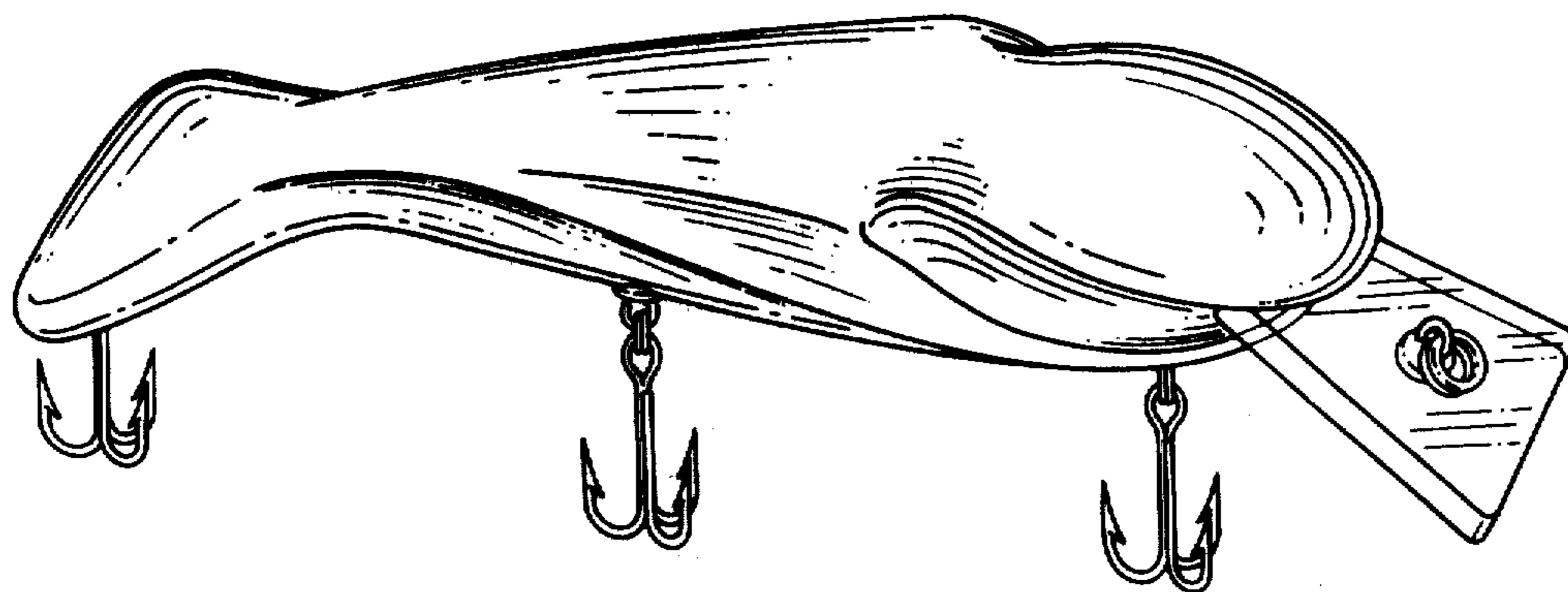

DESCRIPTION

 FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the artificial fishing lure of FIG. 1.



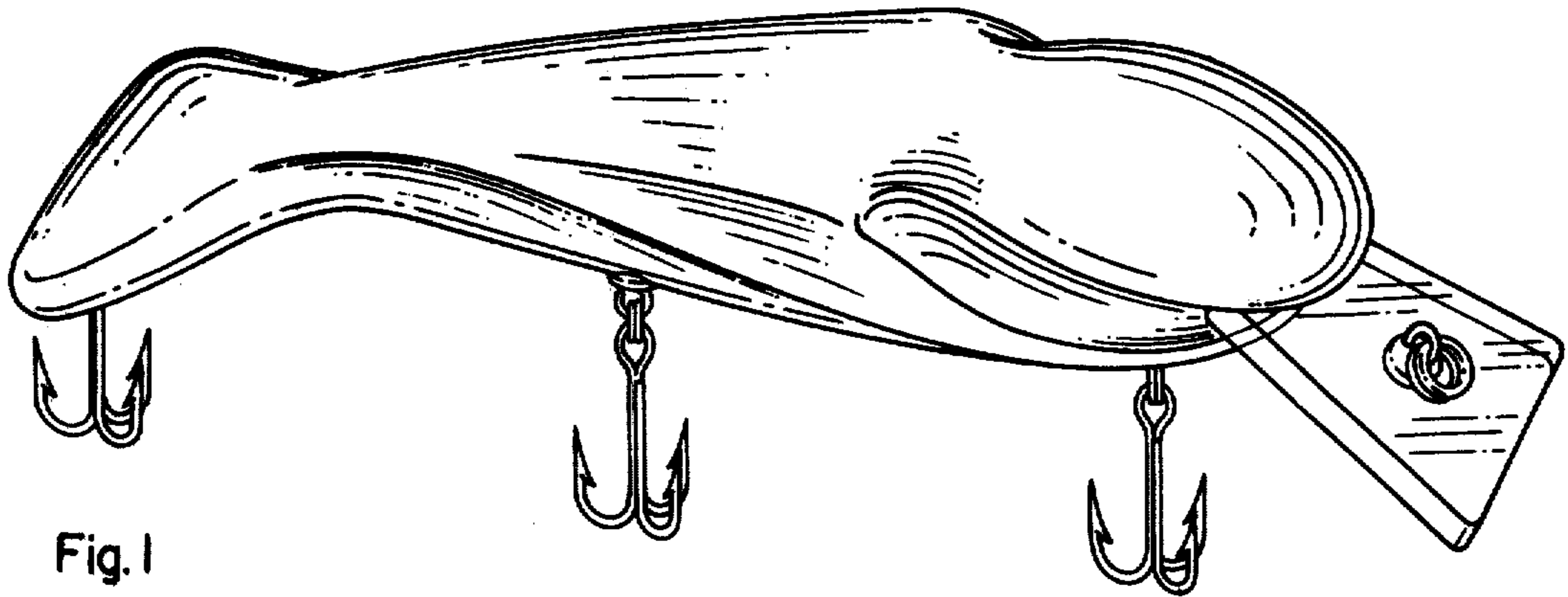

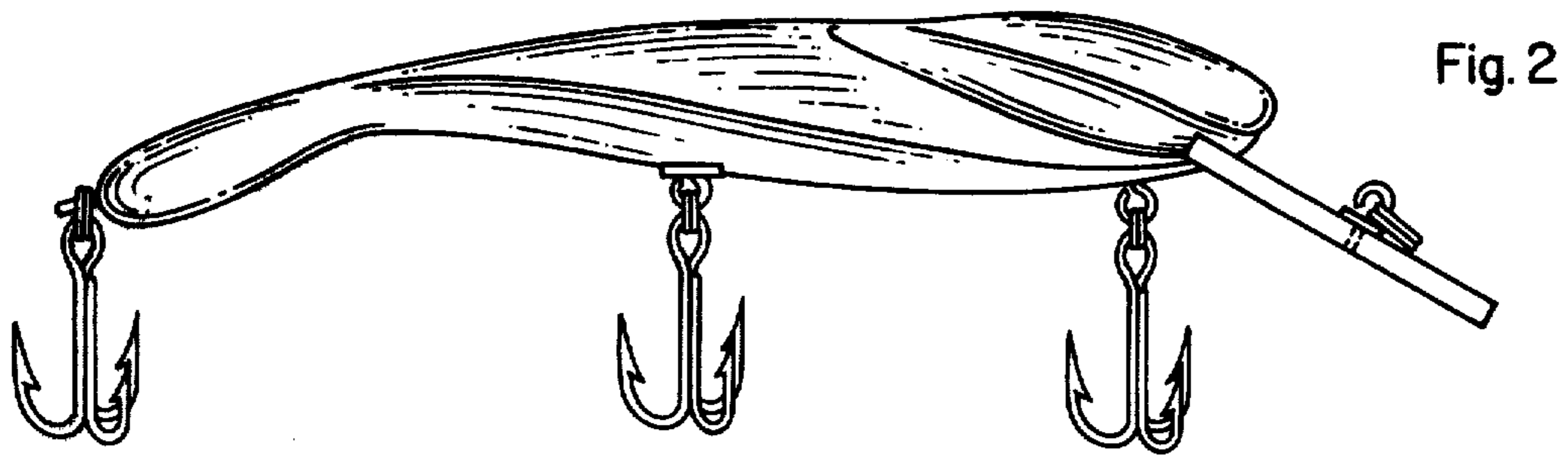

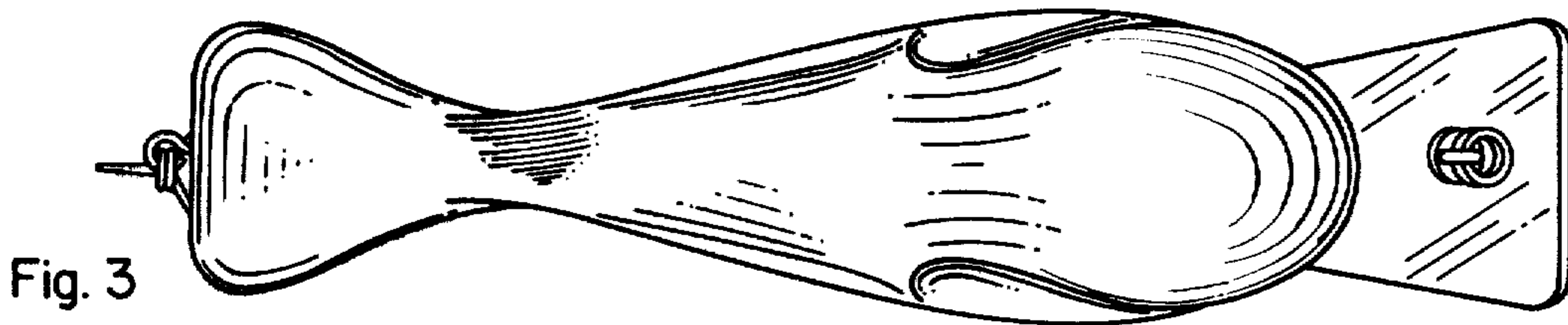

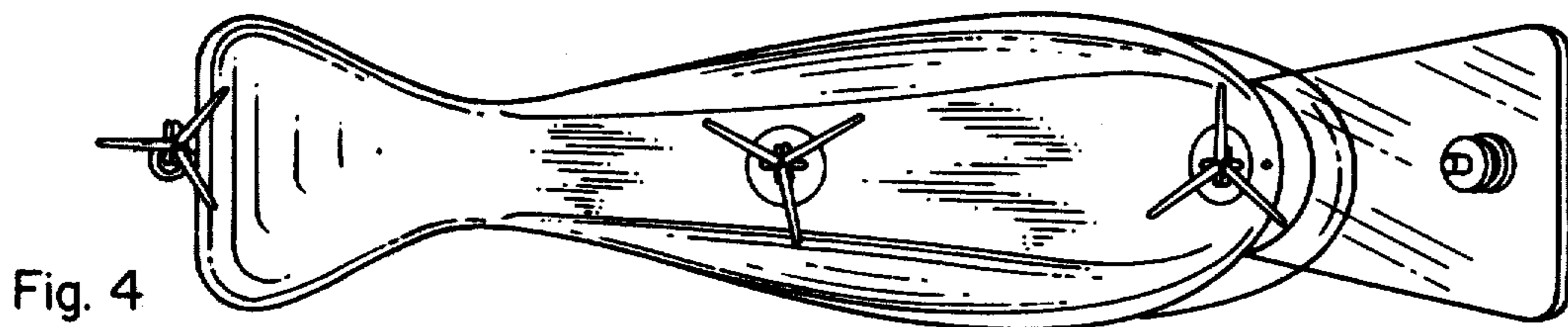

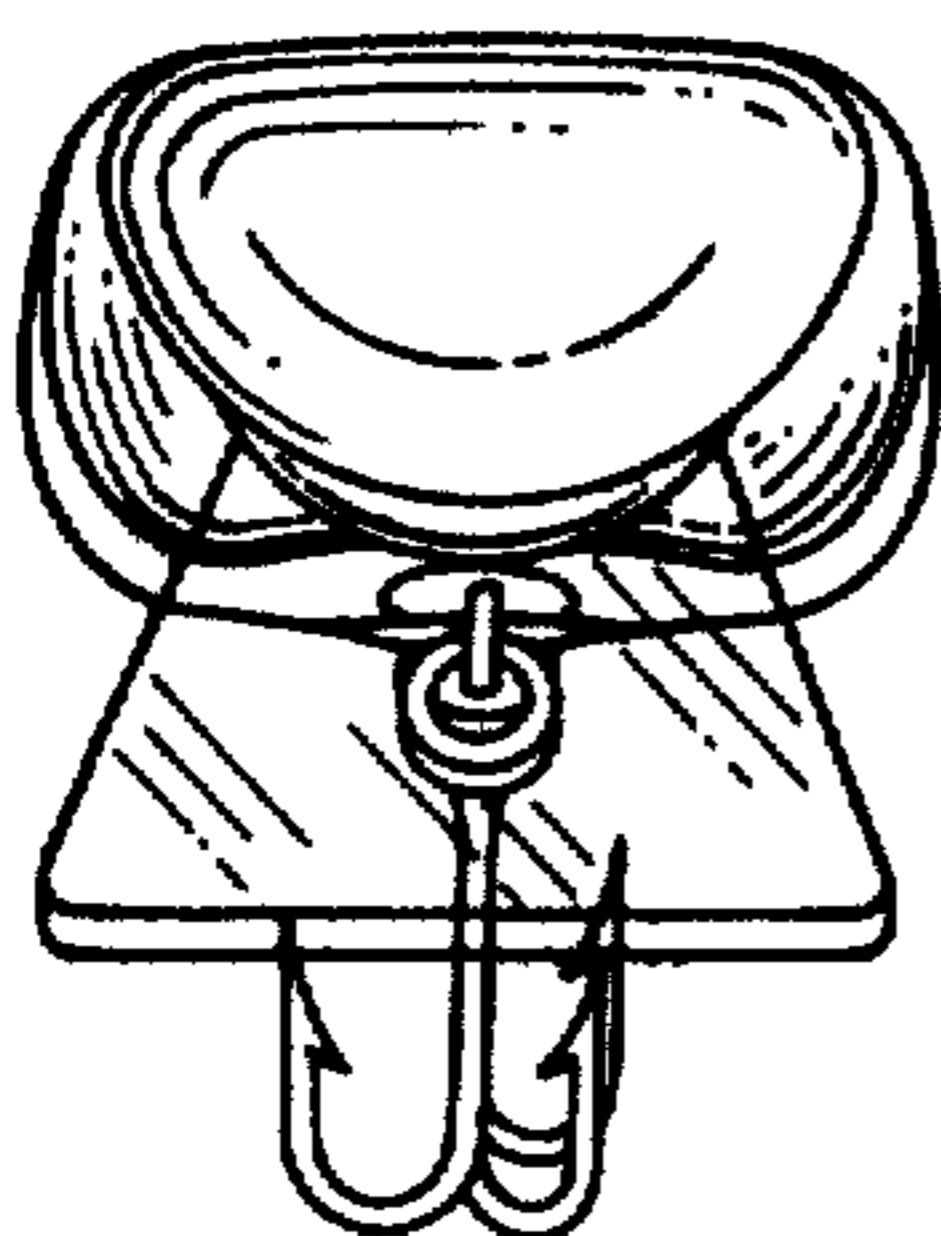

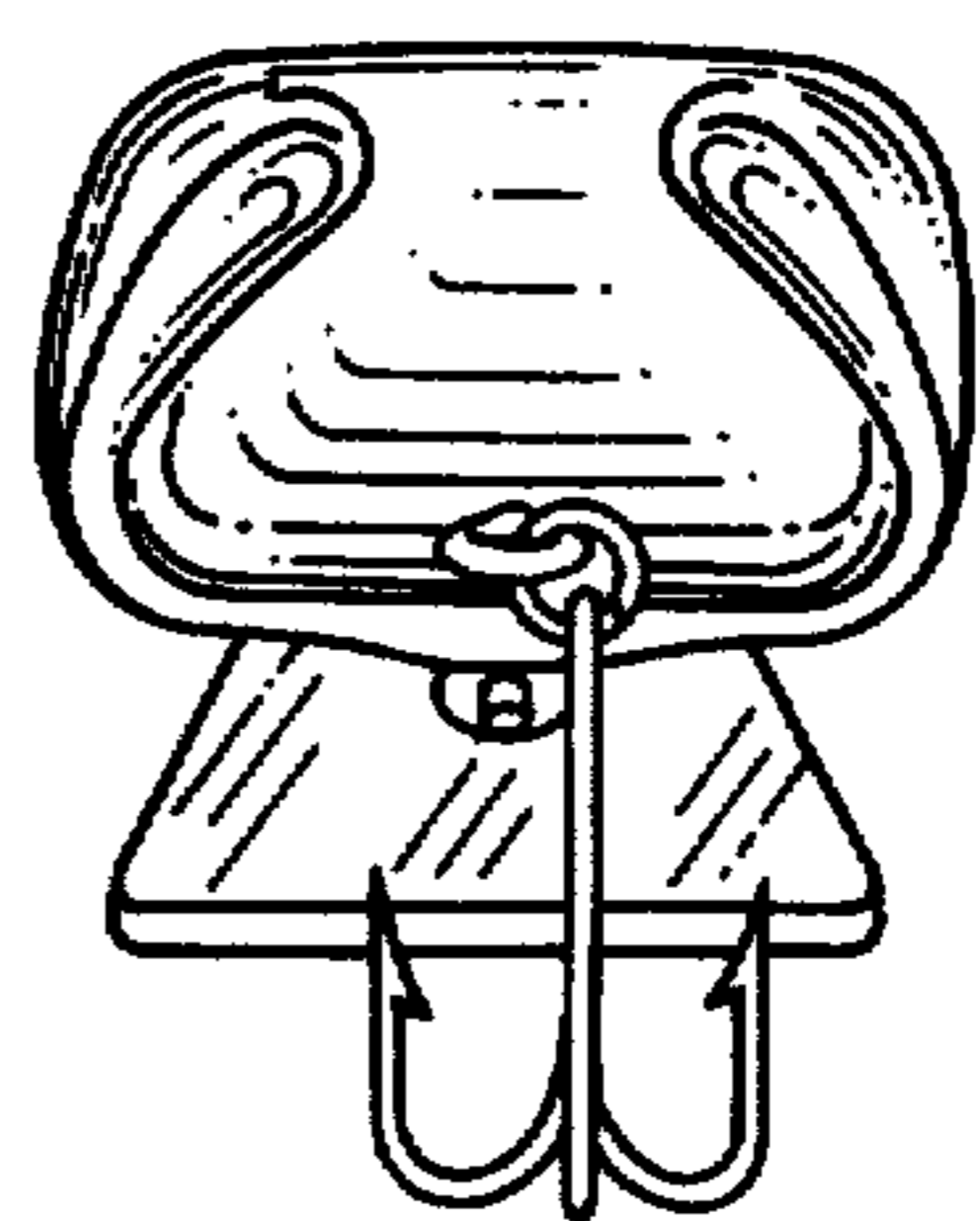
