FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a storage basket for food products showing our new design;

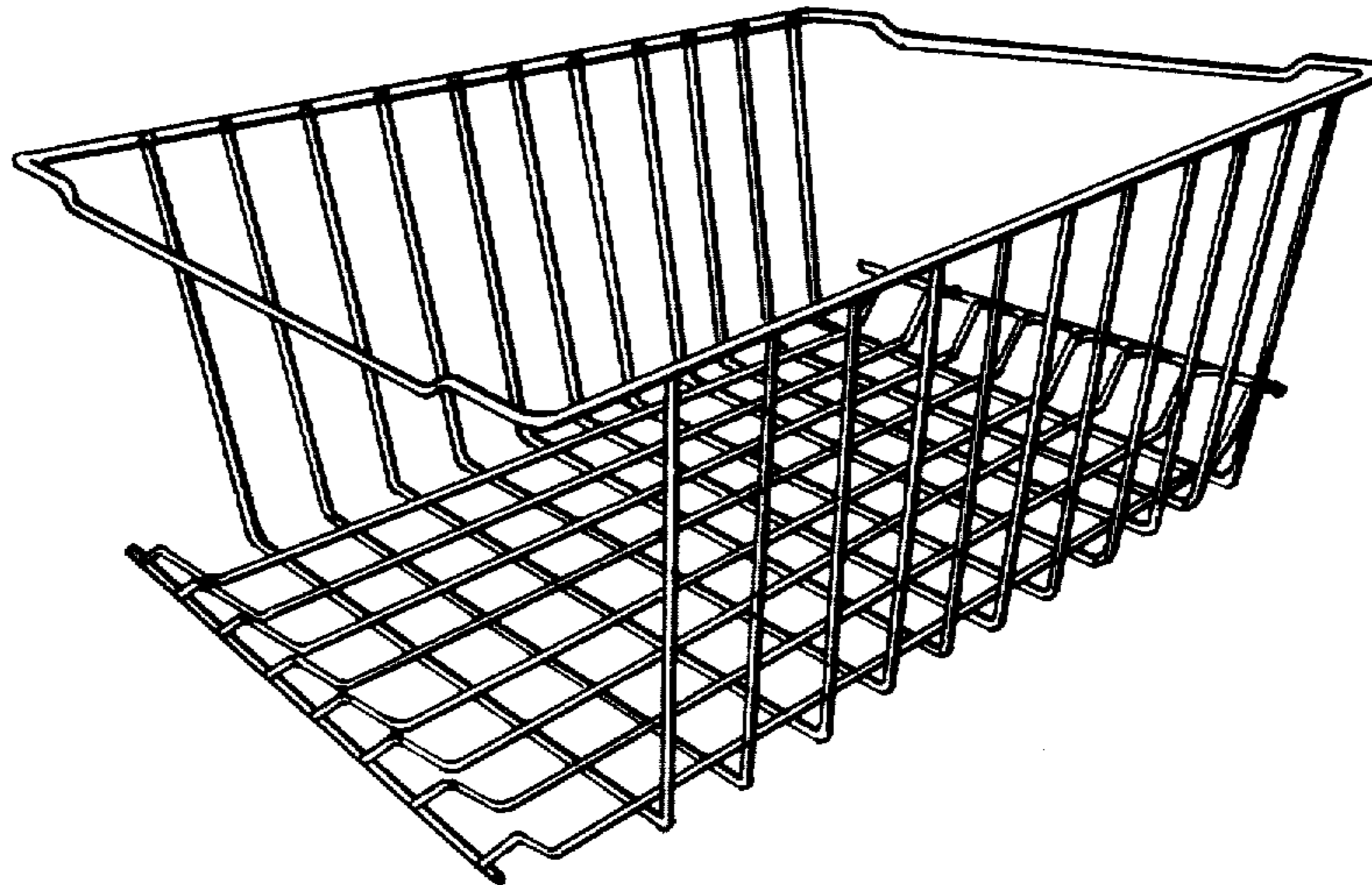

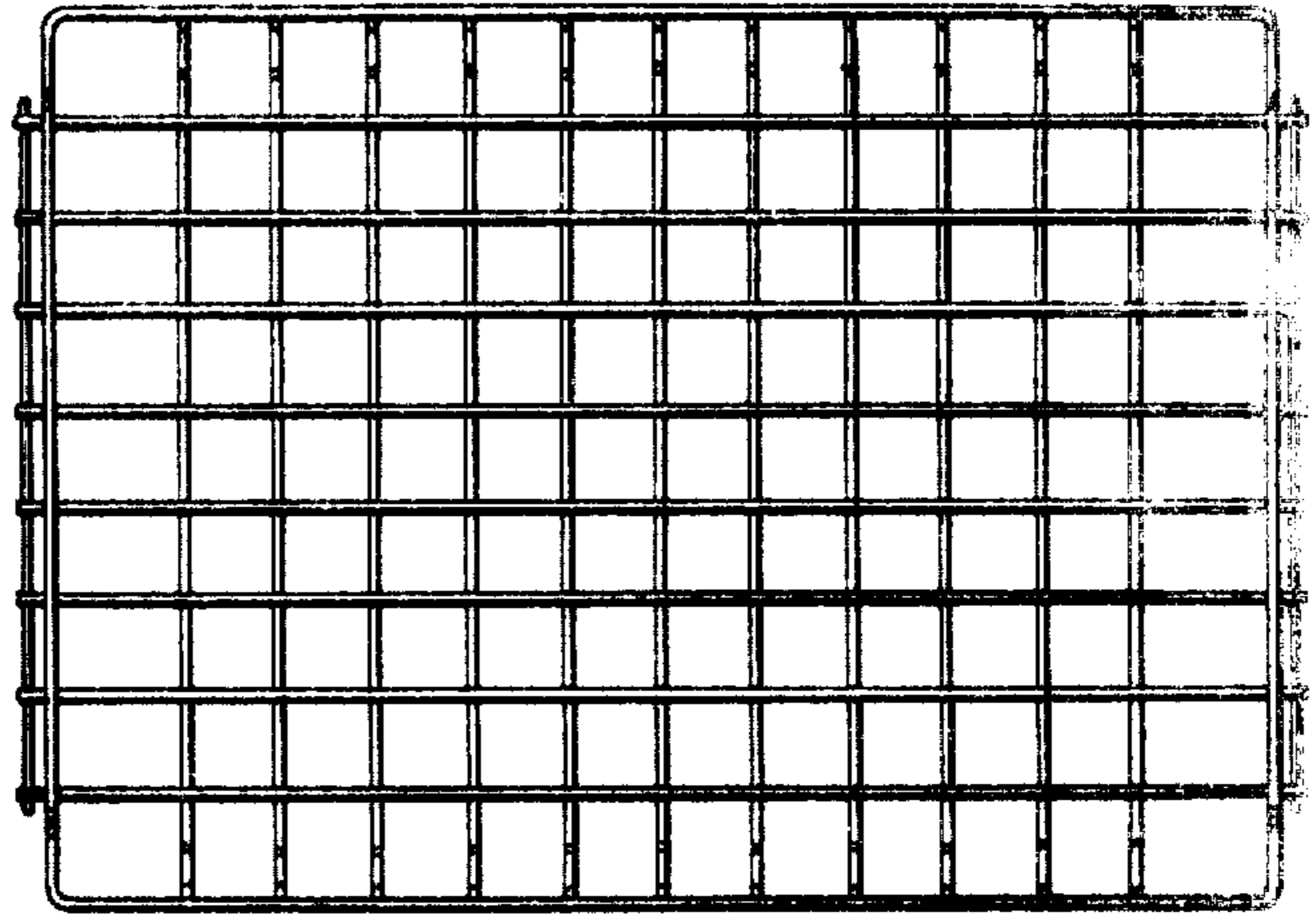

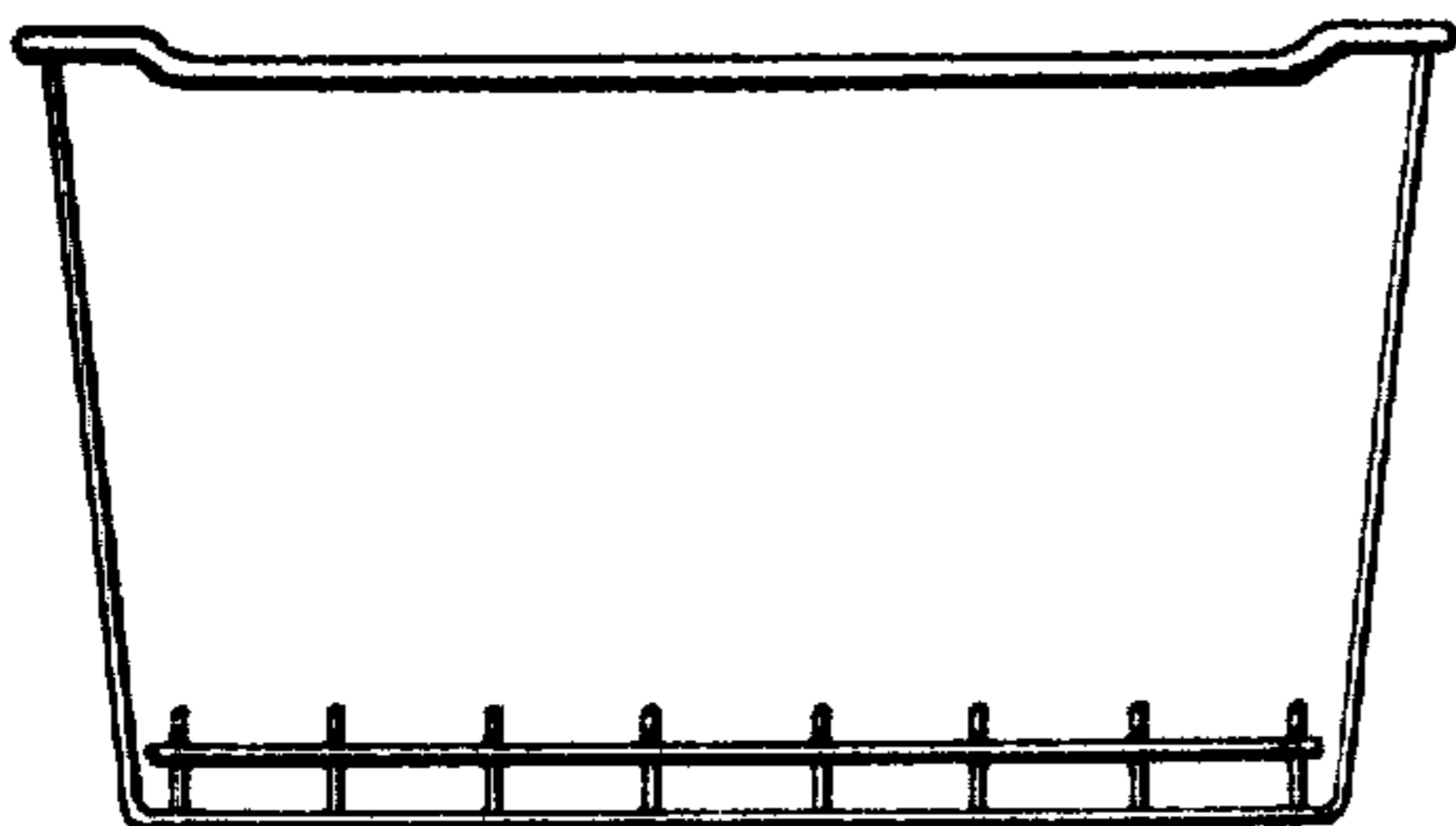

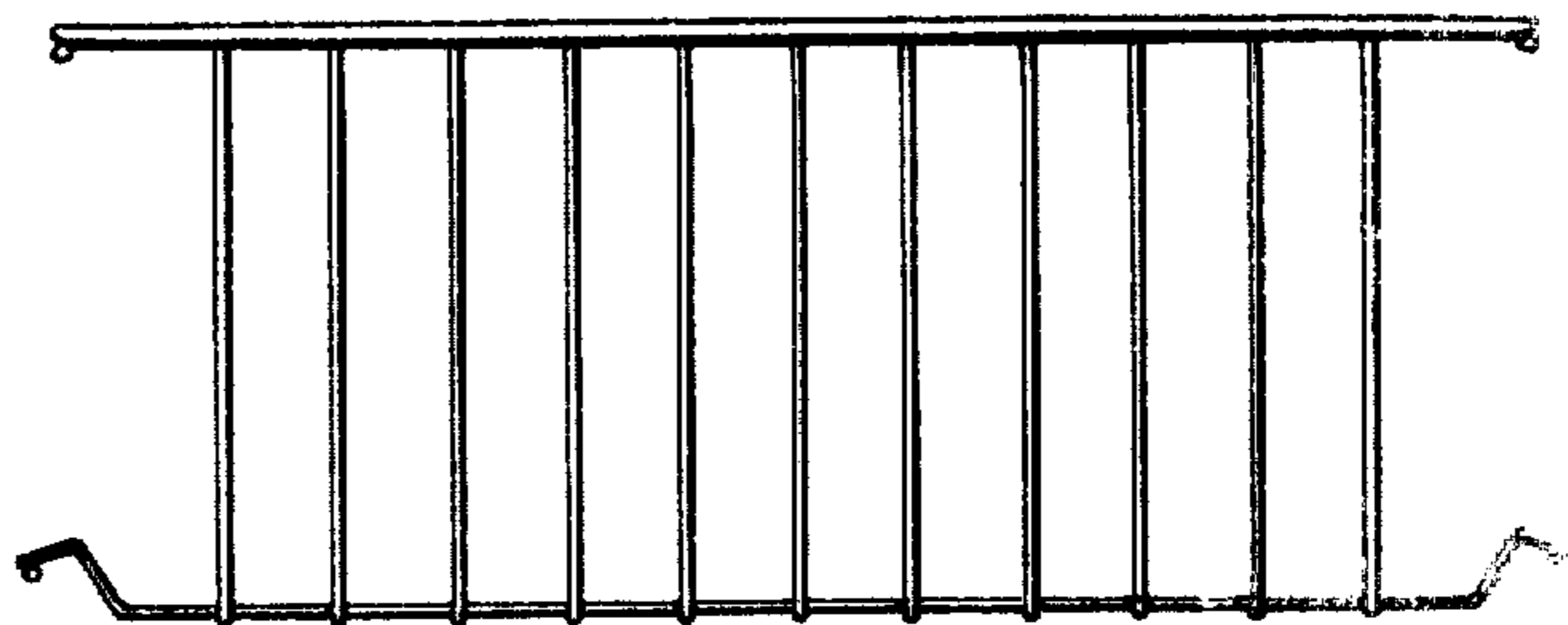

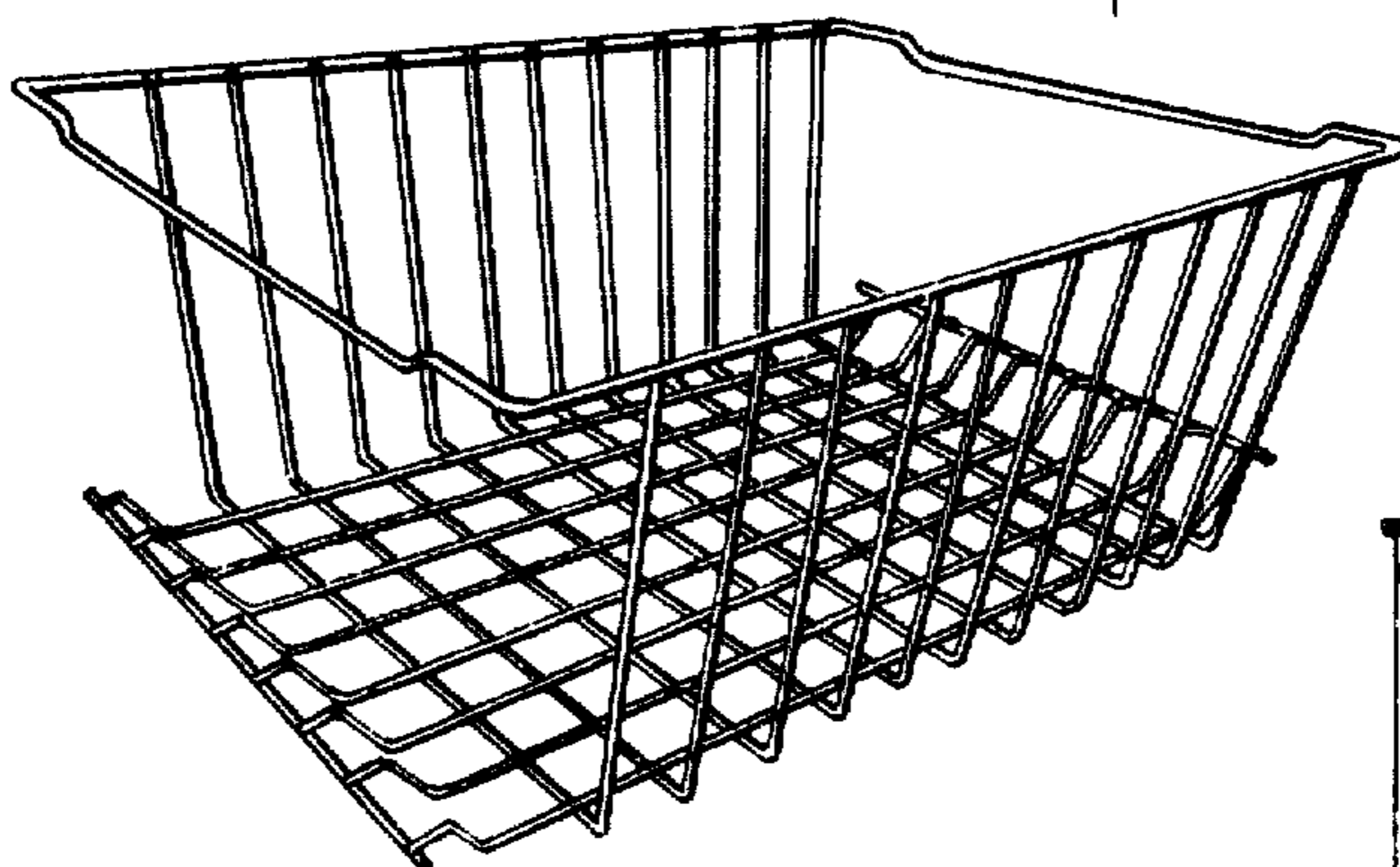
