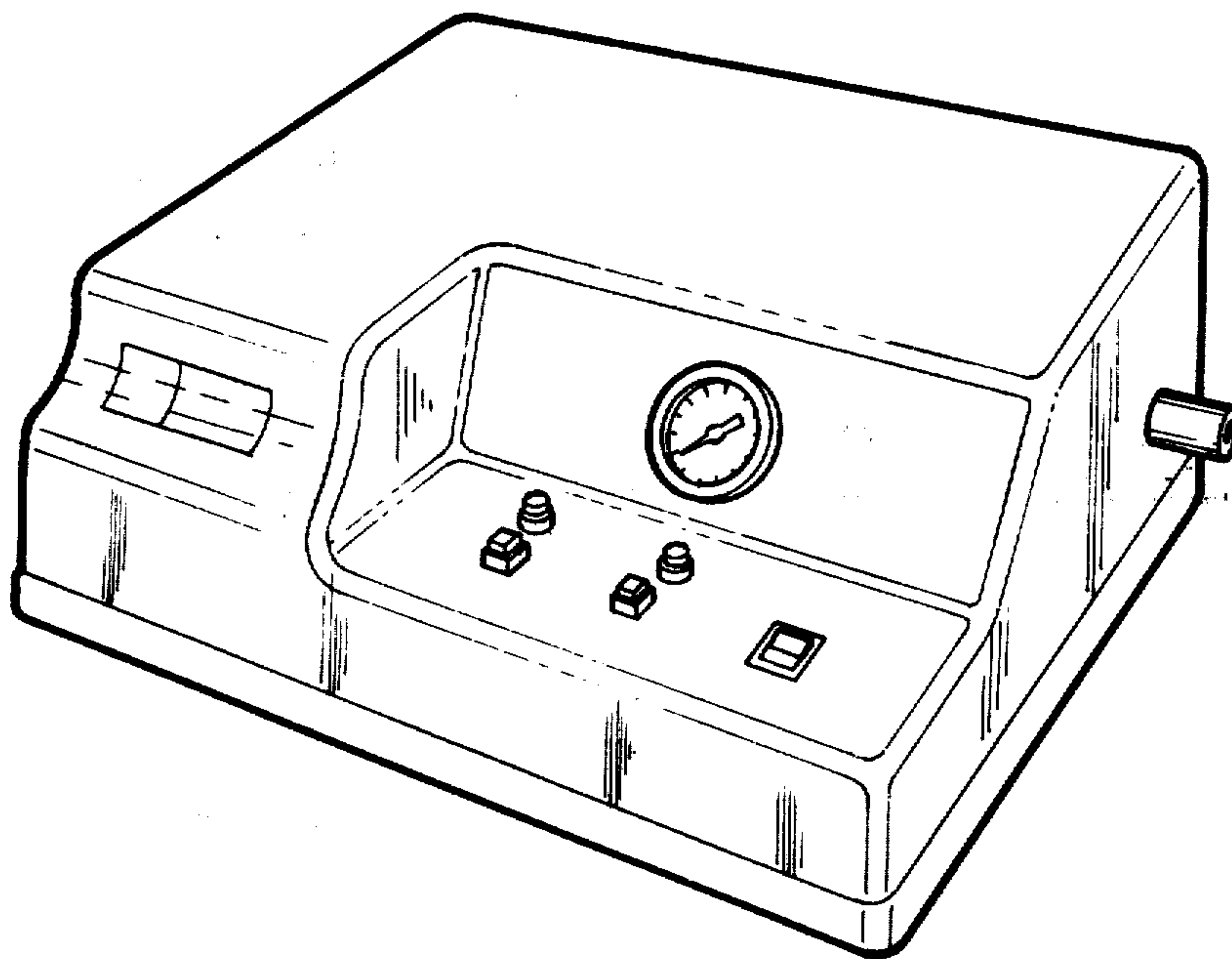

 FIG. 7 is a bottom elevational view of the present invention.



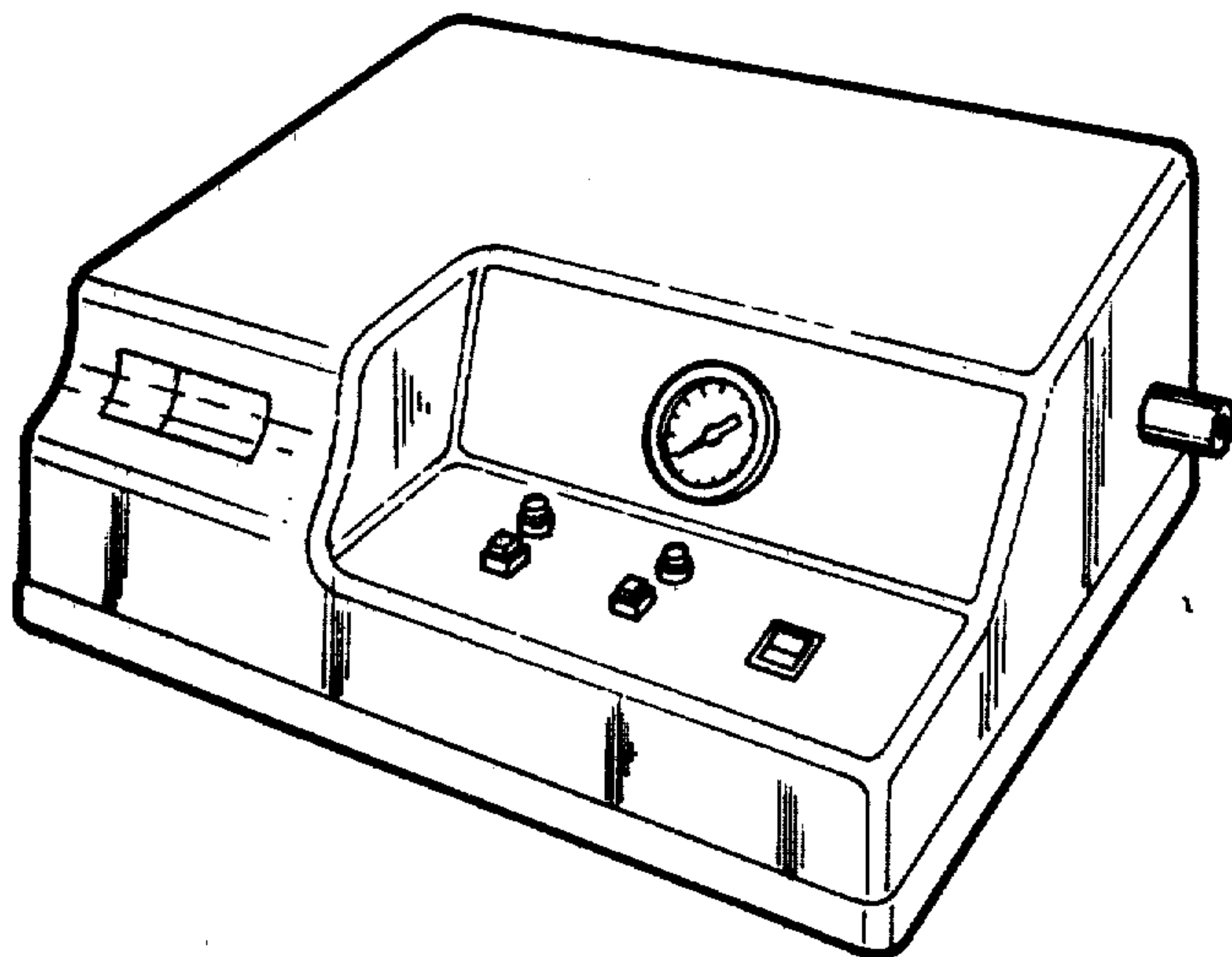

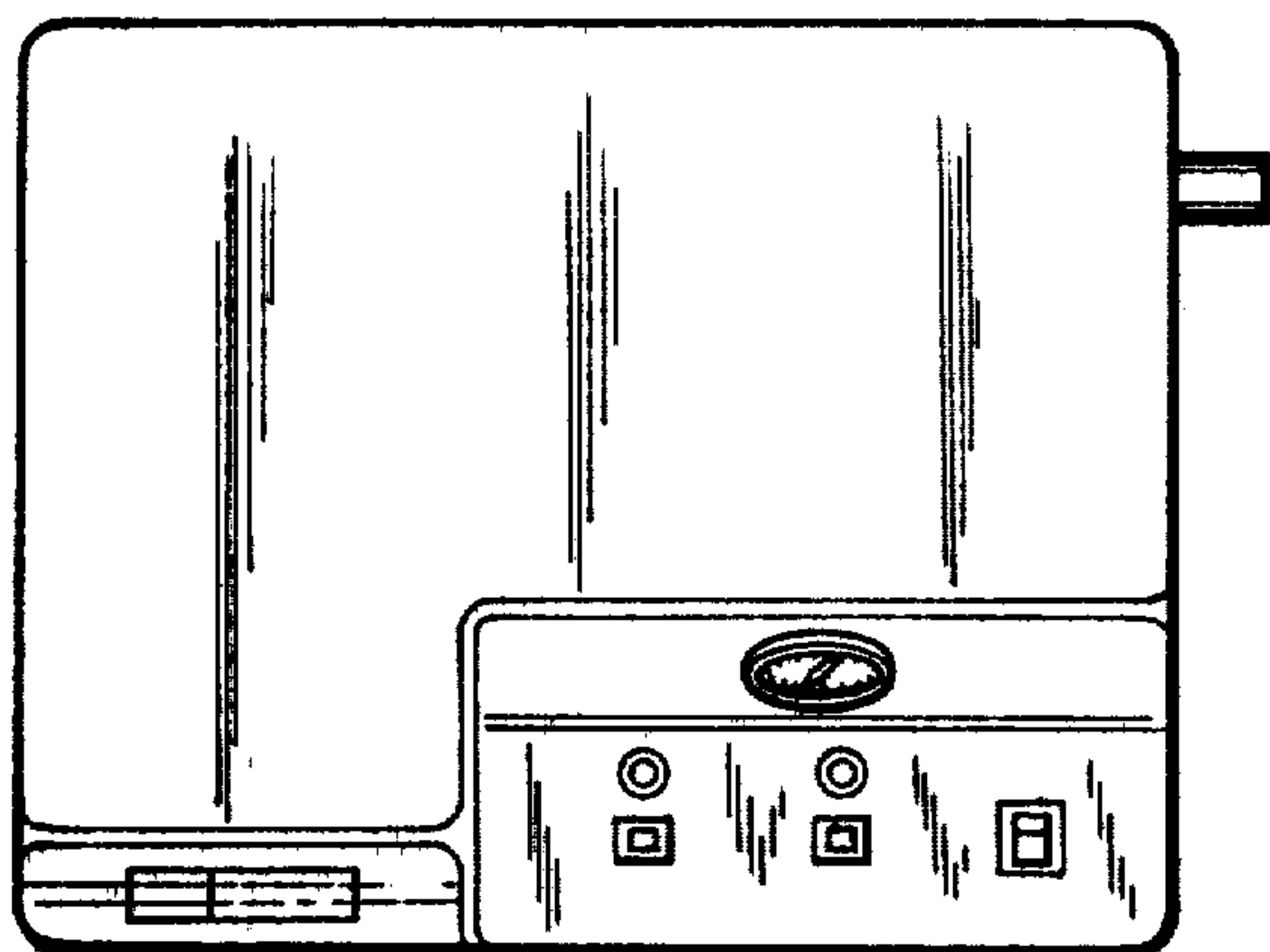

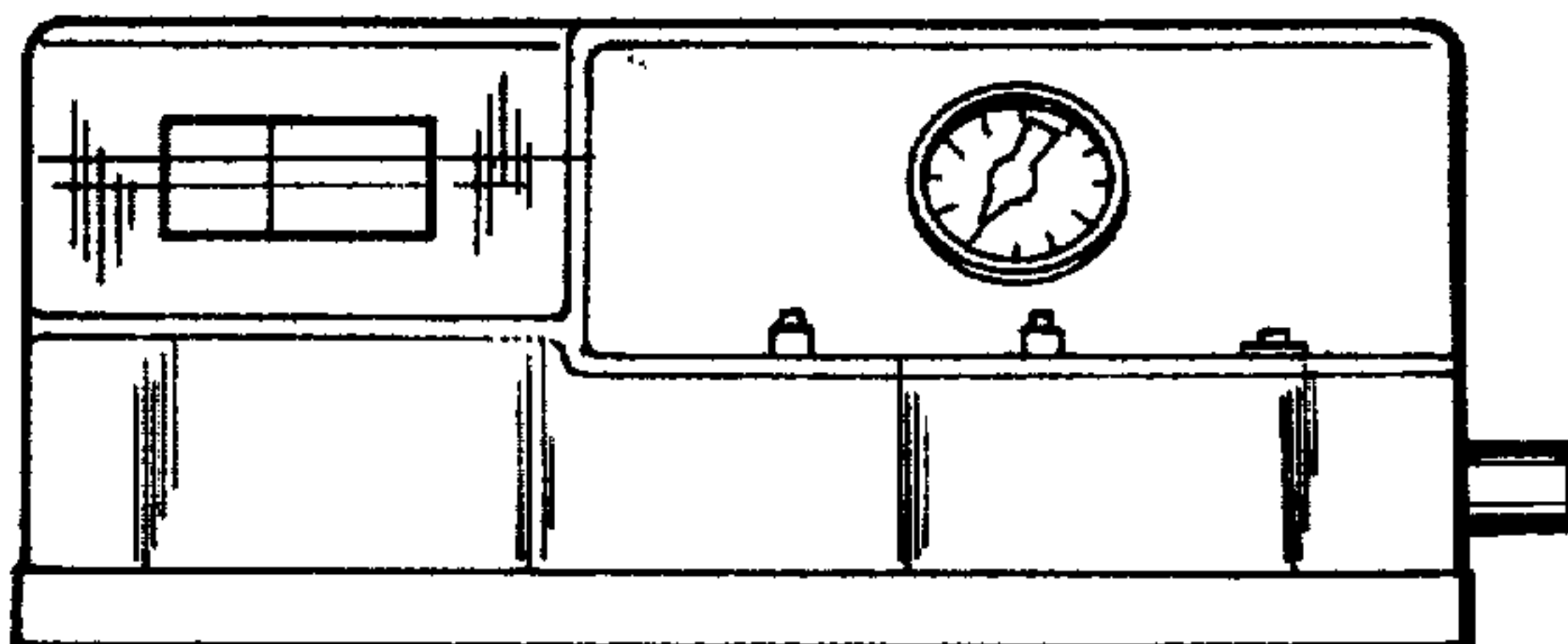

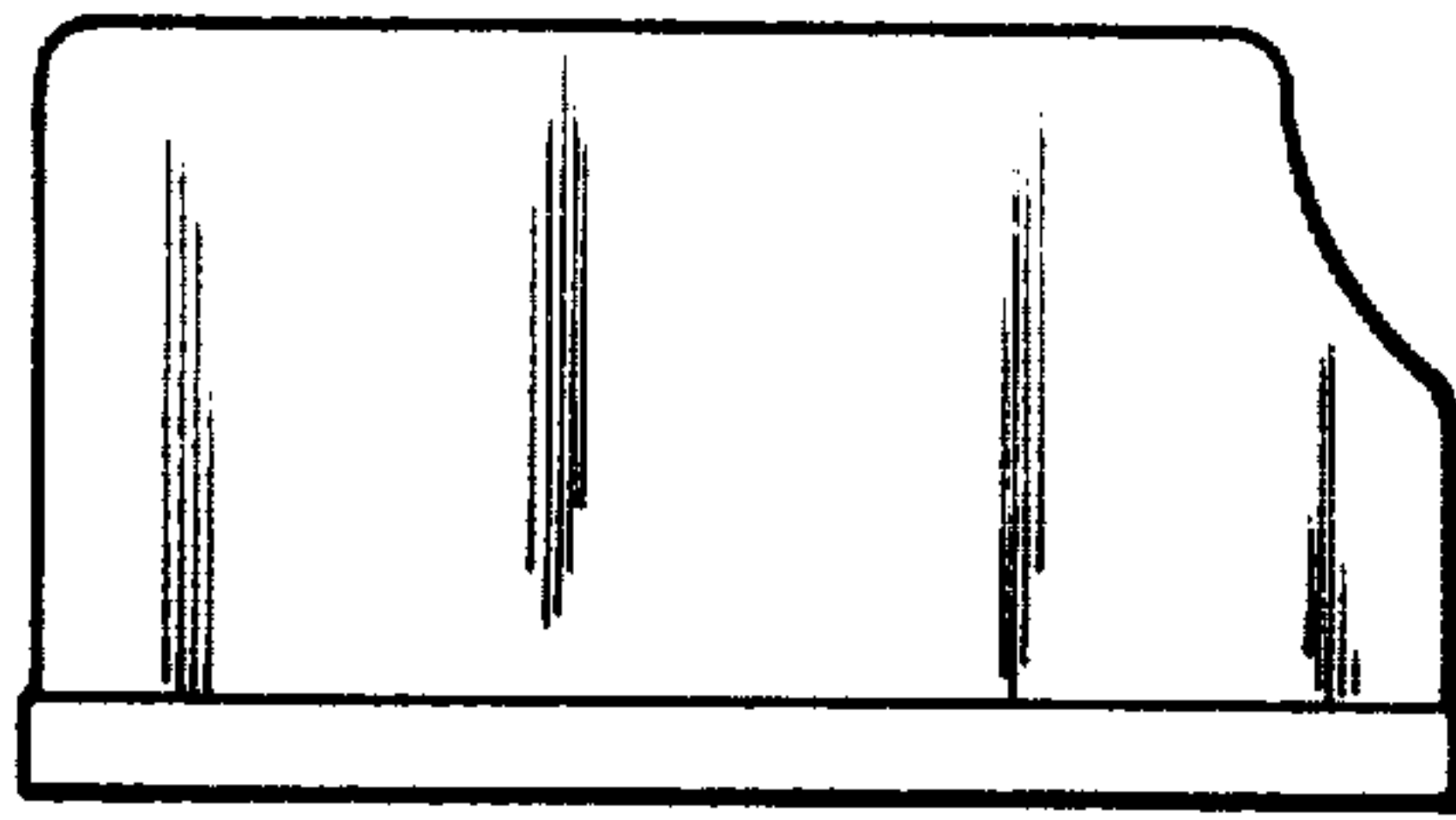

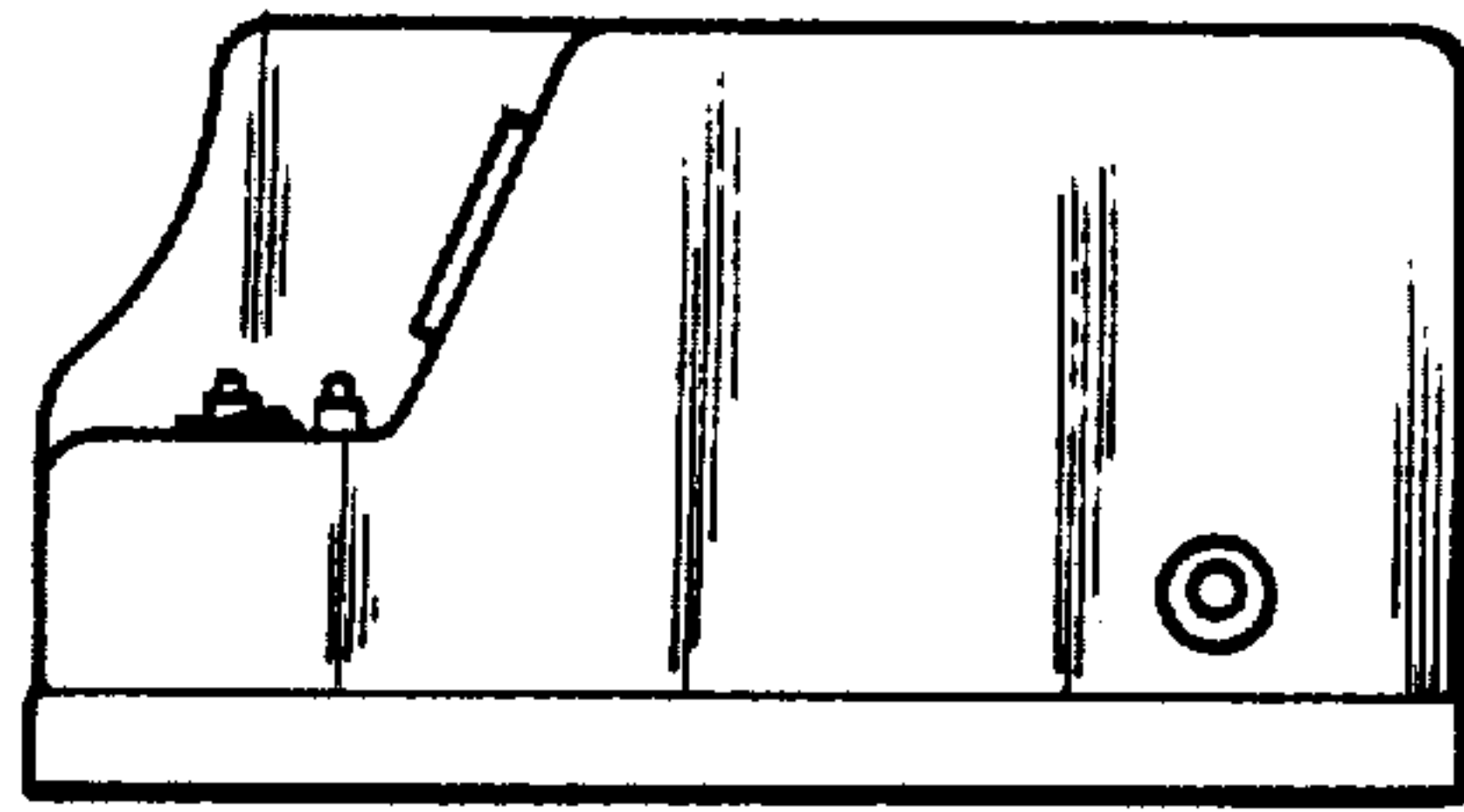

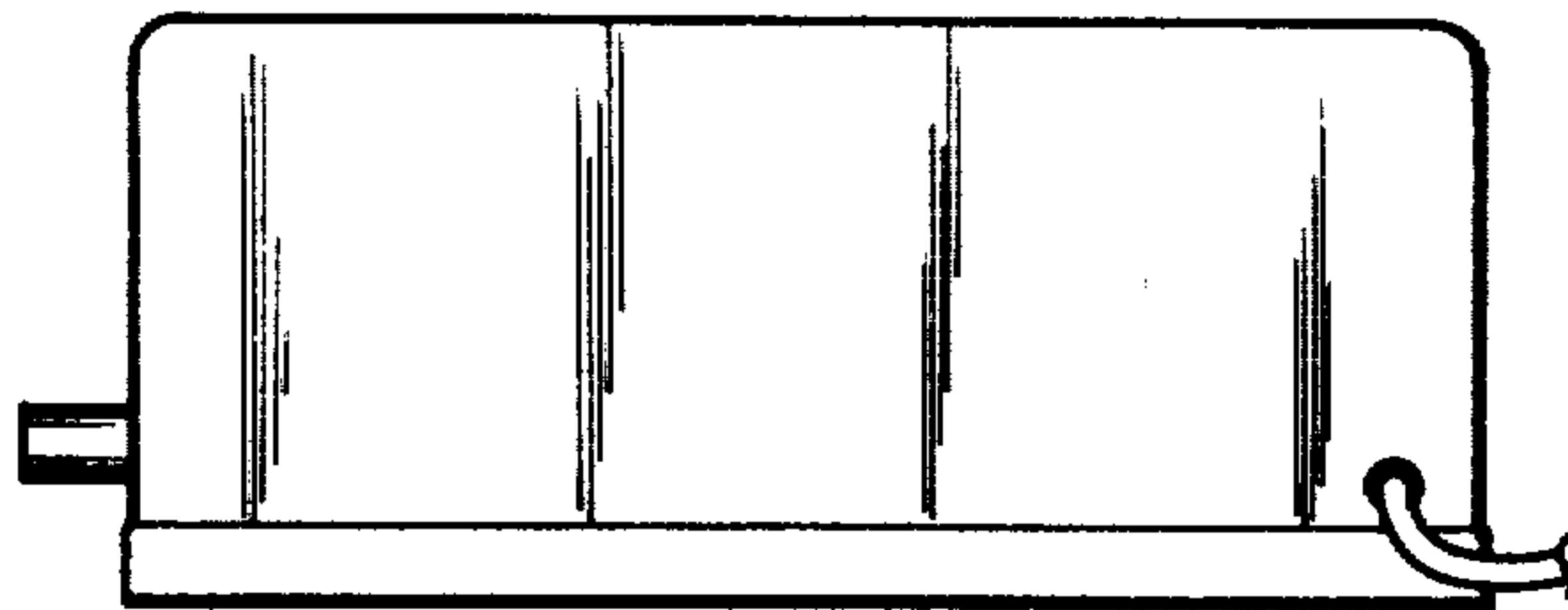

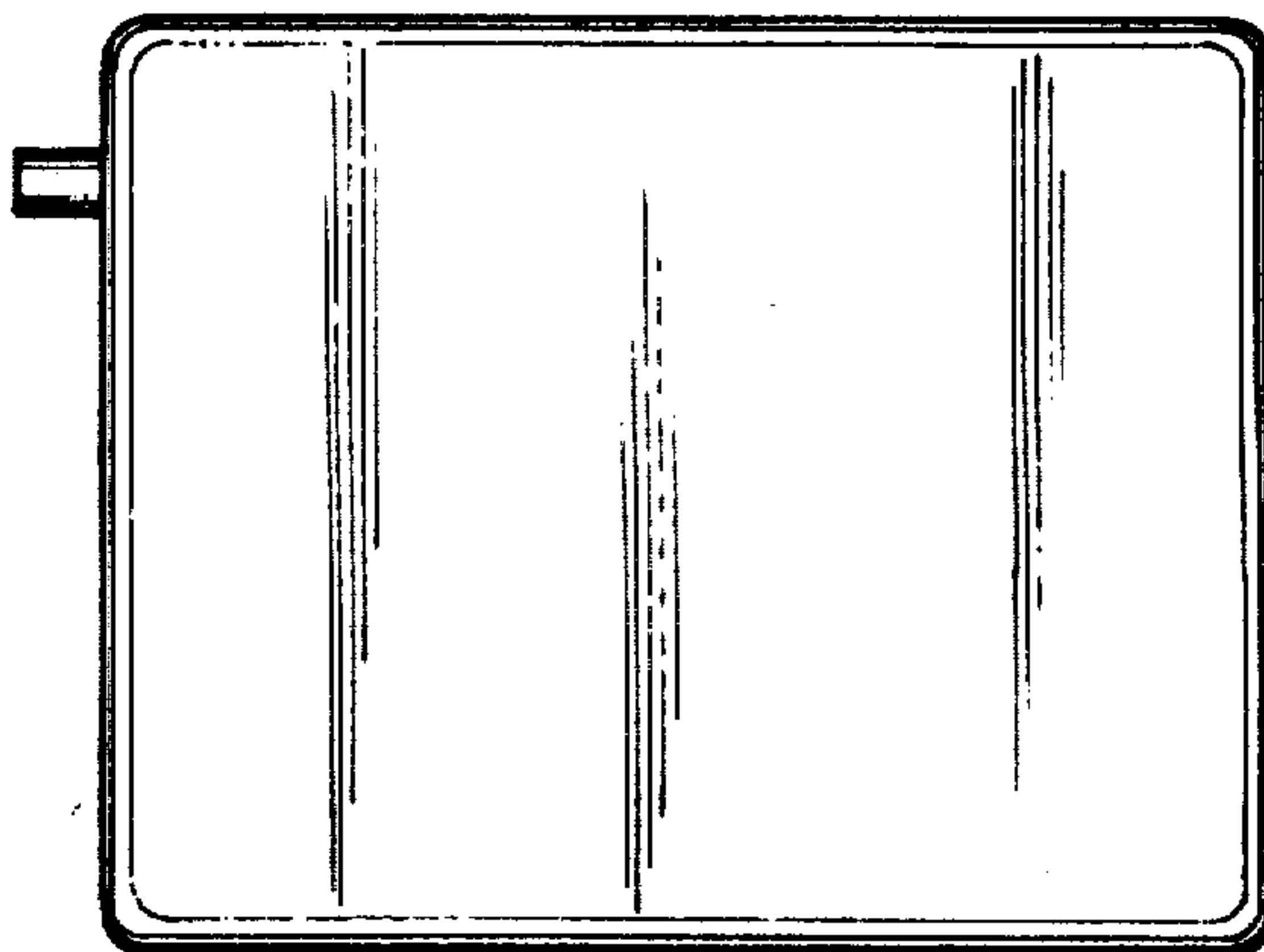
