FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the queen game piece;

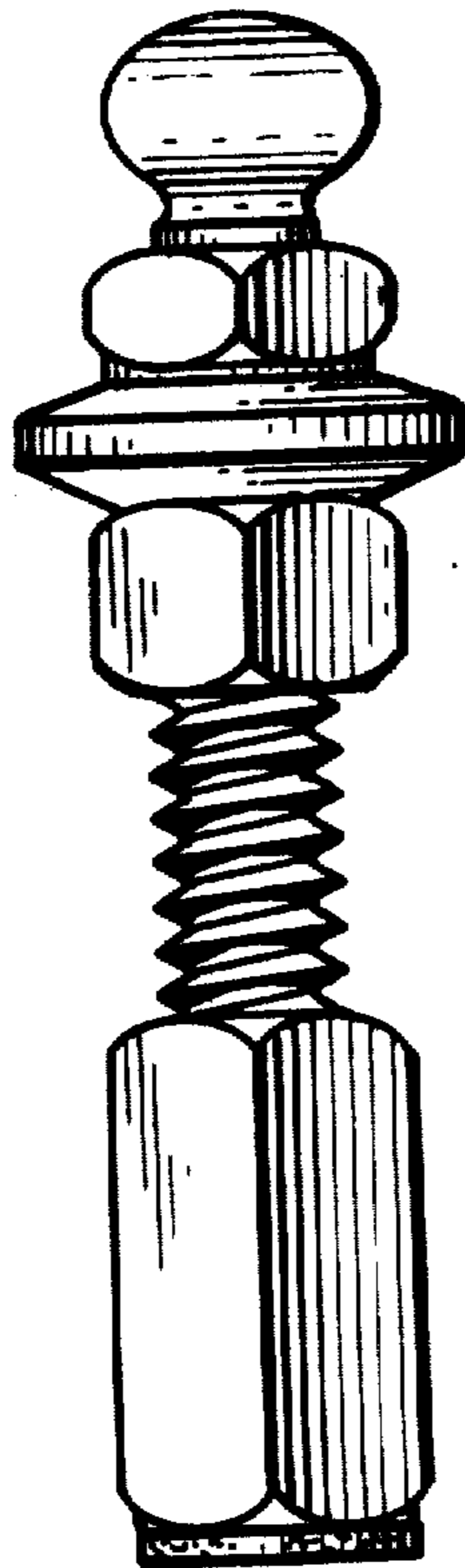
FIG. 6 is an edge view thereof;

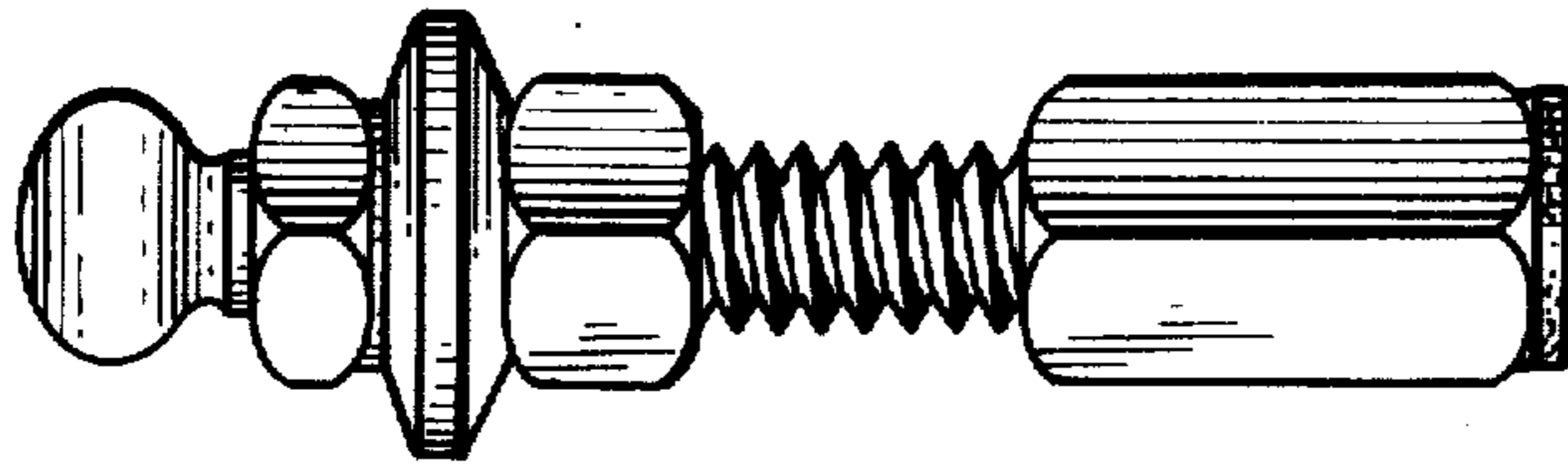

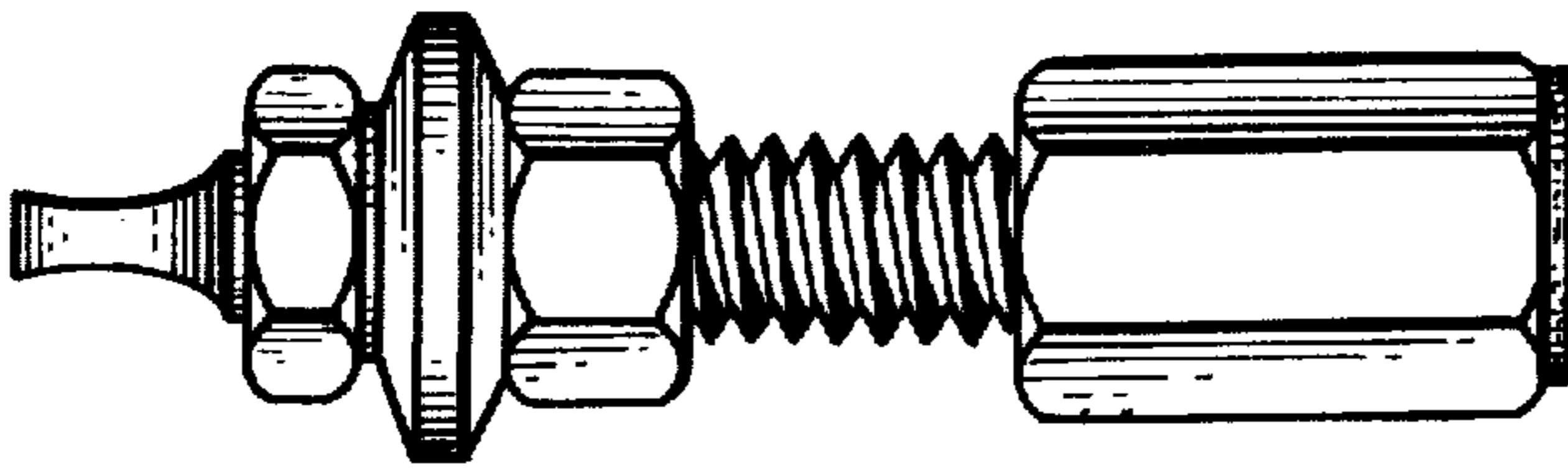

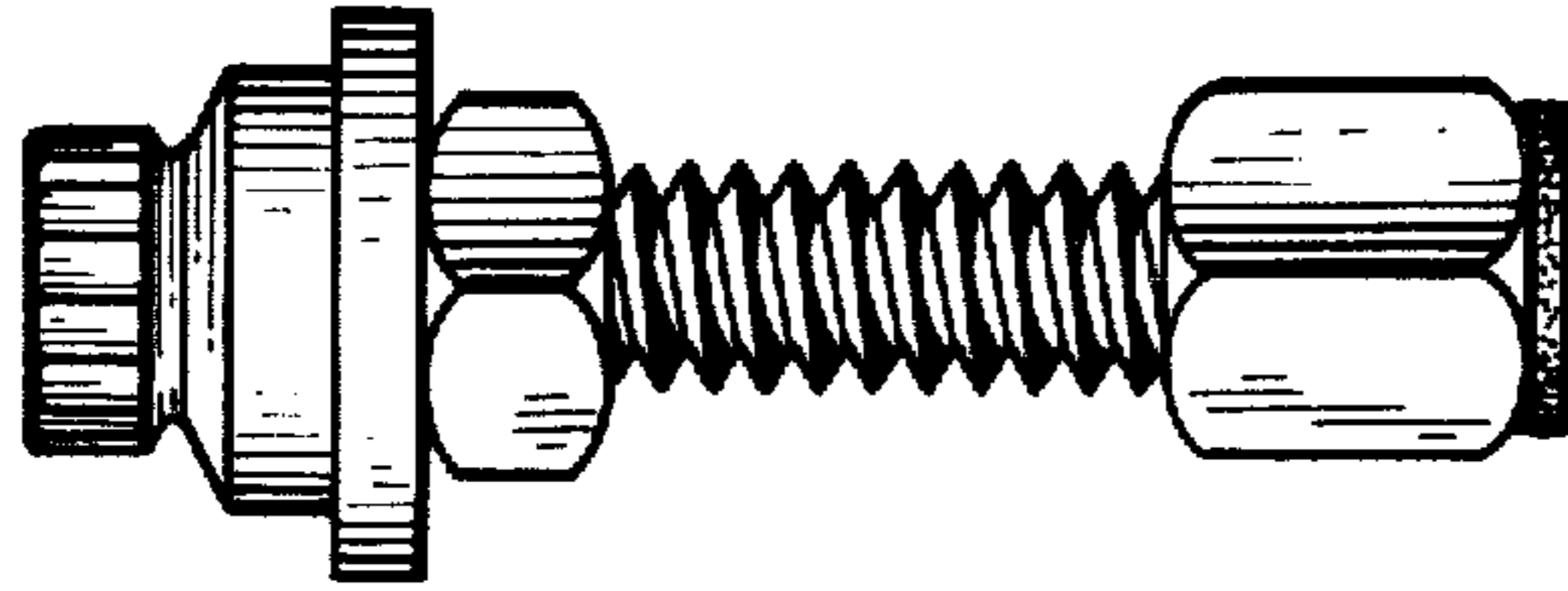

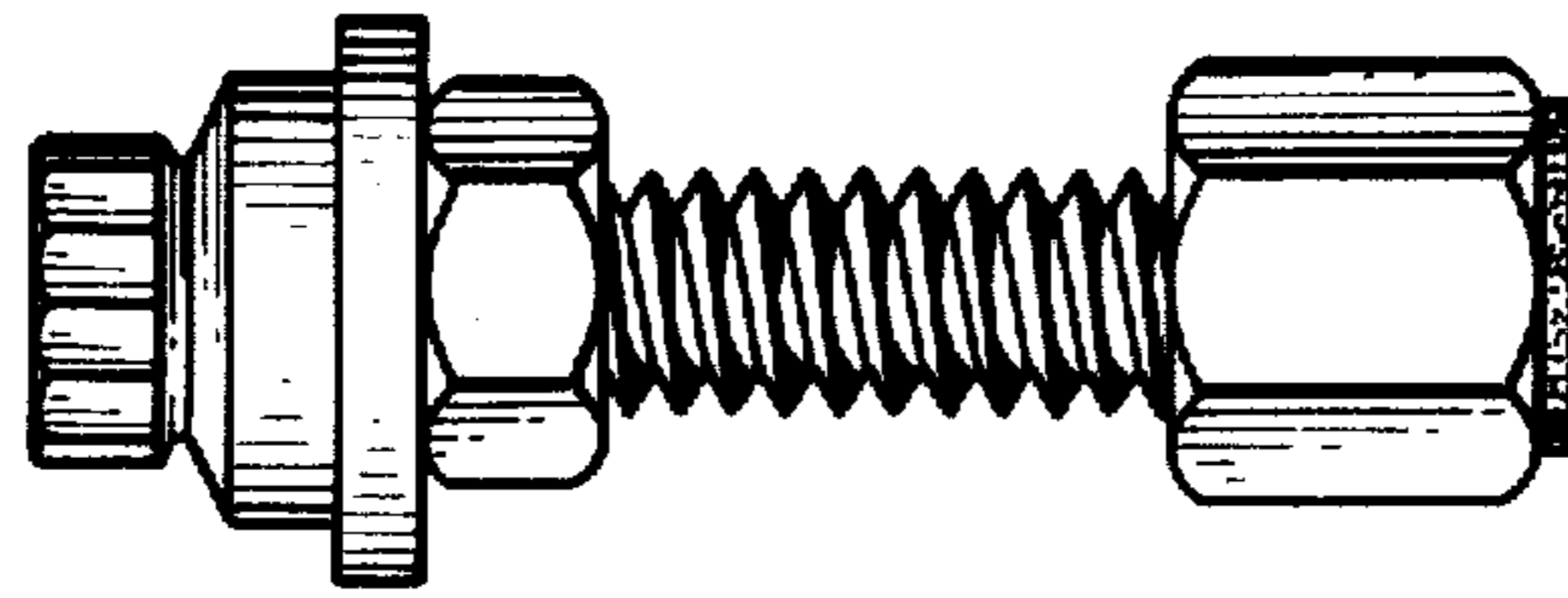

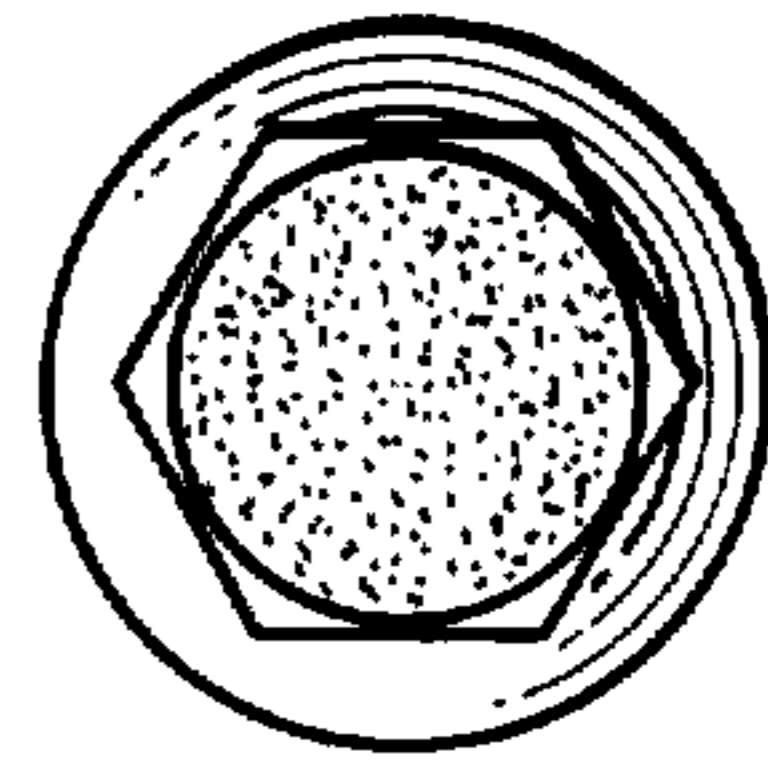

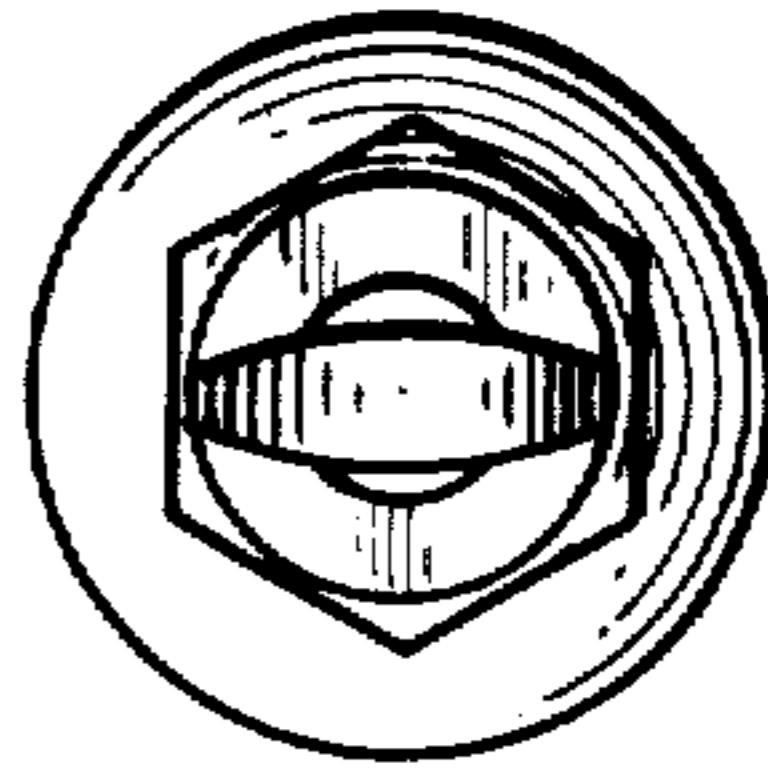

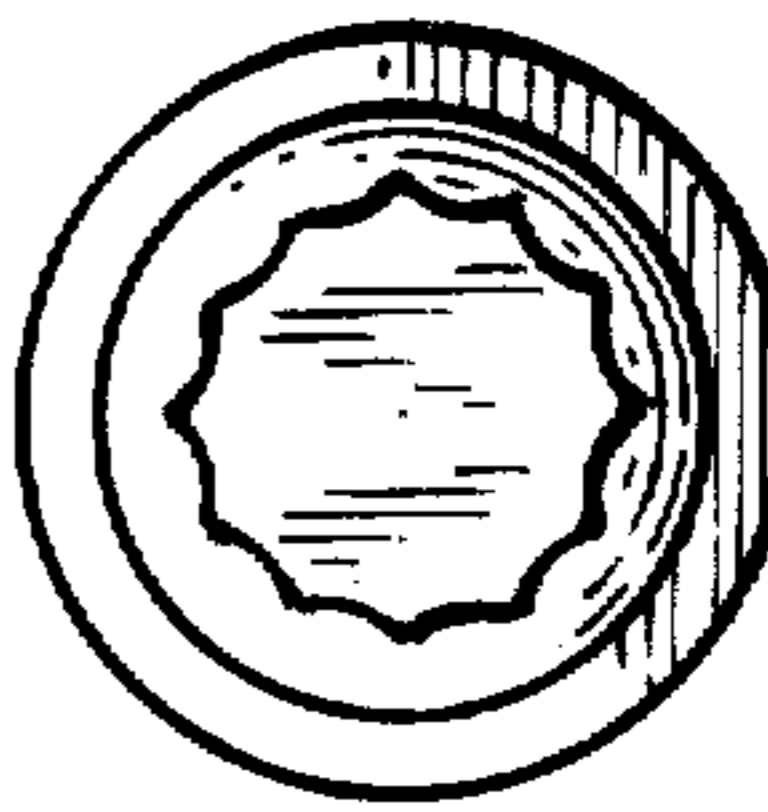
