DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left, and front perspective view of a coffee maker showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a view, partially in section, taken in the direction of line 7-7 of FIG. 2.

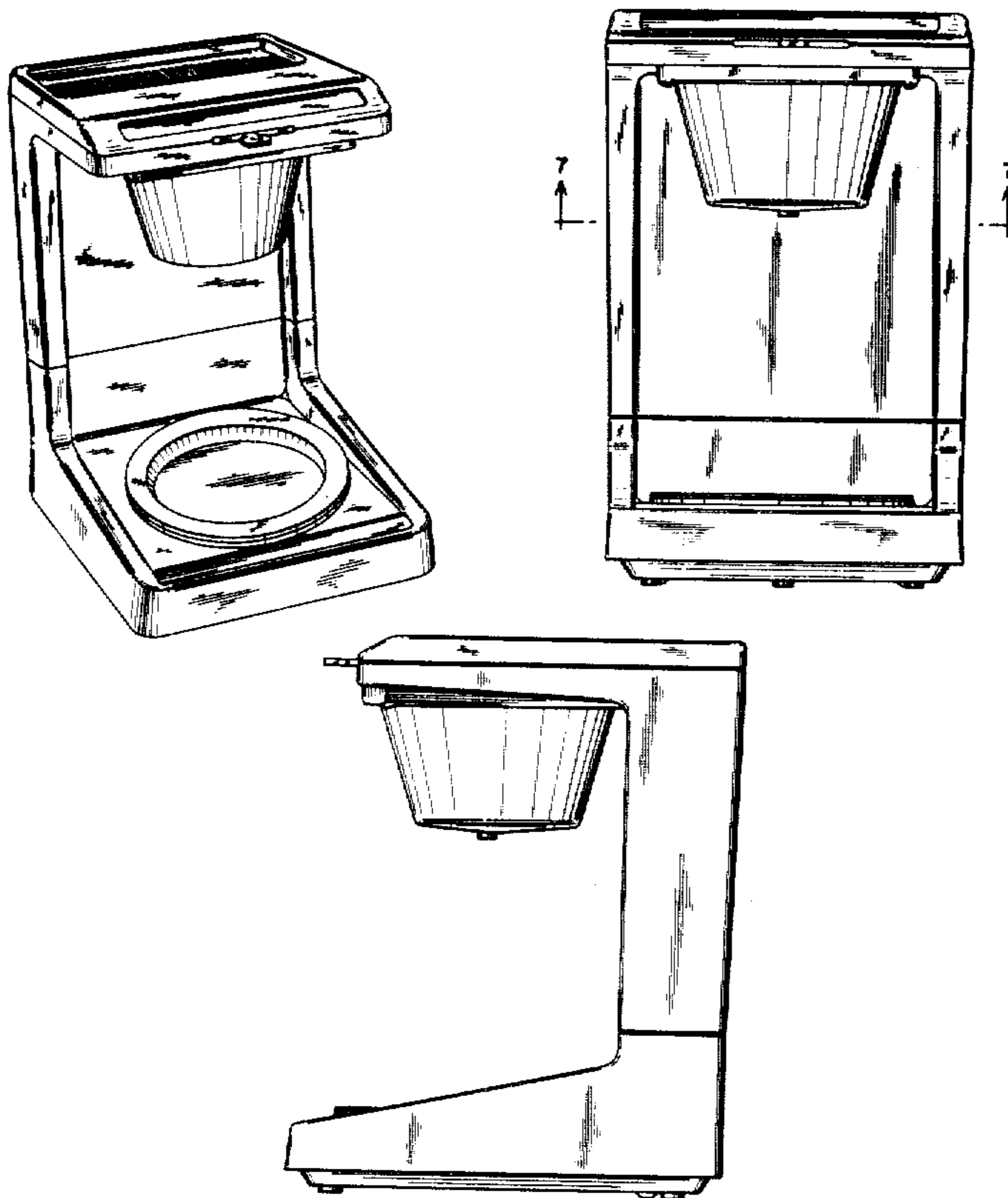
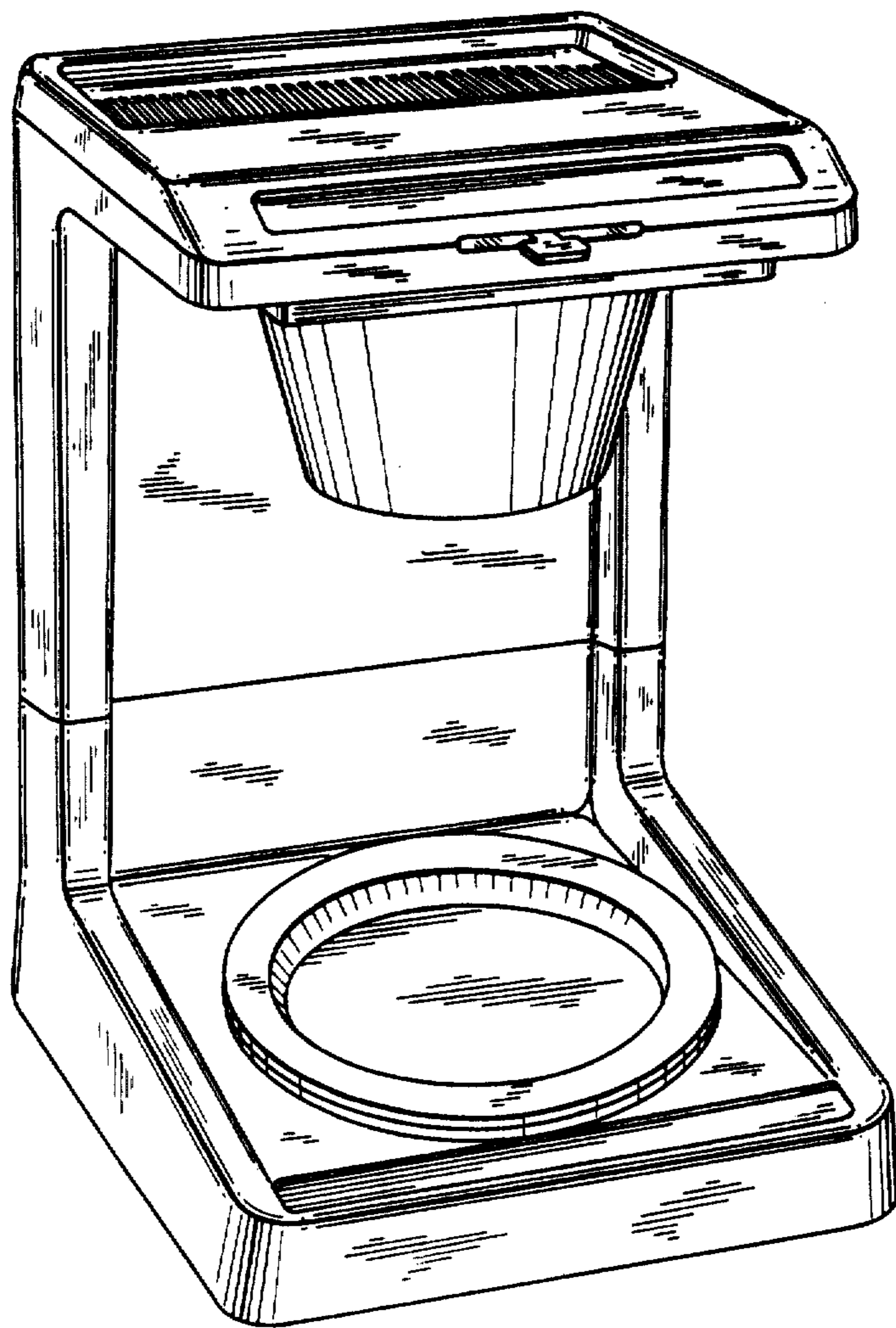

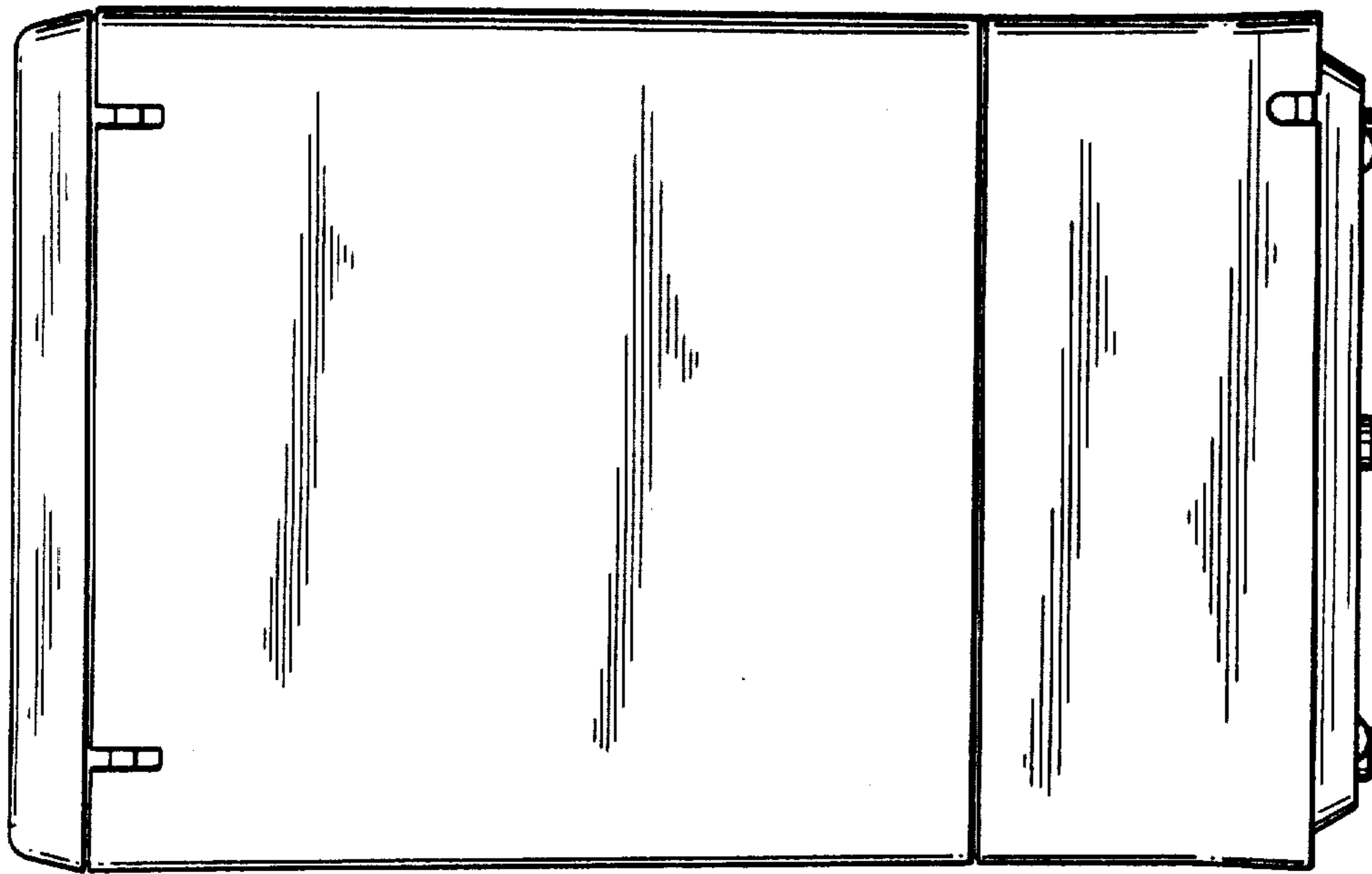

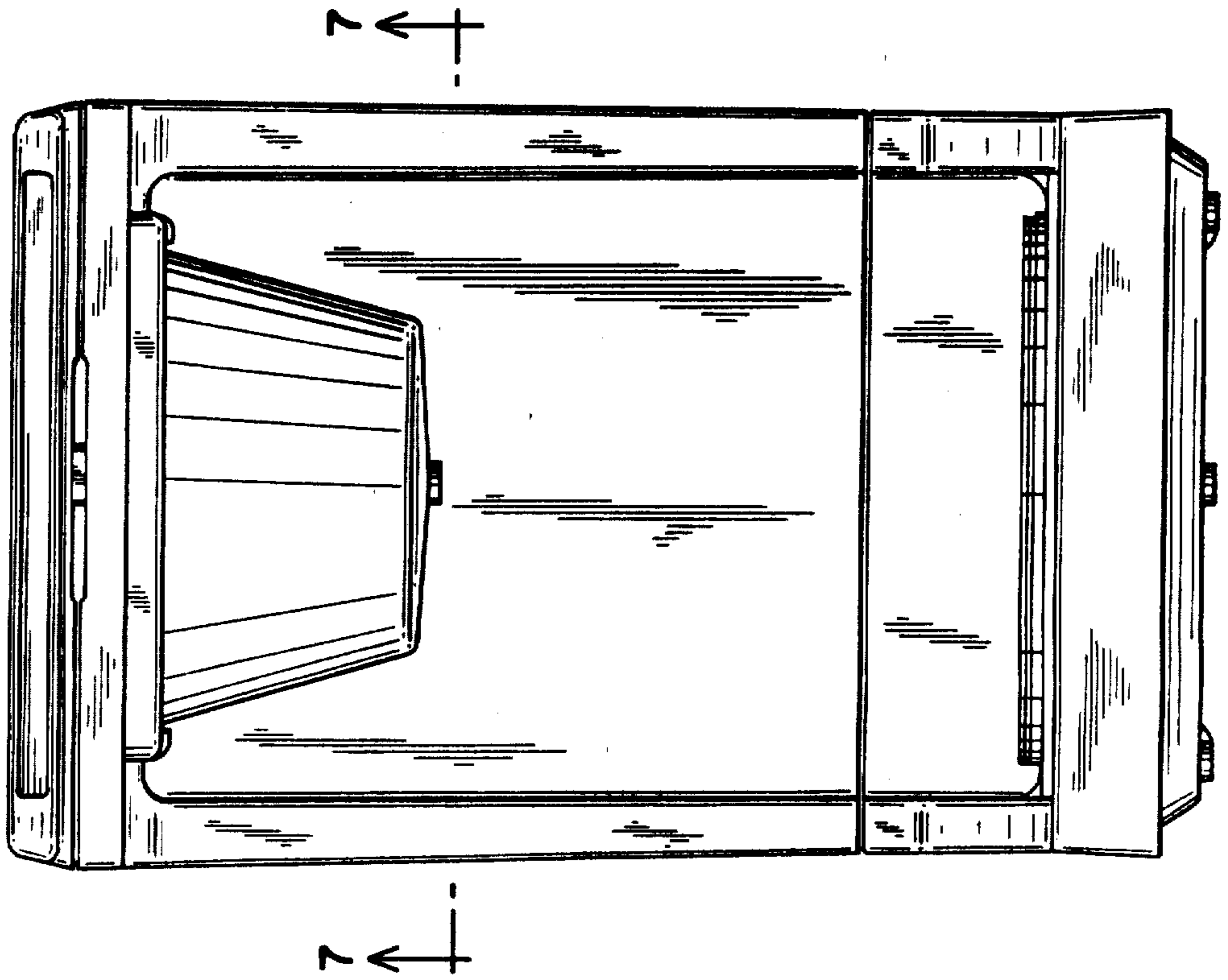

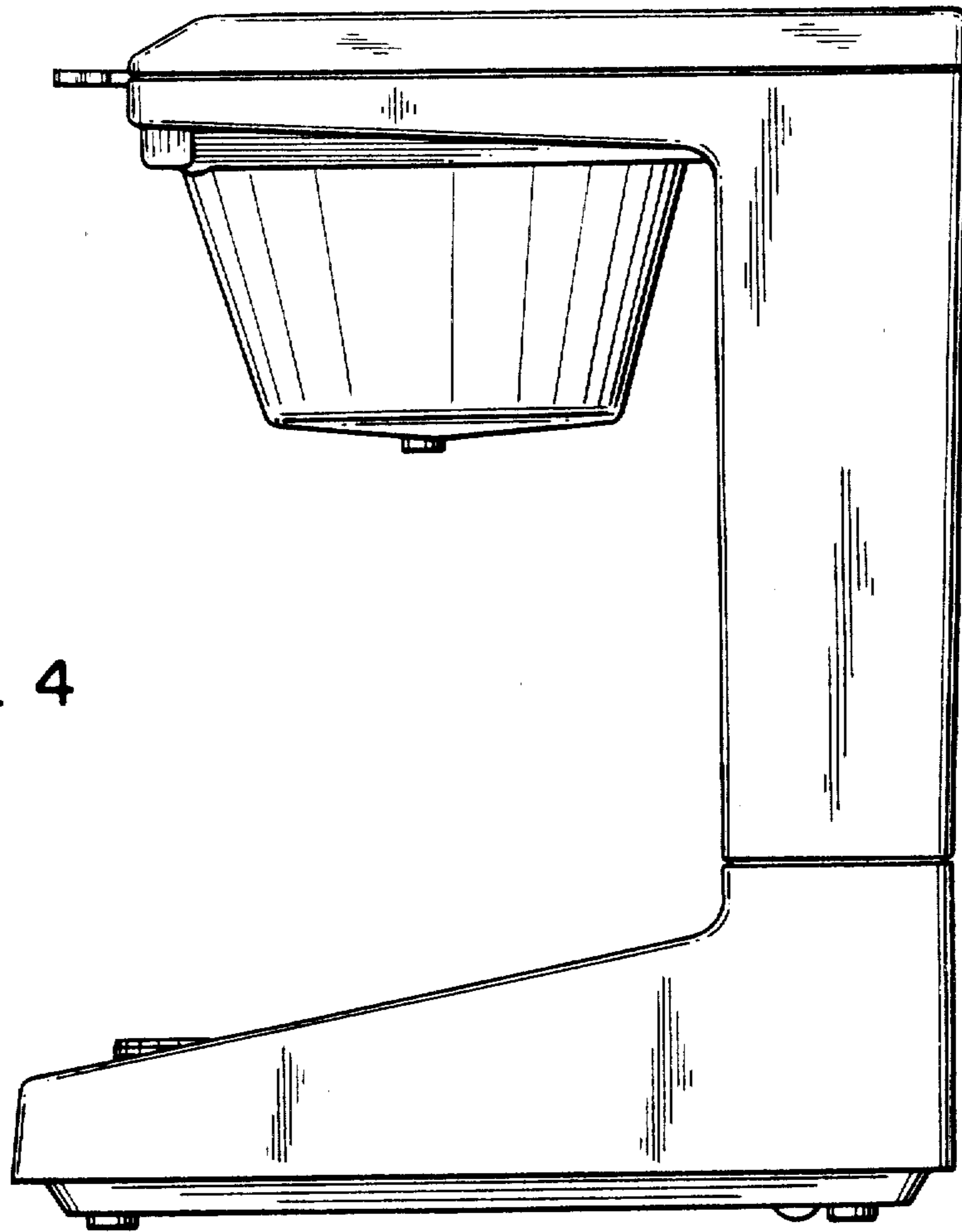

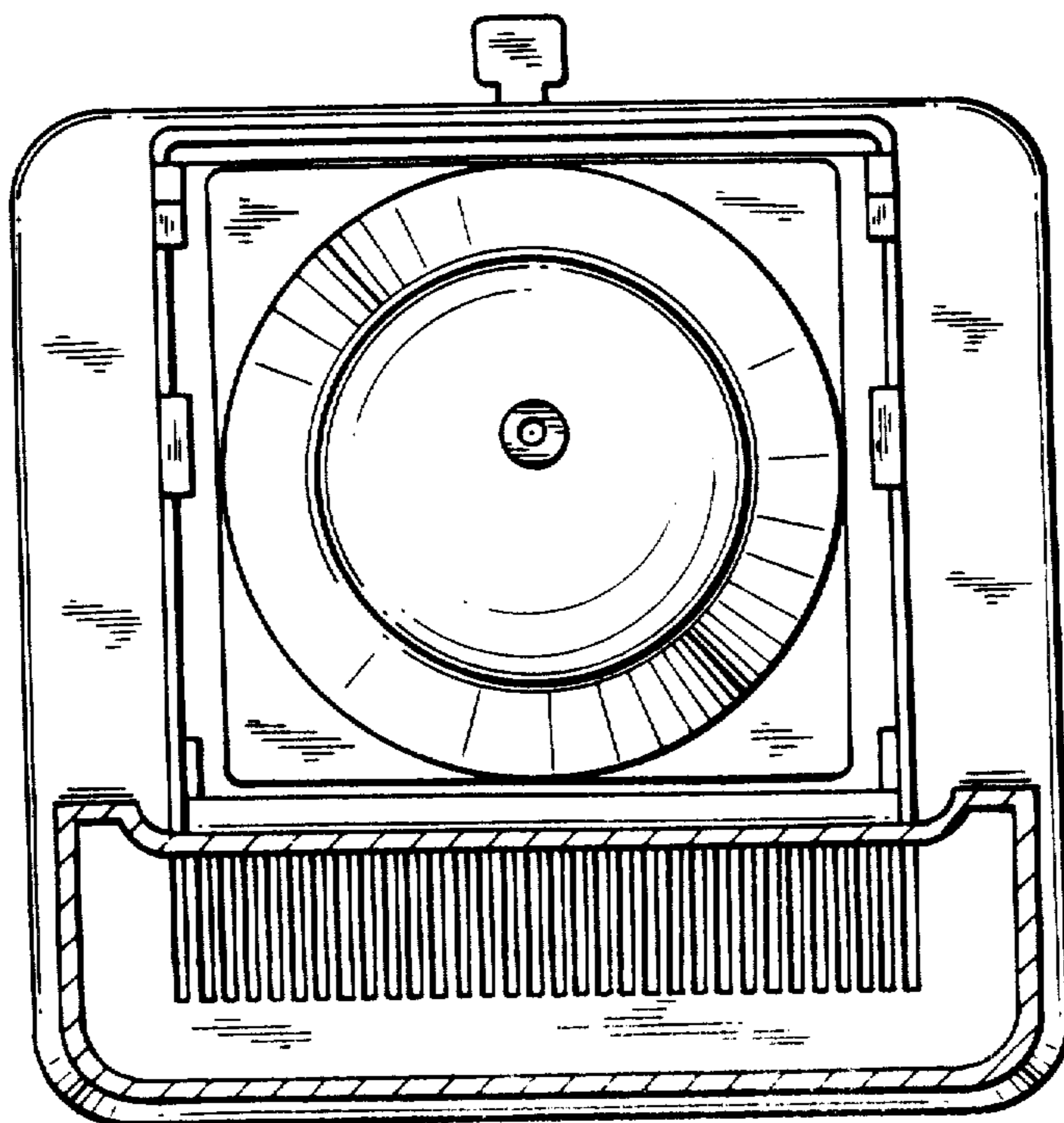

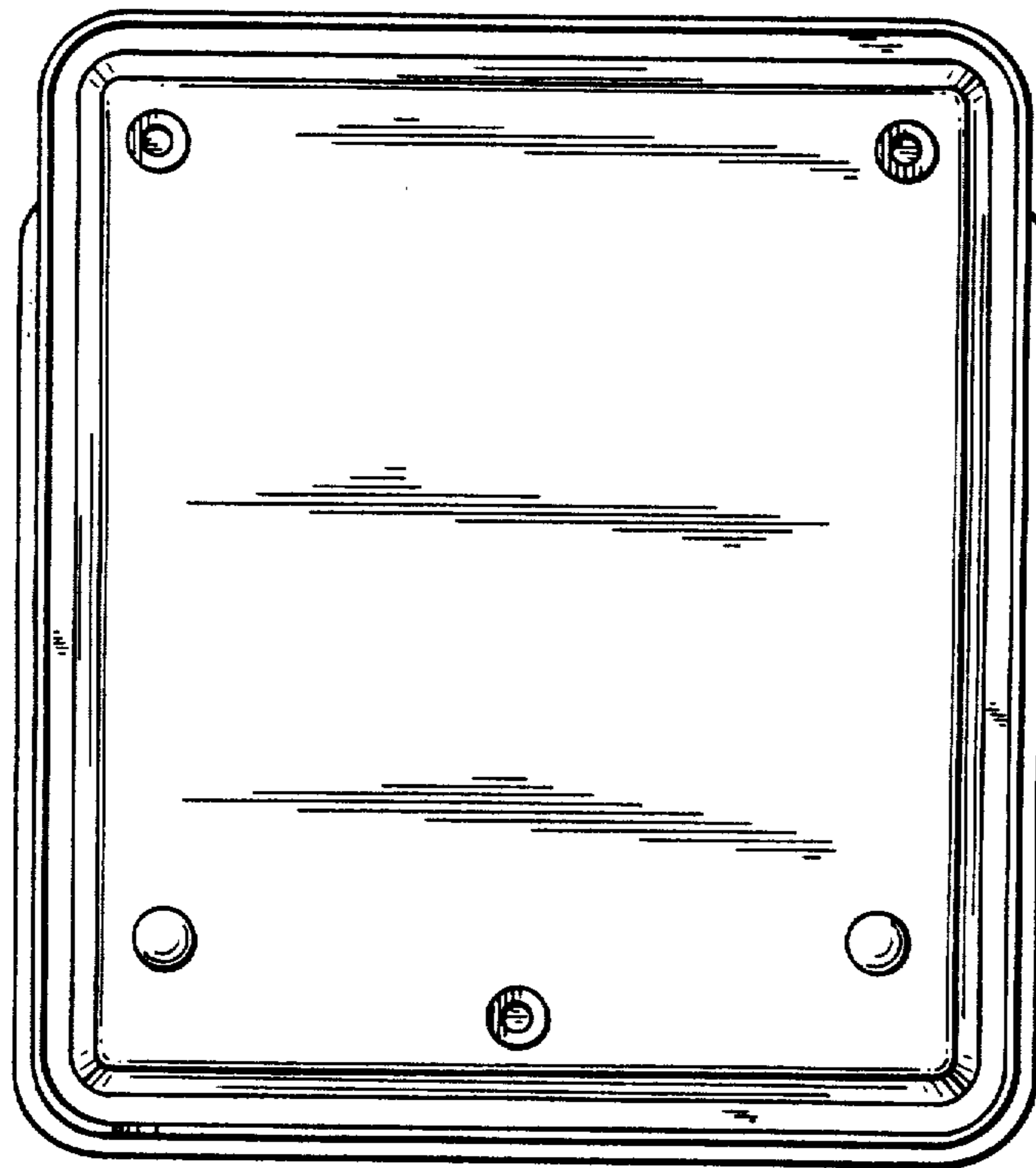
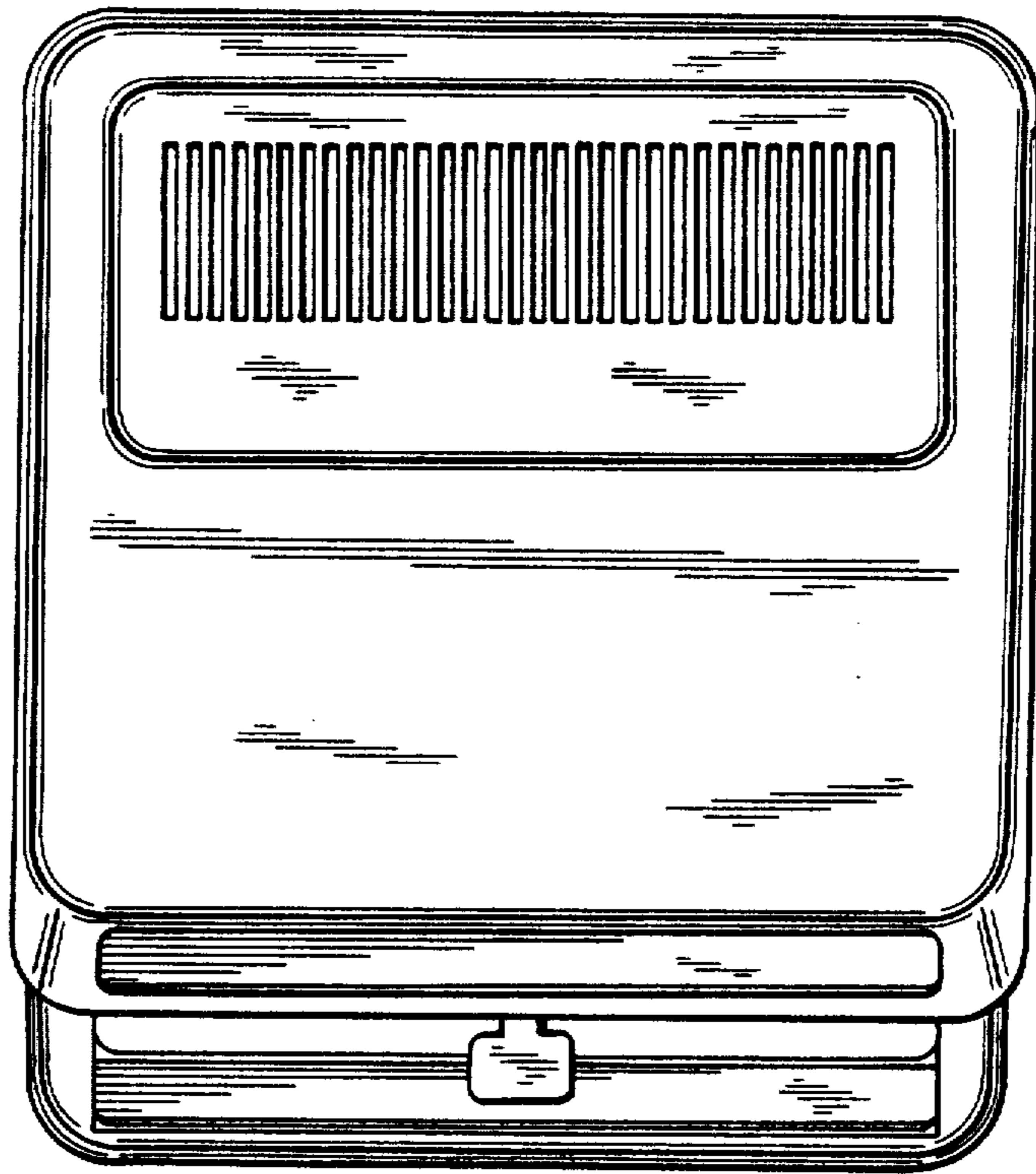
