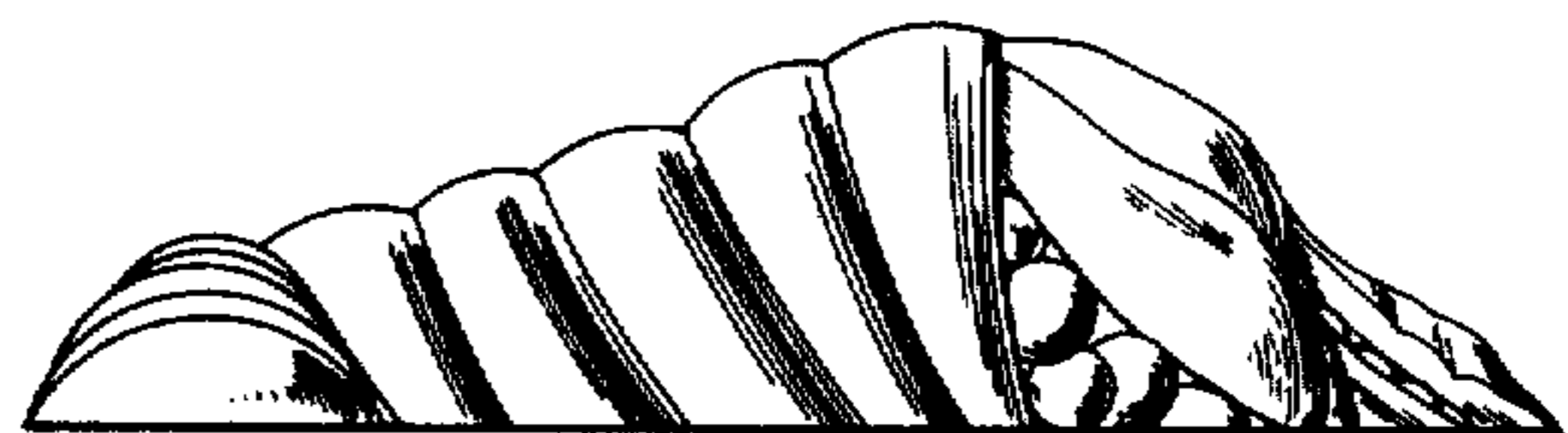

DESCRIPTION

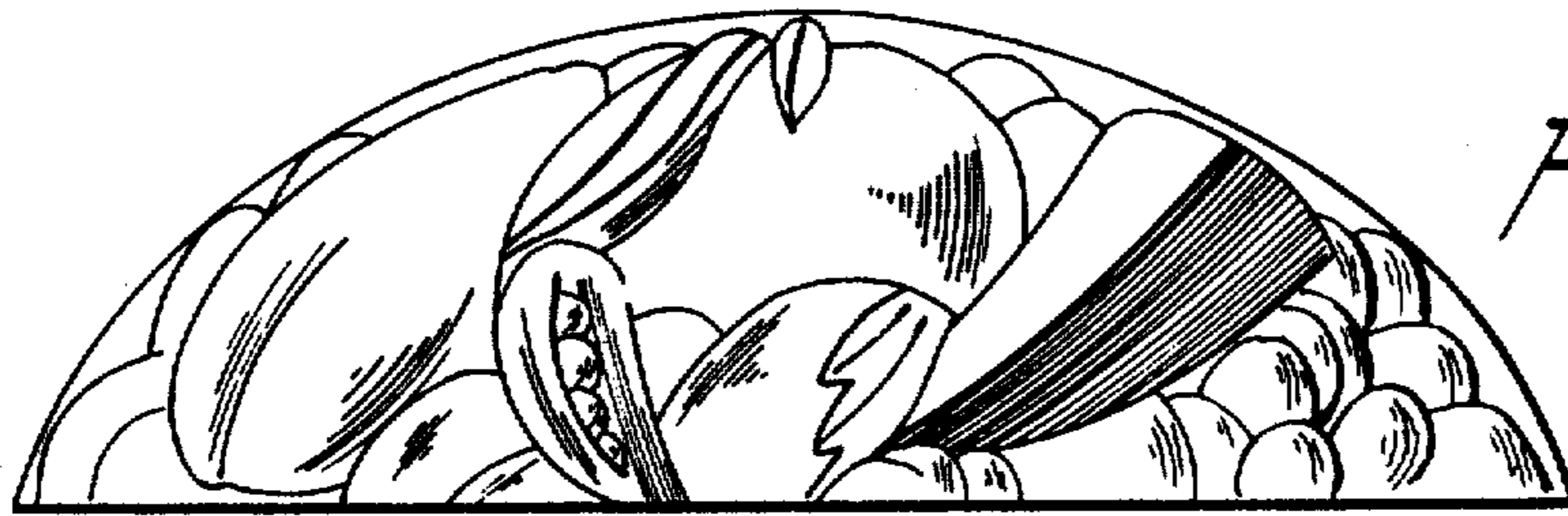
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a food mold showing my new design;

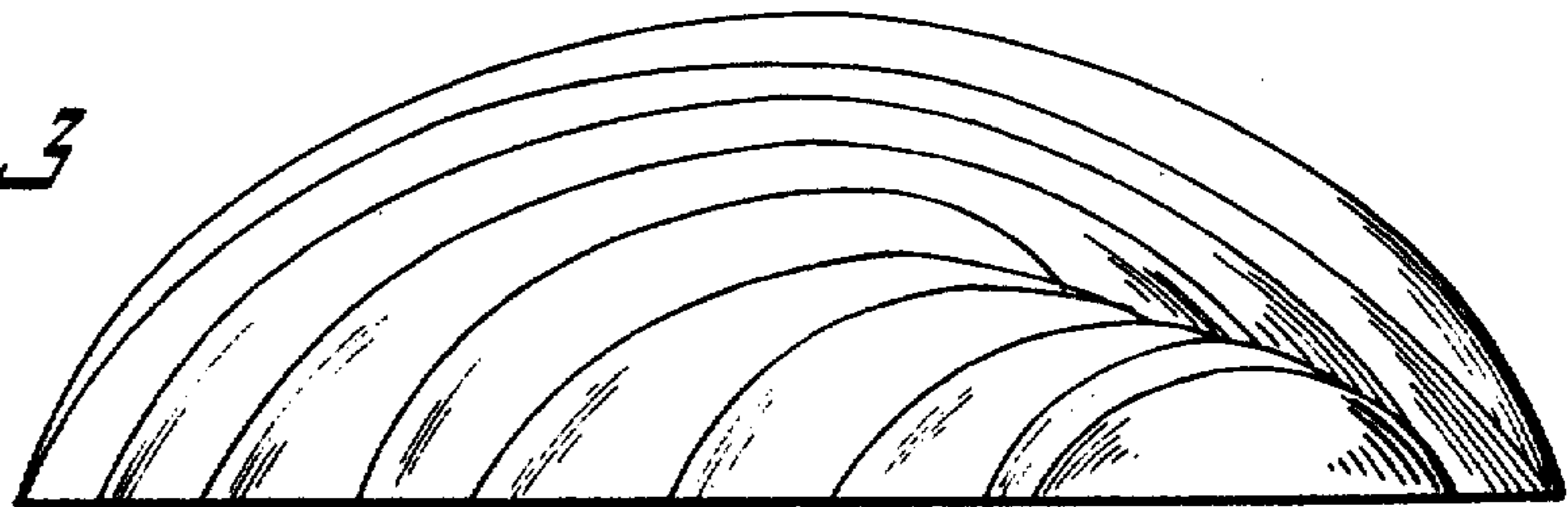

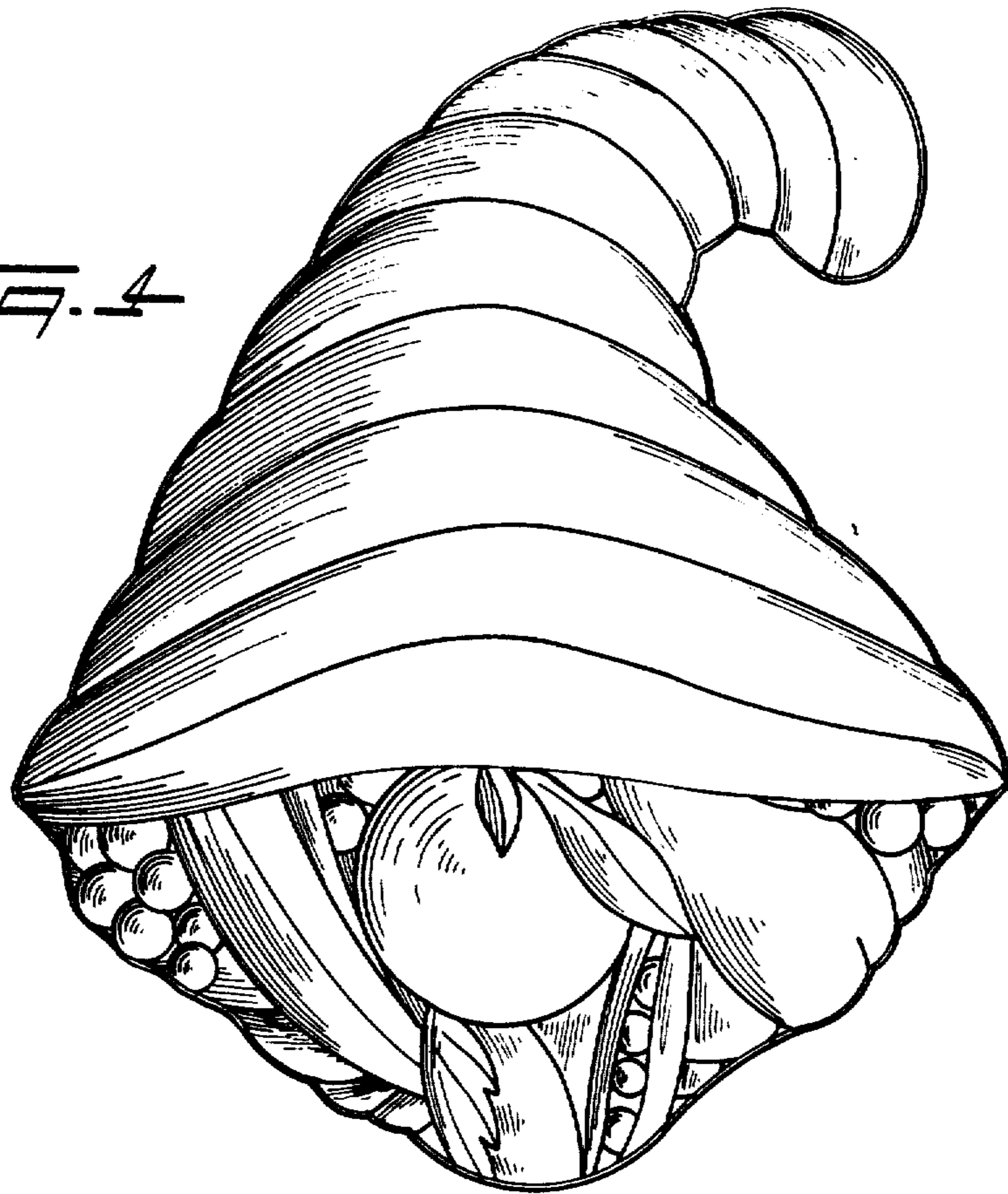

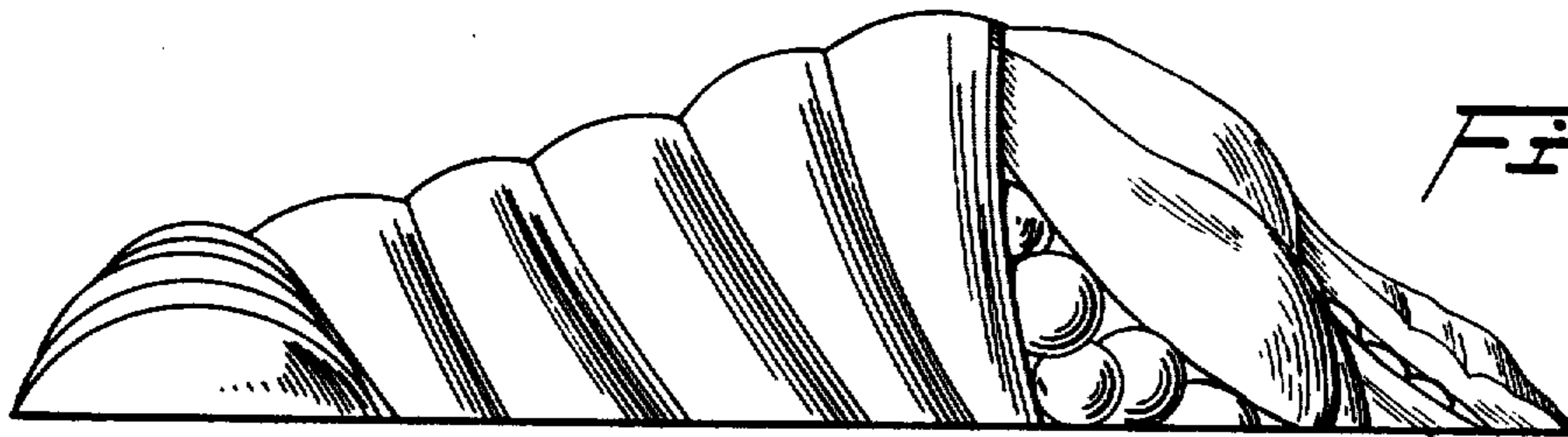
