[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a covered pedestal jar or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a covered pedestal jar or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top view thereof; FIG. 3 is an exploded partial elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5-5 of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6-6 of FIG. 1; and FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along line 7-7 of FIG. 1. The facets that would be visible through the transparent walls and bowl in FIGS. 4, 6, and 7 have been omitted for convenience of illustration.
