DESCRIPTION

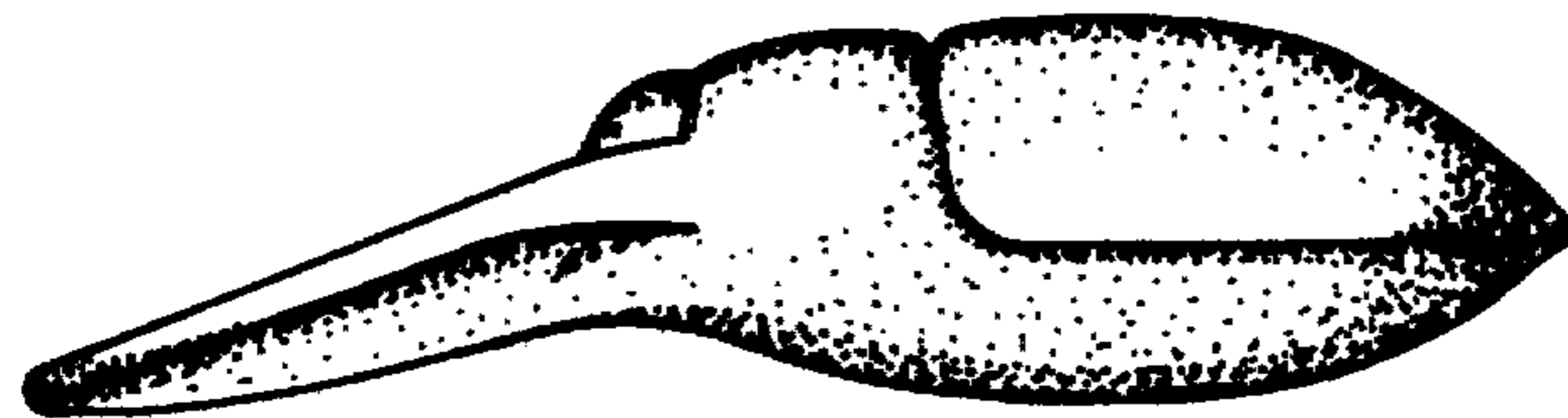
FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a fishing lure embodying our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the fishing lure illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the fishing lure illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view showing the fishing lure as it appears when viewed from ahead.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view showing the fishing lure as it appears when viewed from the rear.



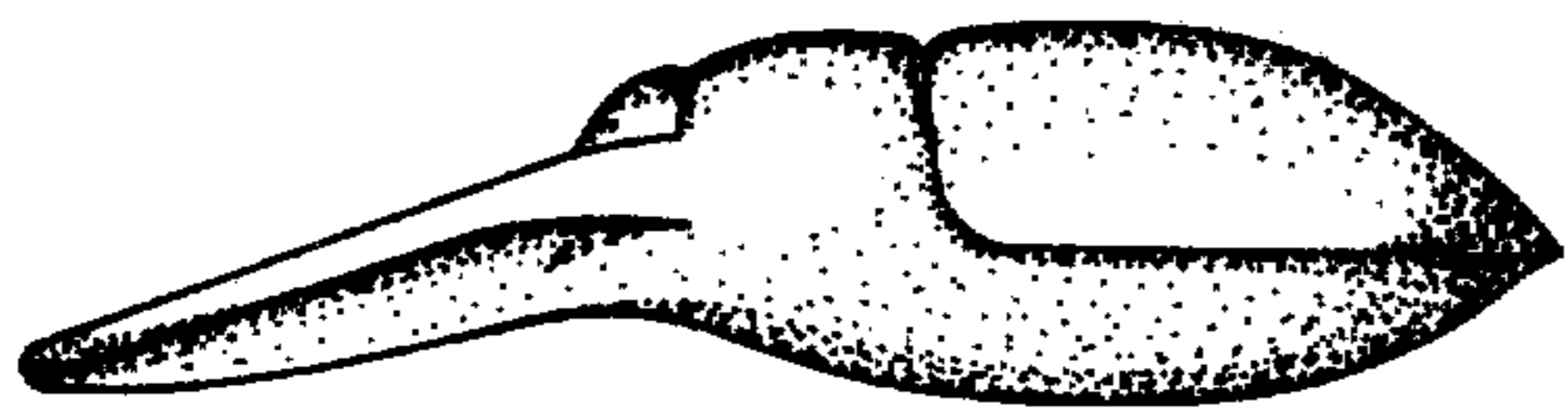

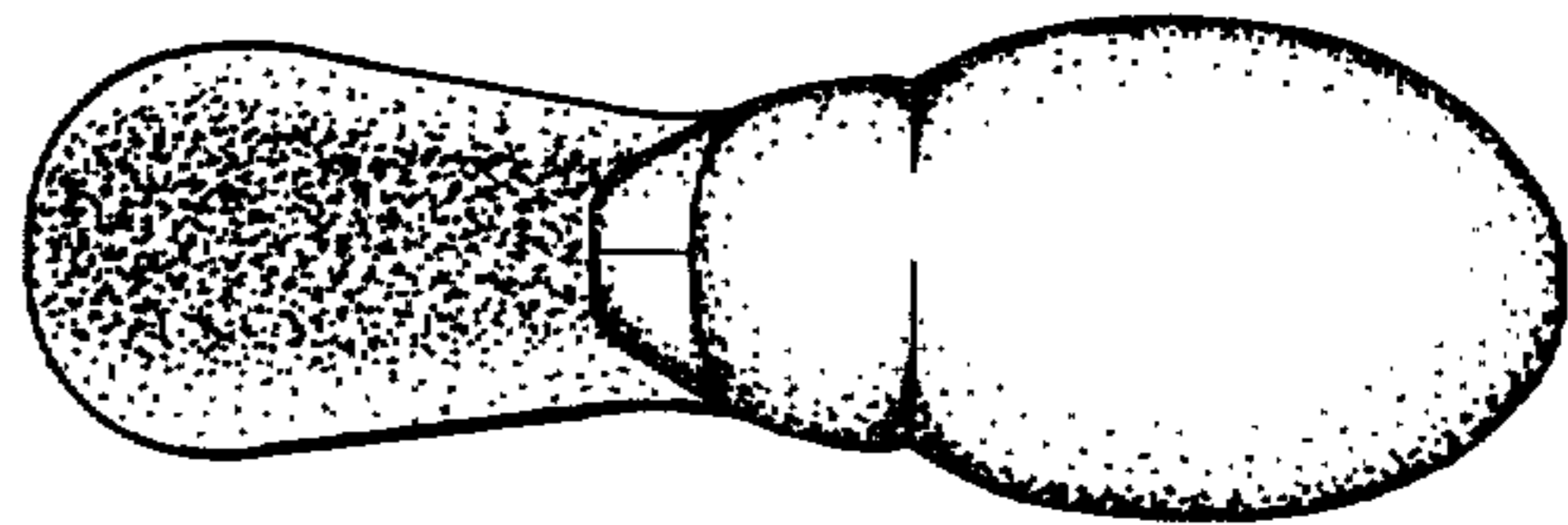

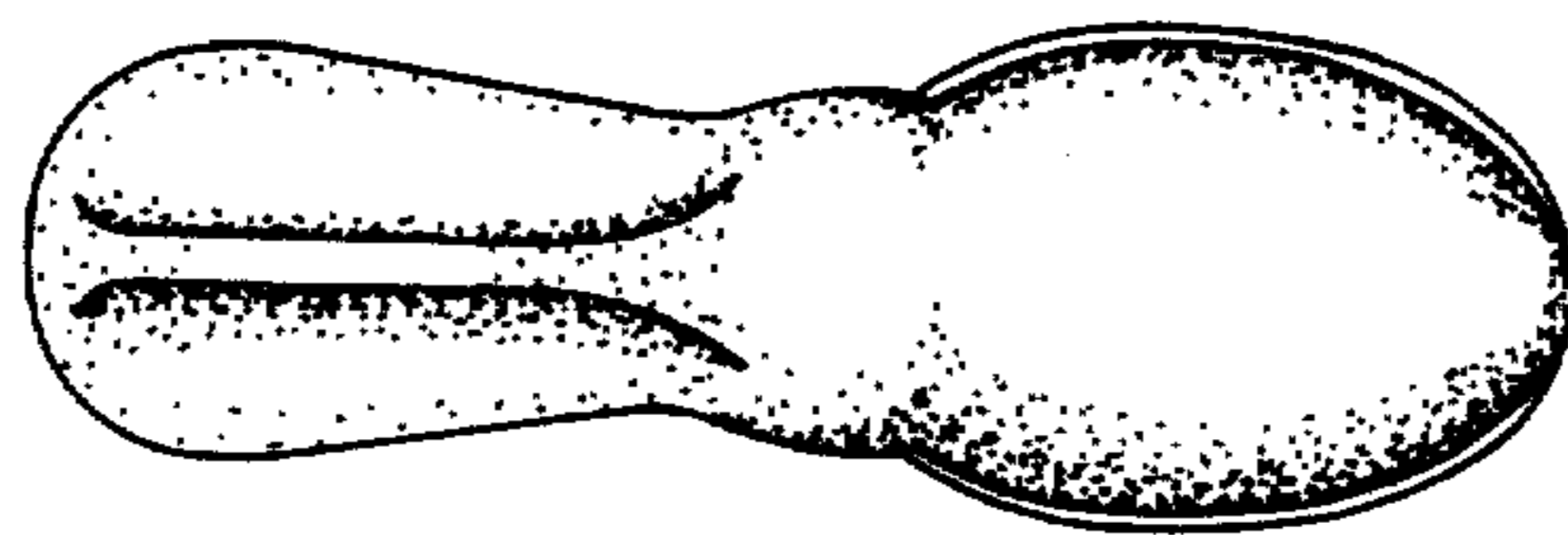

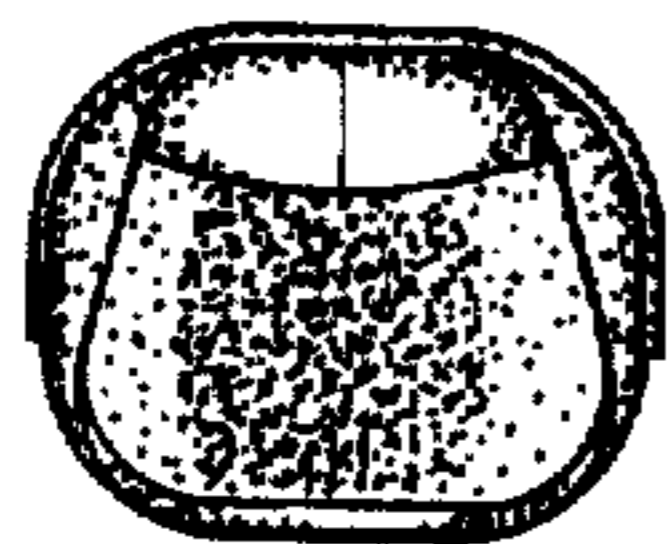

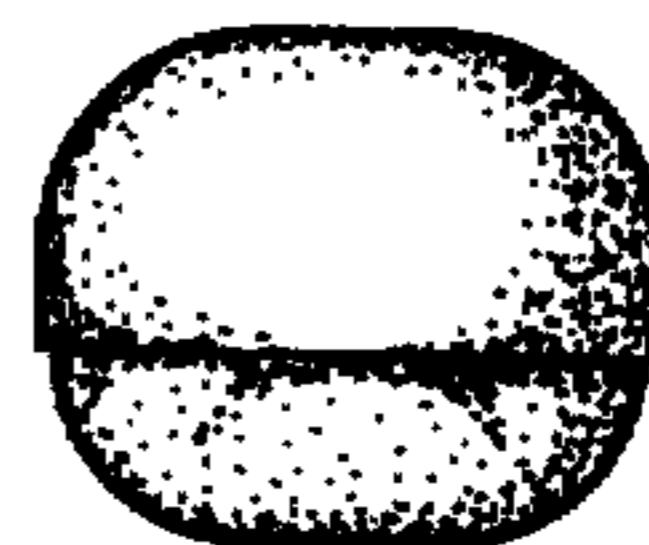
