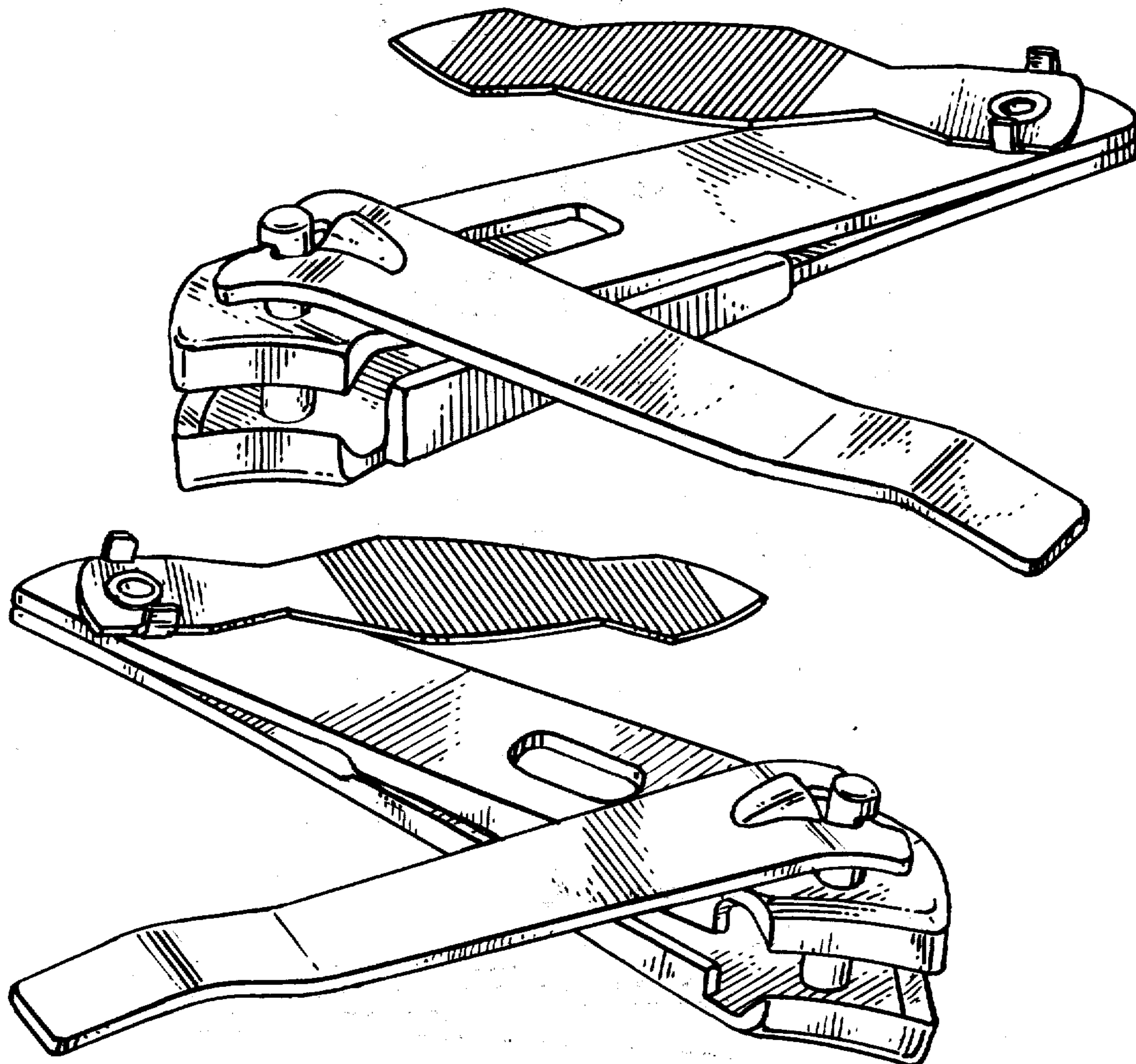

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a nail clipper with clipping emptying chamber, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective showing a front, side and top of the nail clipper with clipping emptying chamber showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective of the device of FIG. 1 but showing various parts moved to another position;
FIG. 3 is a top plan of the device of FIG. 1 as viewed in the FIG. 2 condition;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevation of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a front elevation of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 8 is a rear elevation of the device of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a nail clipper with clipping emptying chamber showing a modified form of my new design in open position.



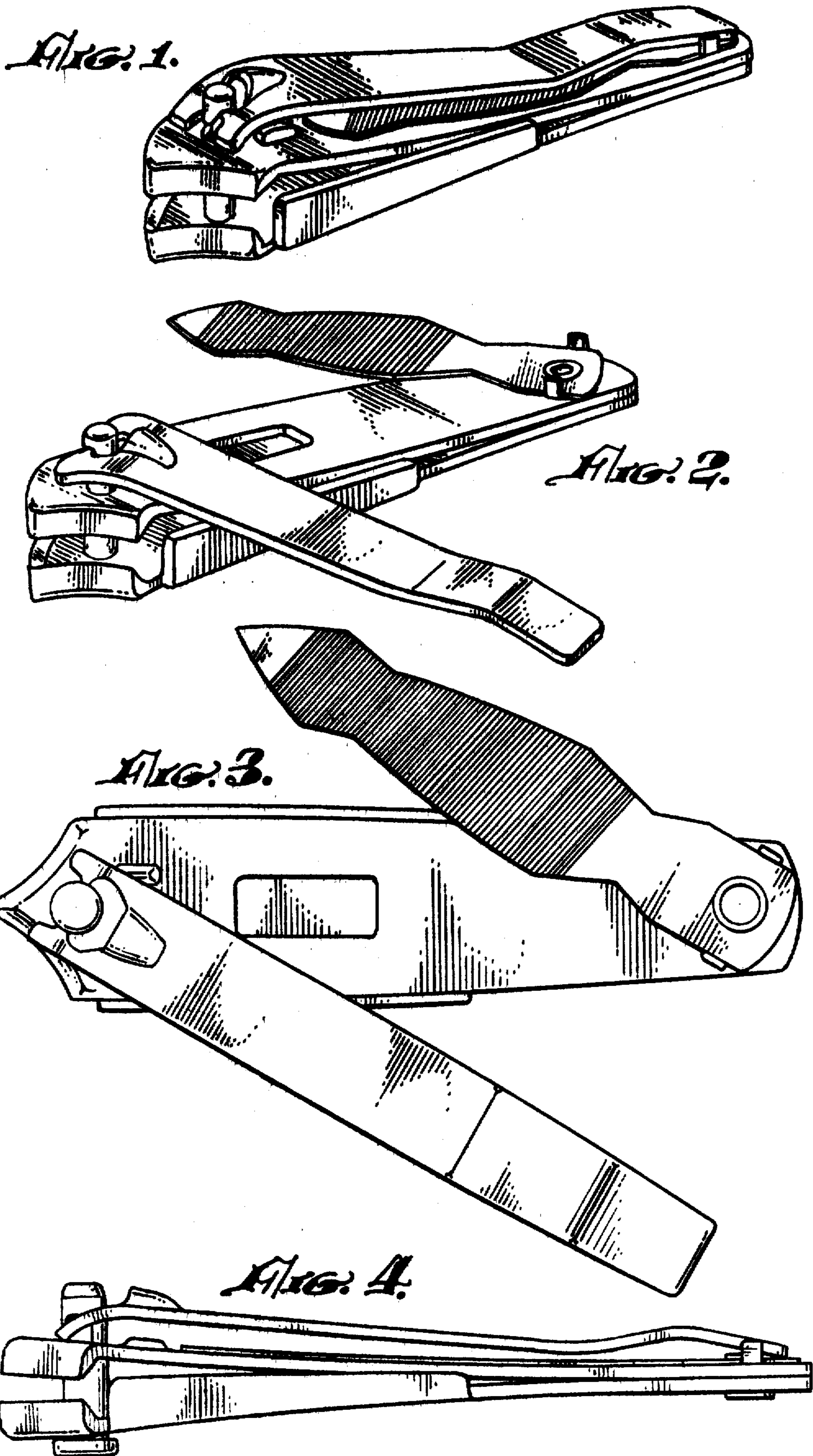

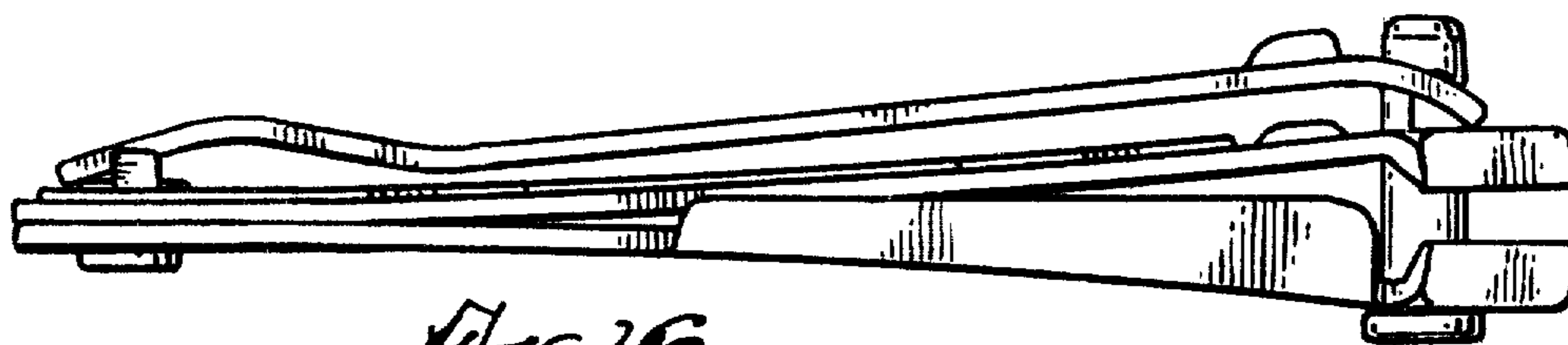

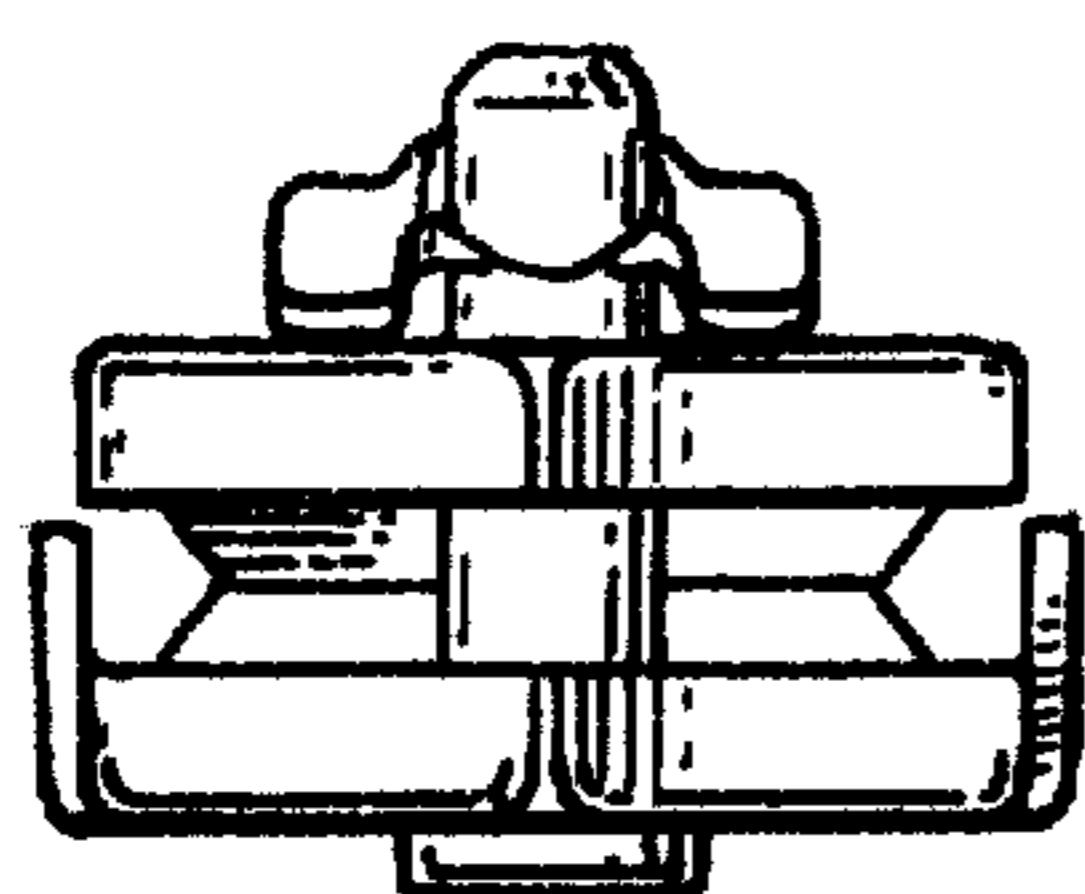

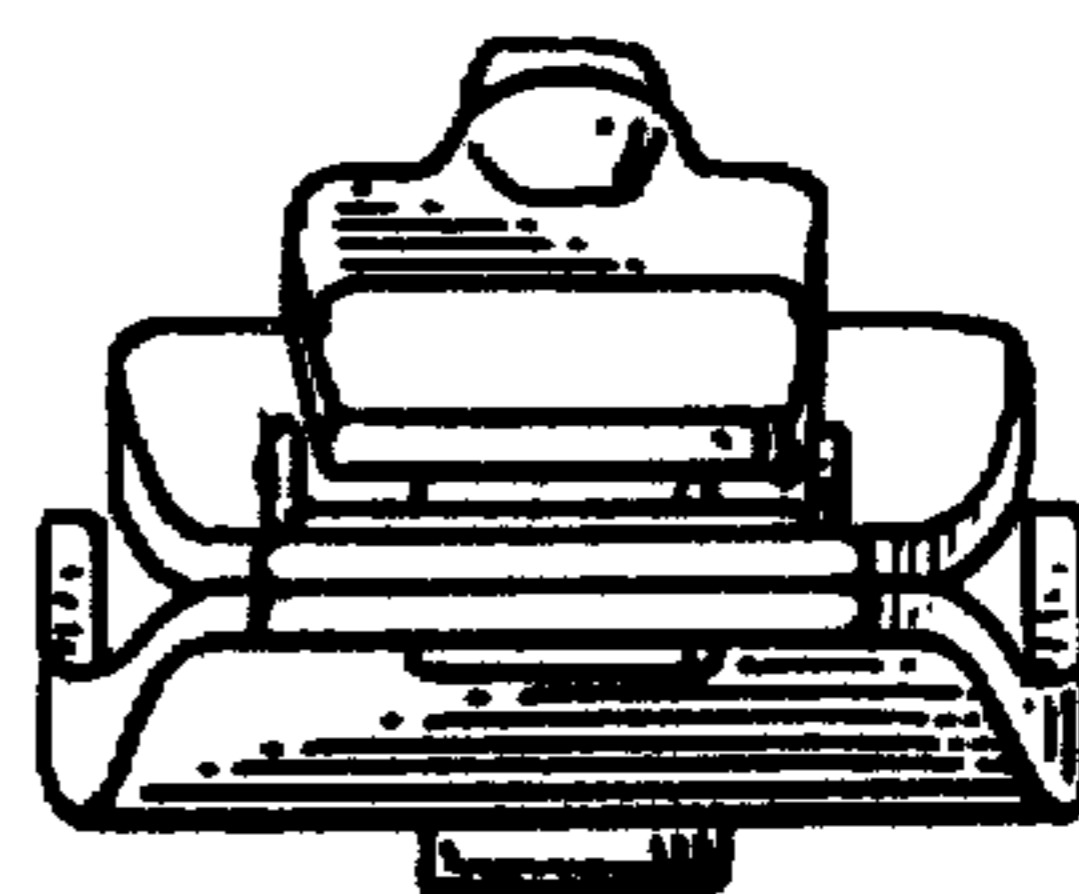

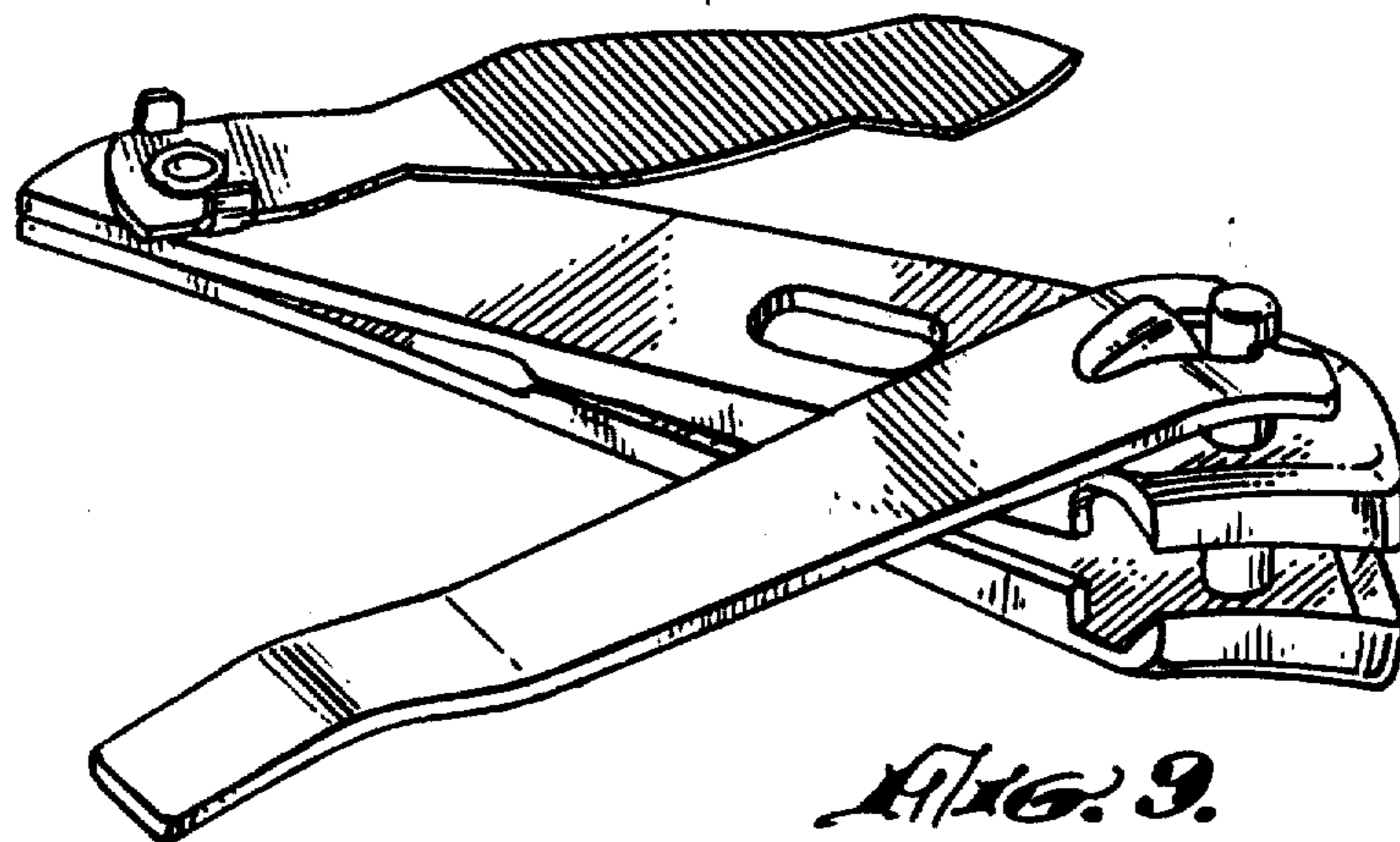
