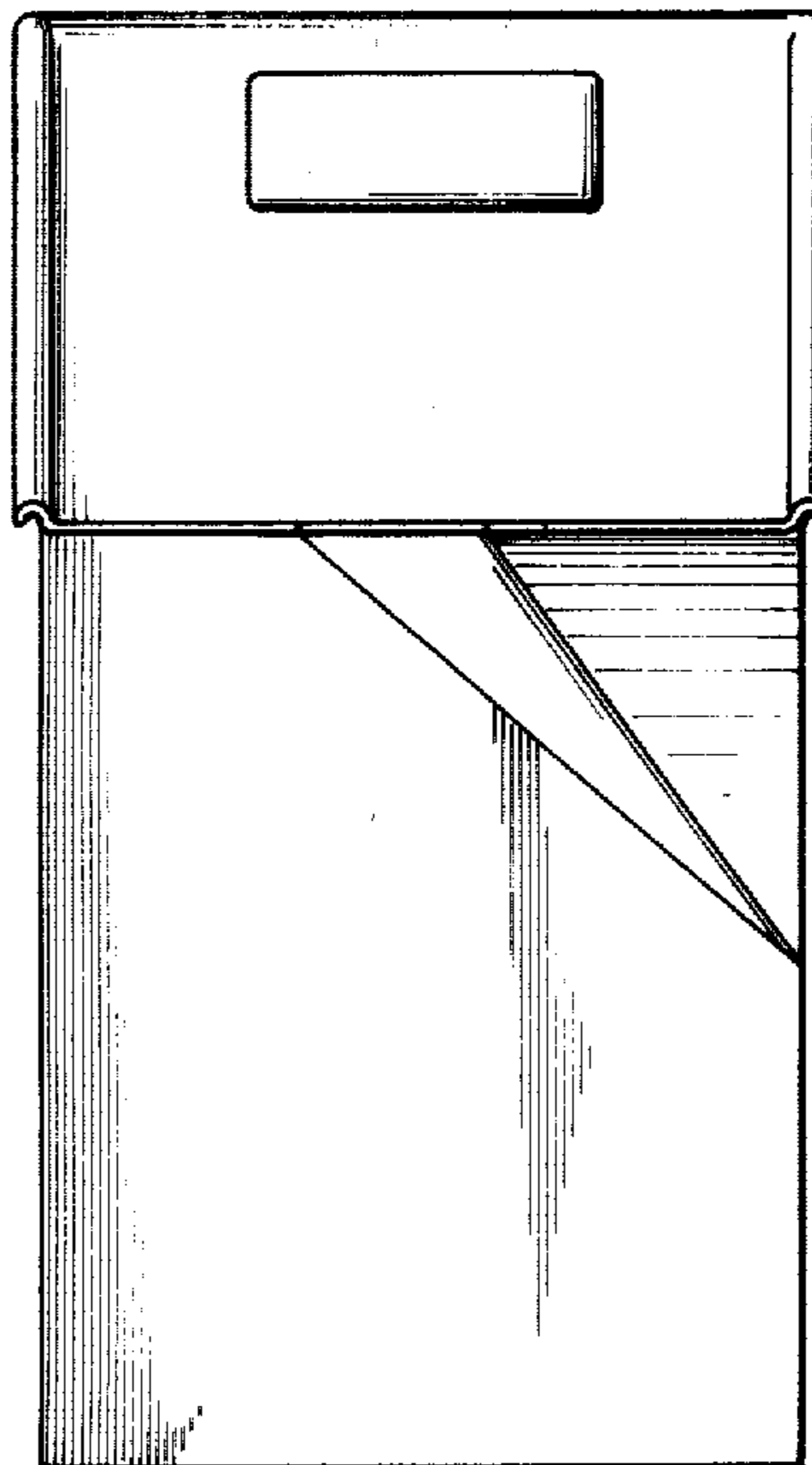

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a quill can showing our new design;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof.



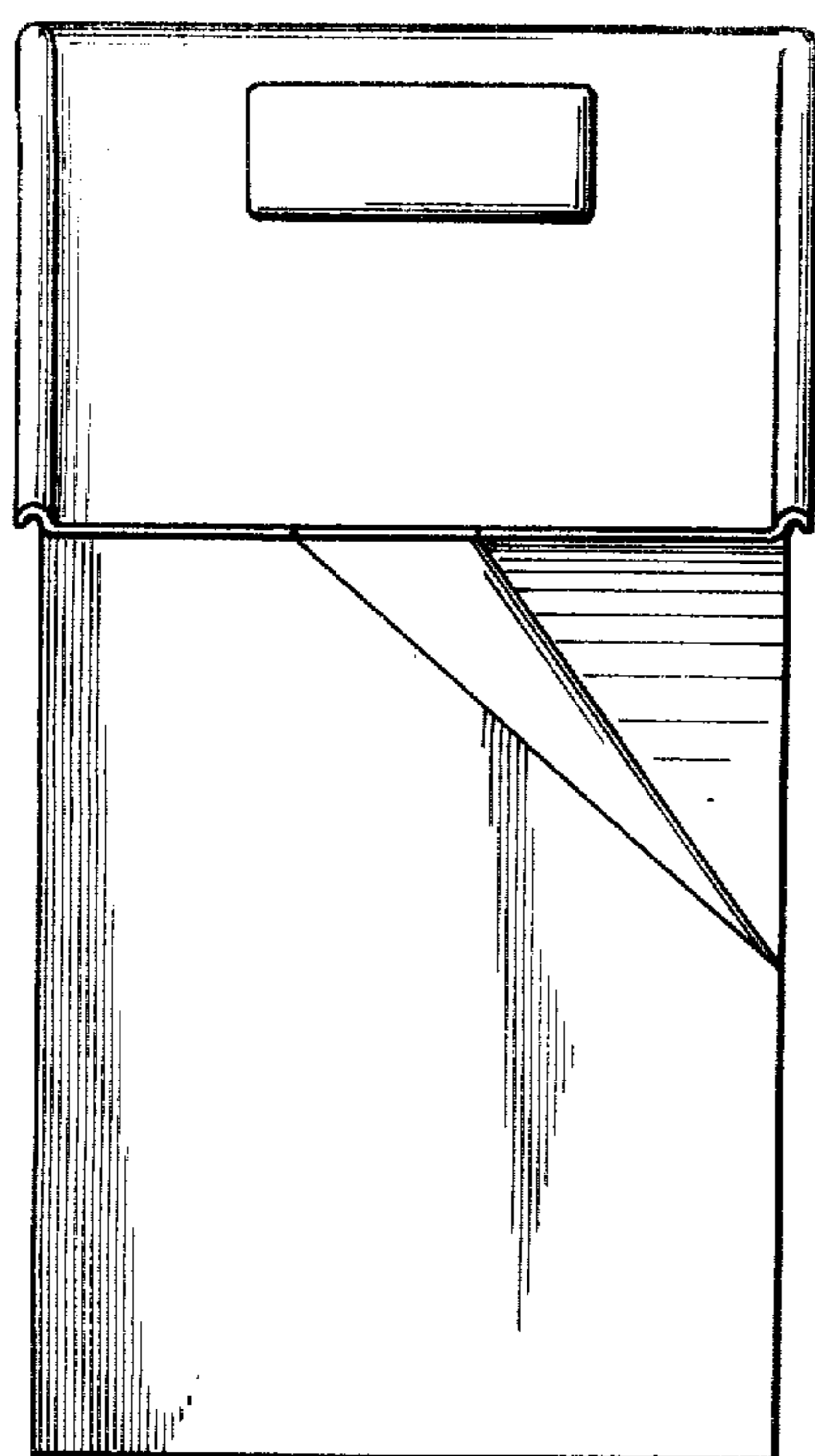

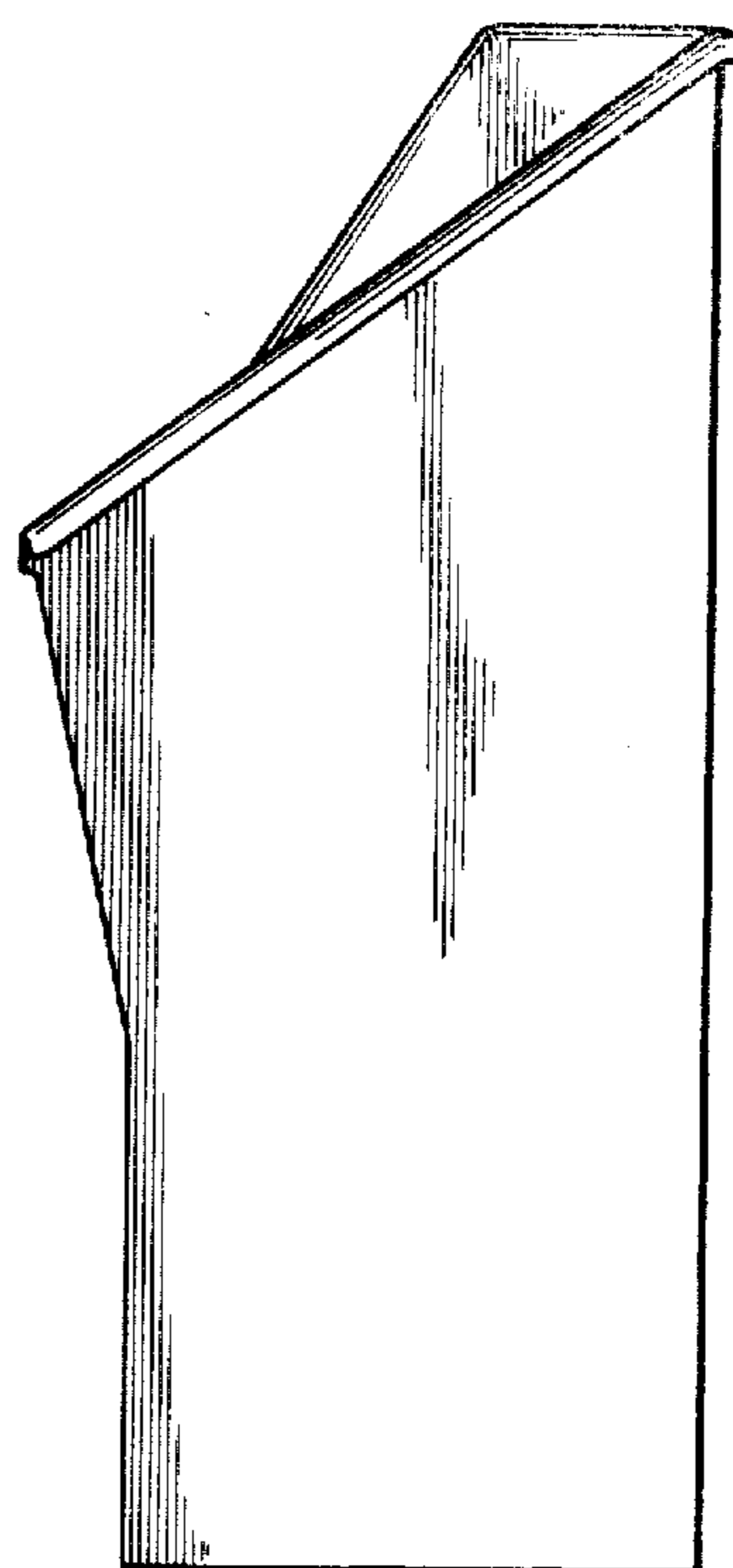

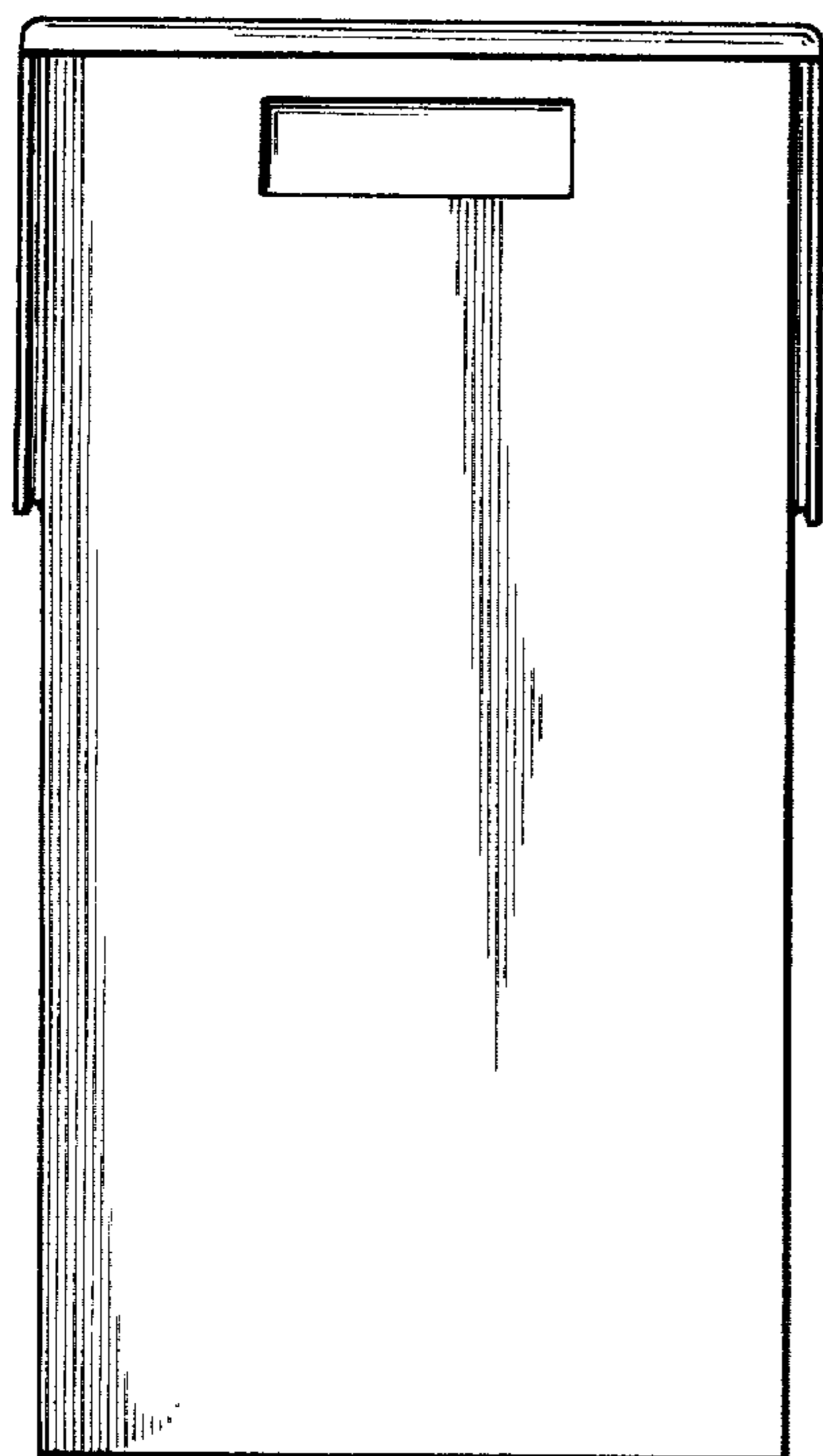

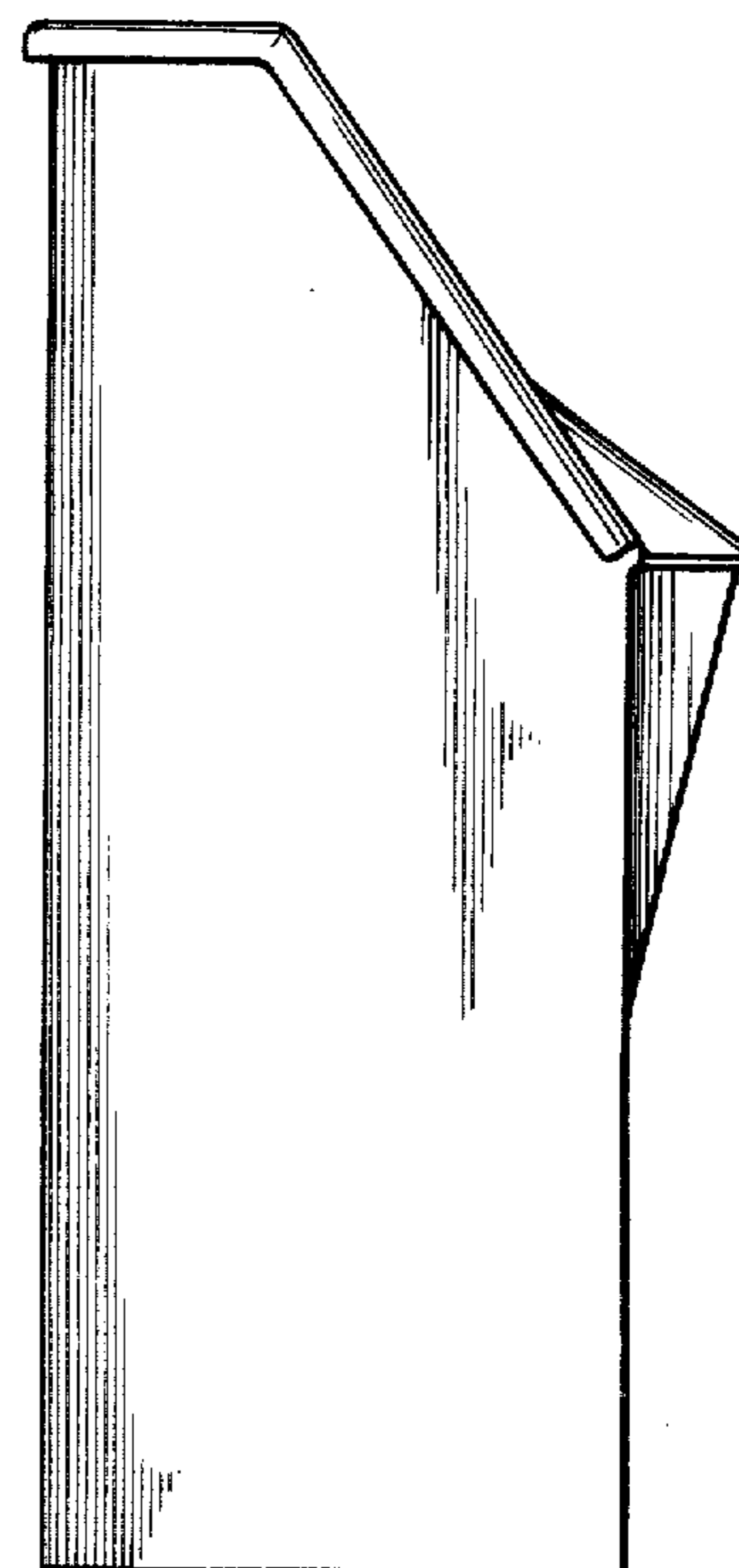

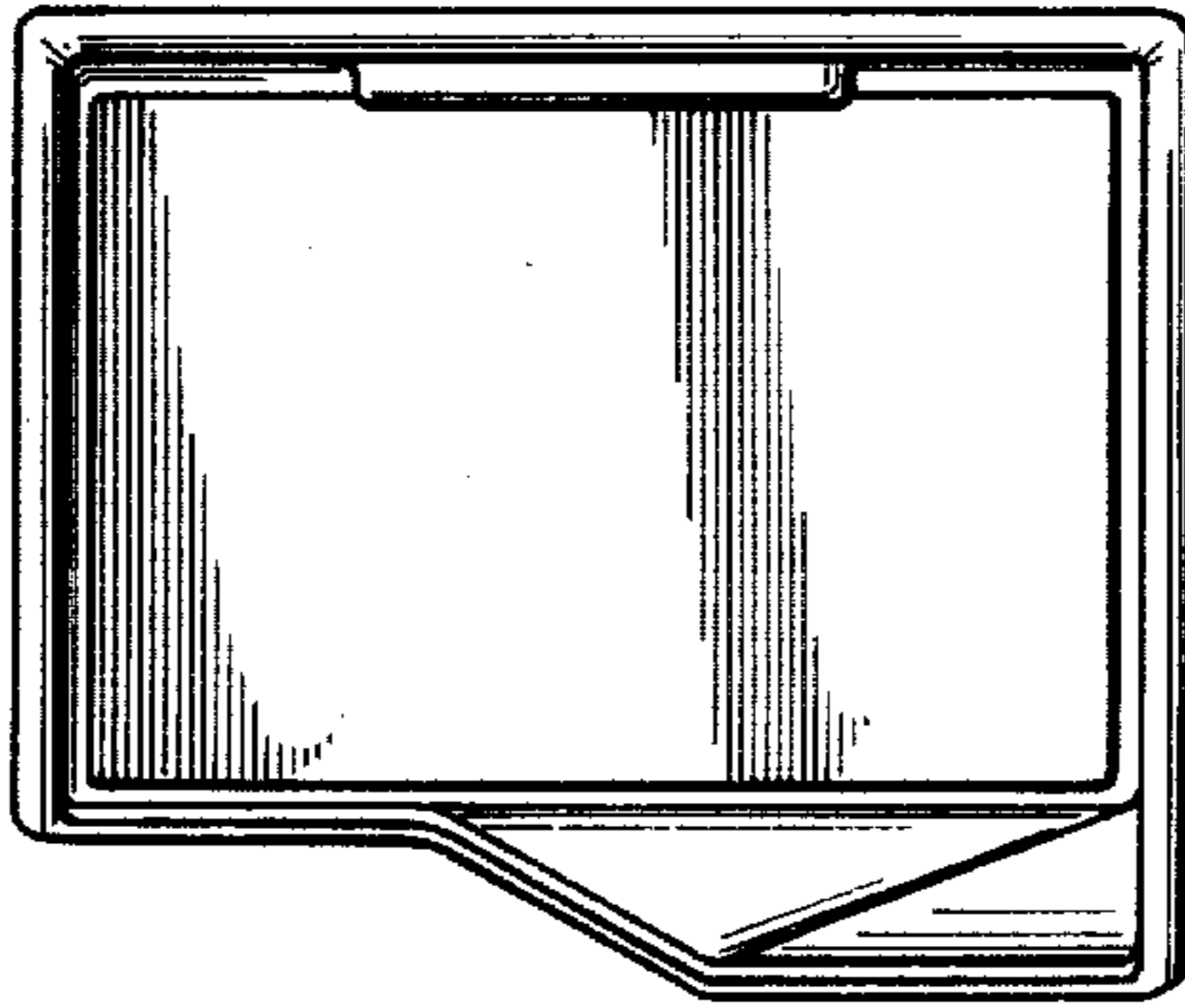

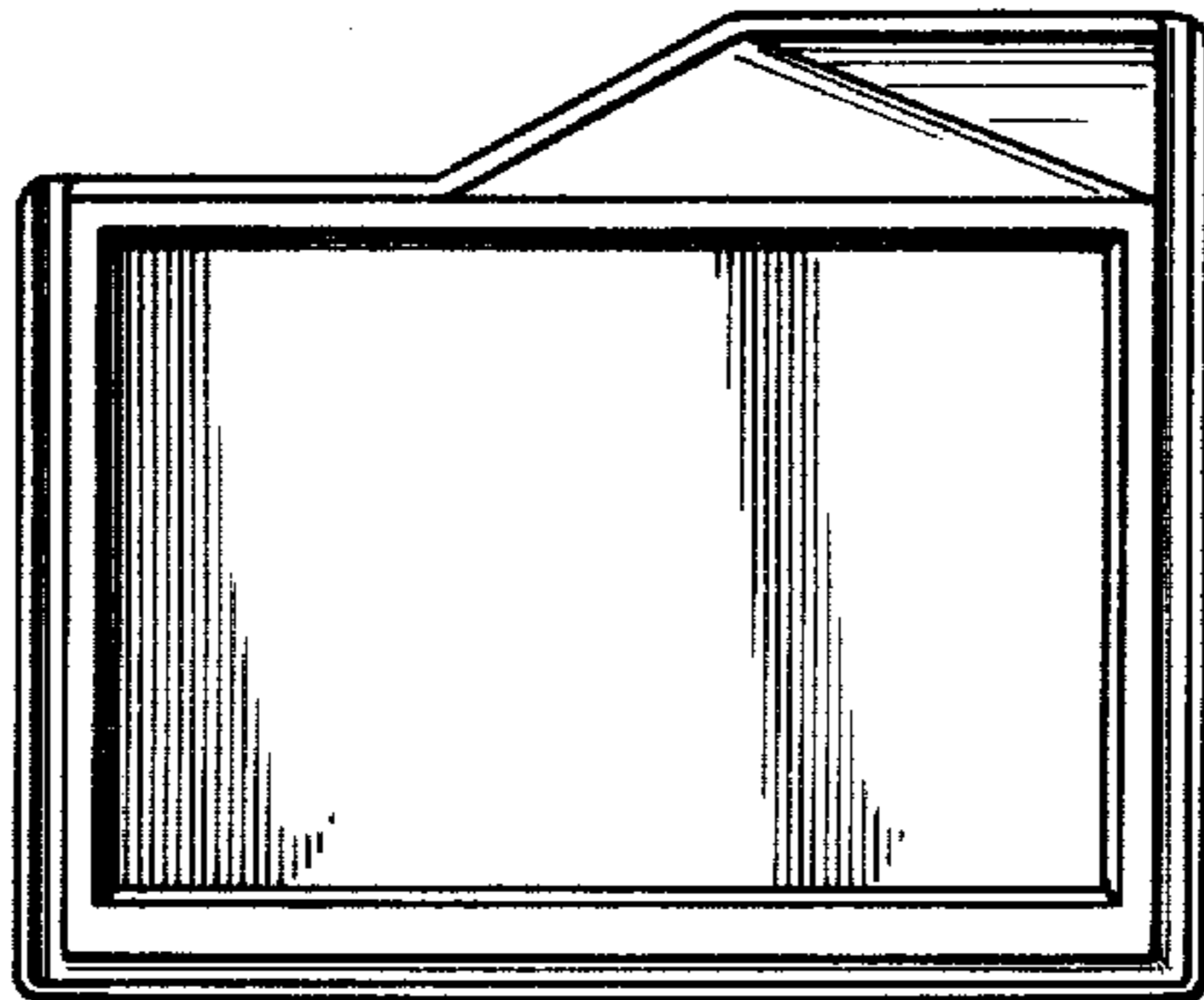

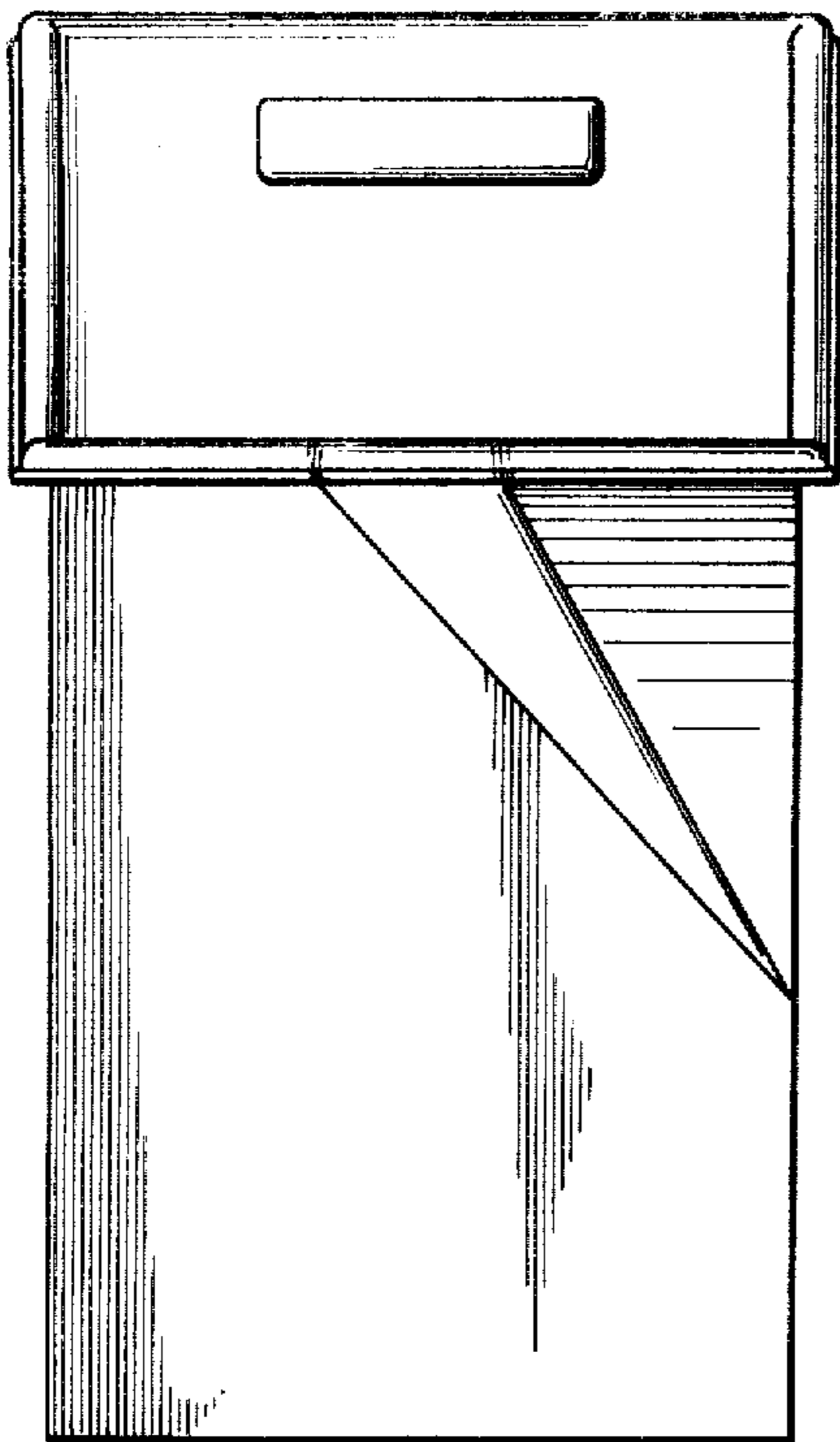

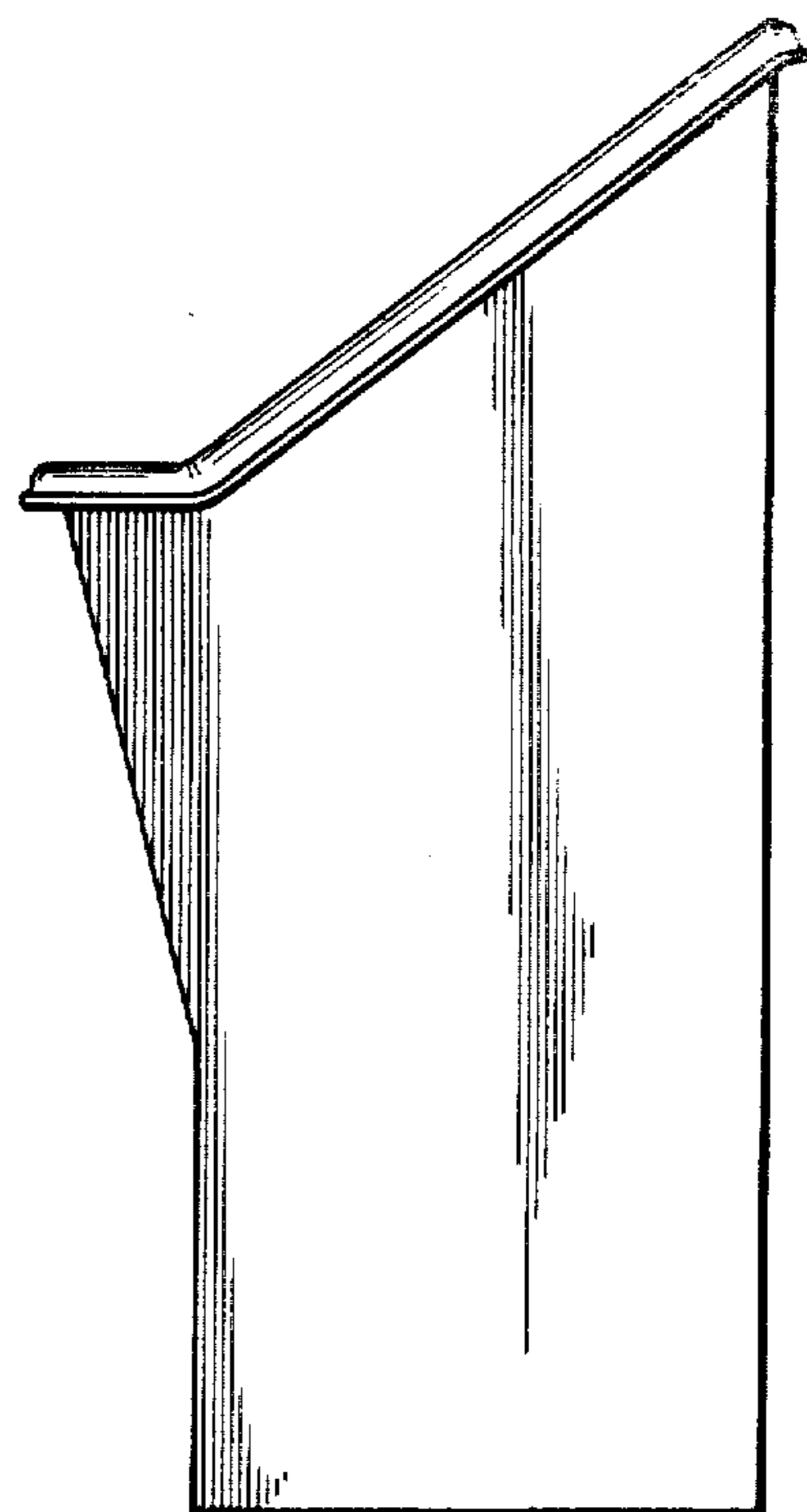

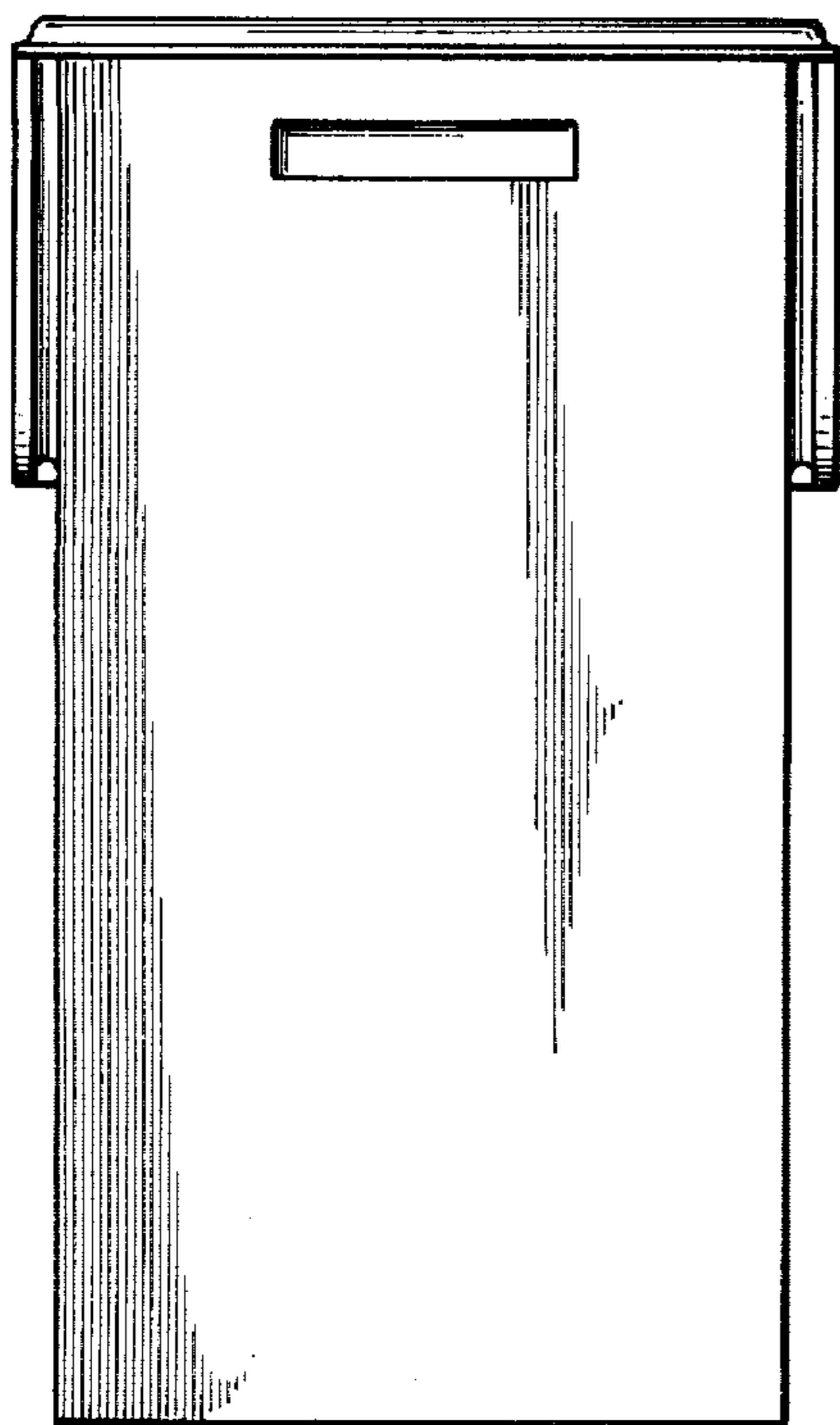

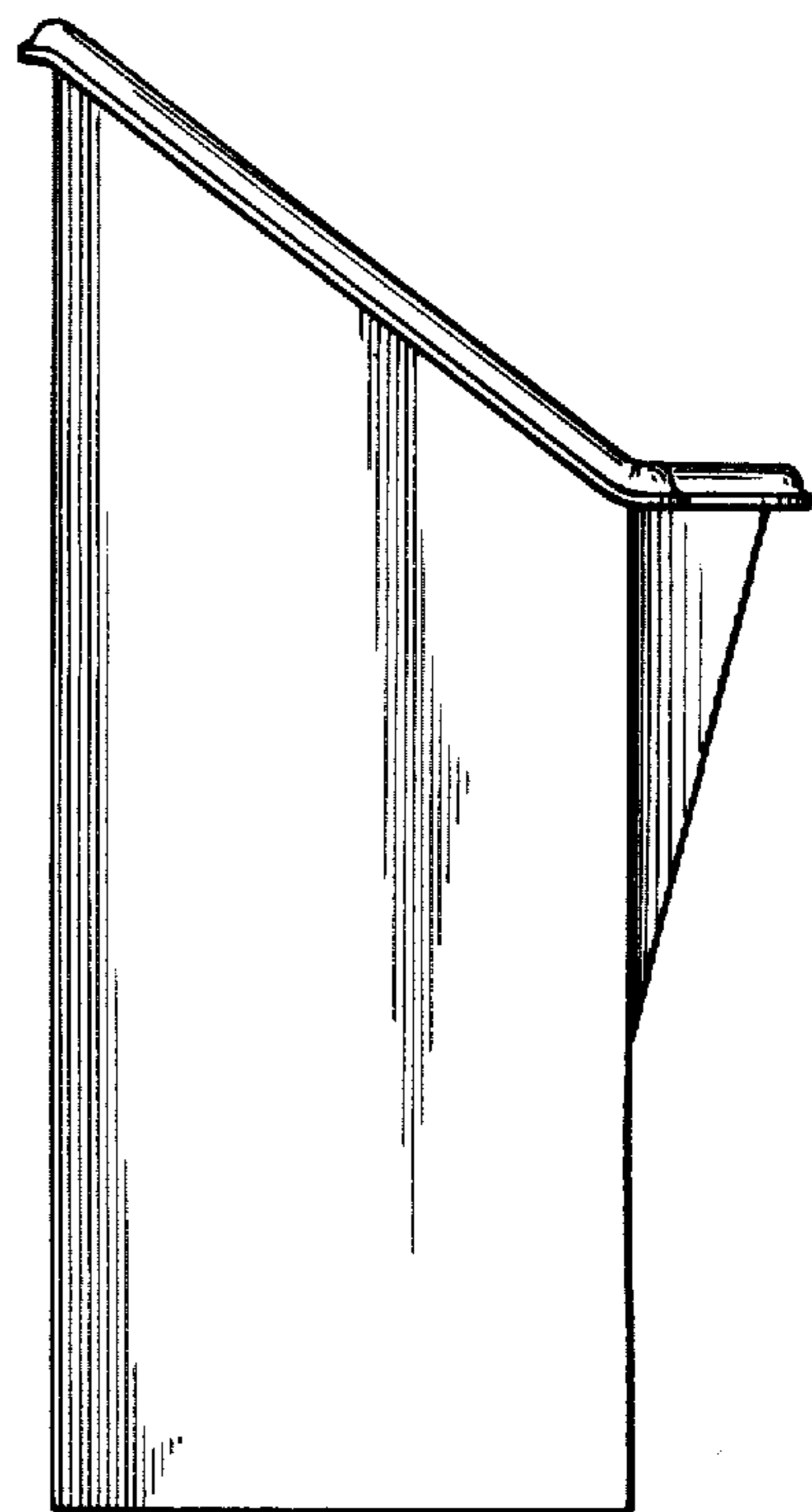

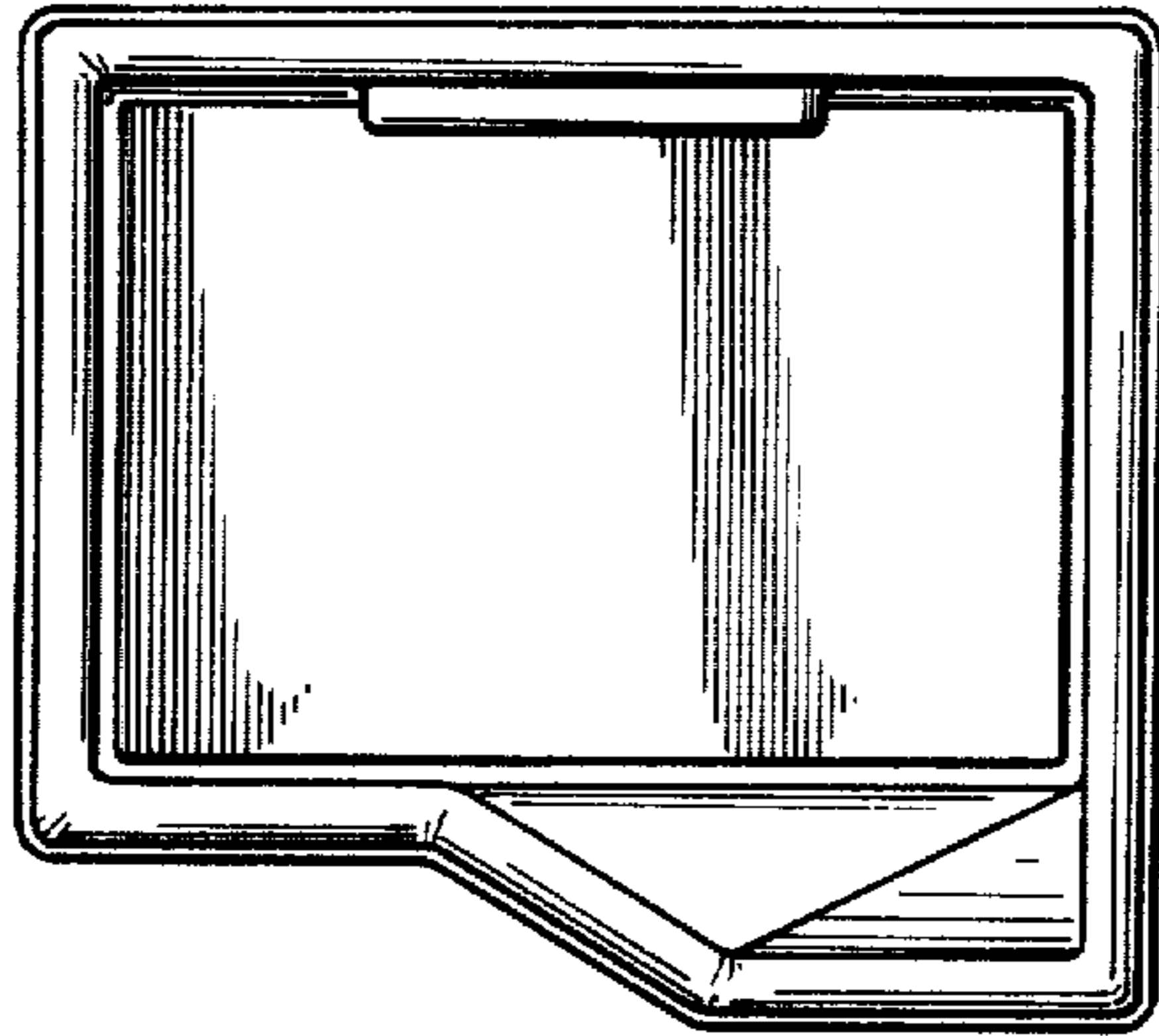

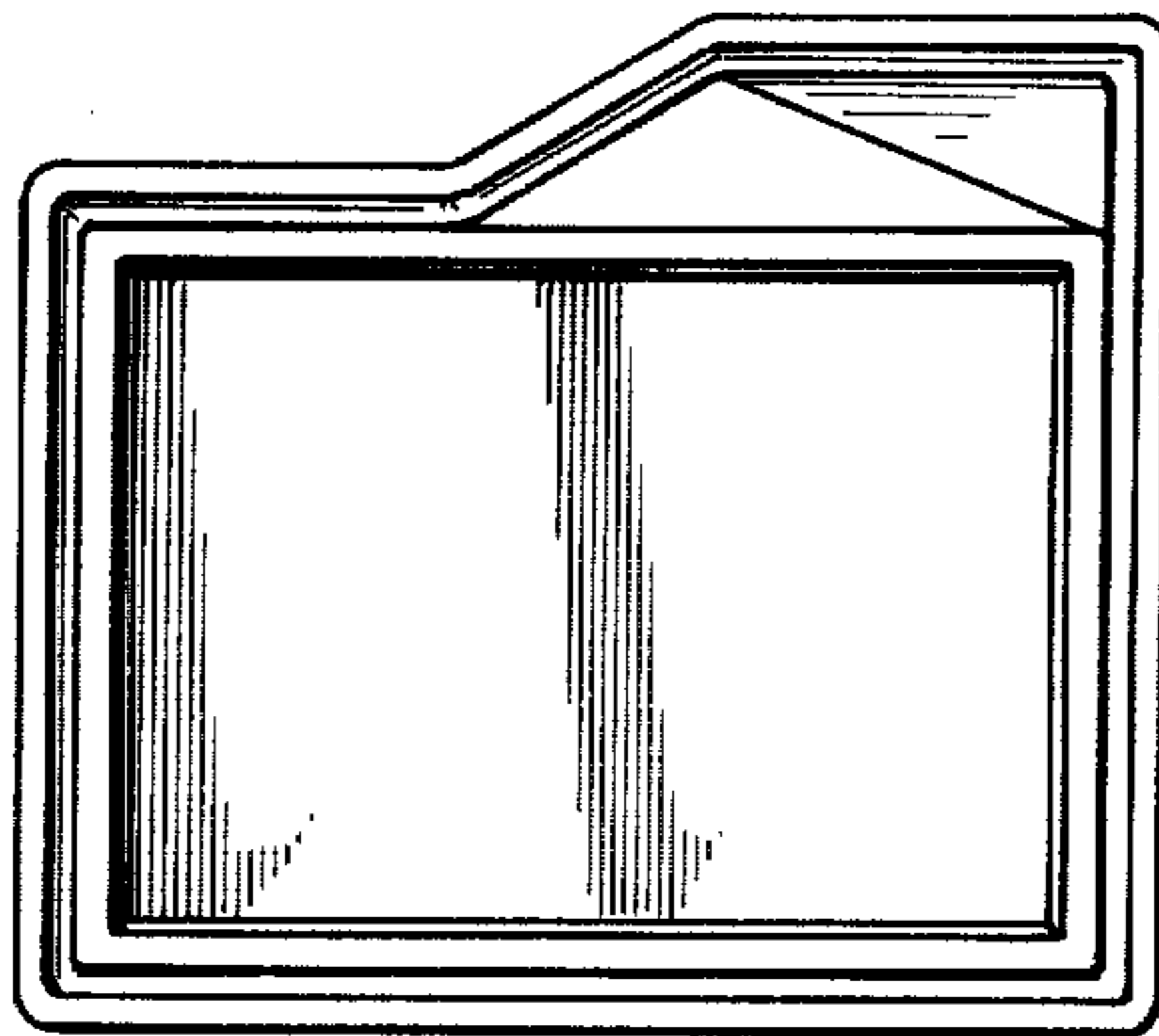
