## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a covered jar or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a covered jar or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an exploded partial elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG.

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG.

FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 10 is a sectional view taken along line 10—10 of a FIG. 2.

The facets that would be visible through the transparent walls and base in FIGS. 5, 6, and 7 have been omitted for convenience of illustration.
