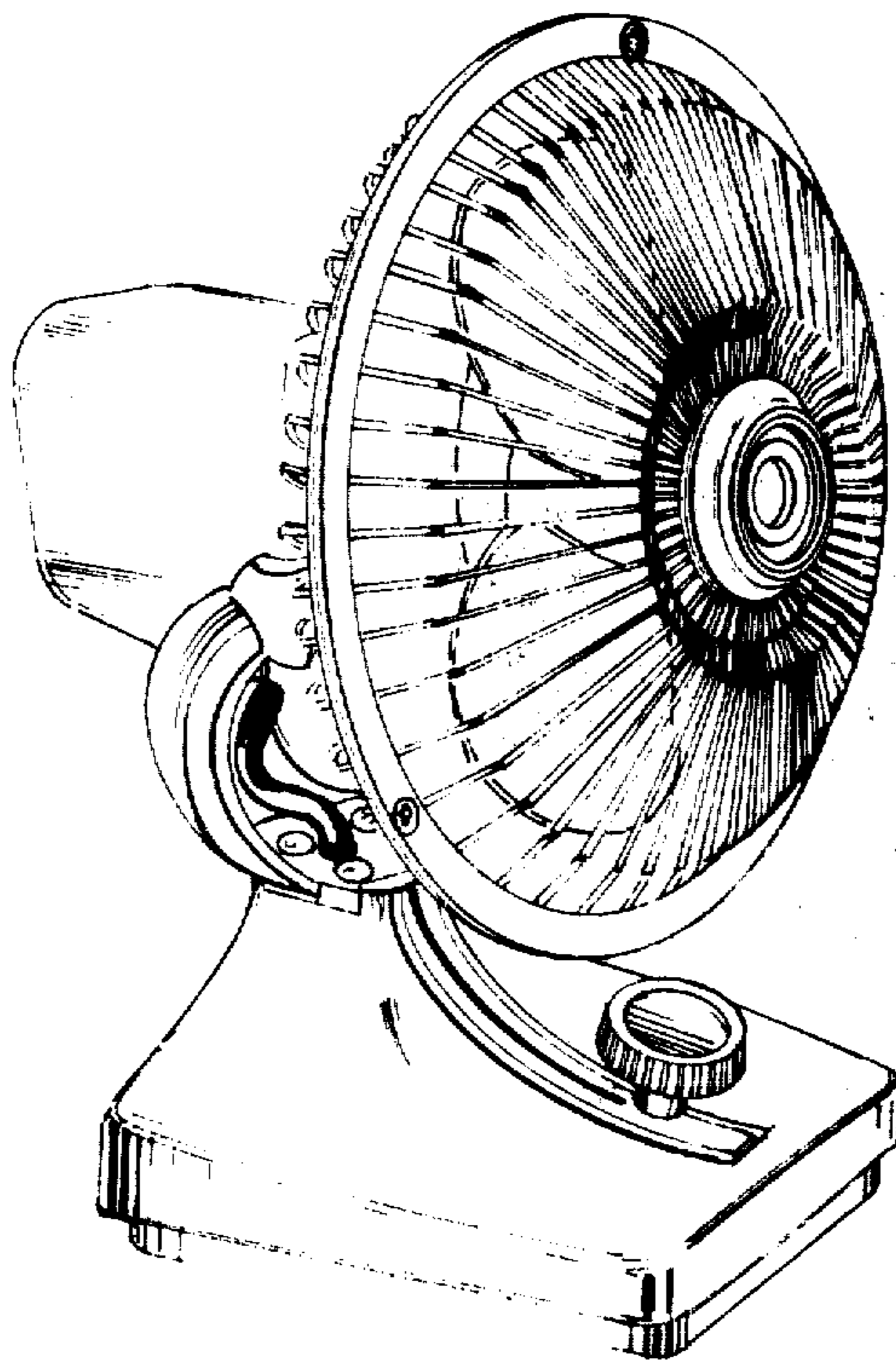

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electric desk fan showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



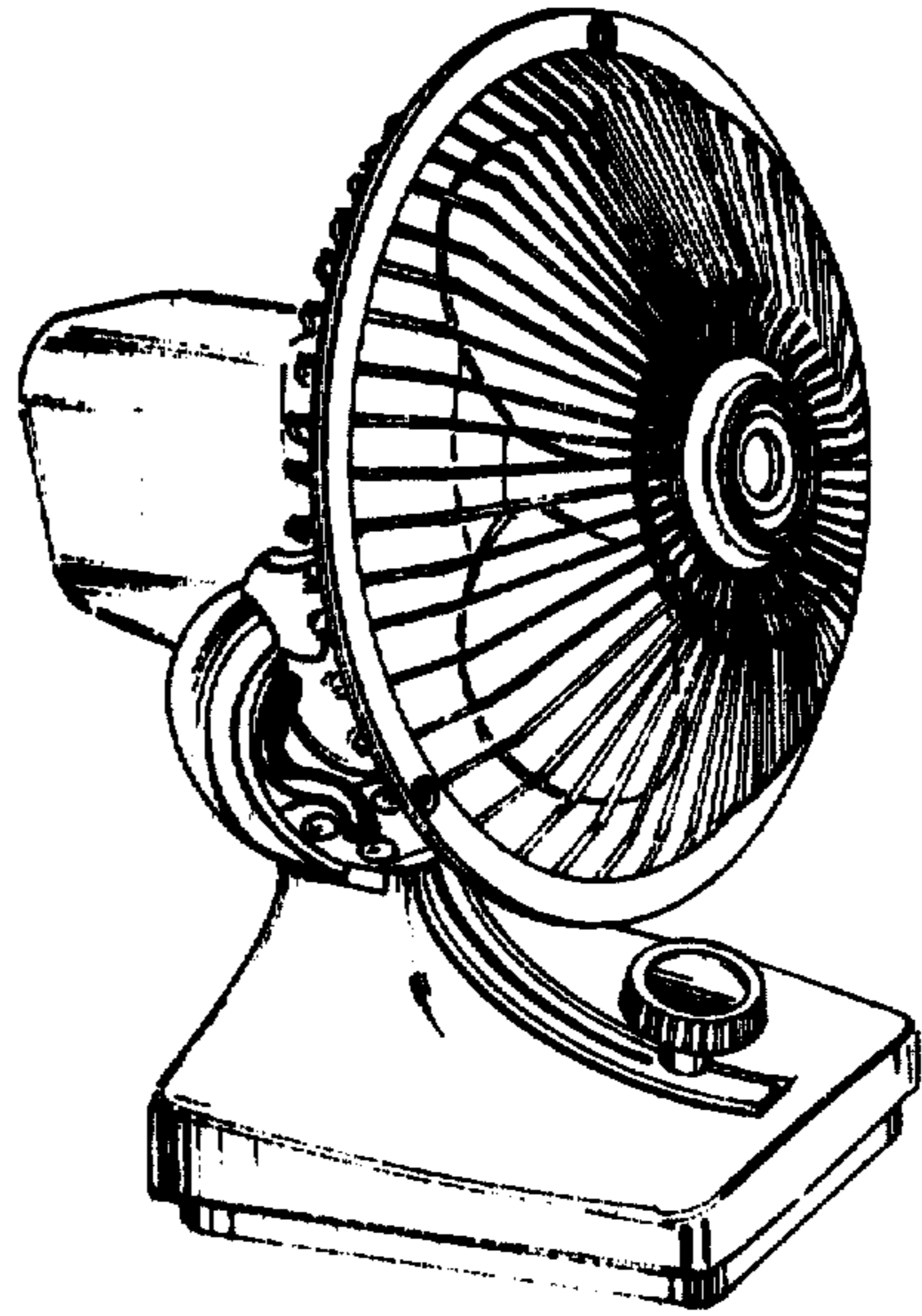

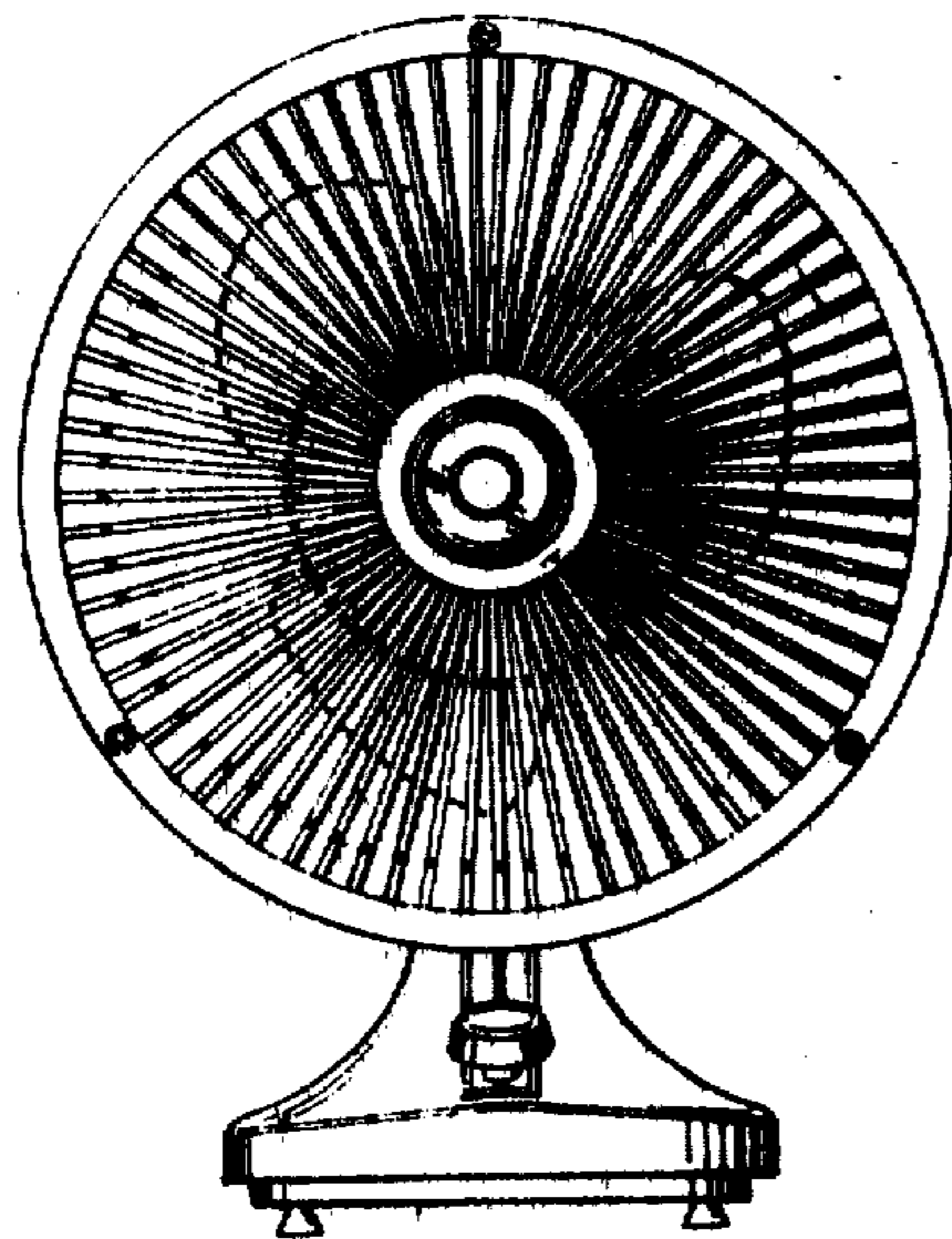

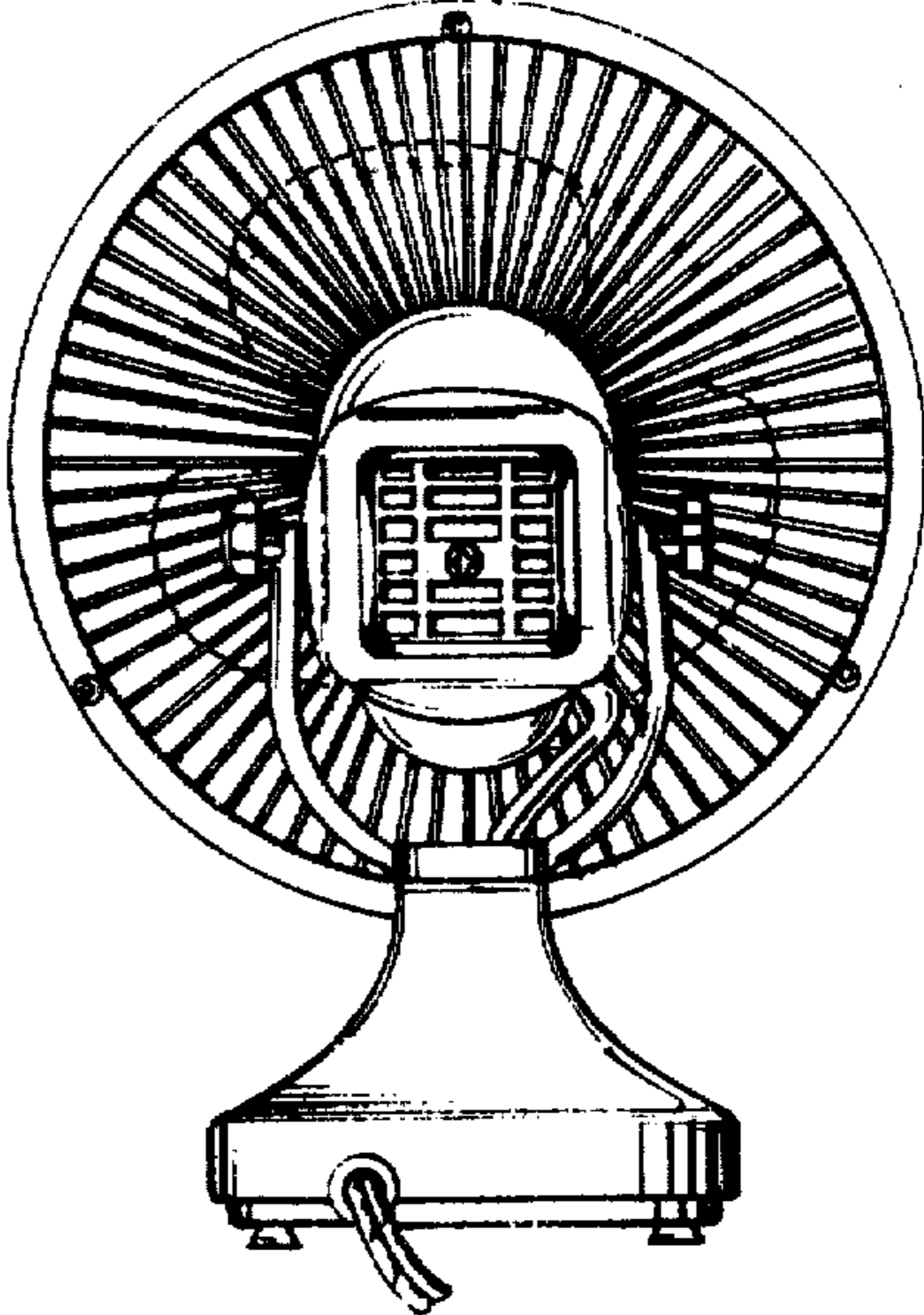

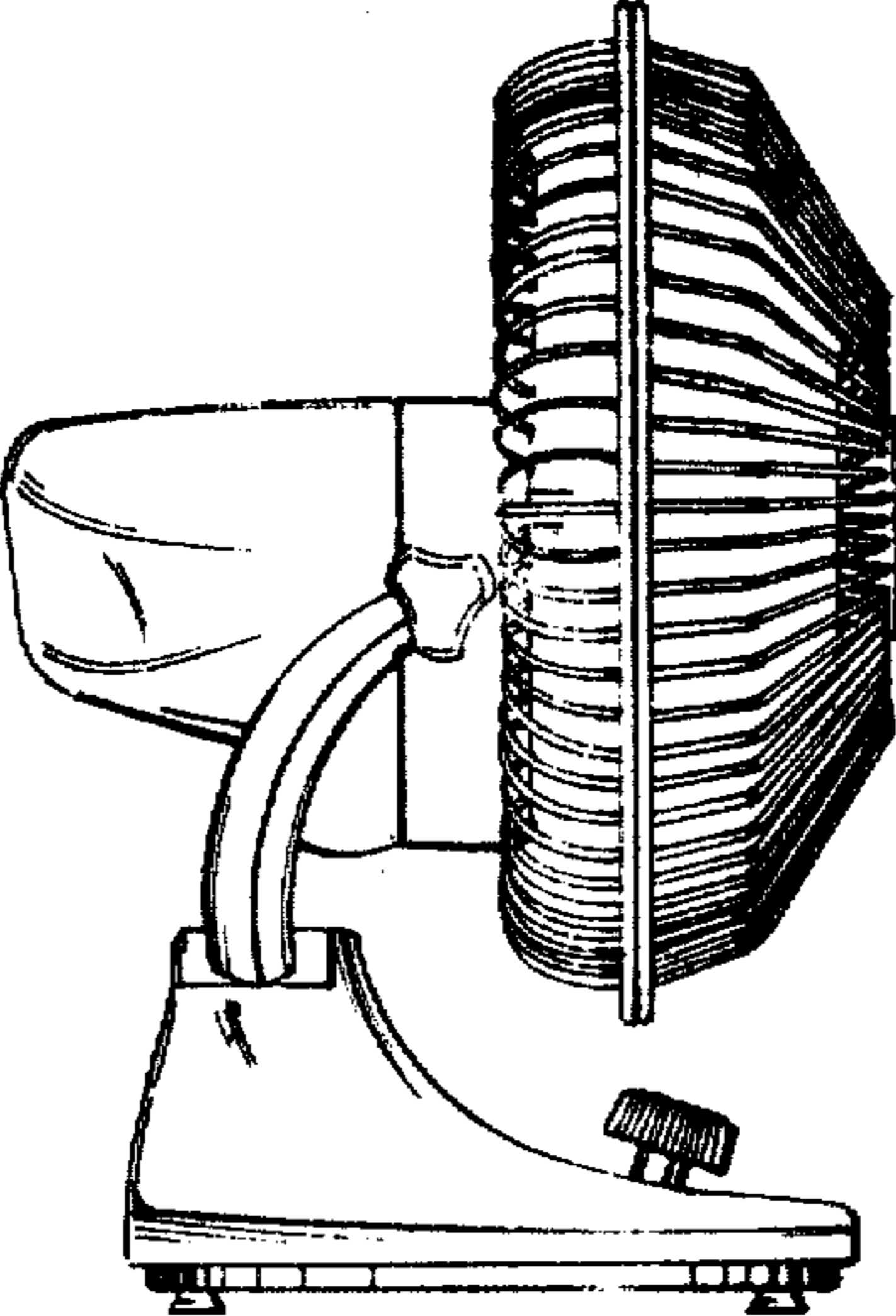

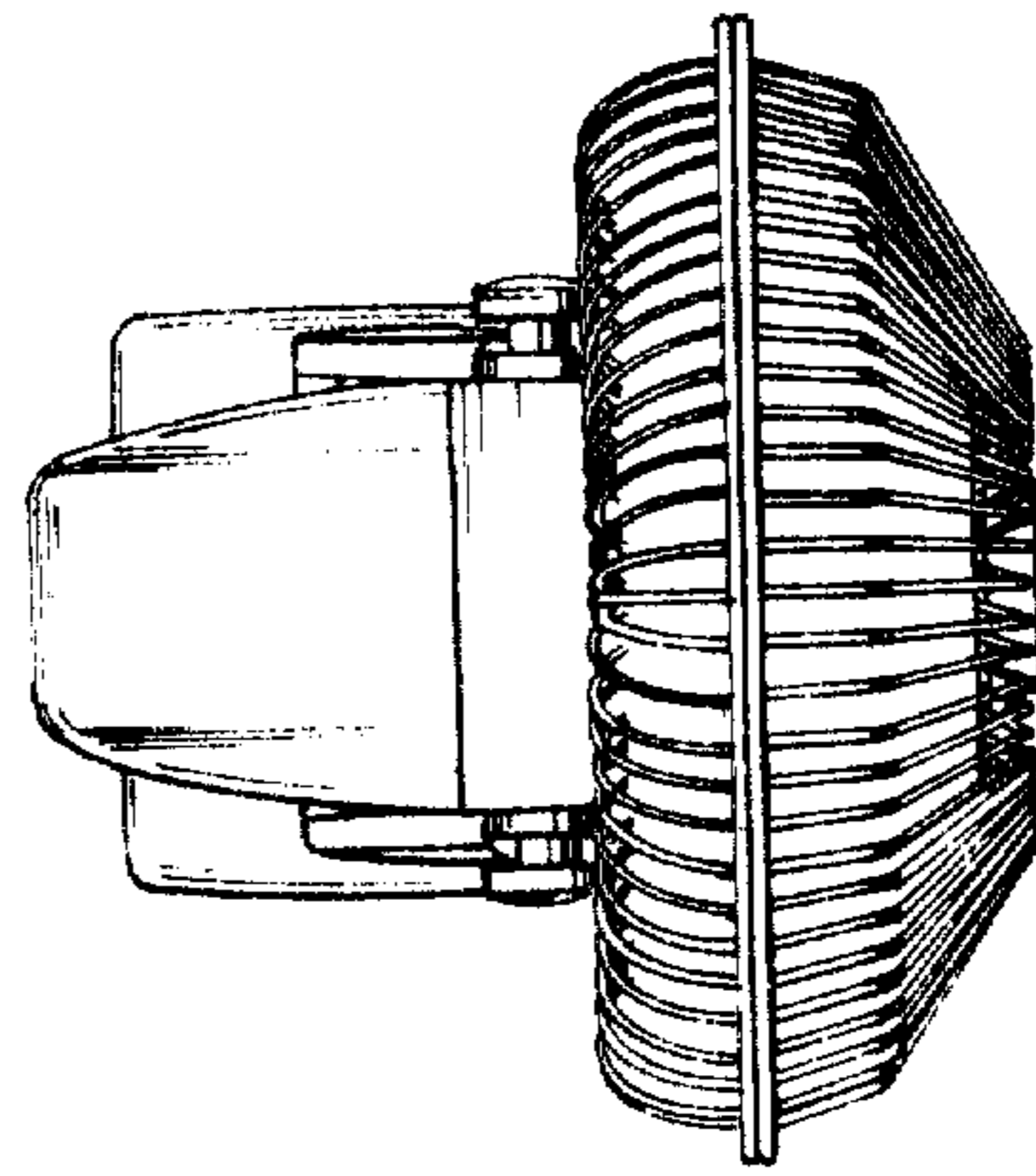

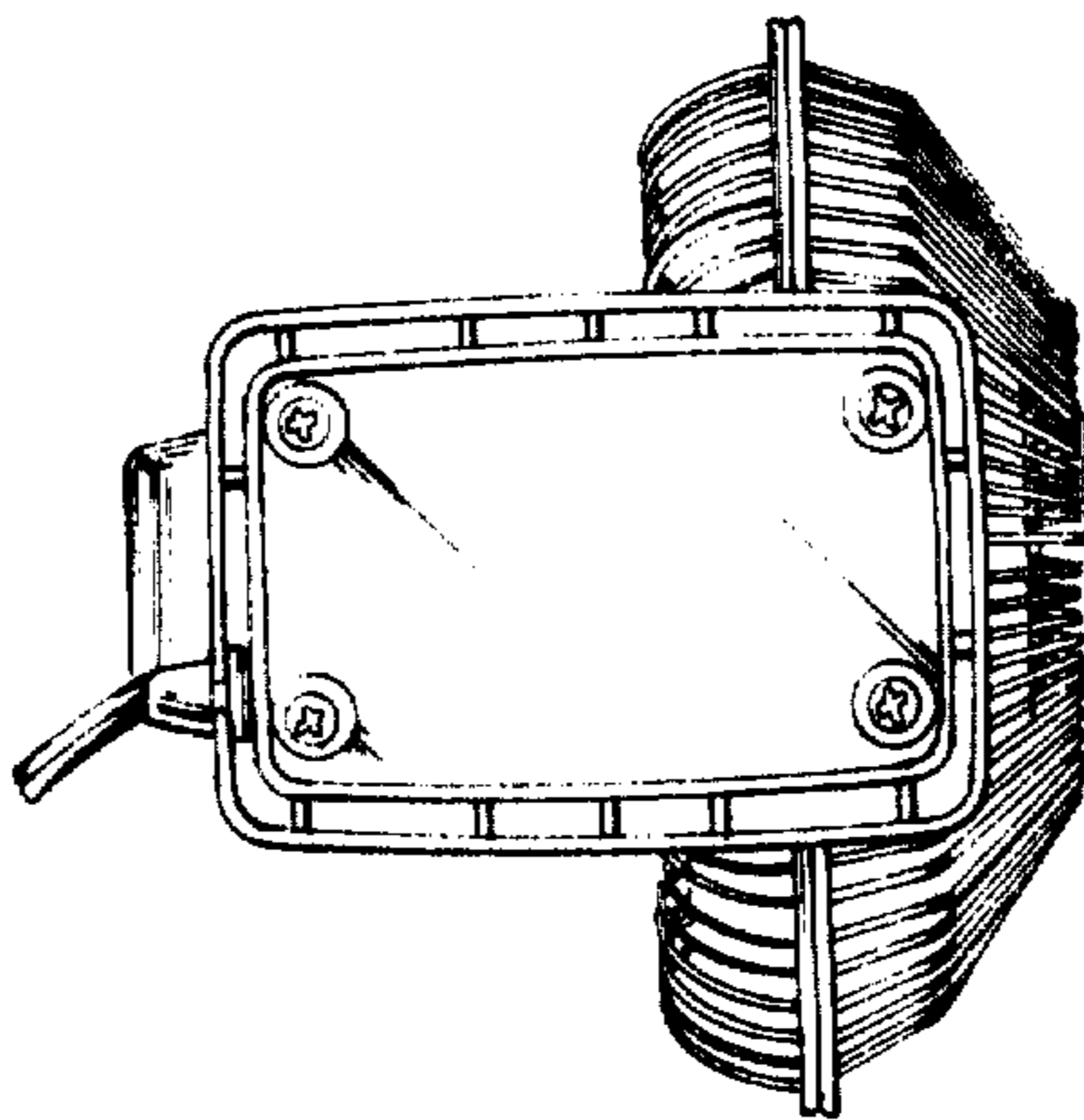
