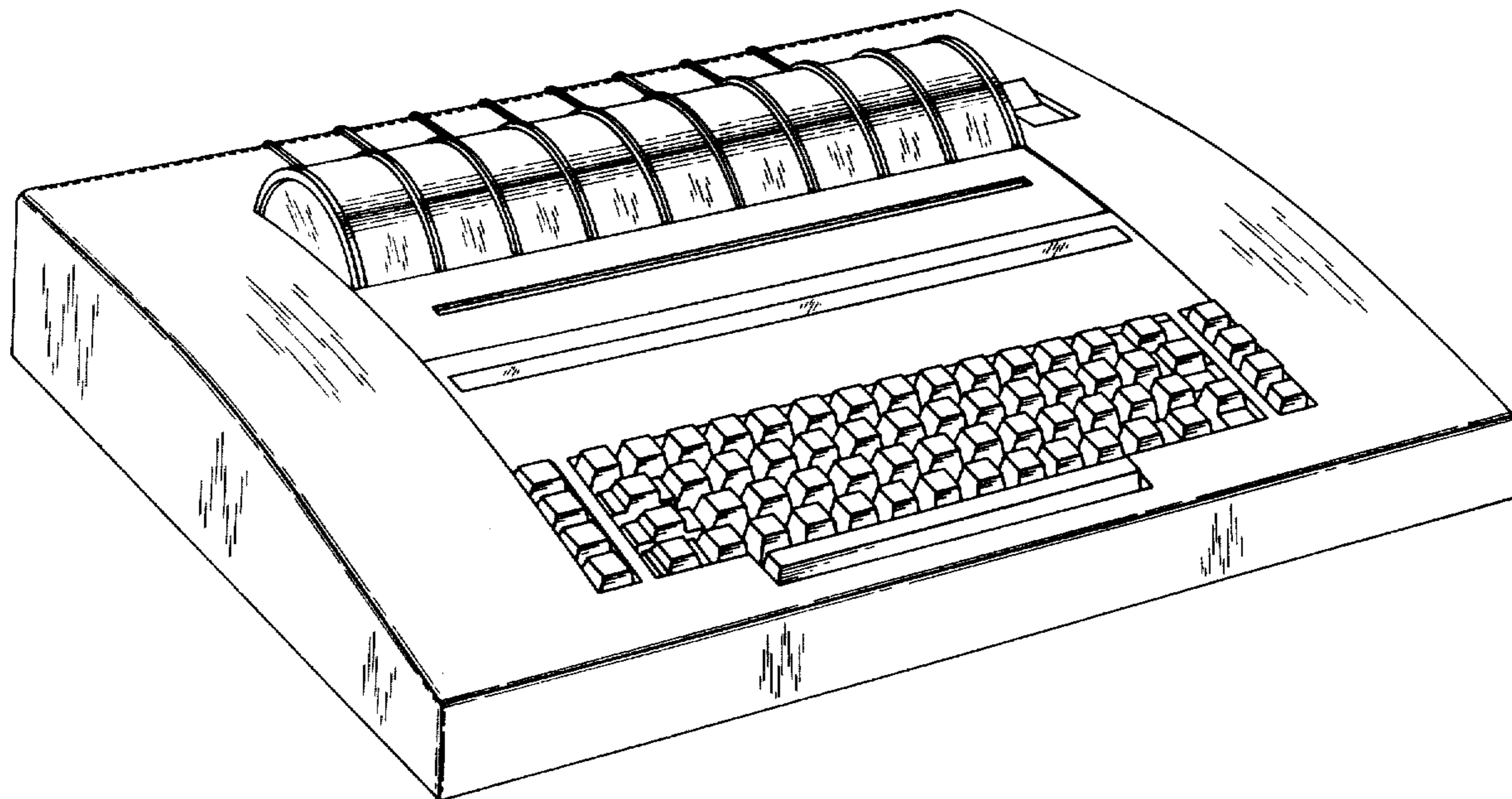

only.



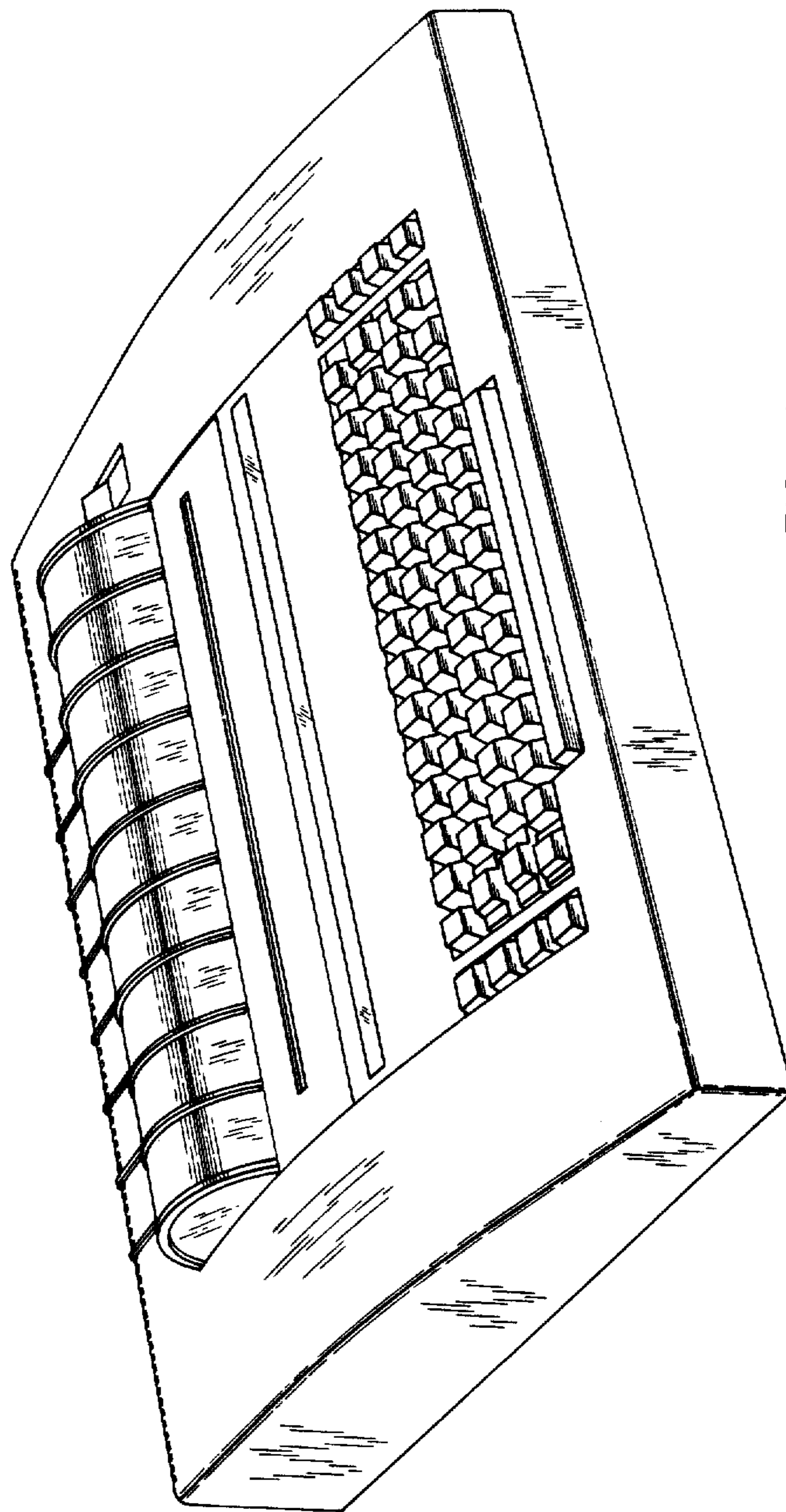

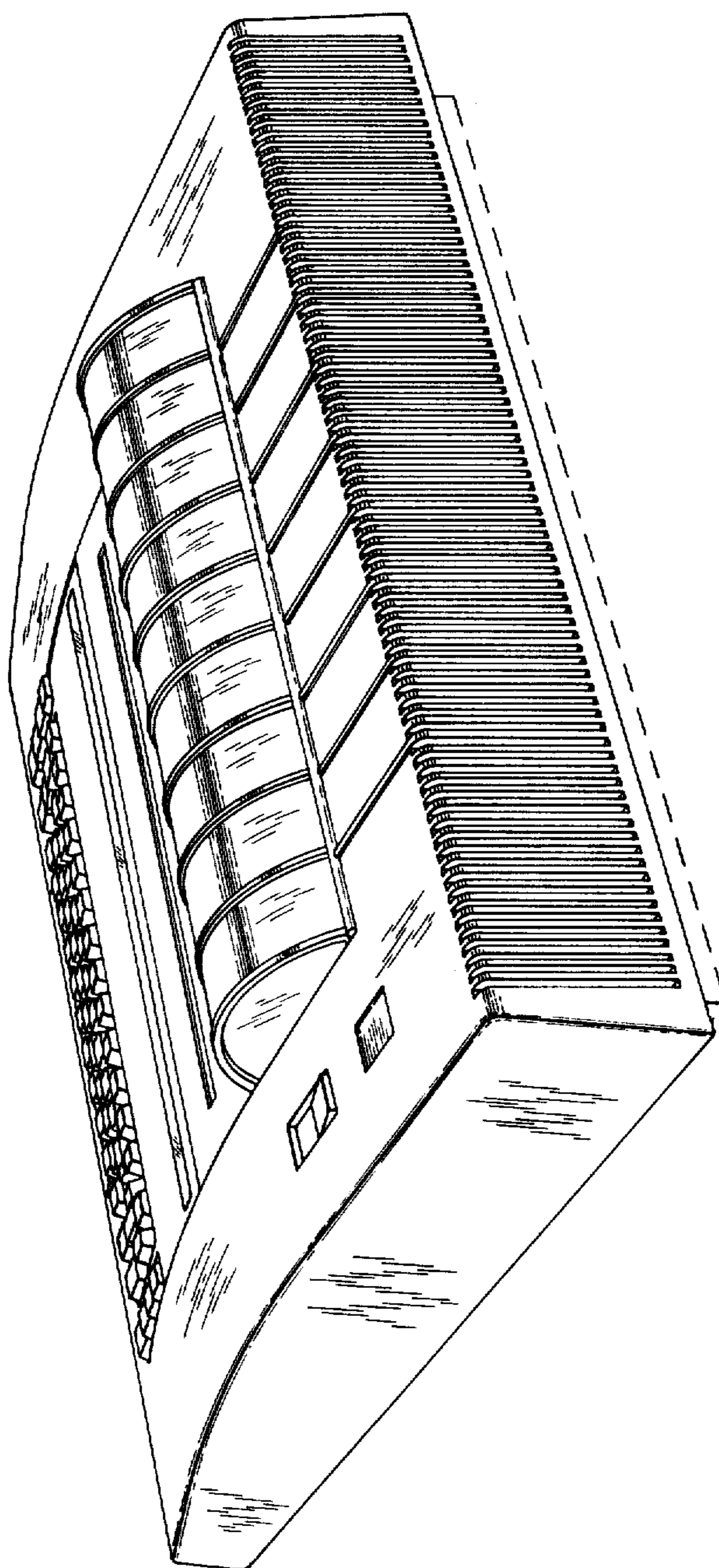

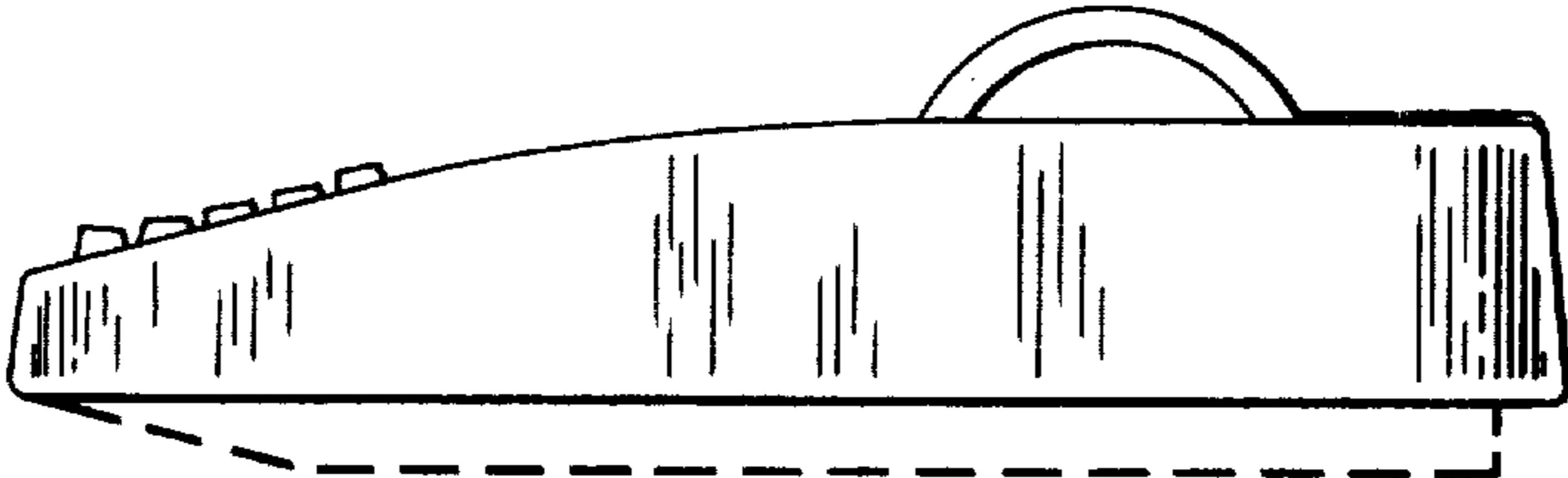
