[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the table showing the triangular table top with its extended top flat side;

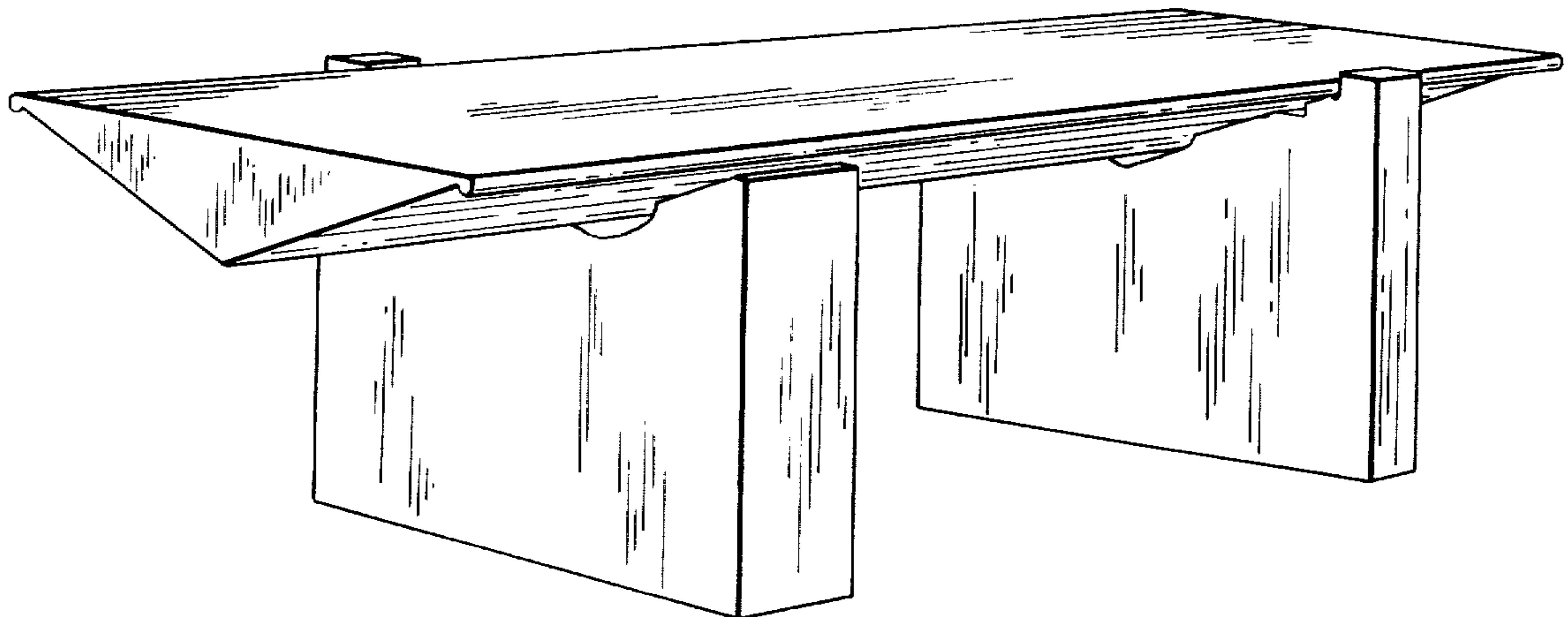
FIG. 2 is a front or back elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view showing the positioning in opposite directions of the twin trapezoidal pedestals;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, left or right; and

FIG. 5 is a top plan view.

The table is characterized by the substantially round molding strips along the longitudinal edges of the top in combination with the grooves on the tops of the leg support panels which engage said molding strips, all as best shown in FIGS. 1 and 4.



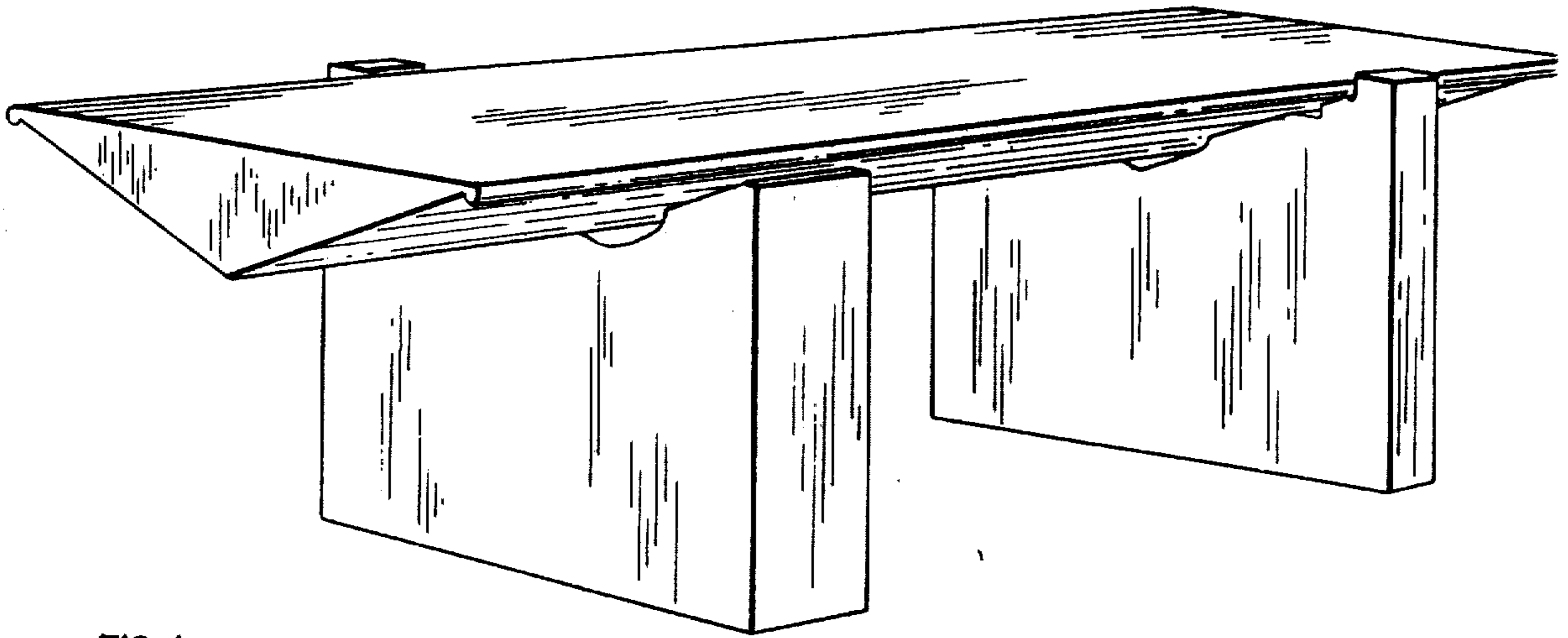

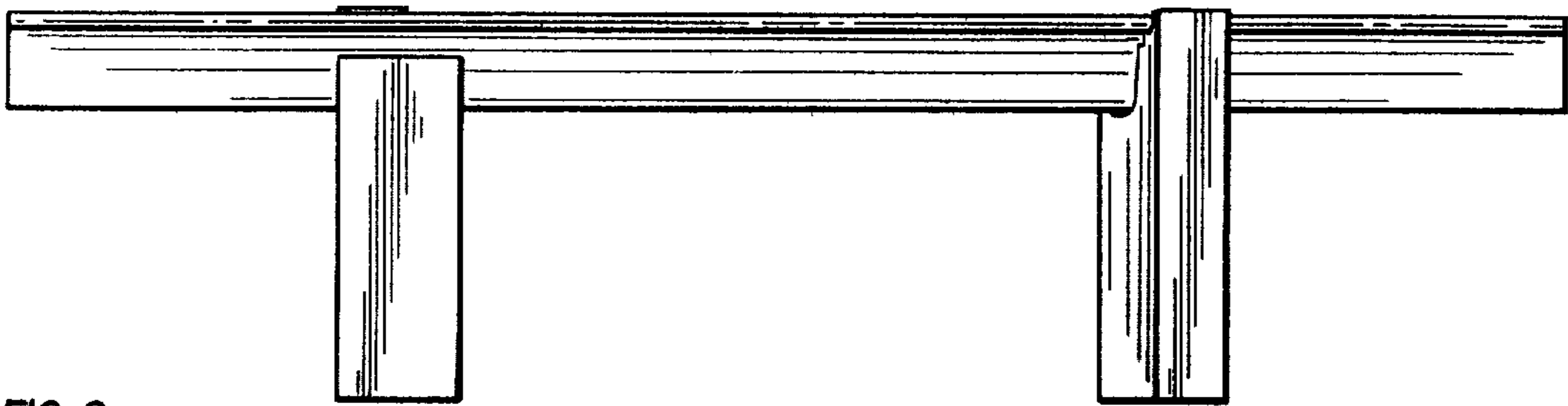

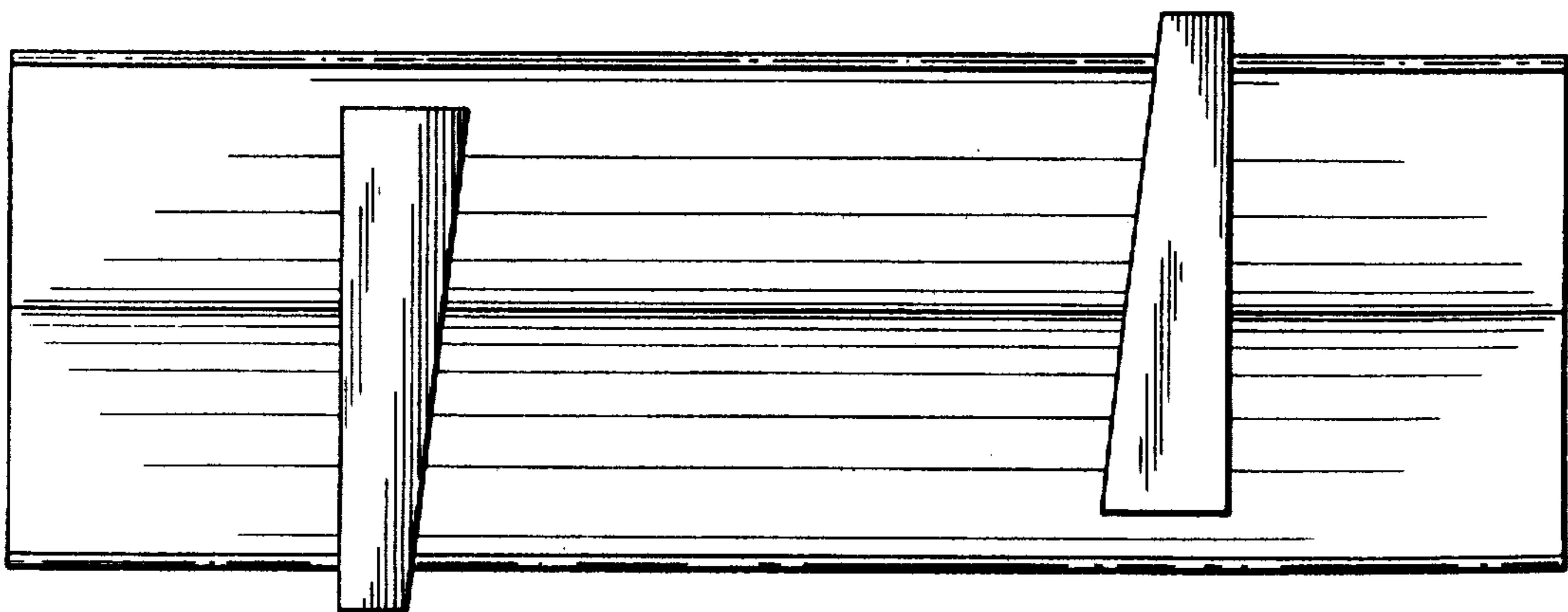

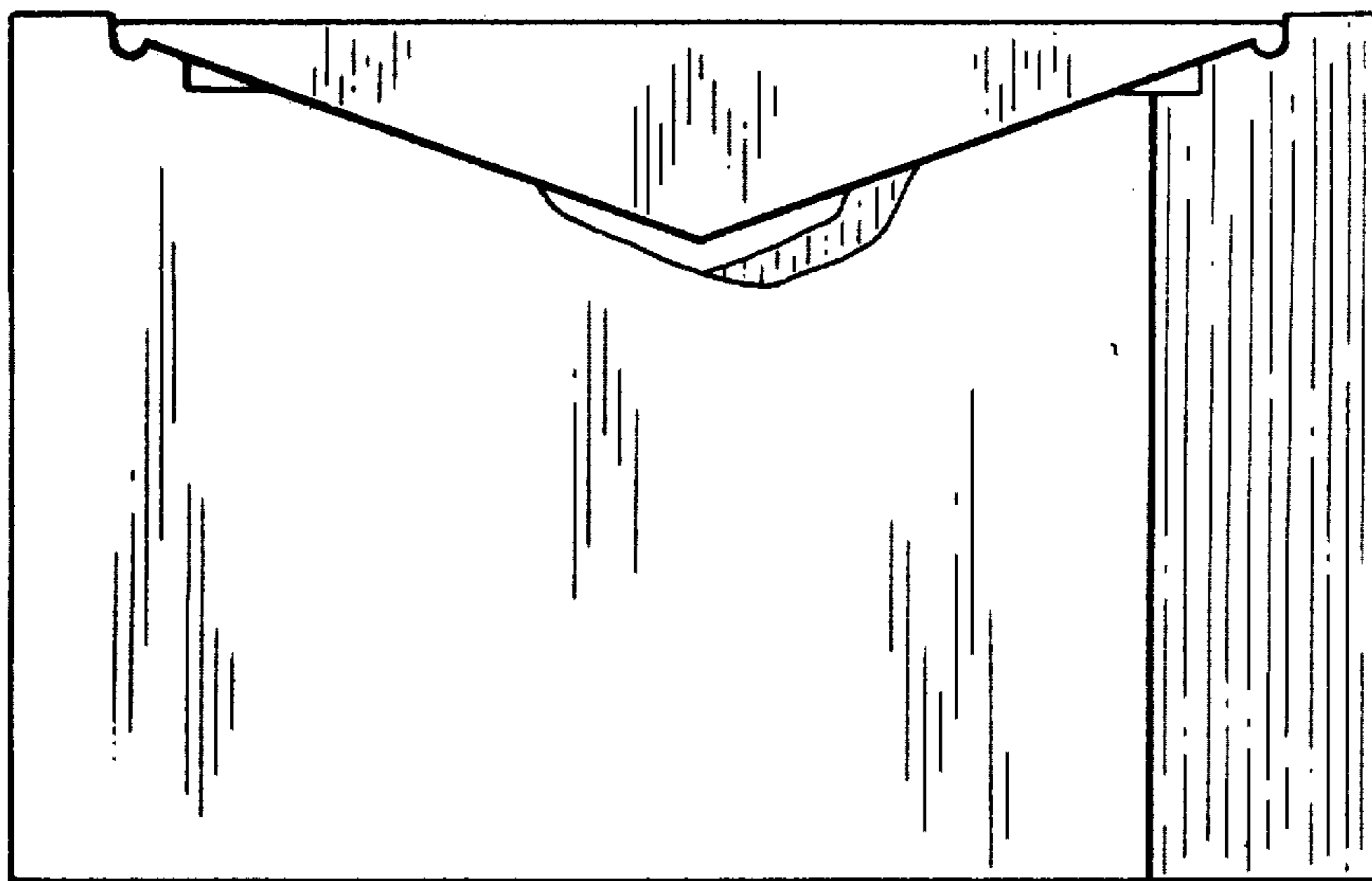

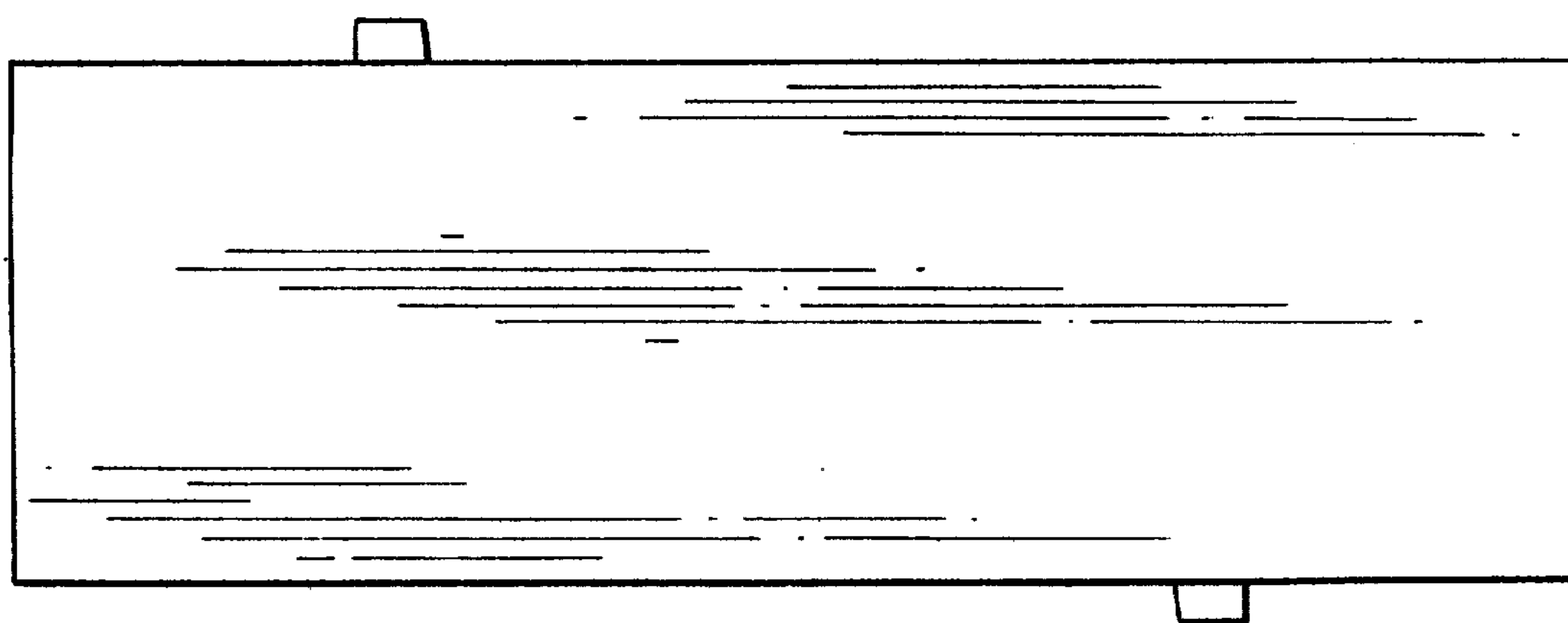
