The ornamental design for a belt buckle, substantially as shown.

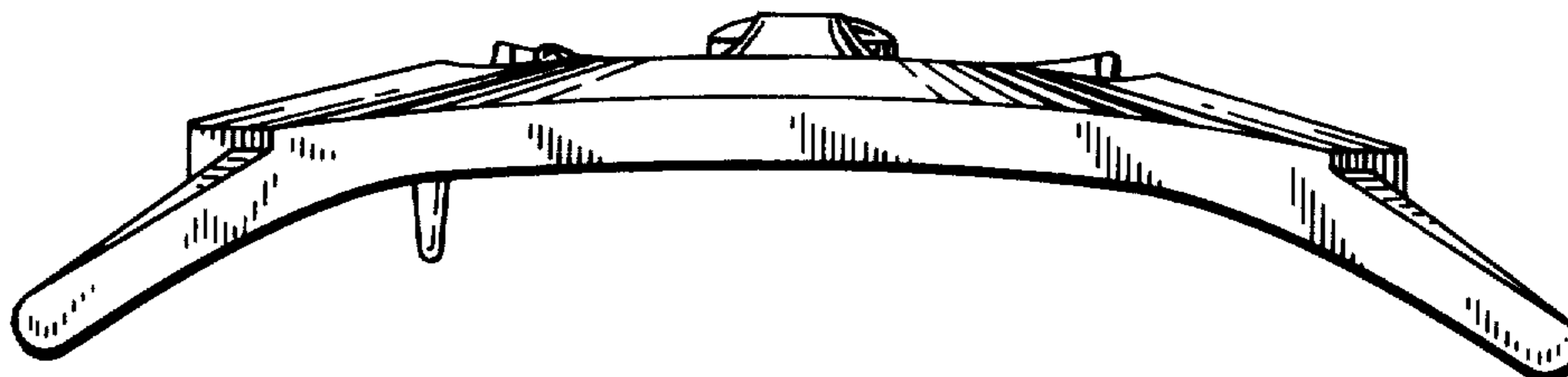
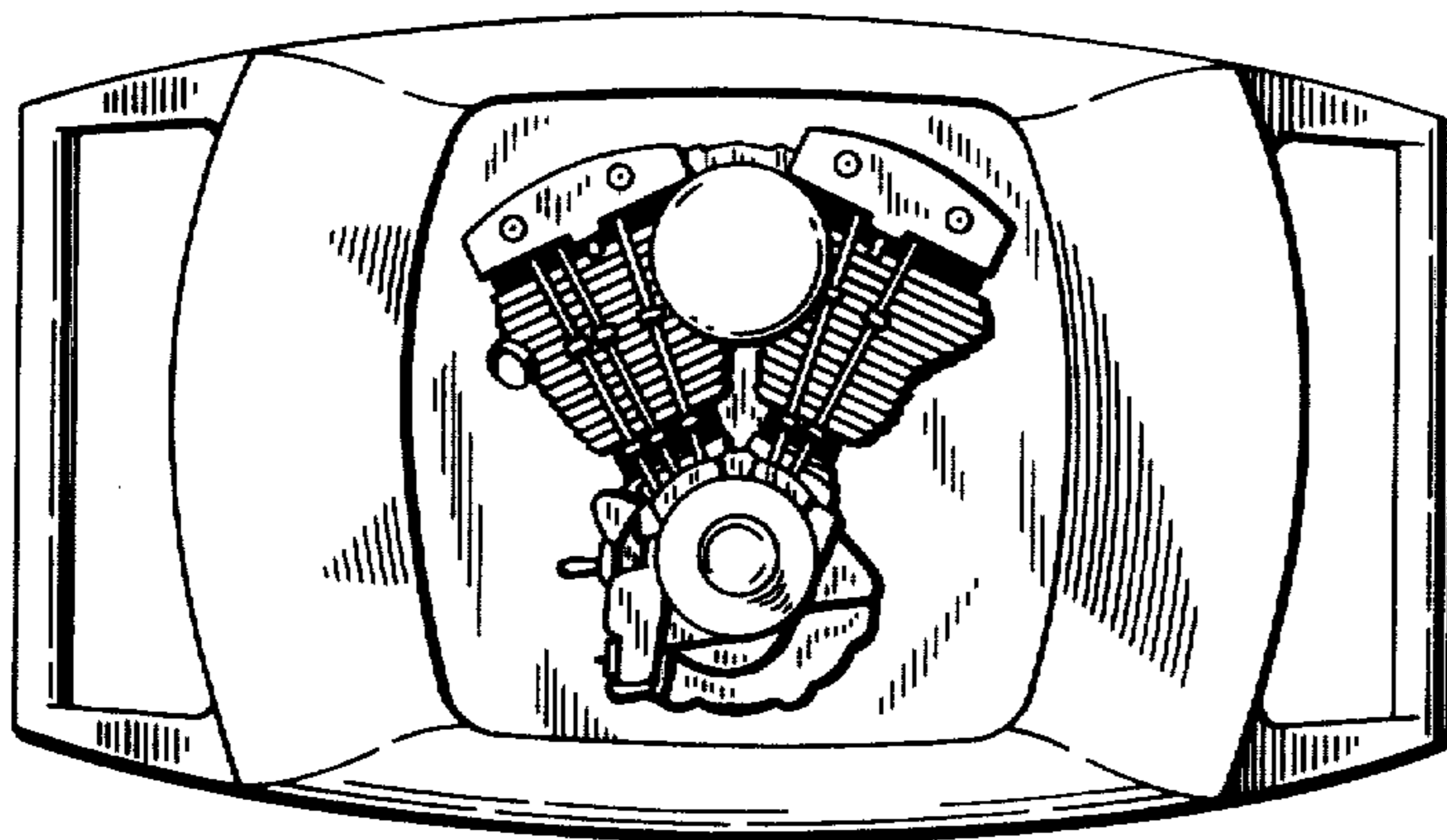
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof.



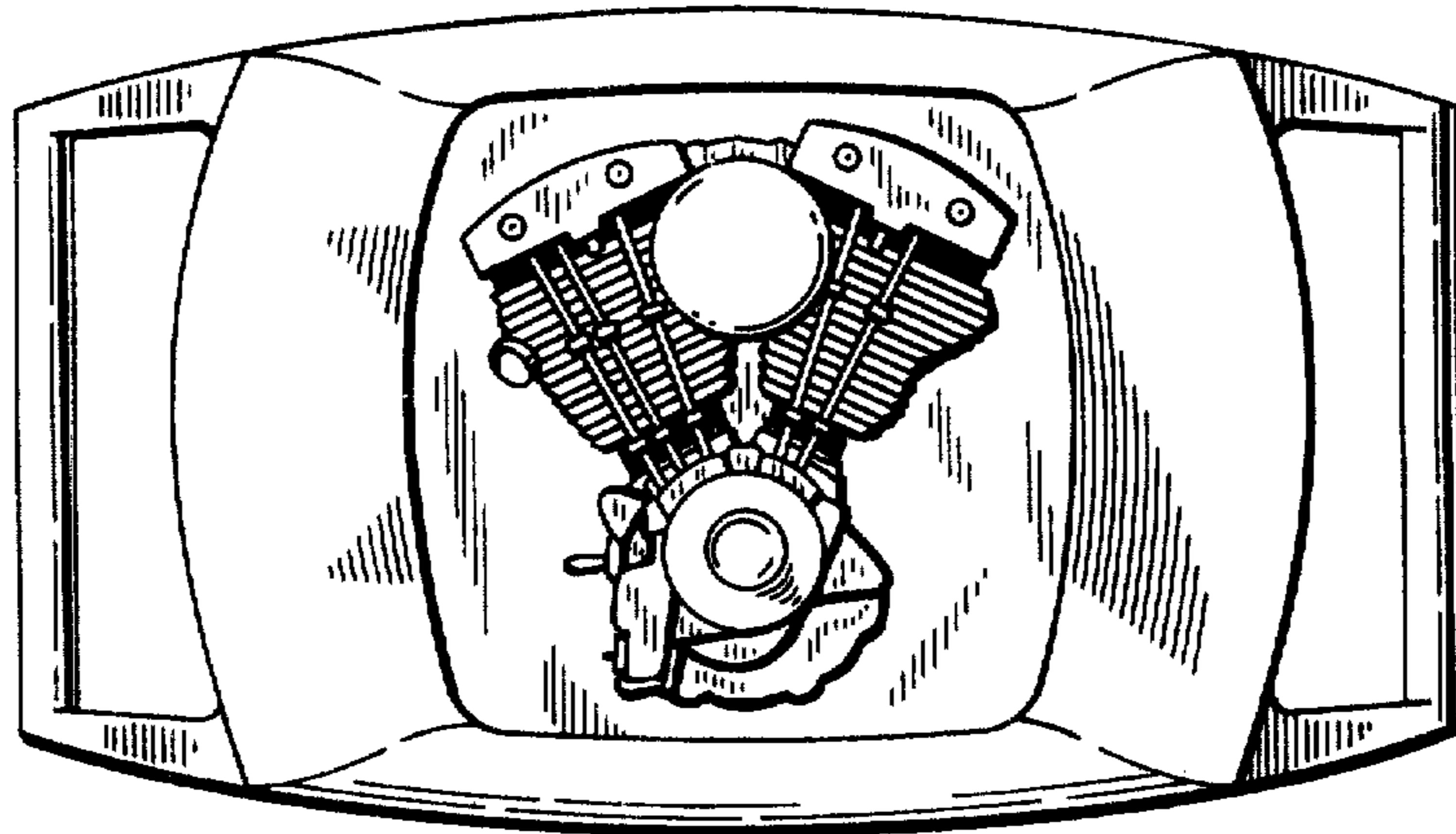

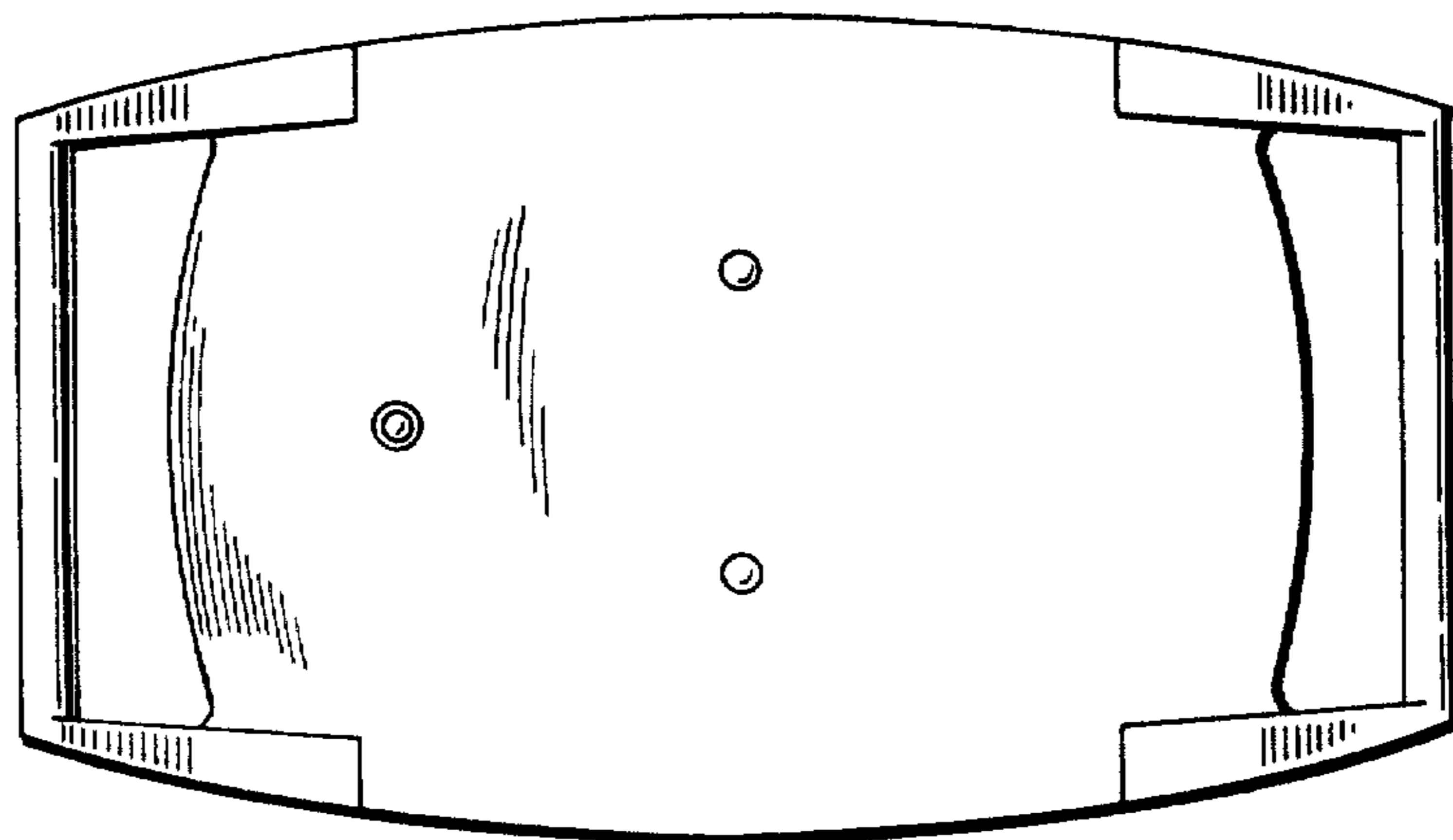

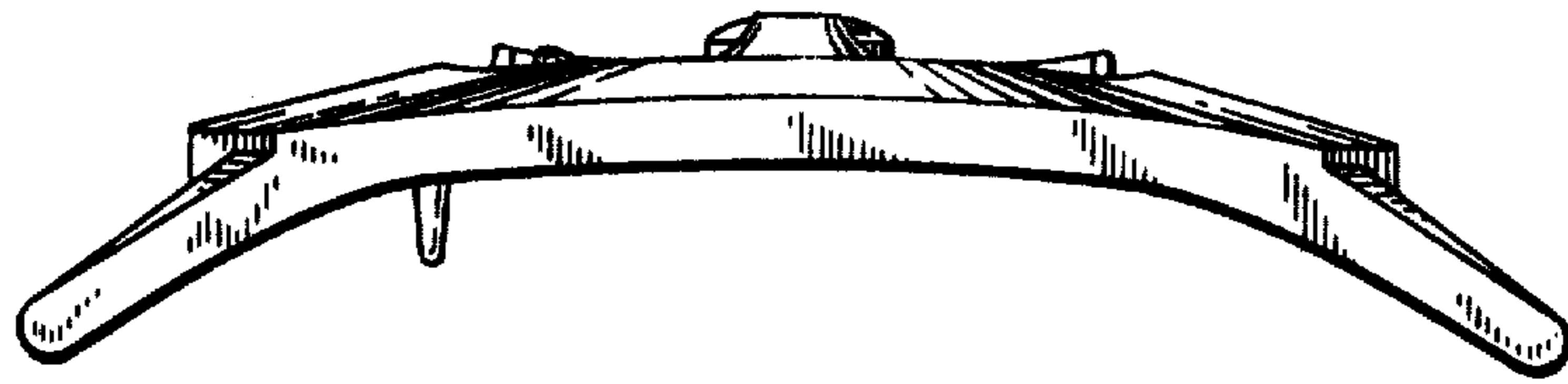

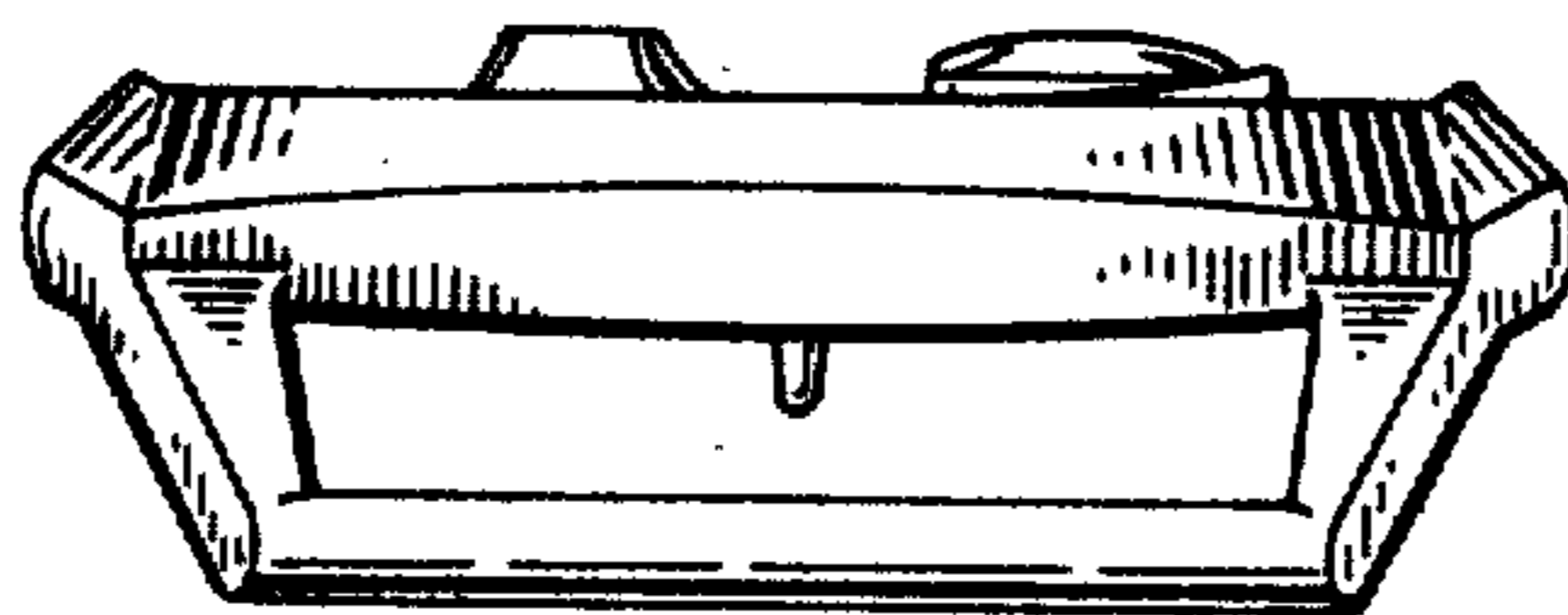
