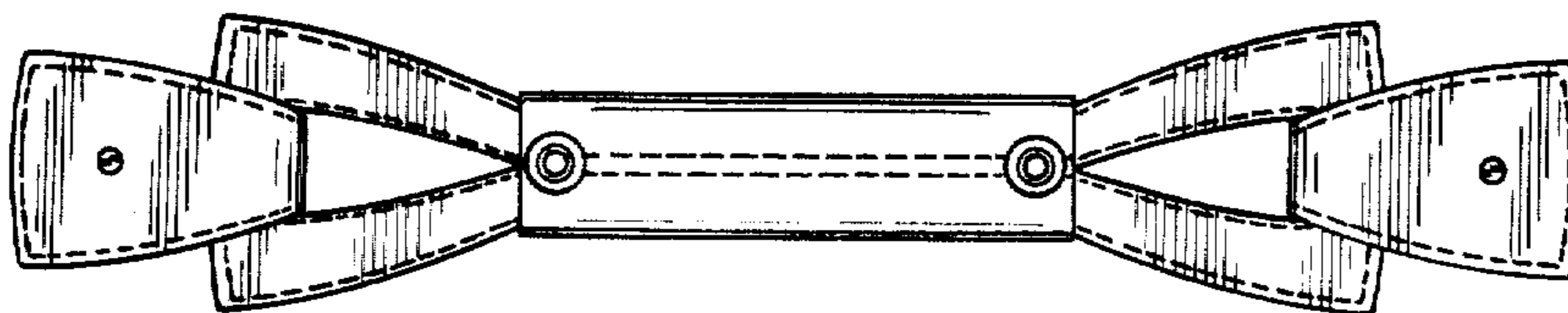
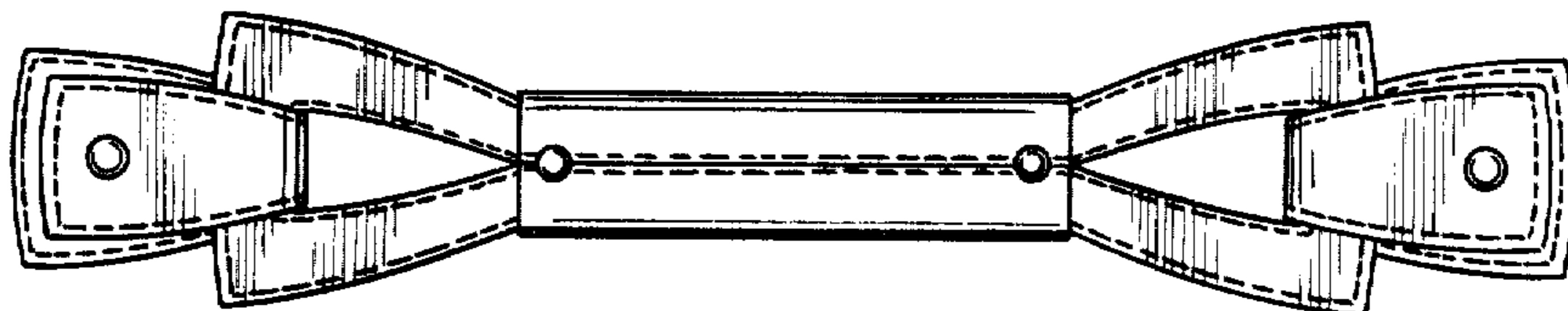

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a handle unit for a luggage case, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a handle unit for a luggage case, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof.



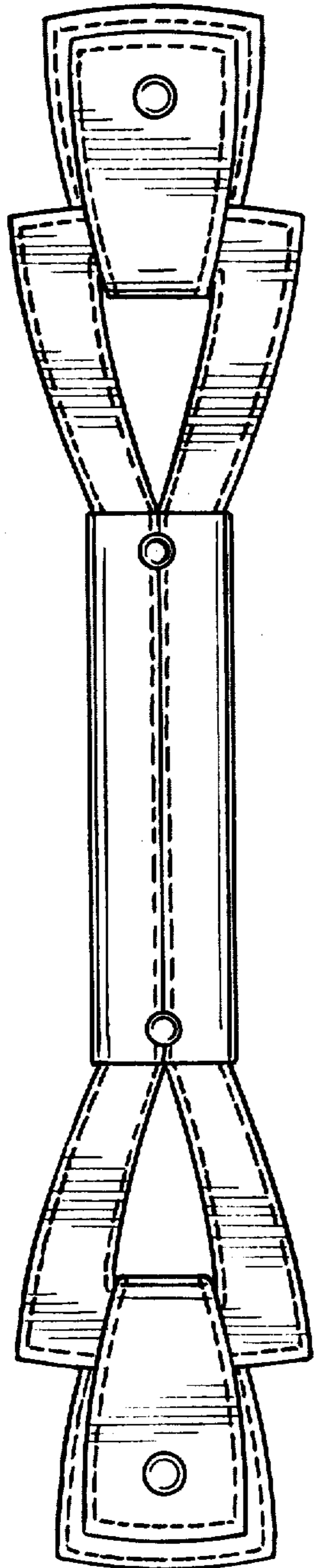

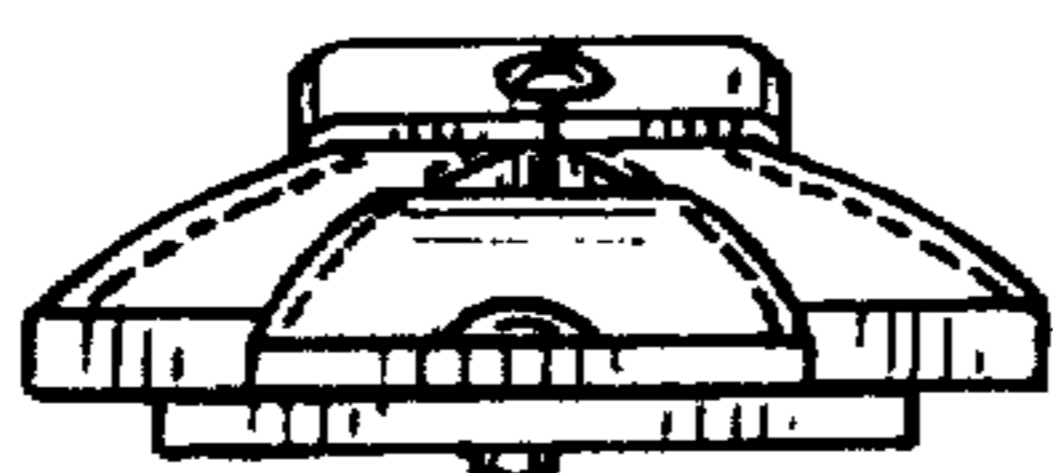

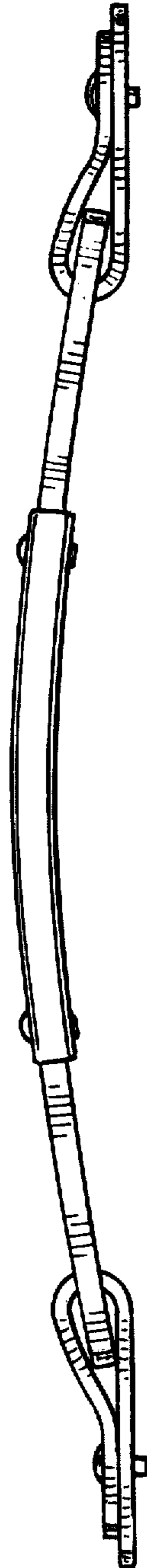

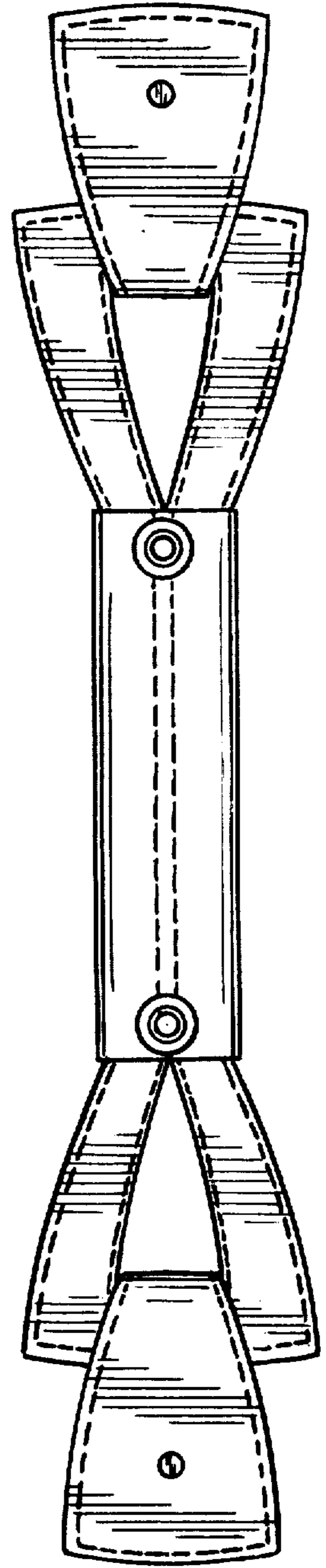
