[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a goblet or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a goblet or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

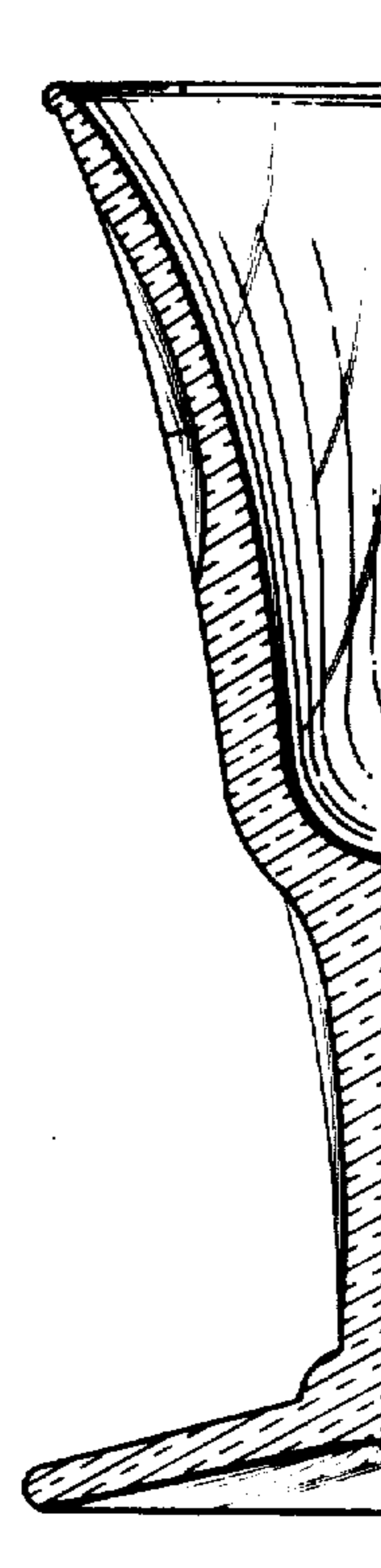
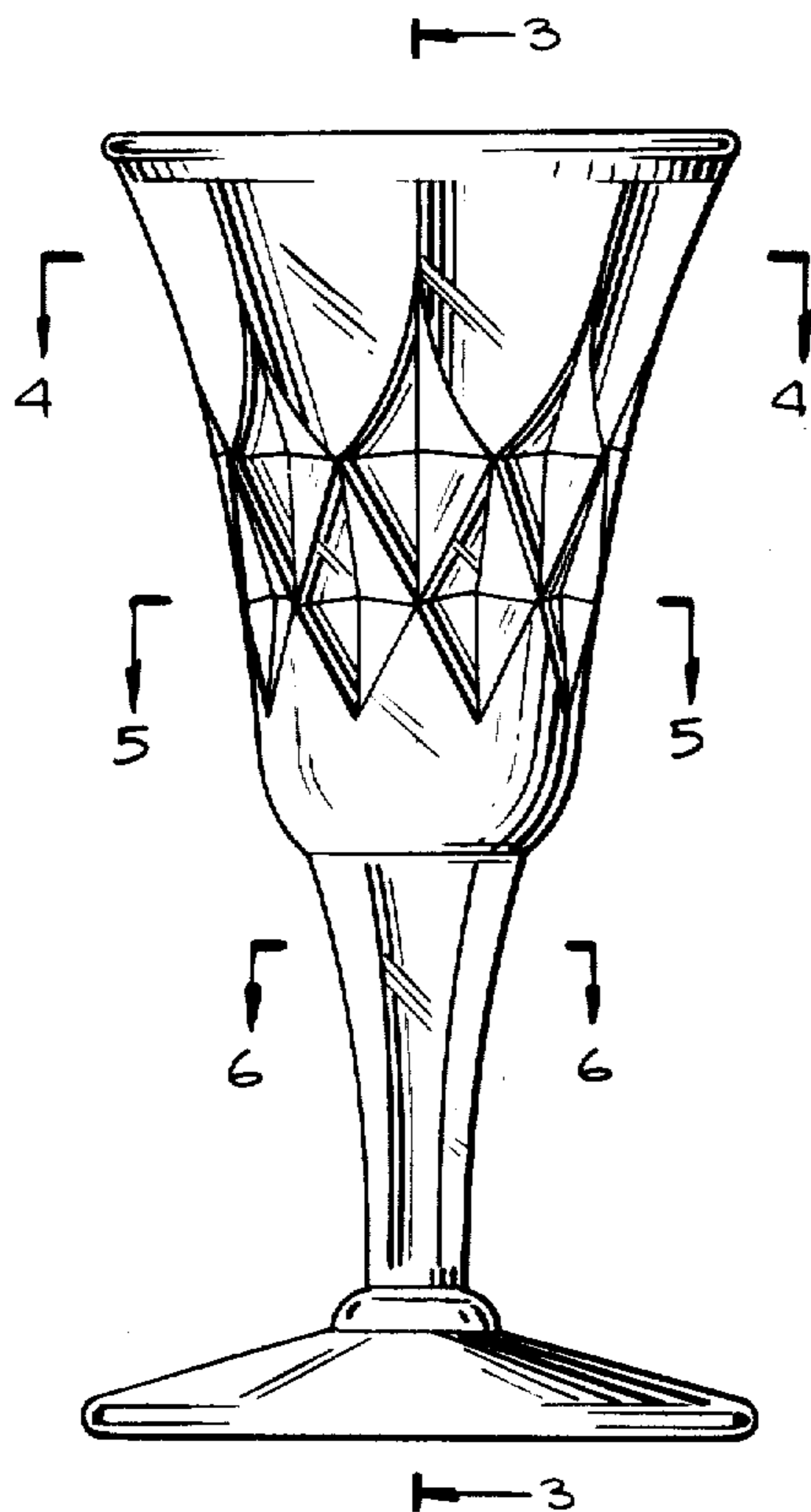
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1.

The base has been eliminated from FIGS. 4, 5, and 6 for convenience of illustration.

The facets that would be visible through the transparent walls in FIGS. 3, 4, and 5 have been omitted for convenience of illustration.



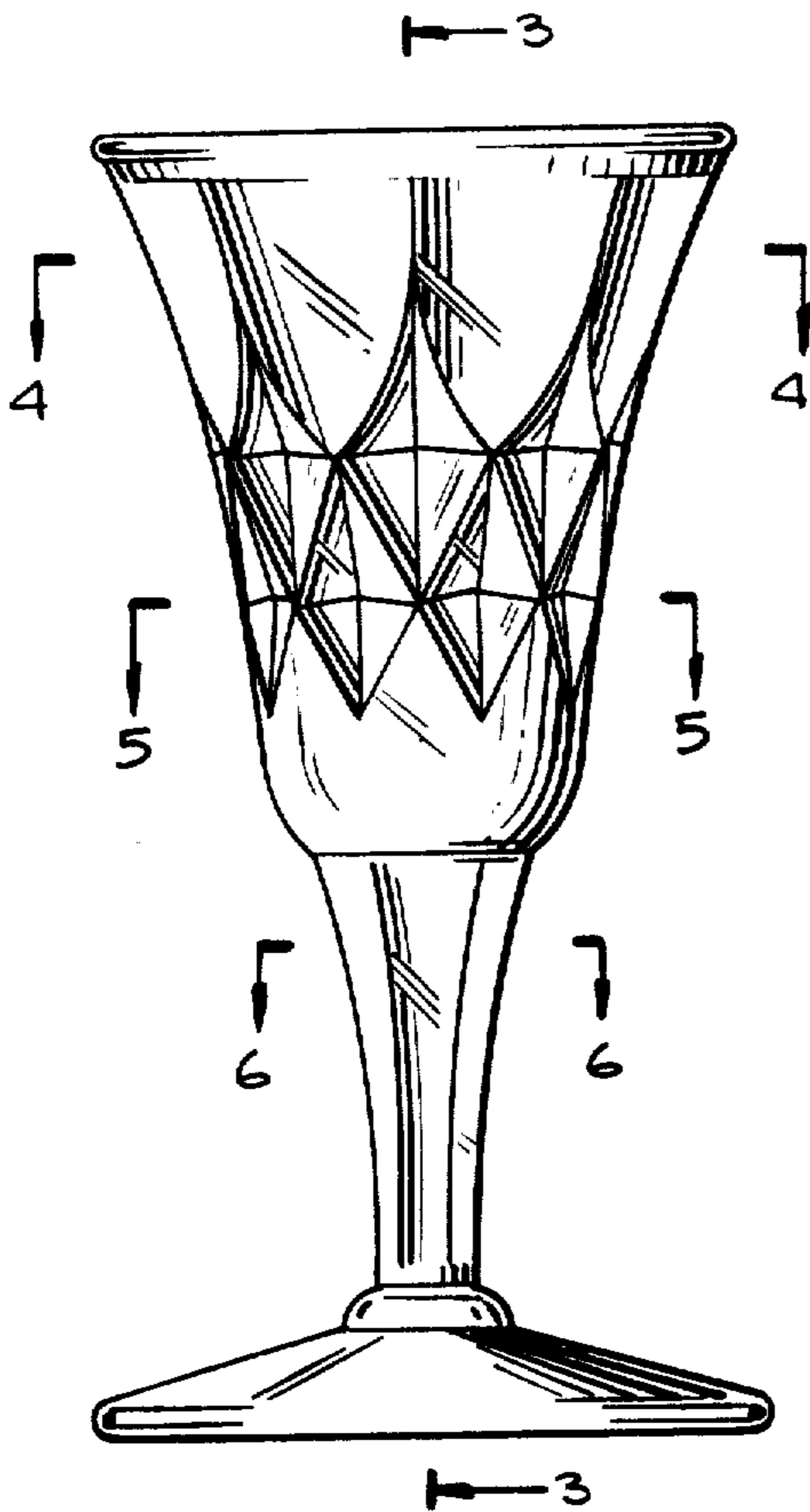

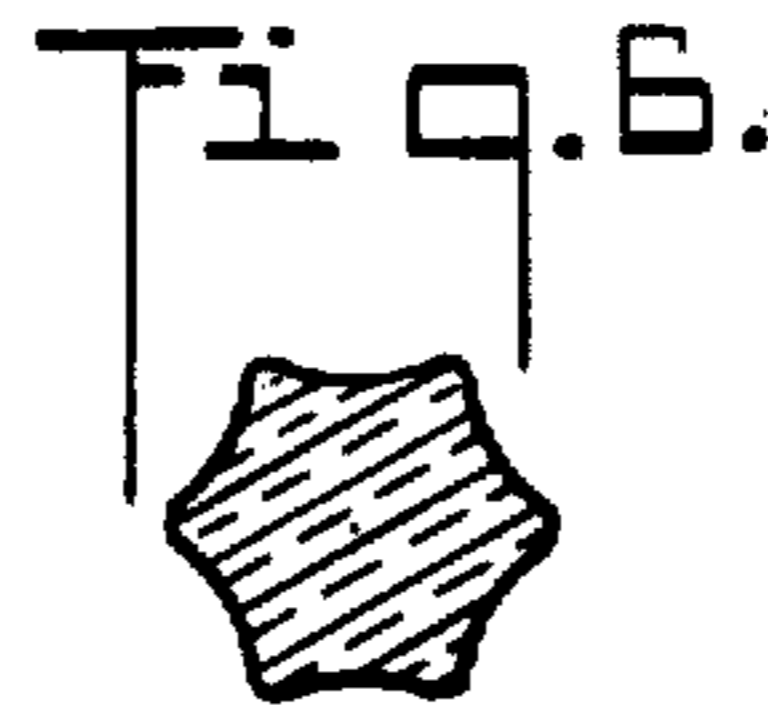

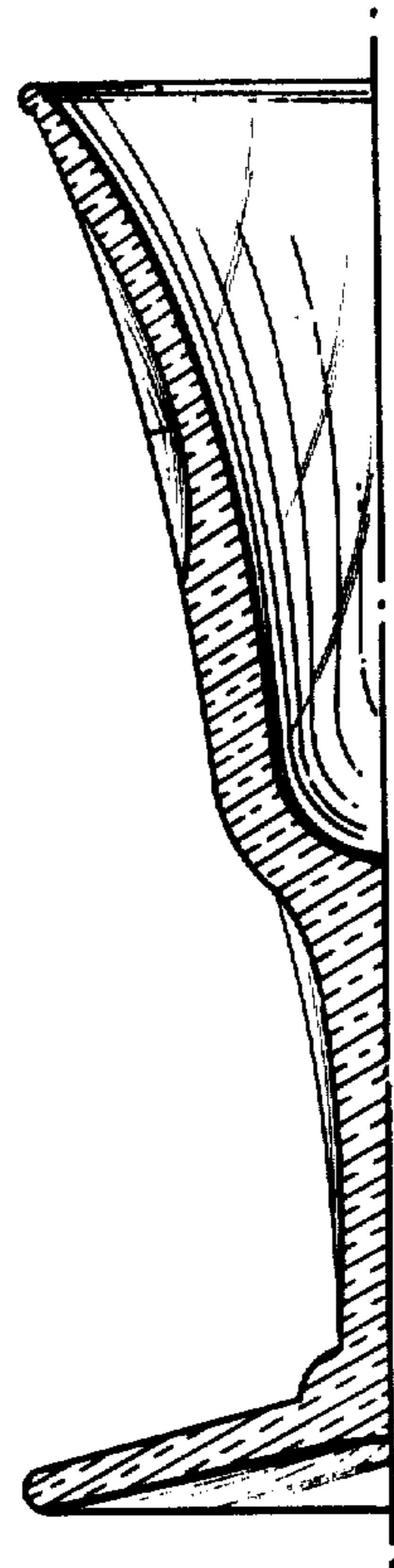

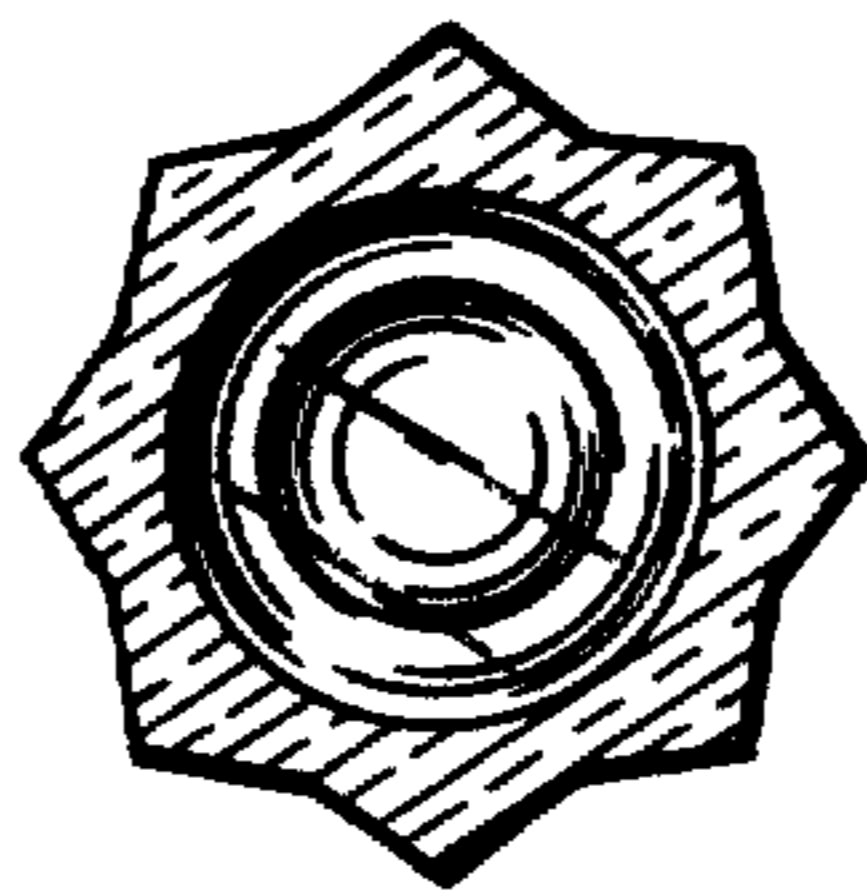

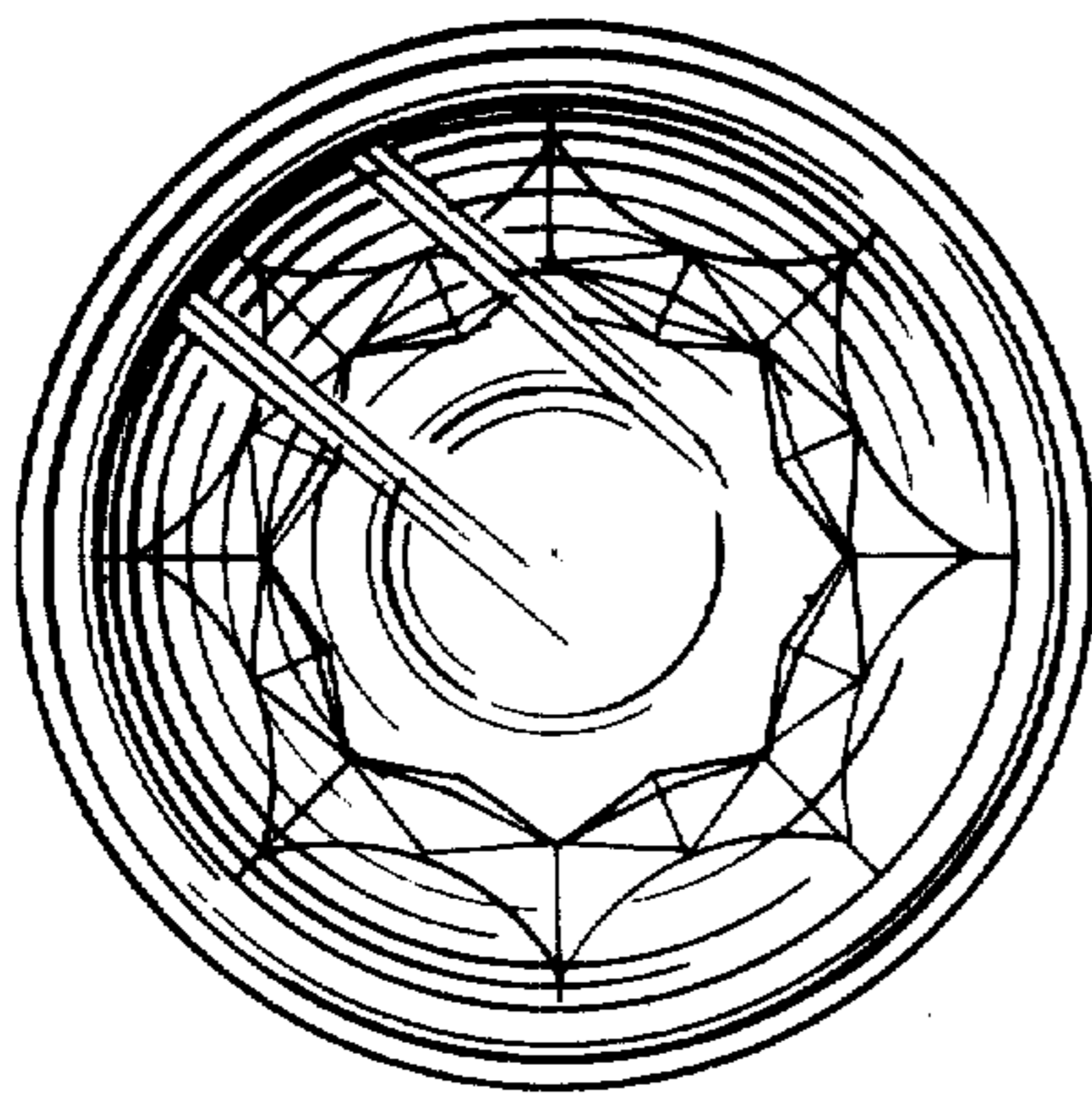

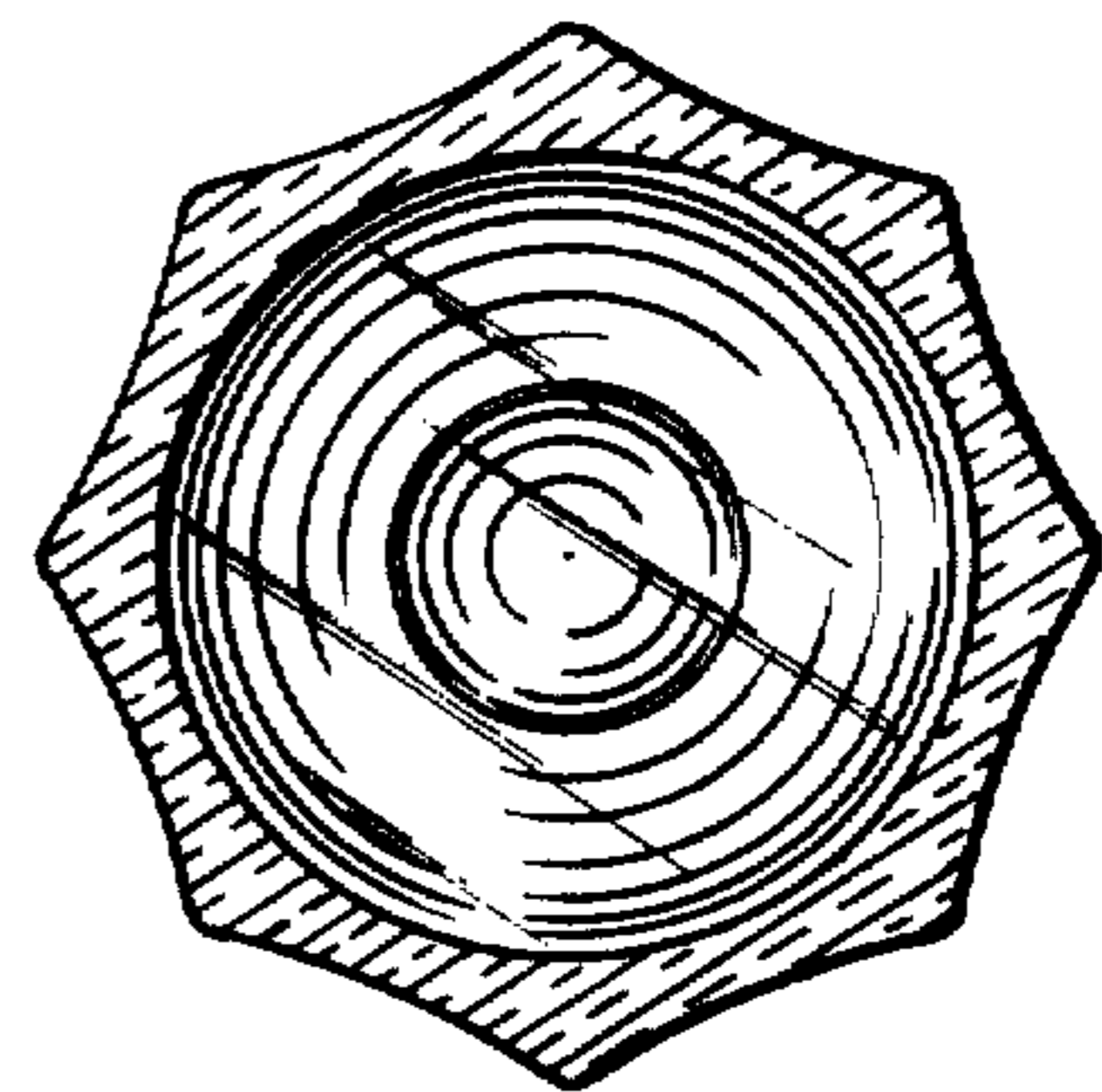
