[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wall mountable bicycle support, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a wall mountable bicycle support showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

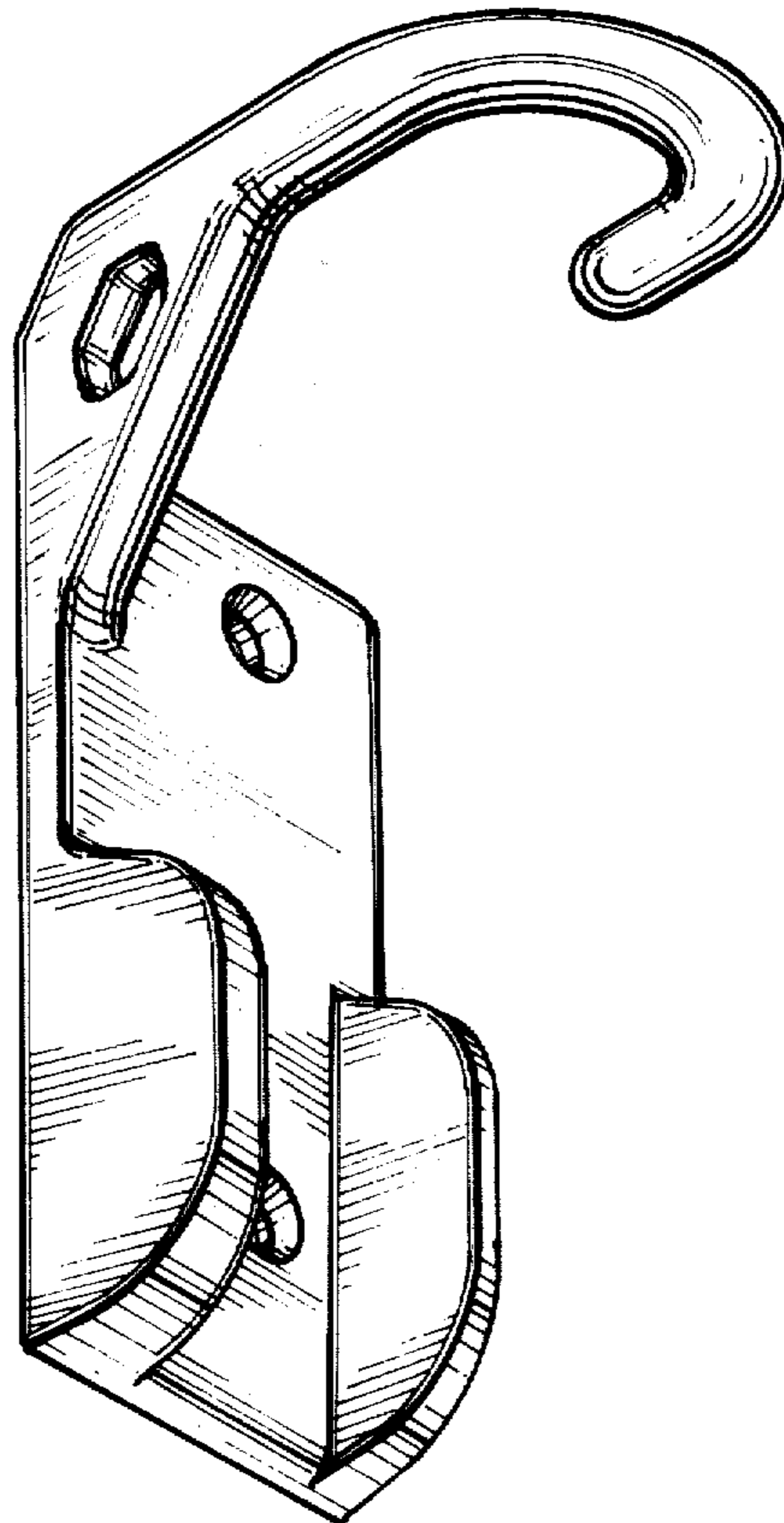

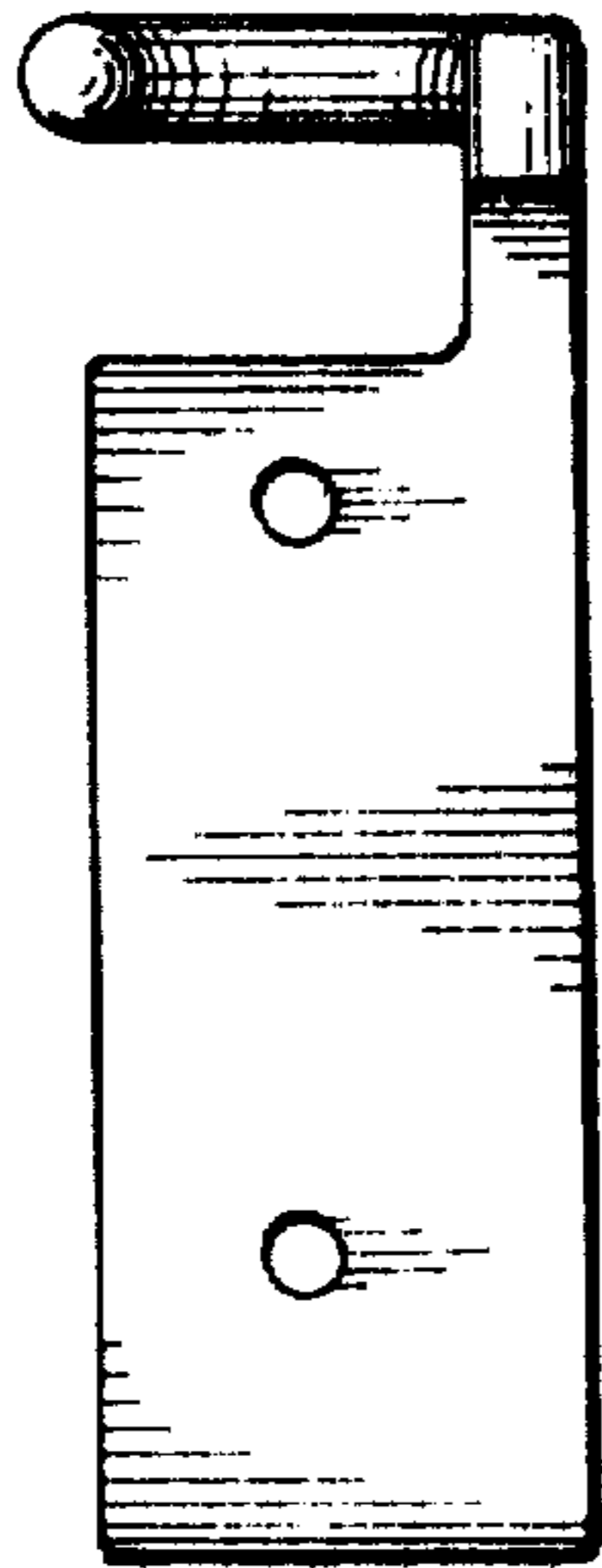

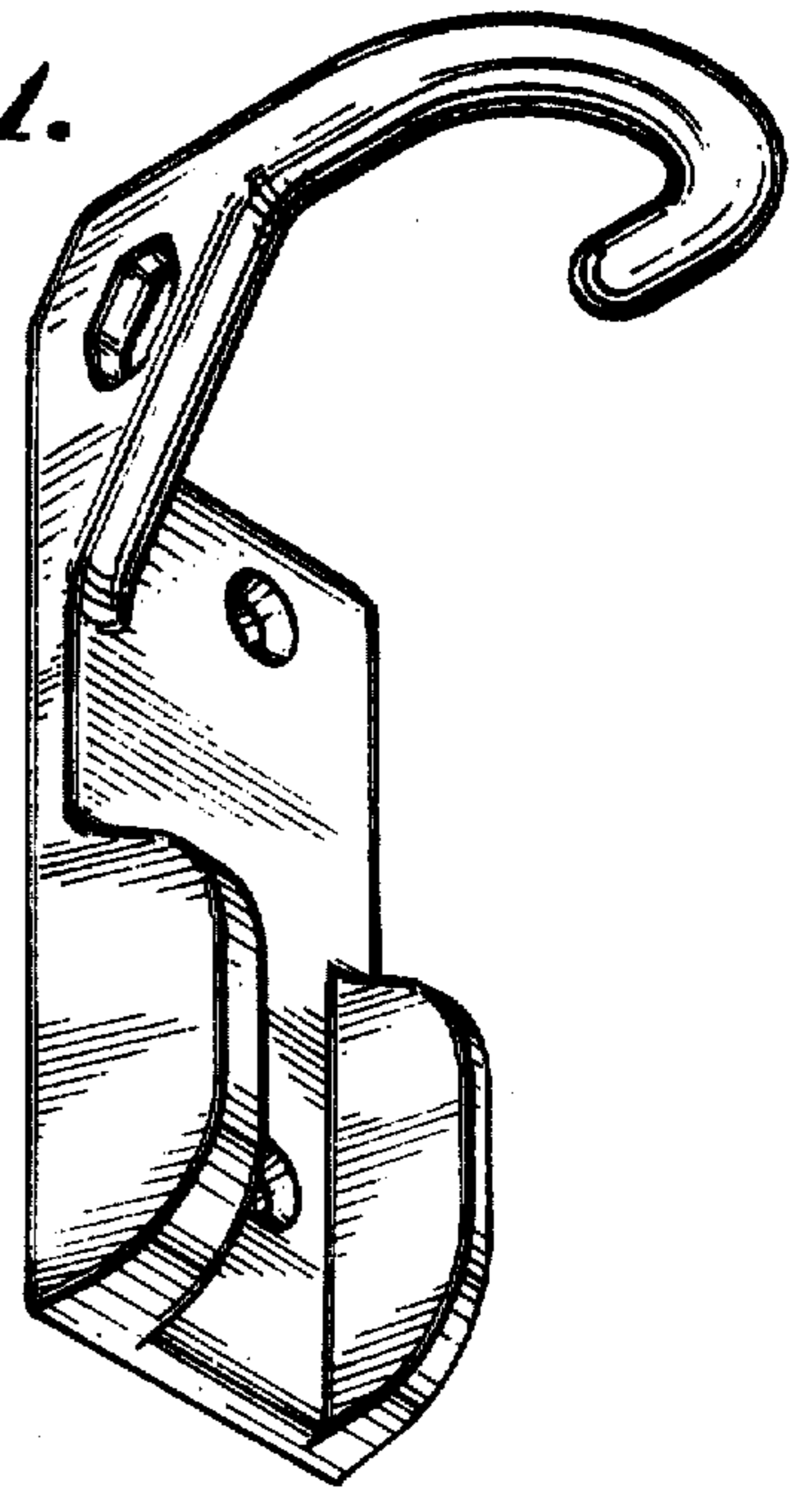

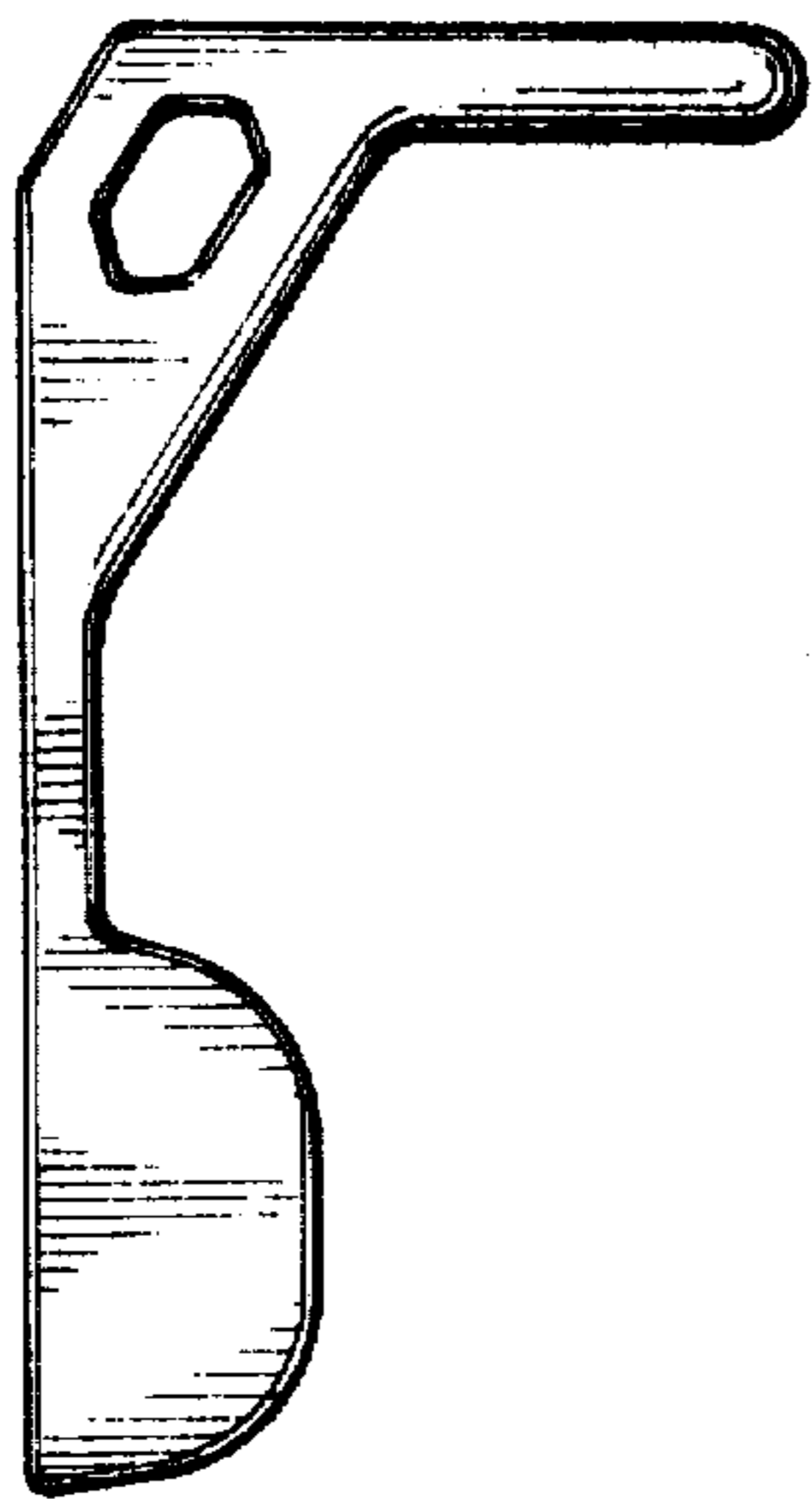
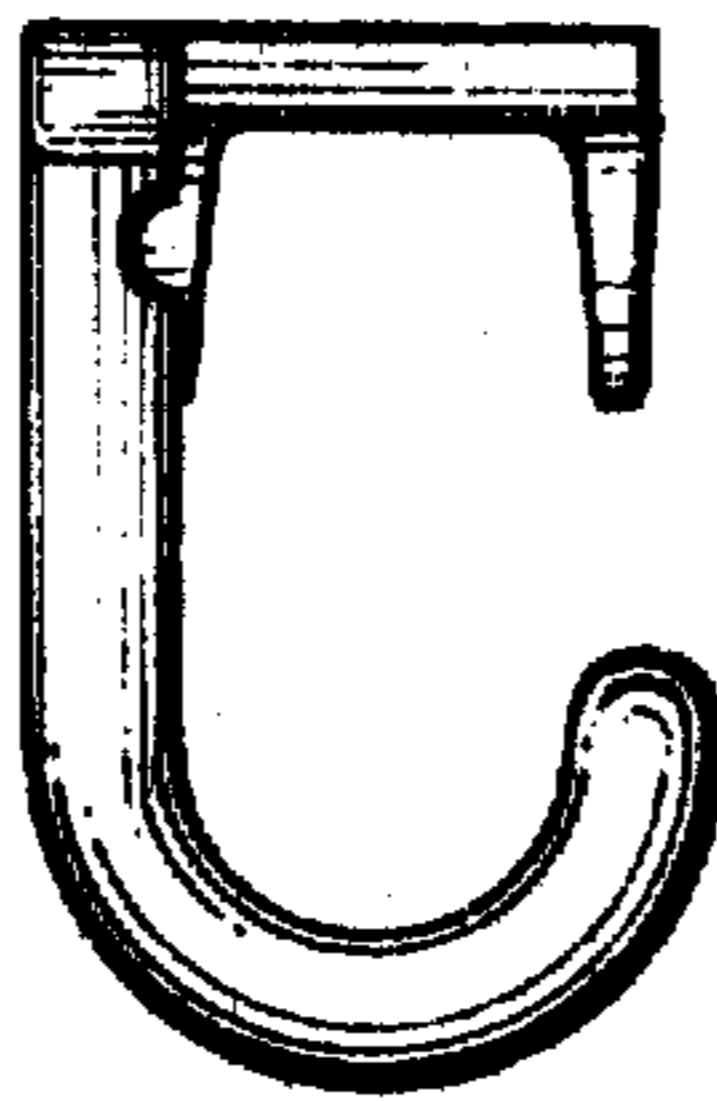

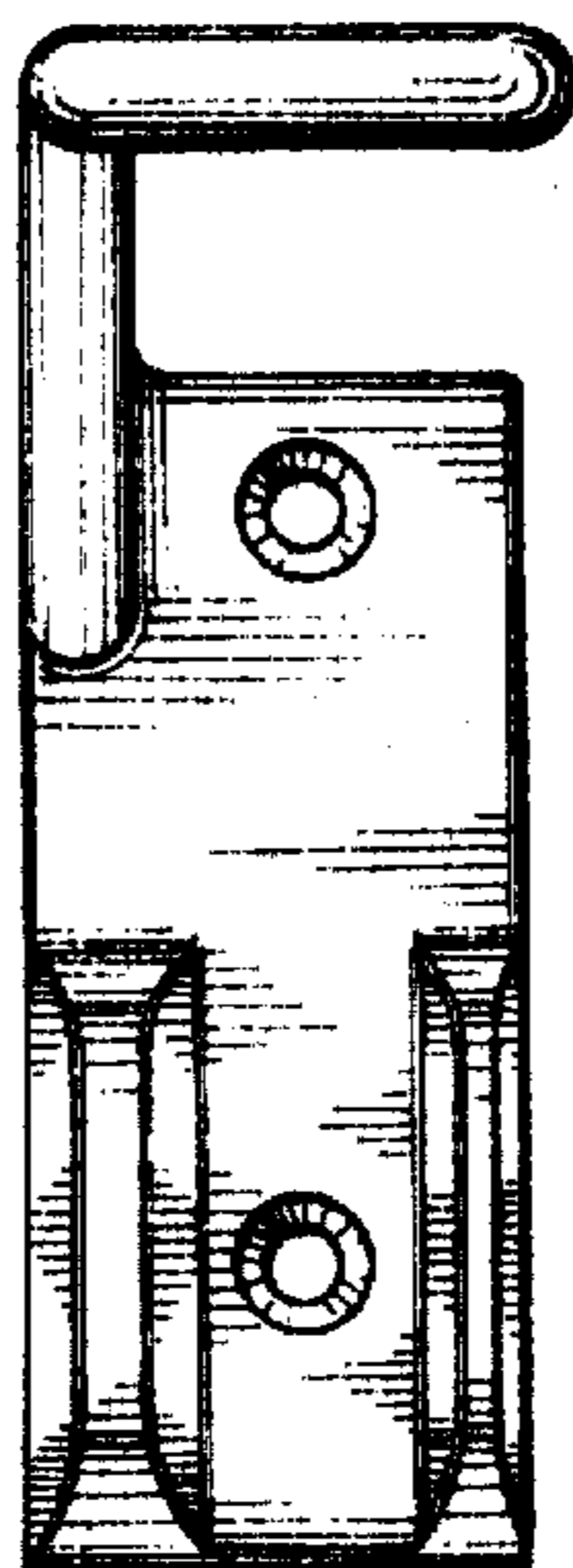

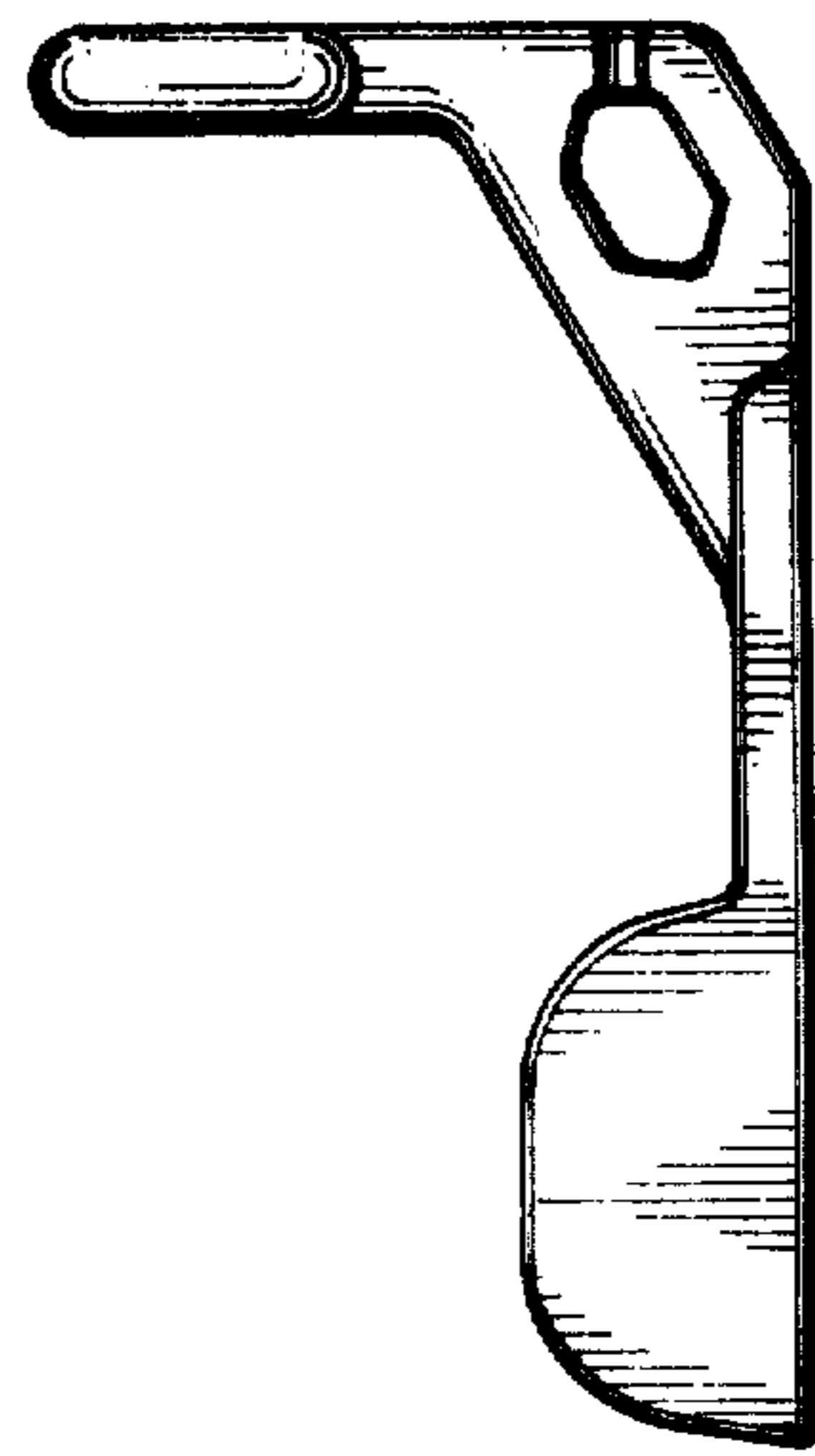

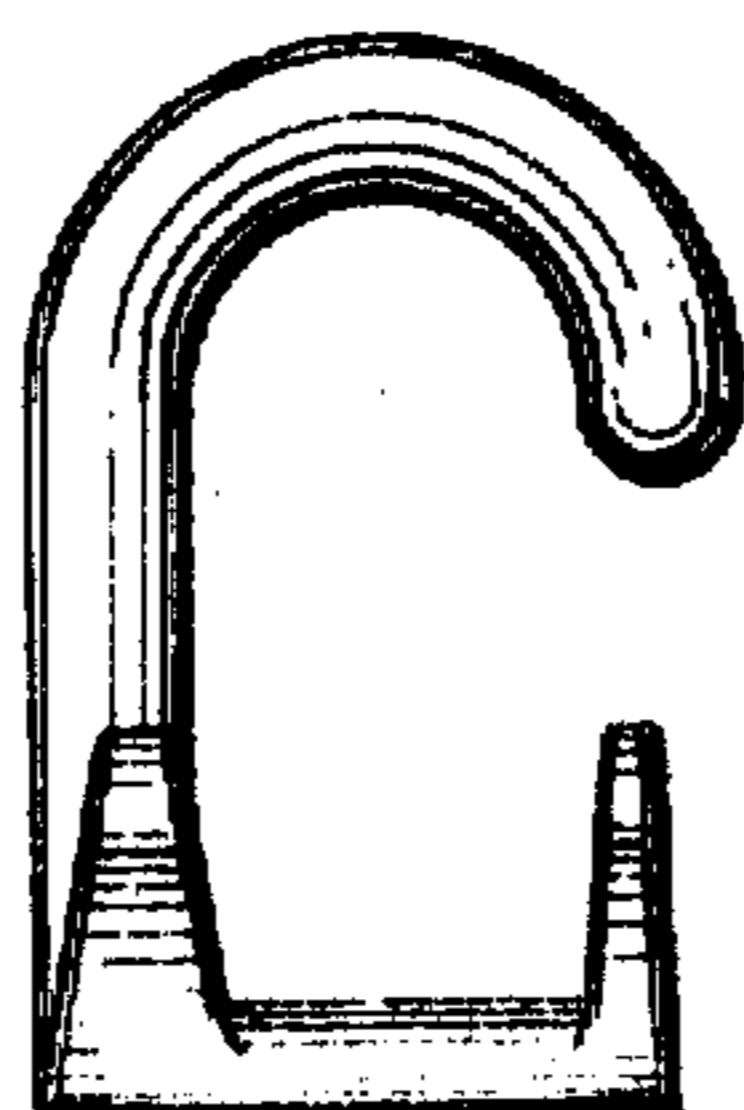
