The broken line disclosure on FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the design claimed.

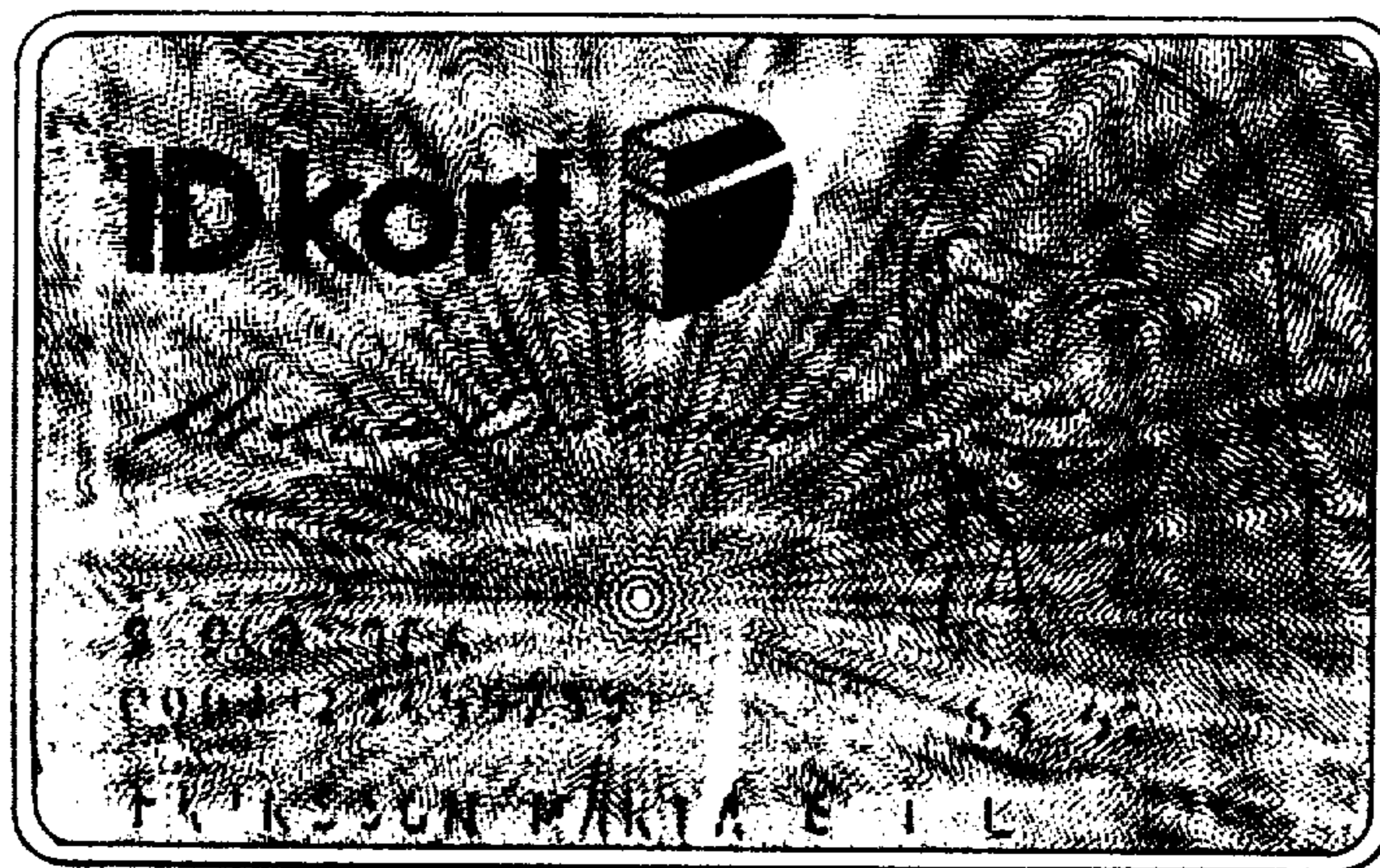

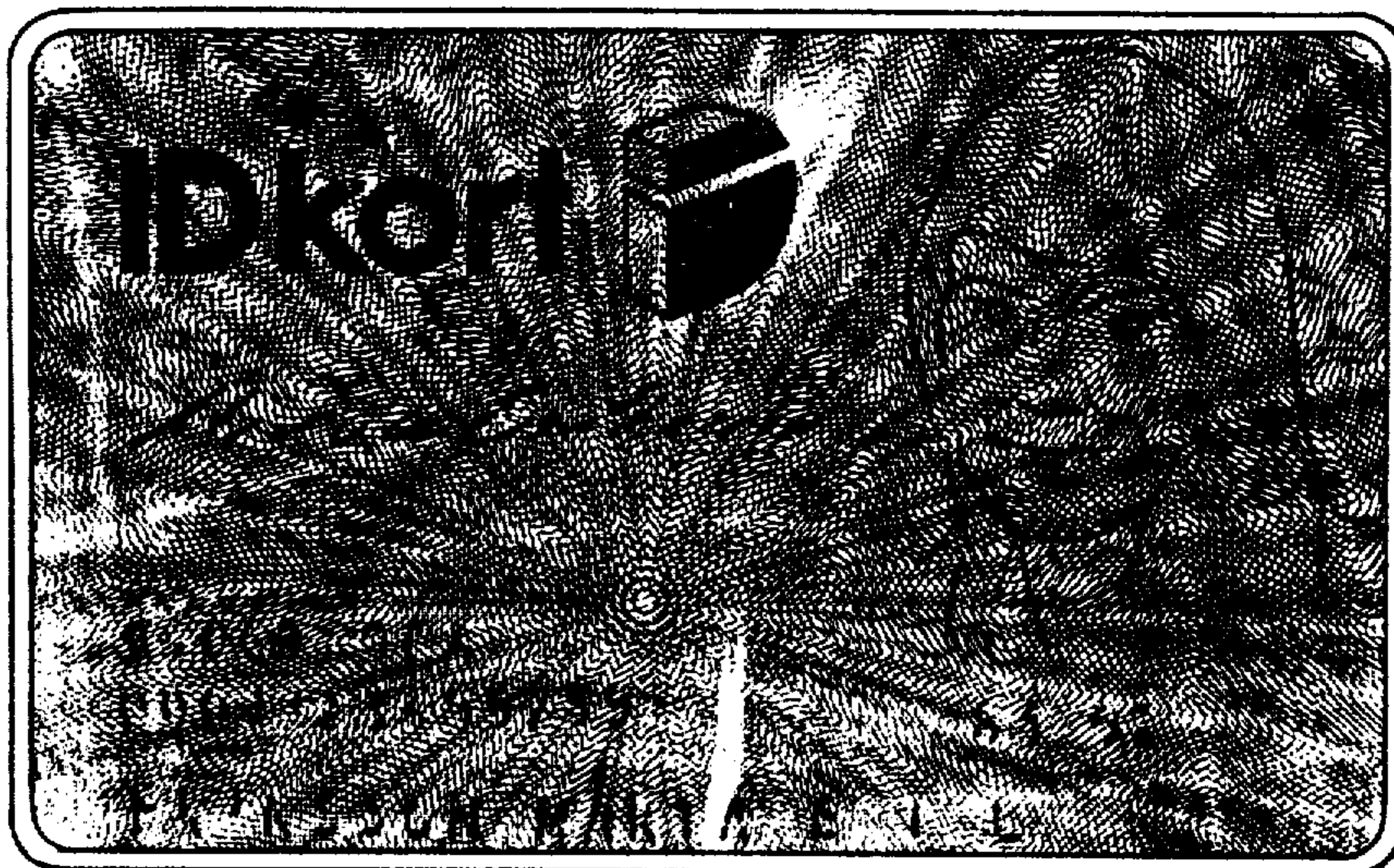
