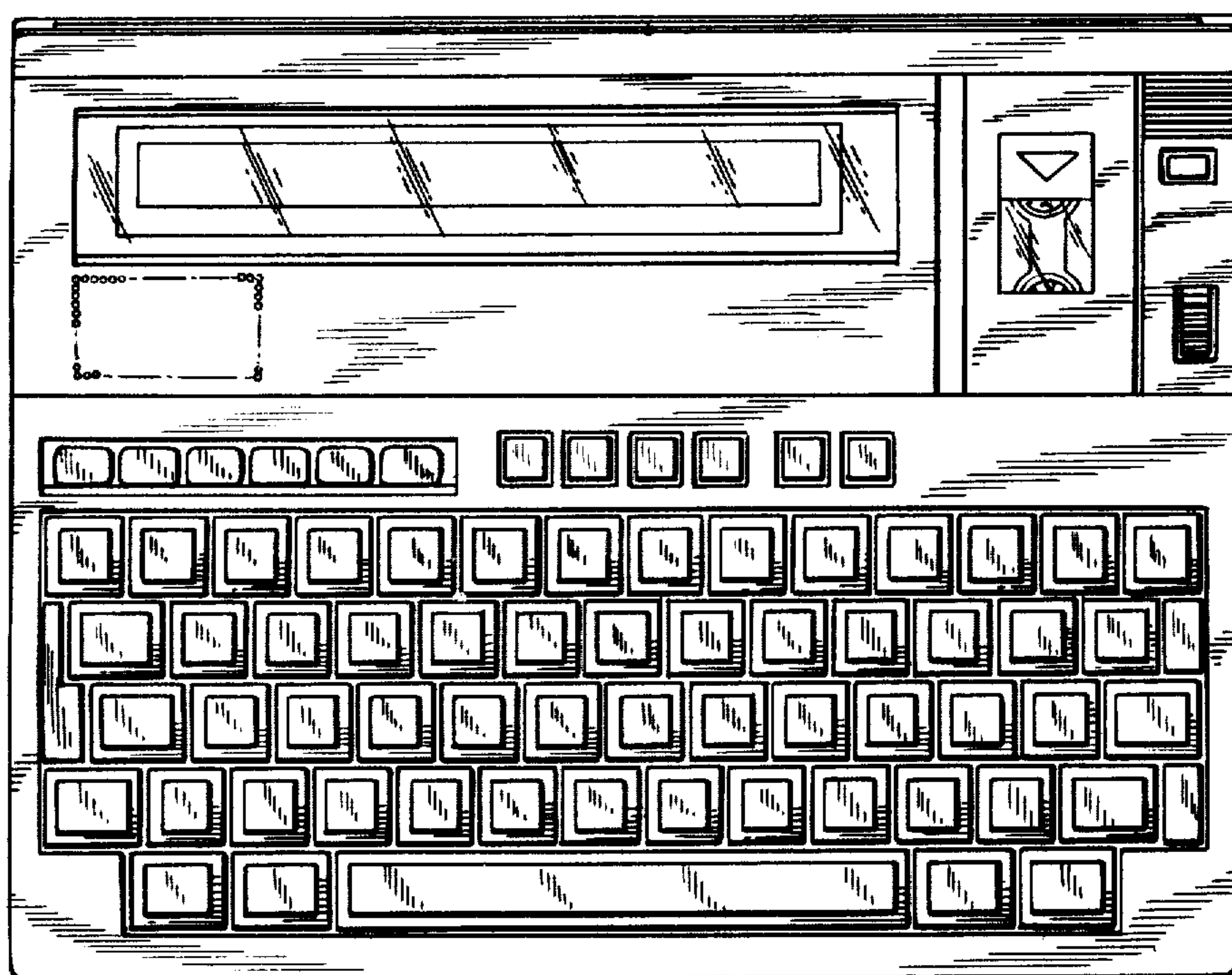

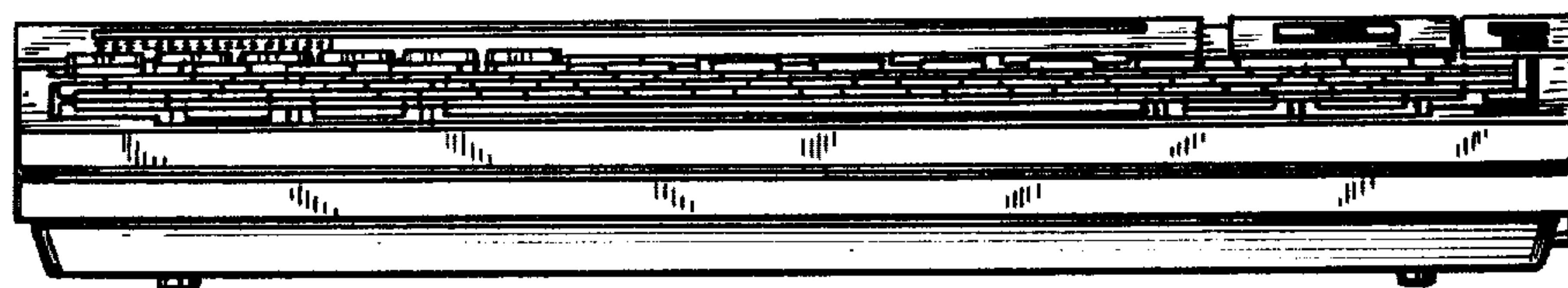

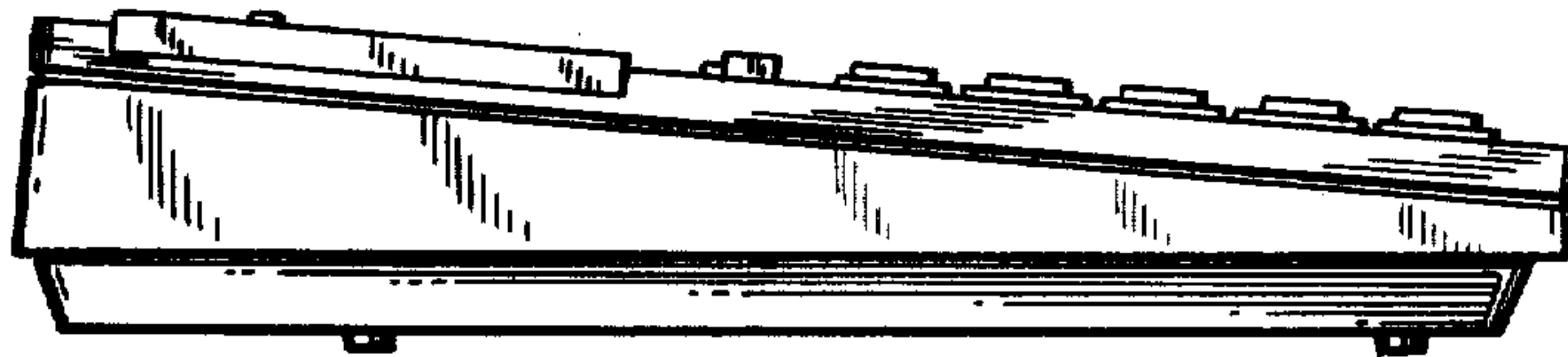
