[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a condiment shaker or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a condiment shaker or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an exploded partial elevational view thereof with a cap shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5-5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6-6 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along line 7-7 of FIG. 1.

The facets that would be visible through the transparent walls in FIG. 5 have been omitted for convenience of illustration.
