DESCRIPTION

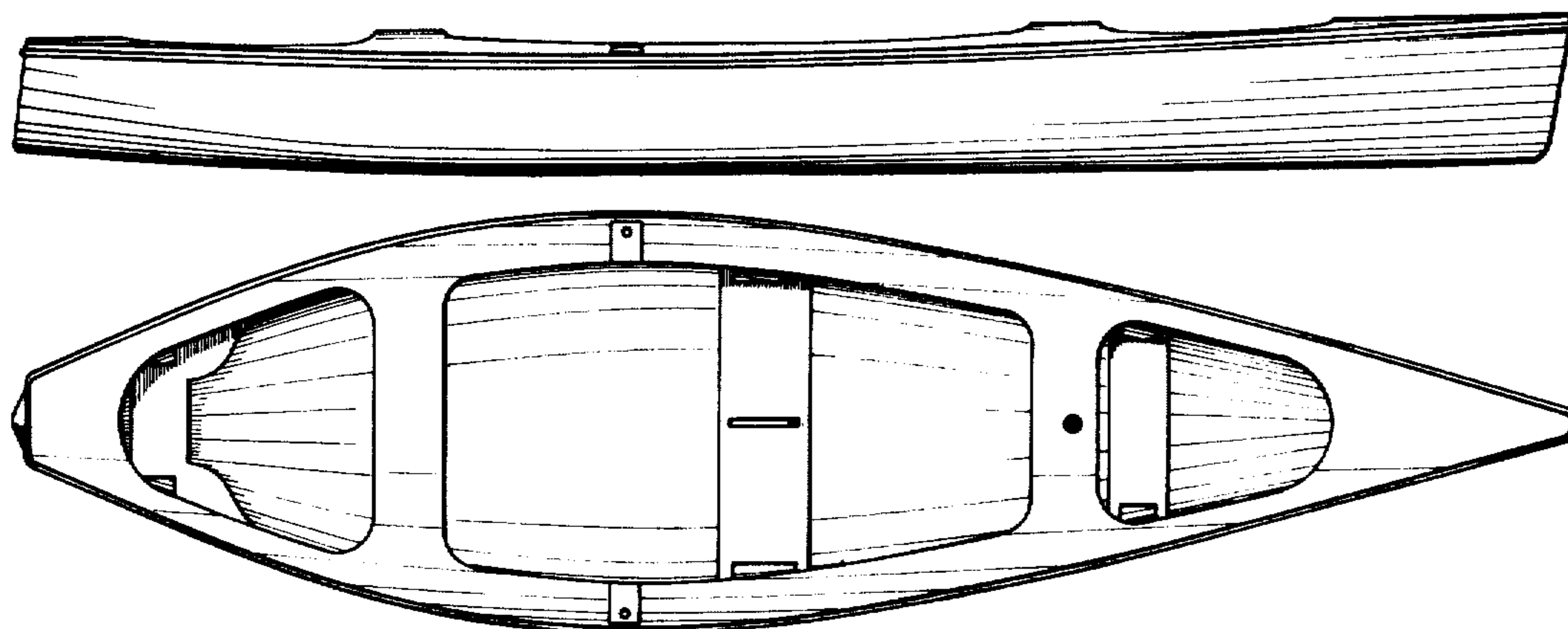
FIG. 1 is a side view of a multi-purpose boat showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a stern end elevation thereof.



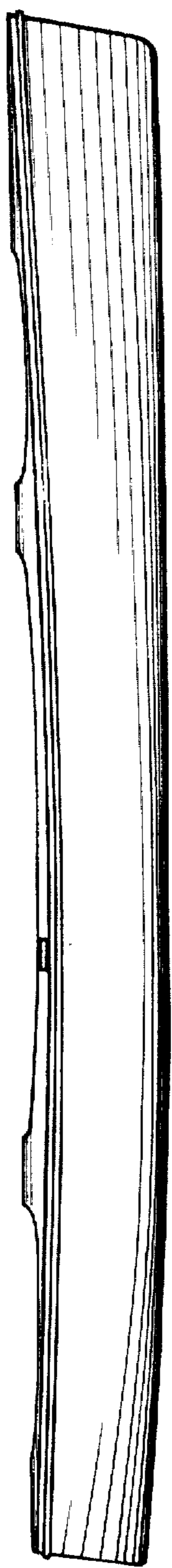

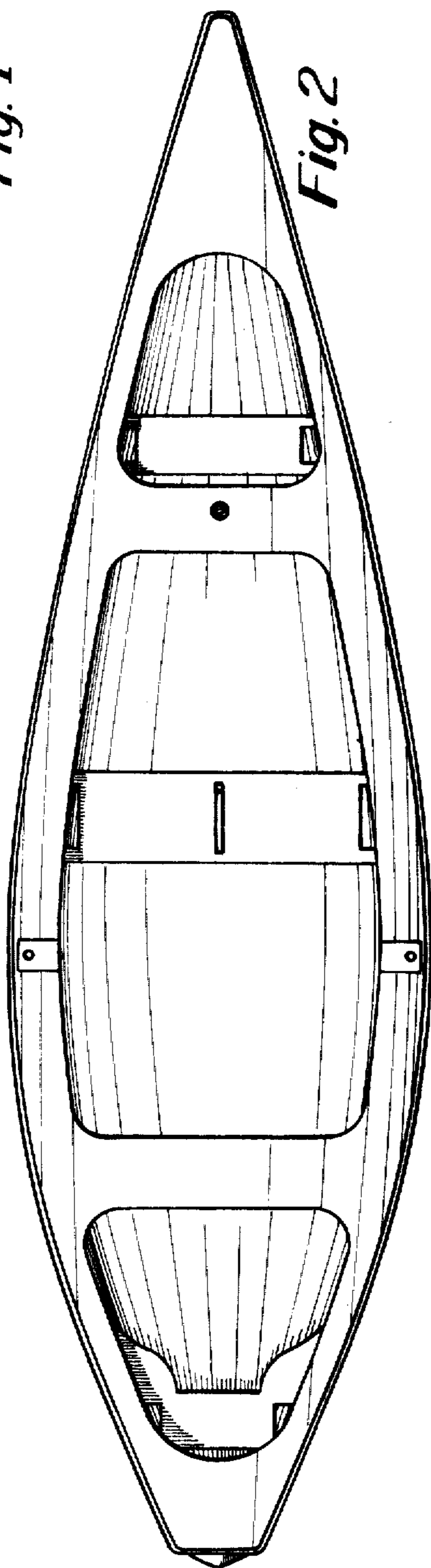

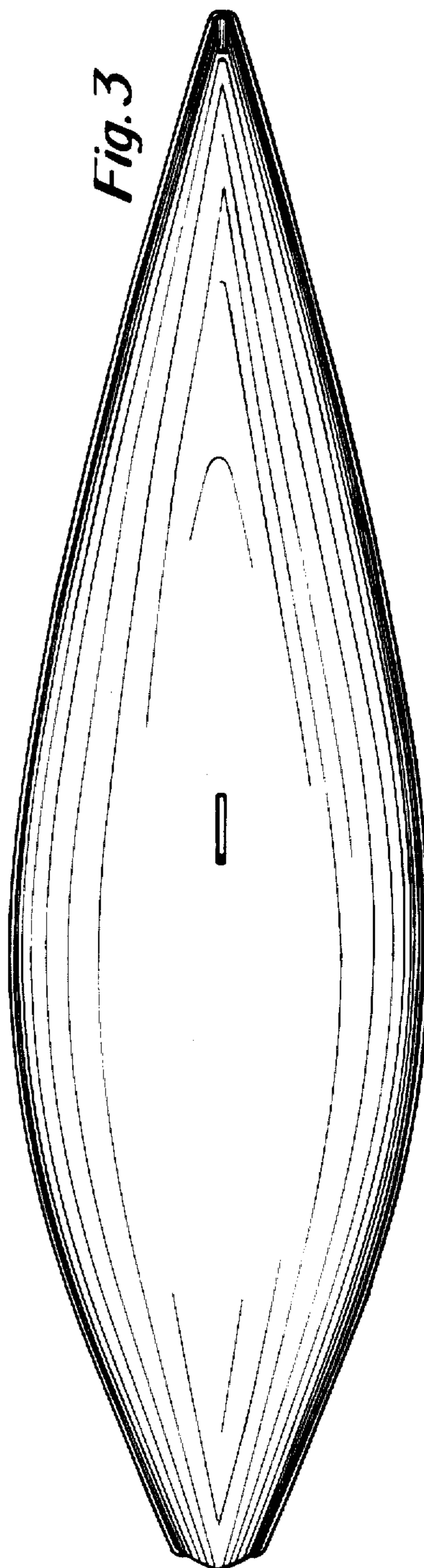

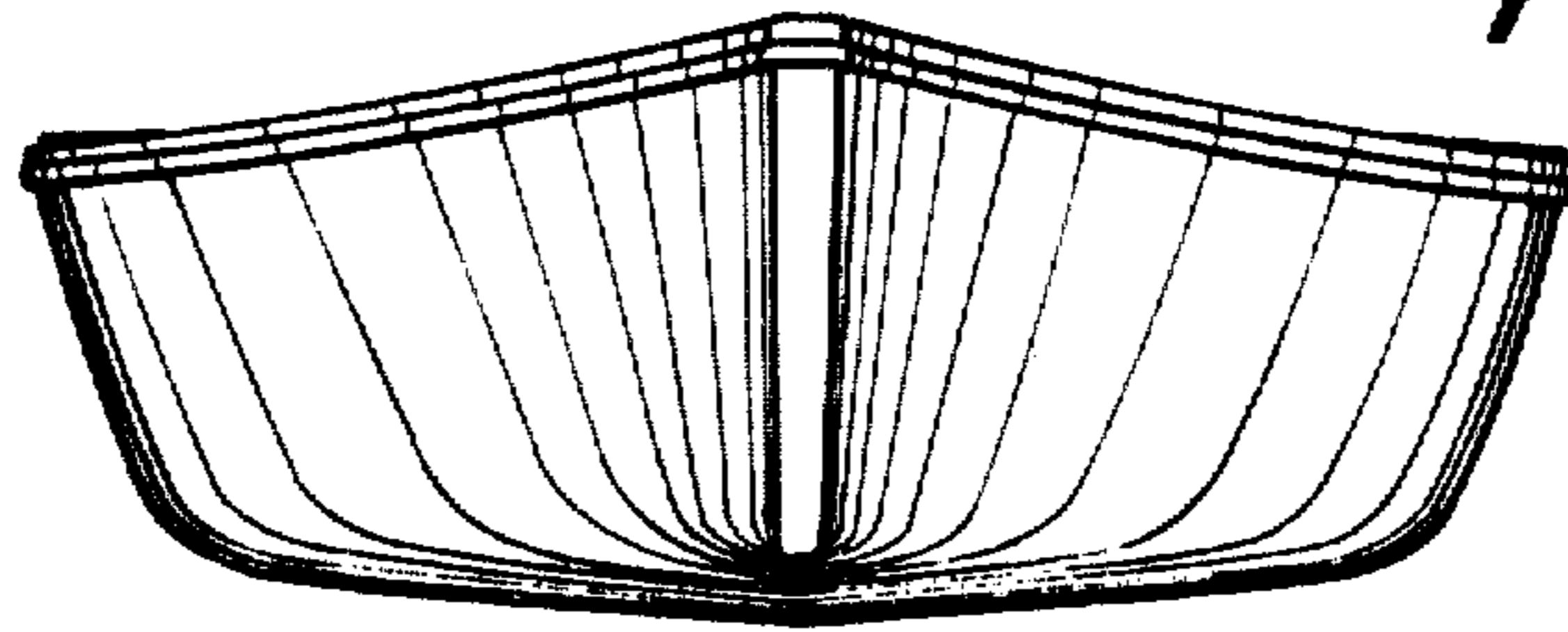
