DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fishing lure show-
ing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror
image thereof;

mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left end view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a right end view thereof.

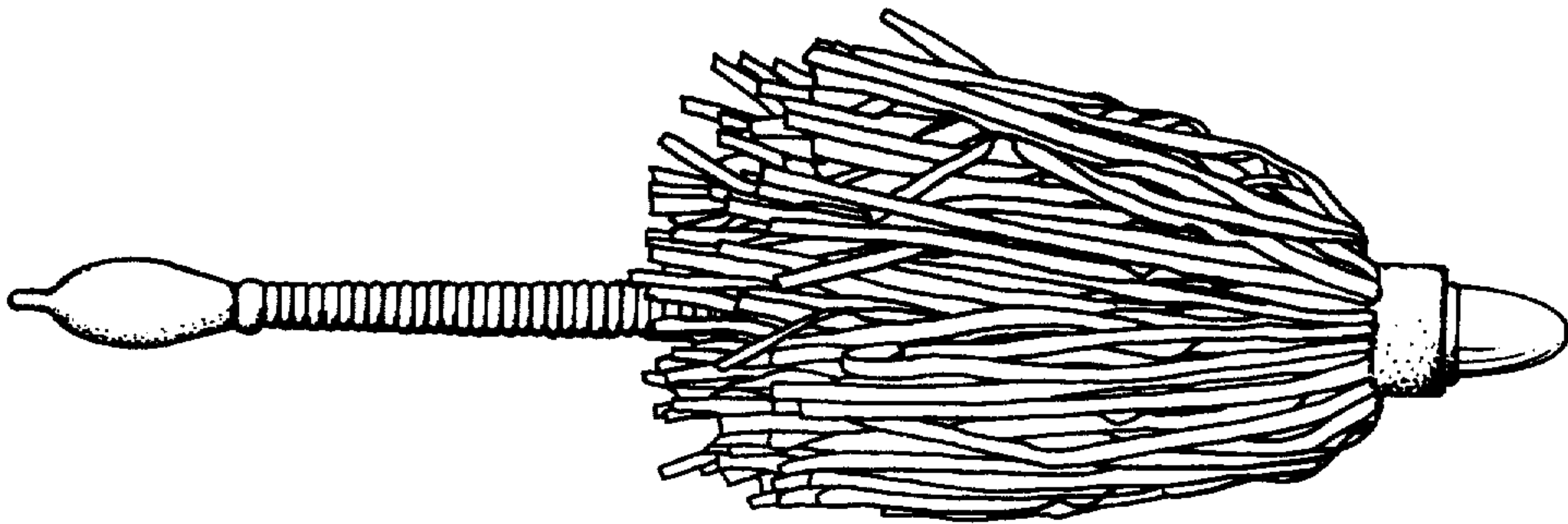

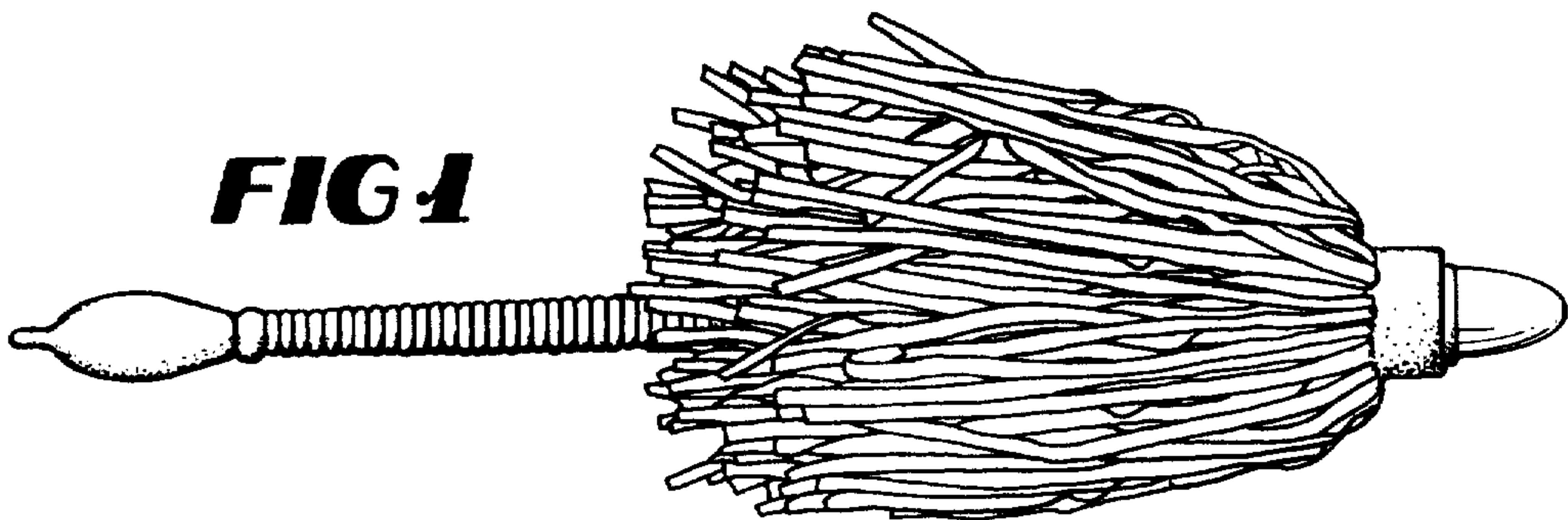

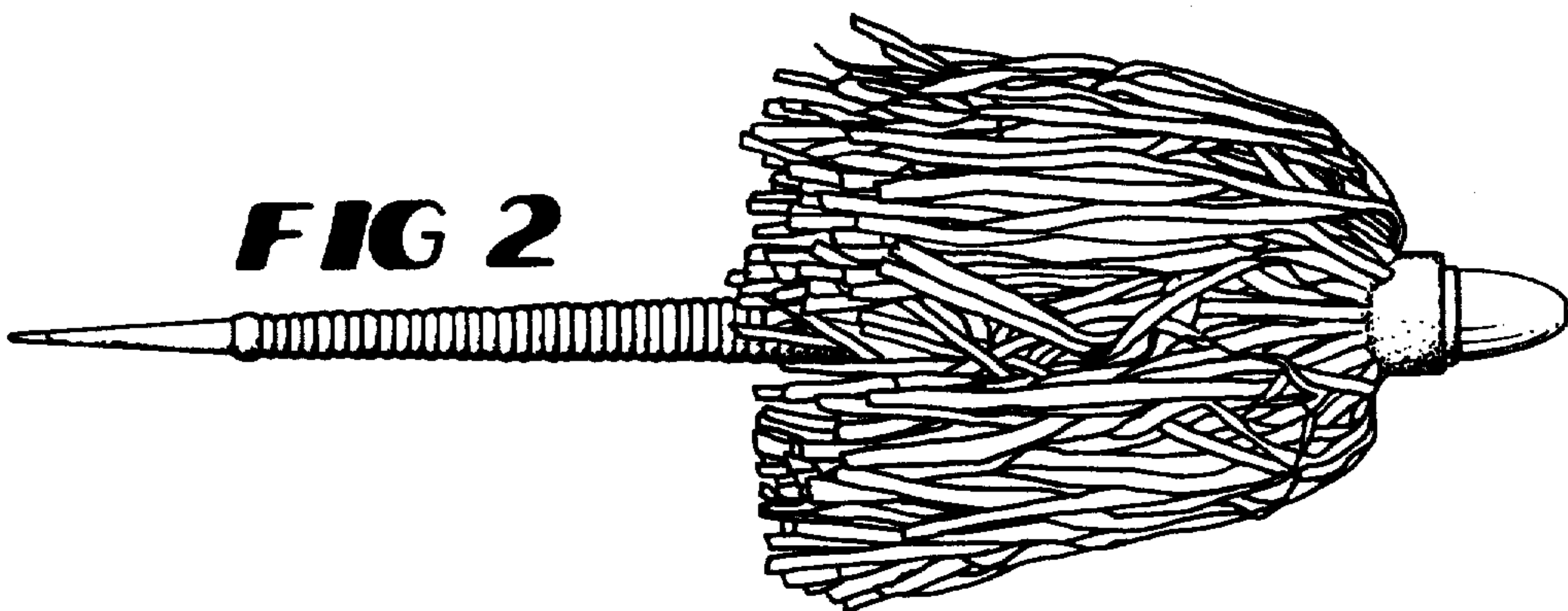

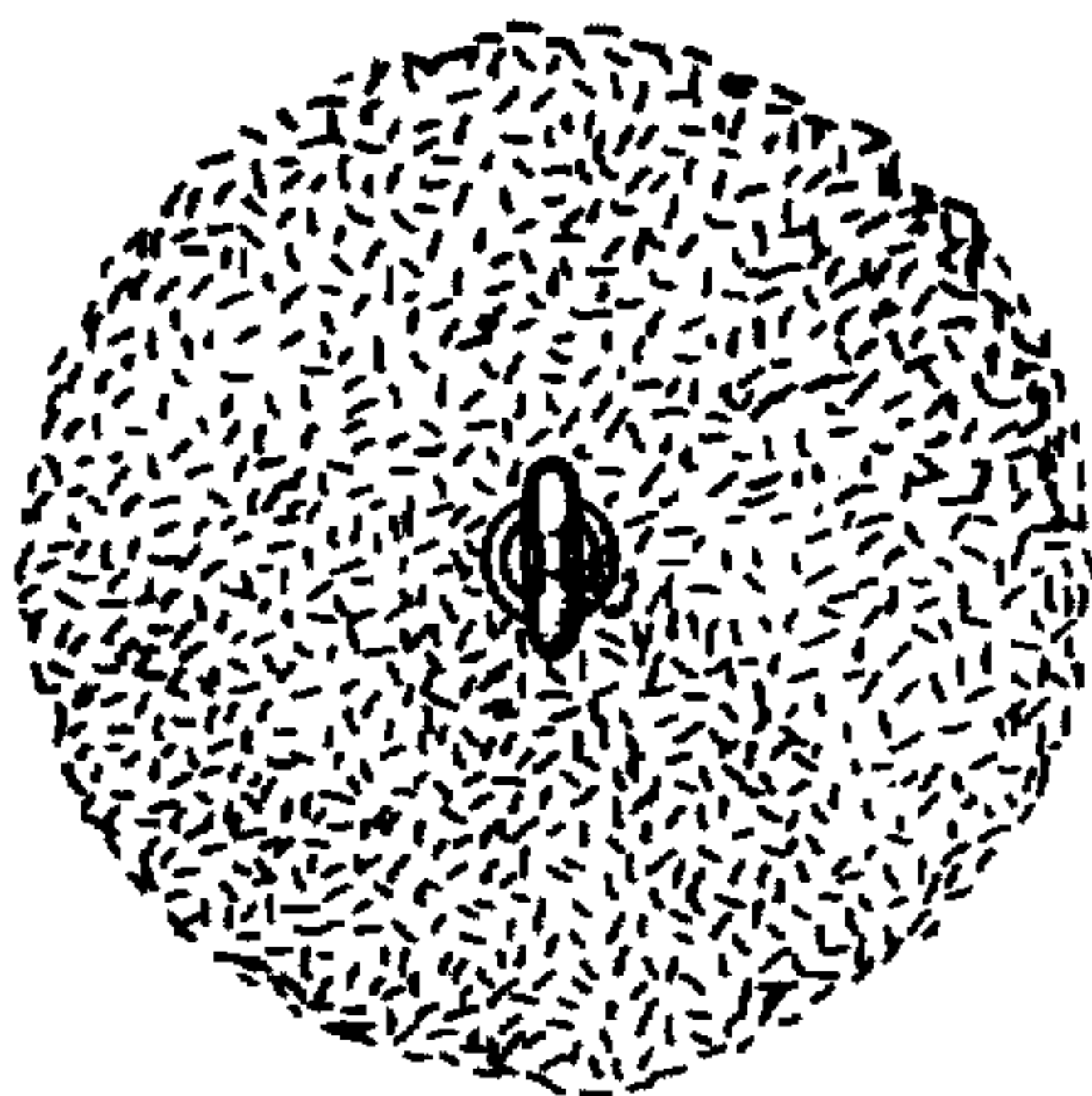
