FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a horseshoe showing my new design;

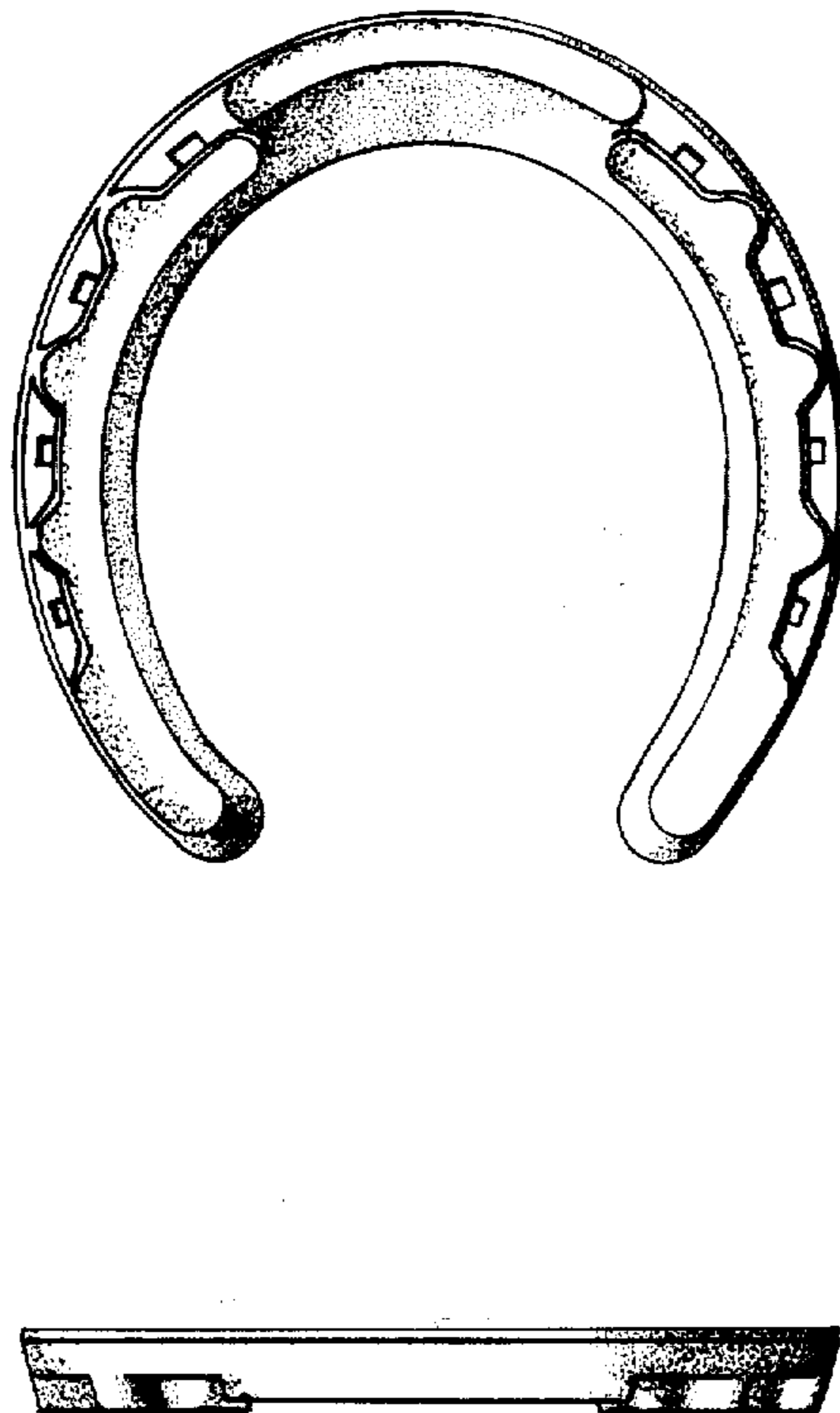

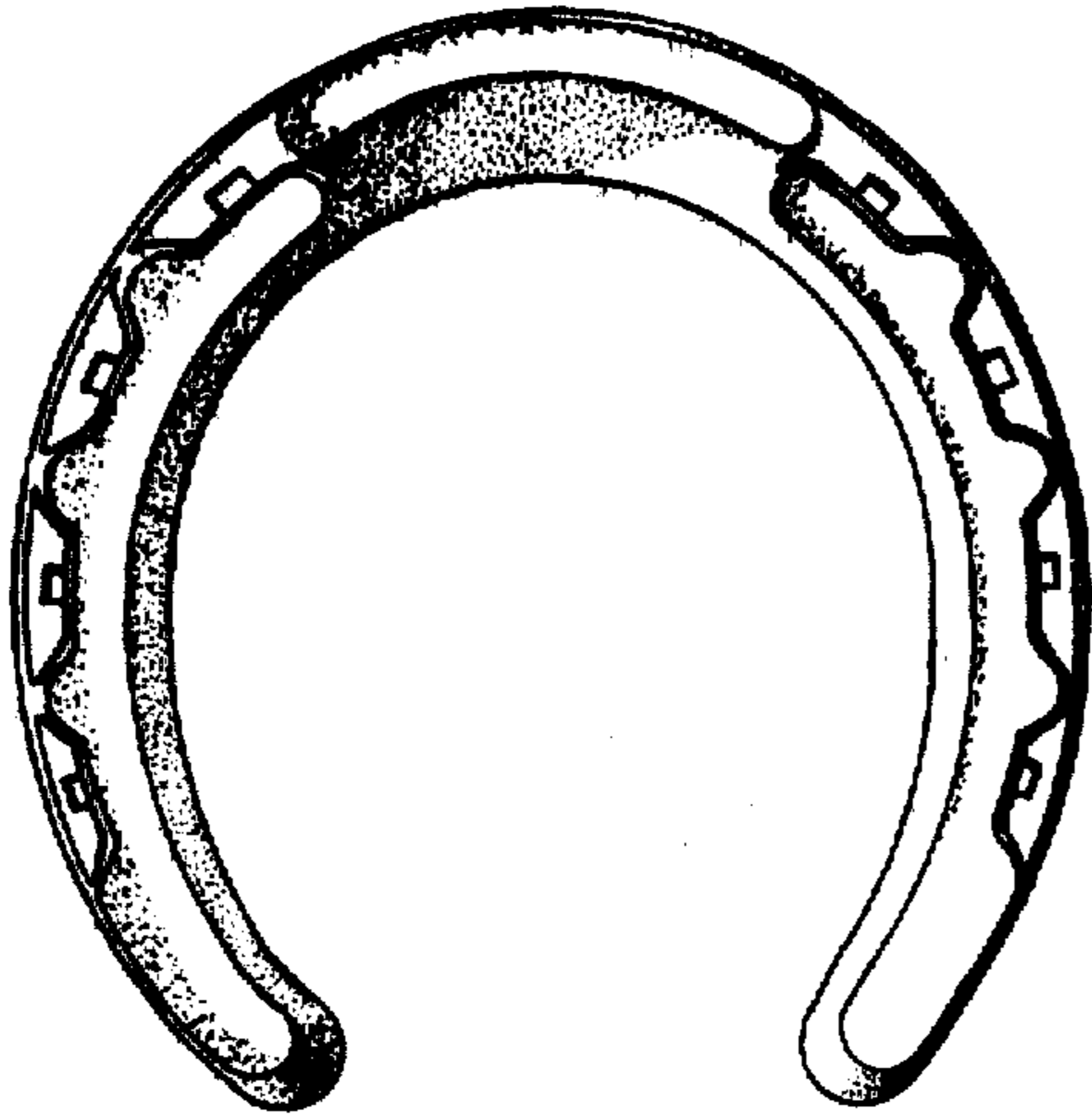

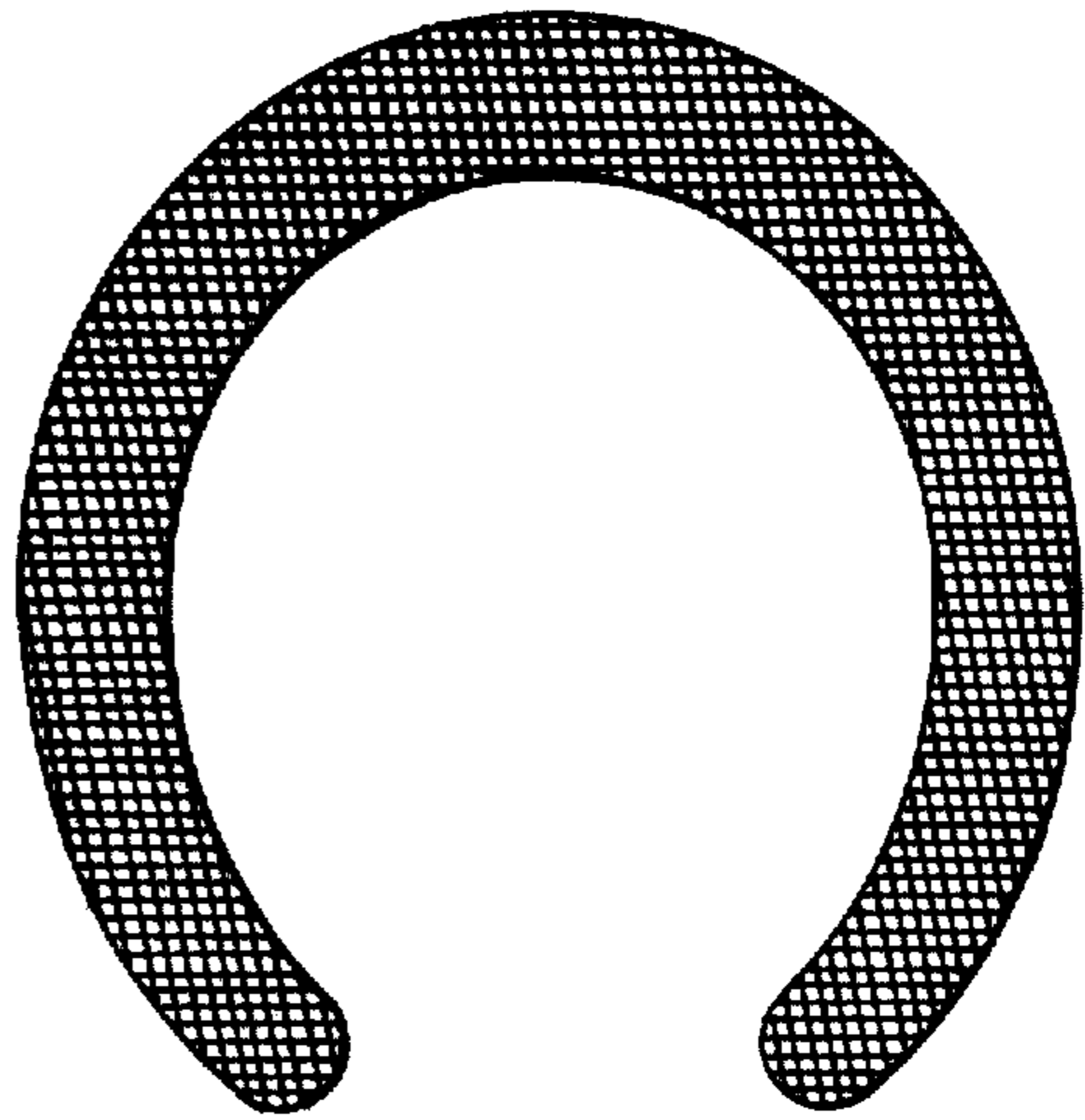

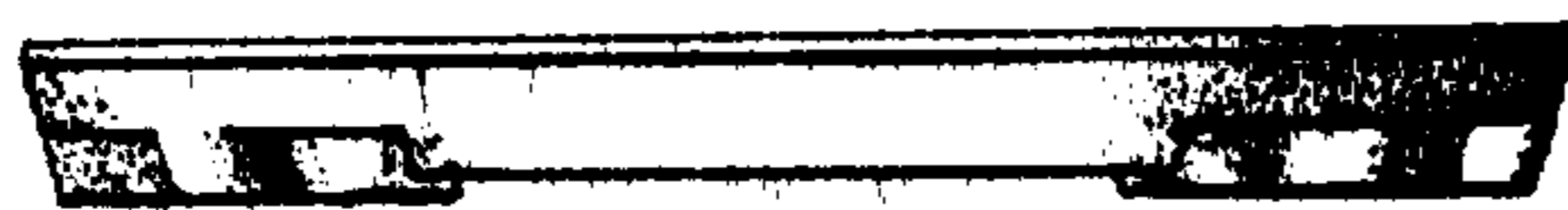
