FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an automatic information center showing our new design;

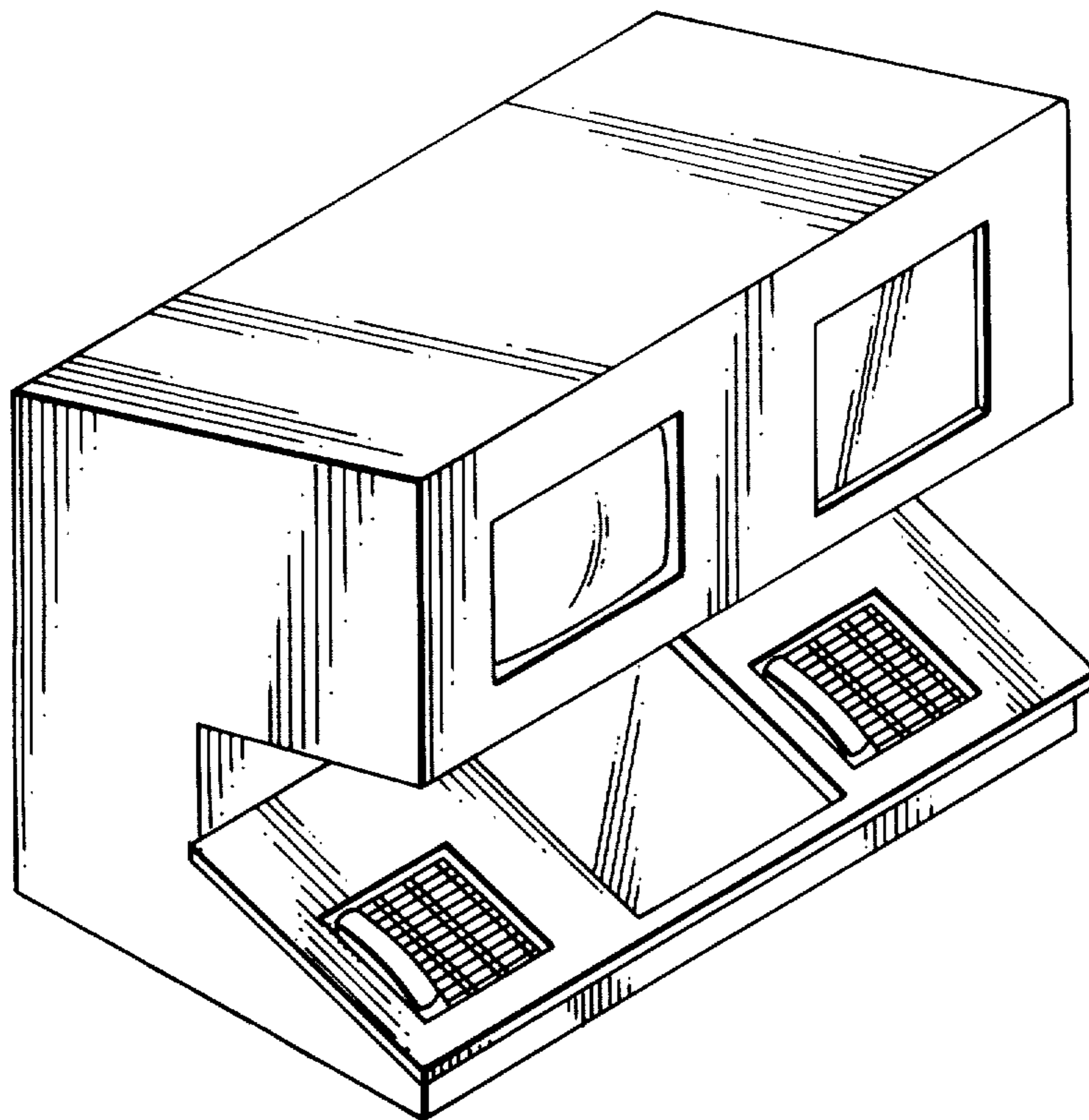
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.



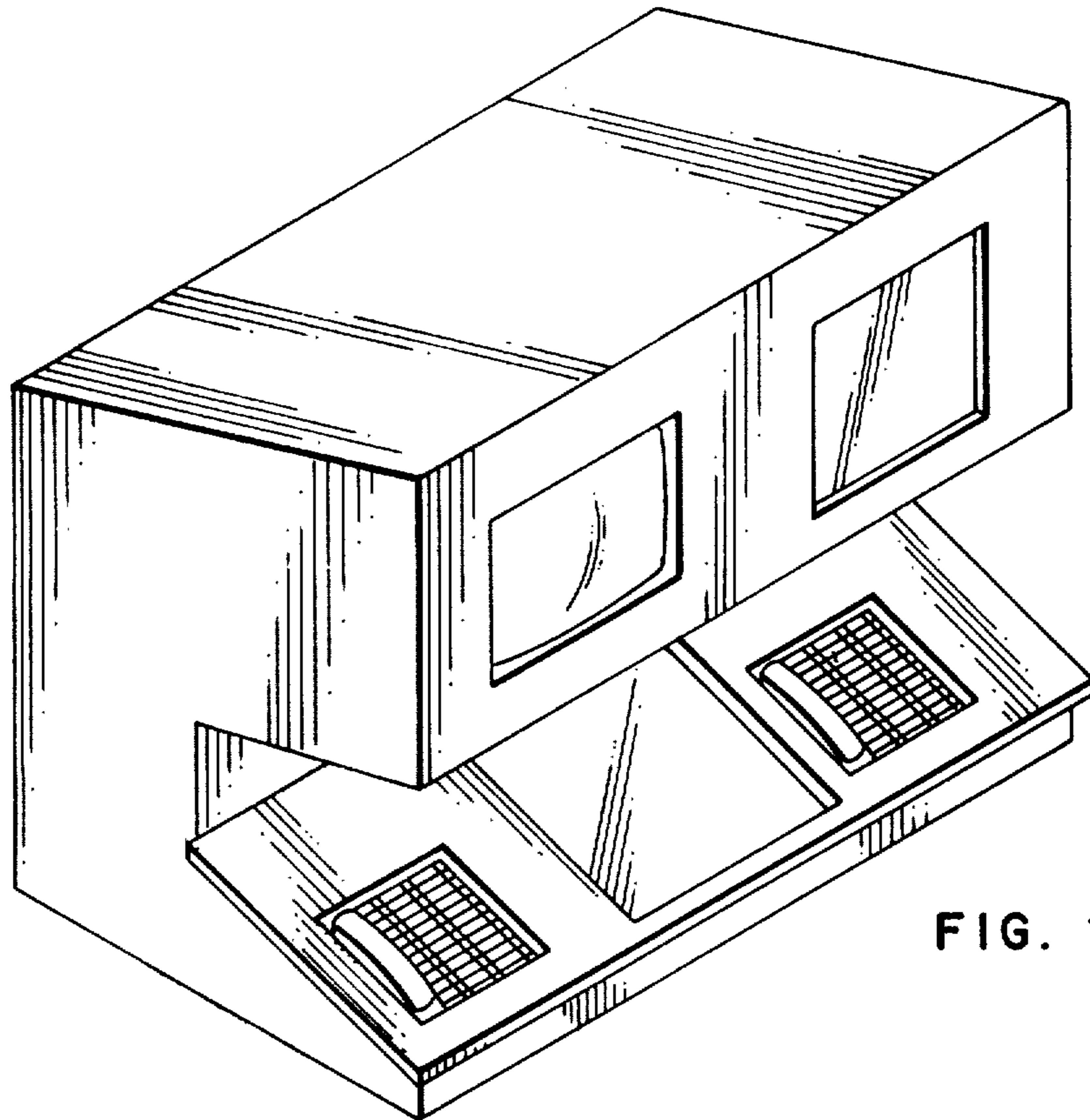

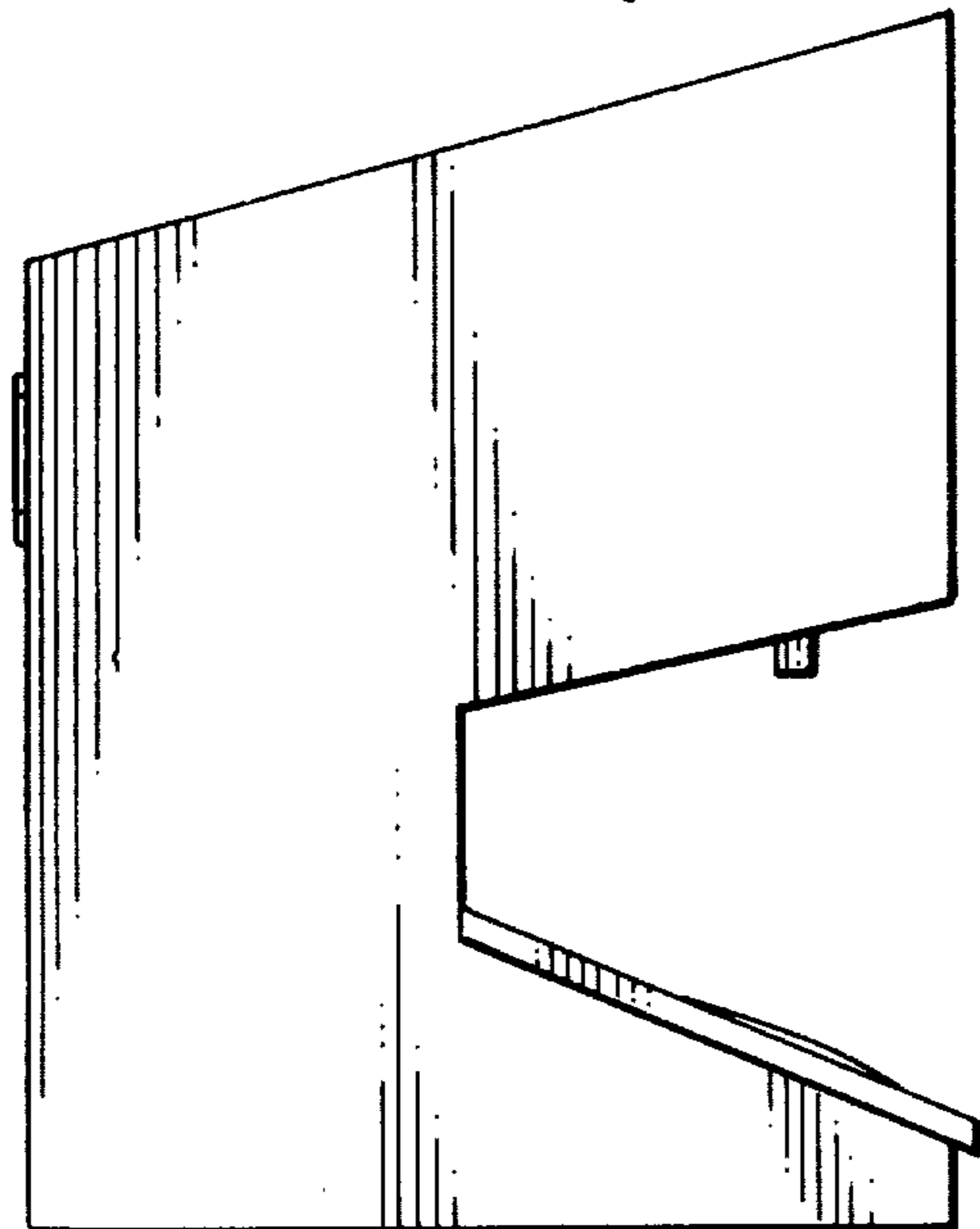

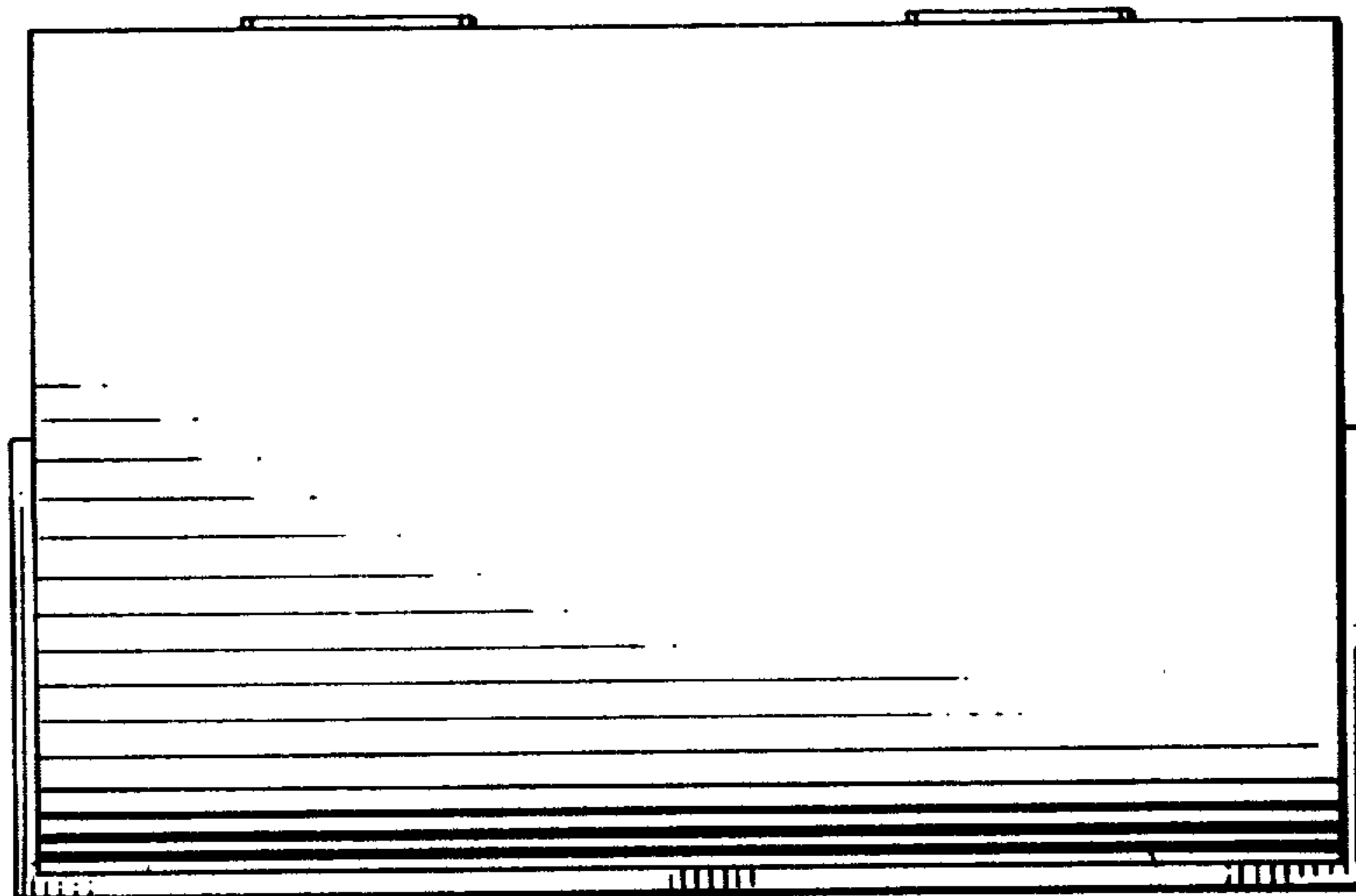

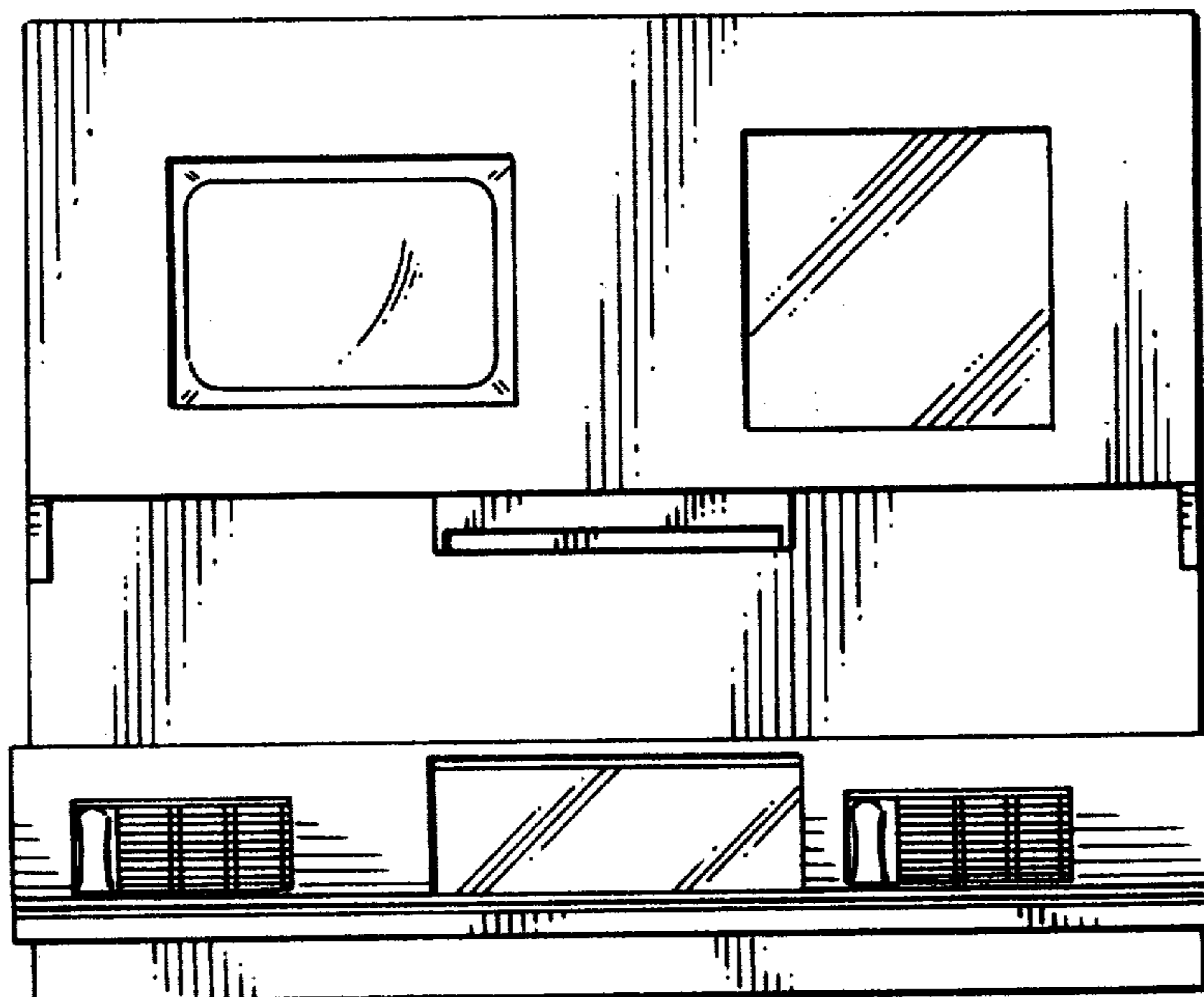

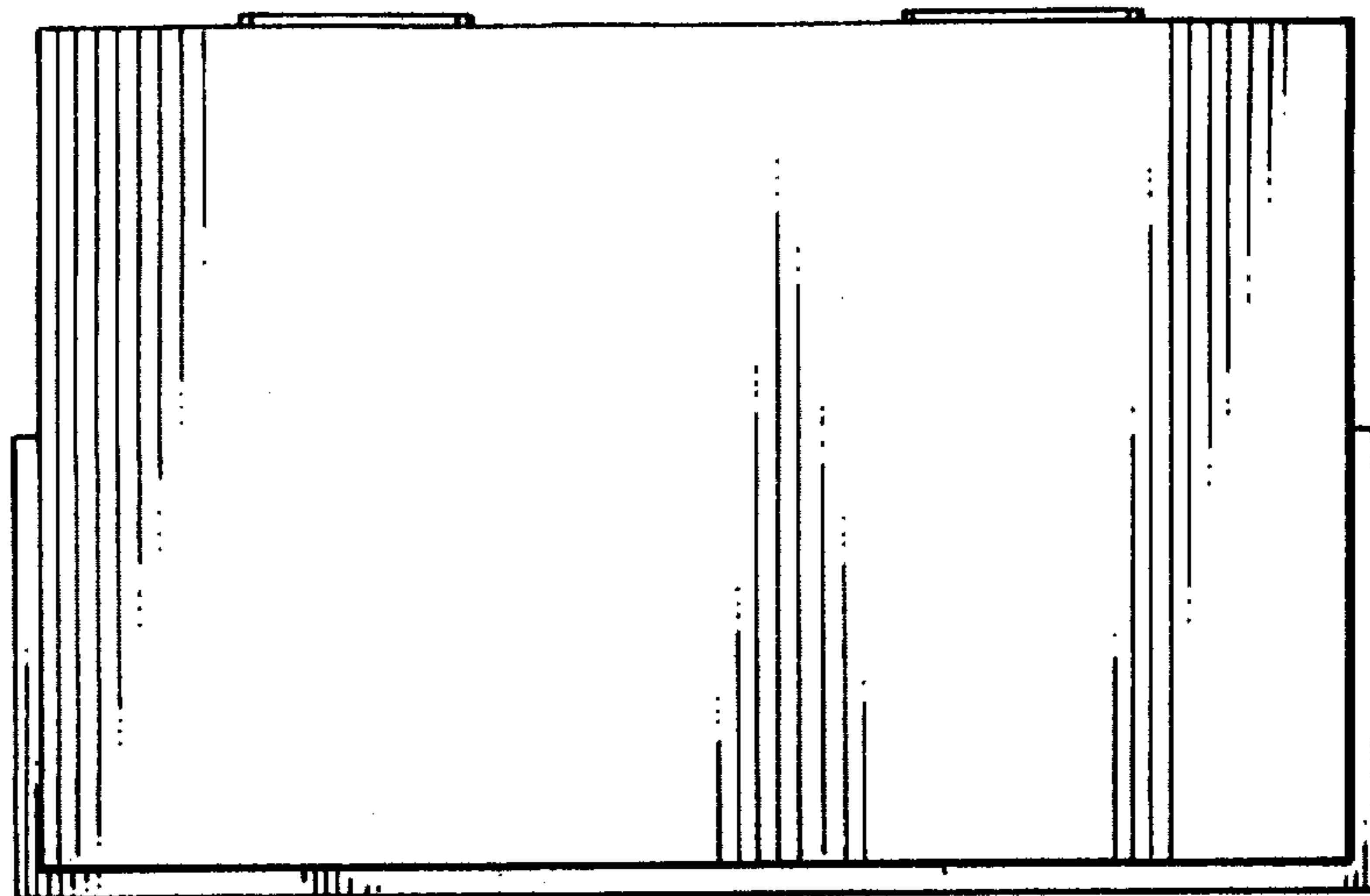

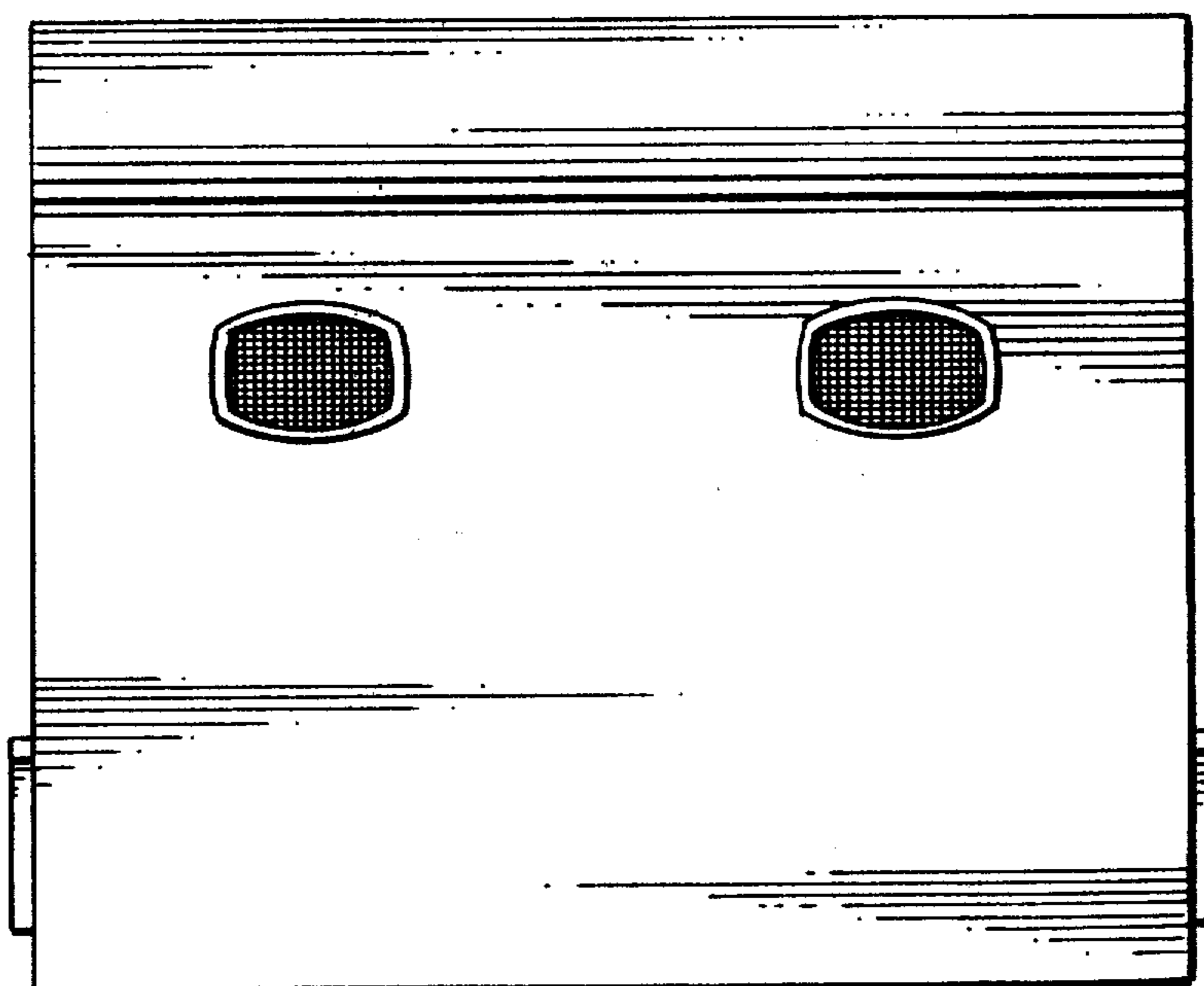
