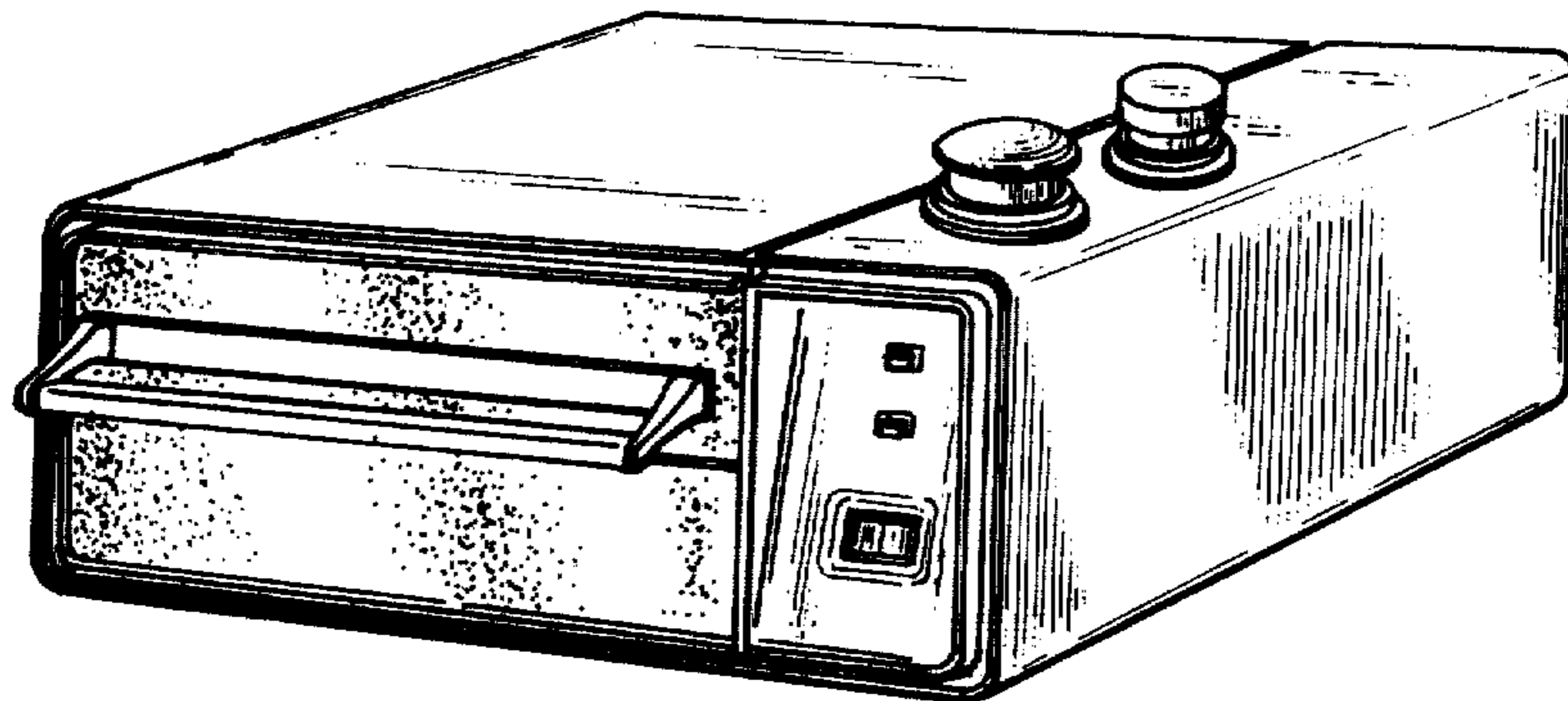

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a food steamer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a food steamer showing our new design, wherein the cover is closed; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof viewed from the left side of FIG. 2; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof viewed from the right side of FIG. 2; and FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof wherein the lid is open.



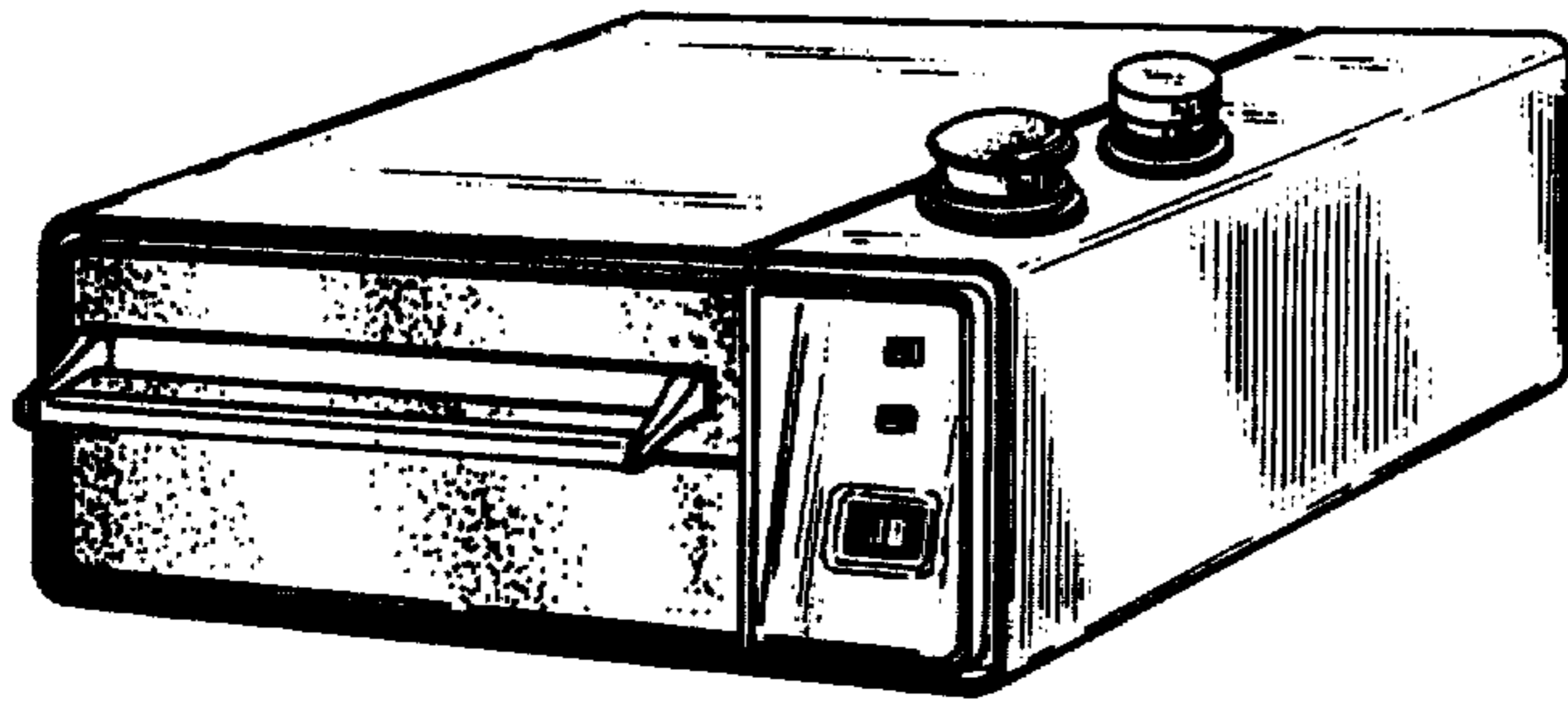

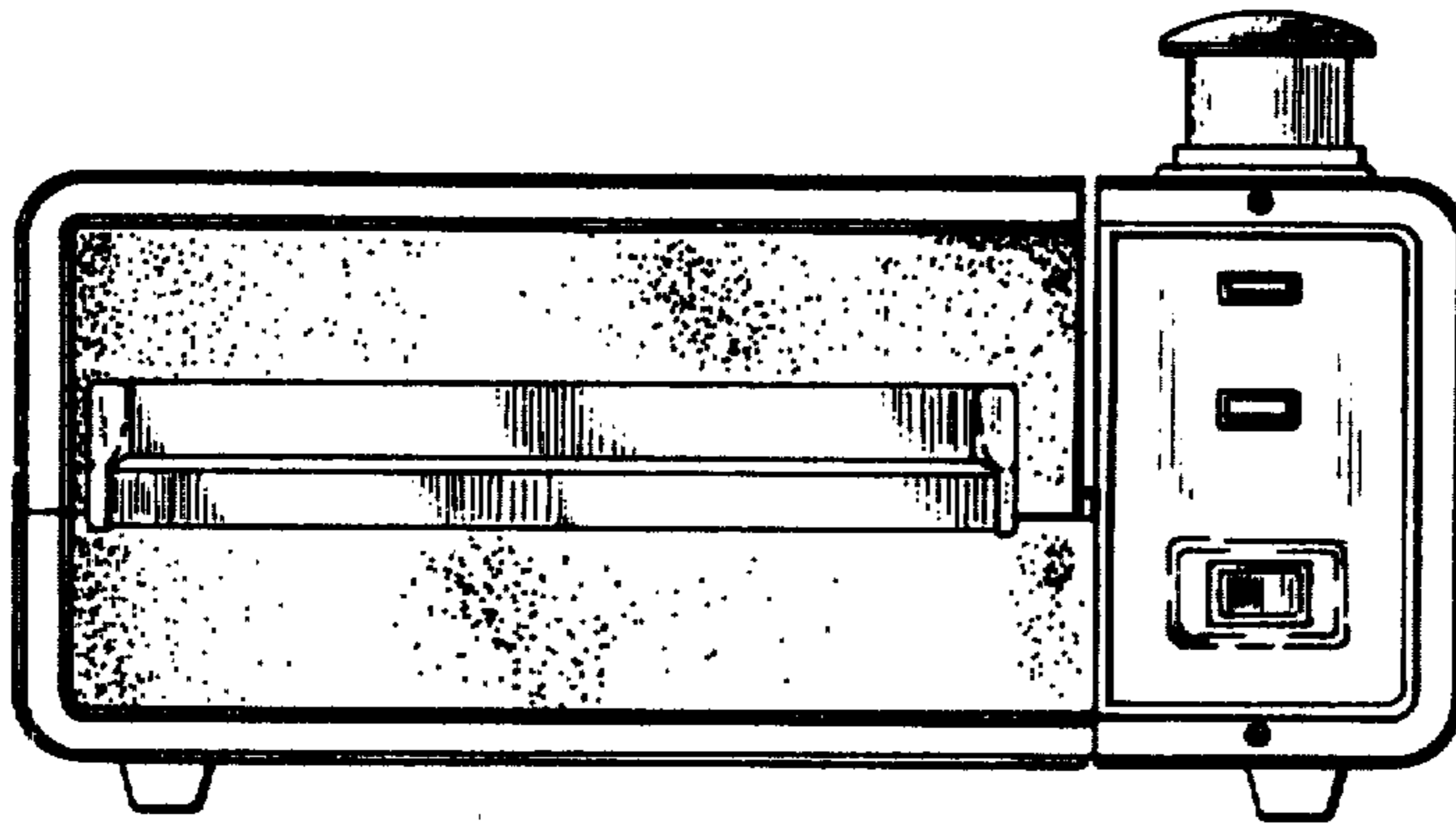

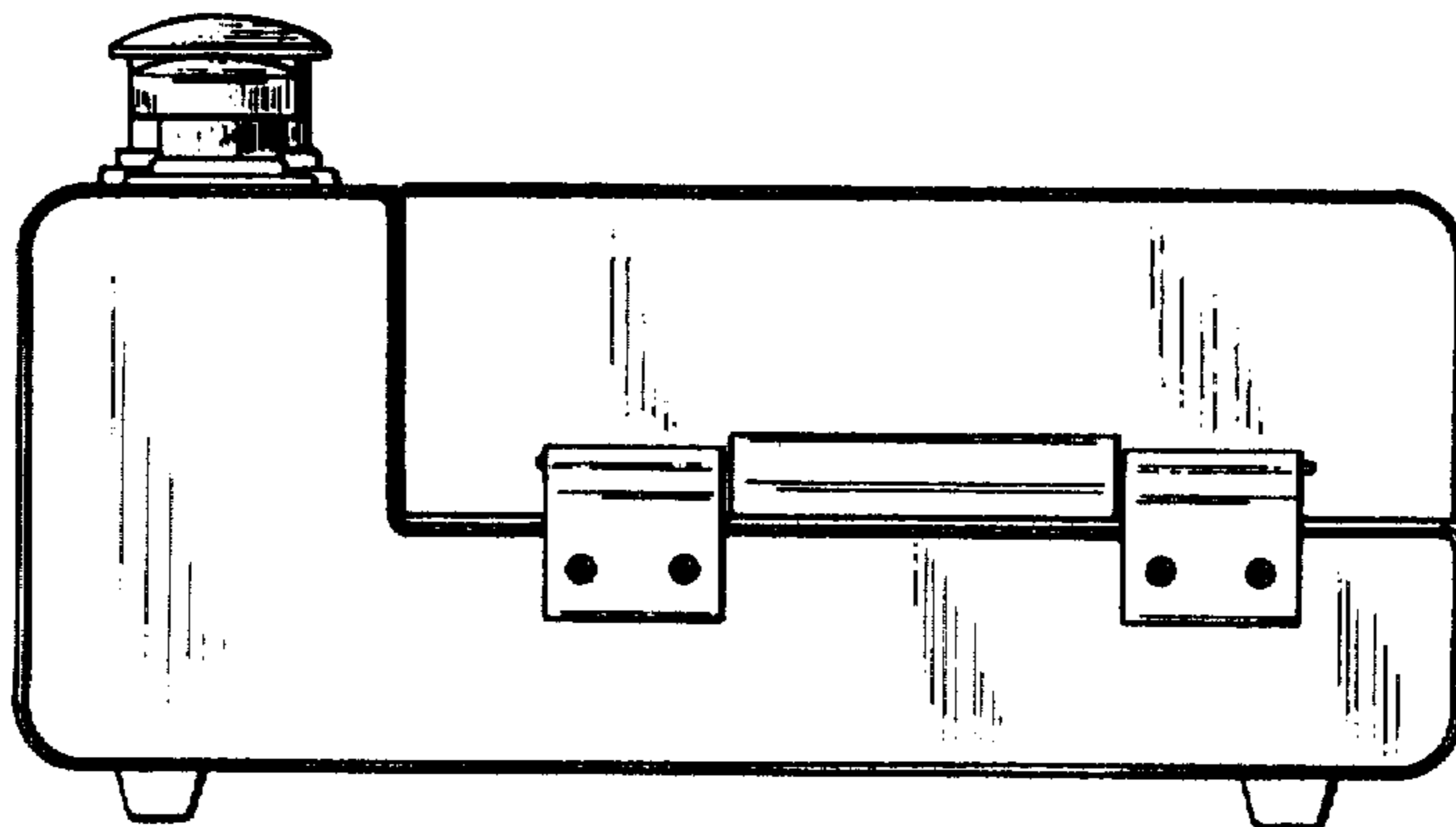

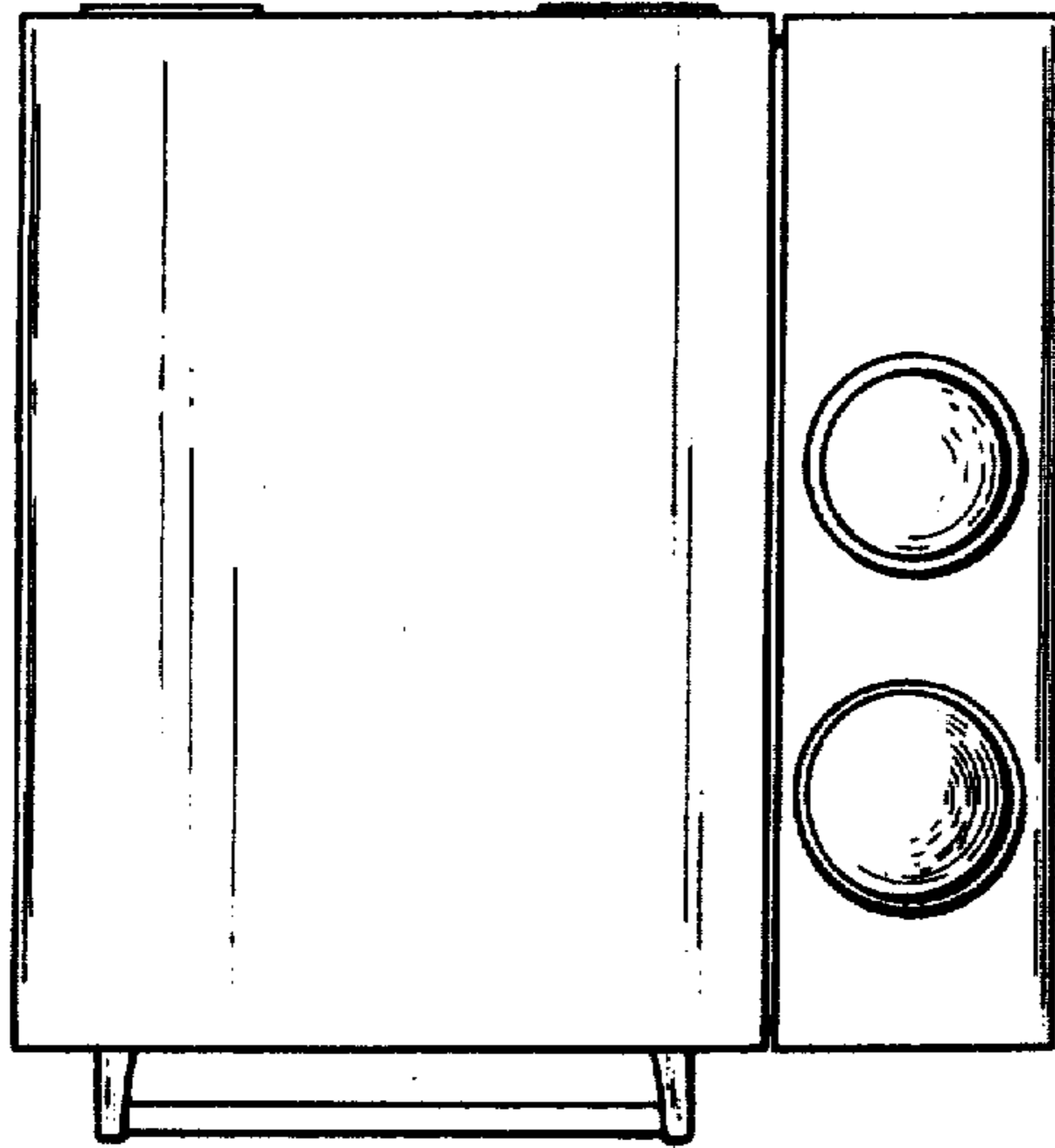

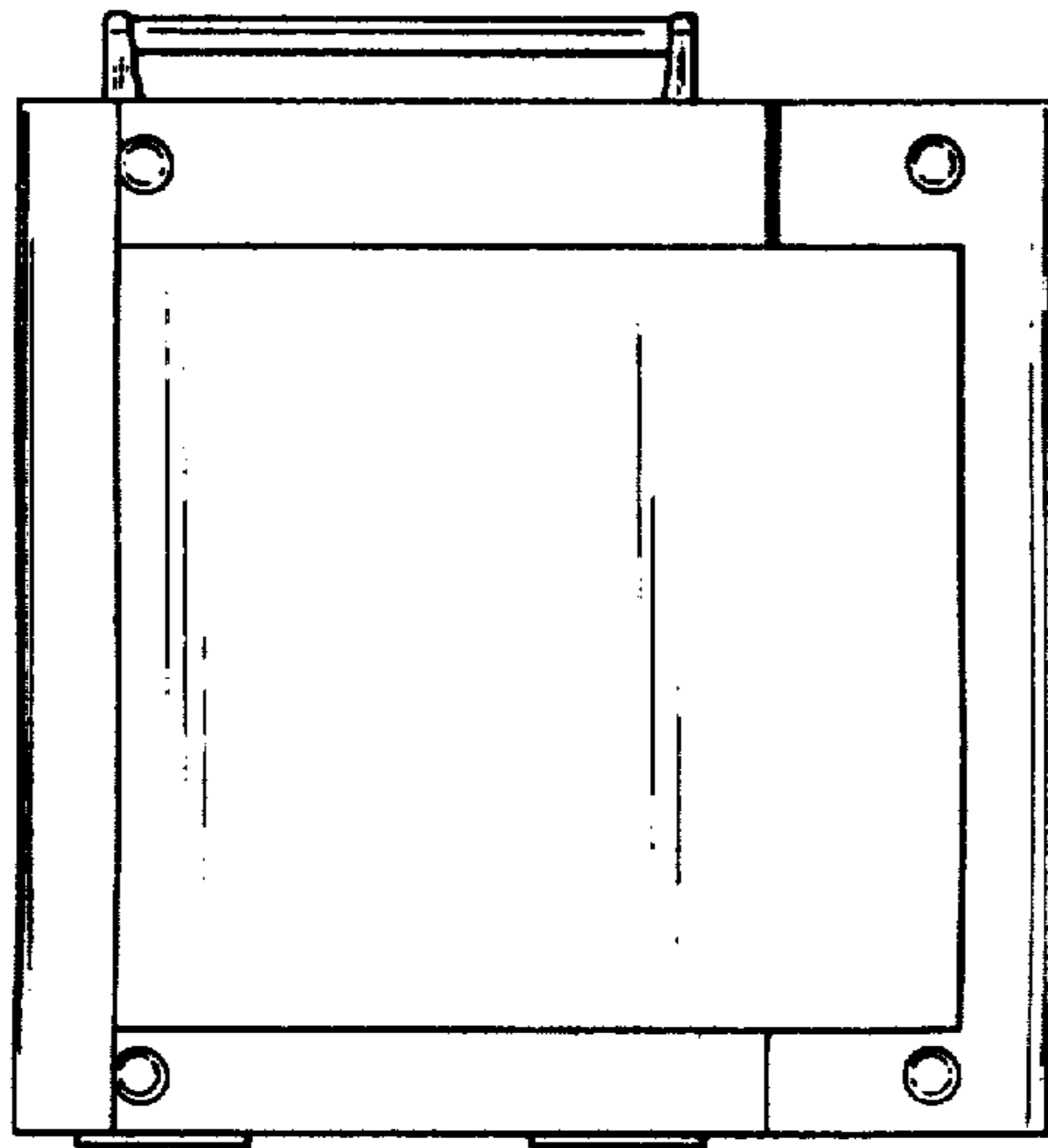

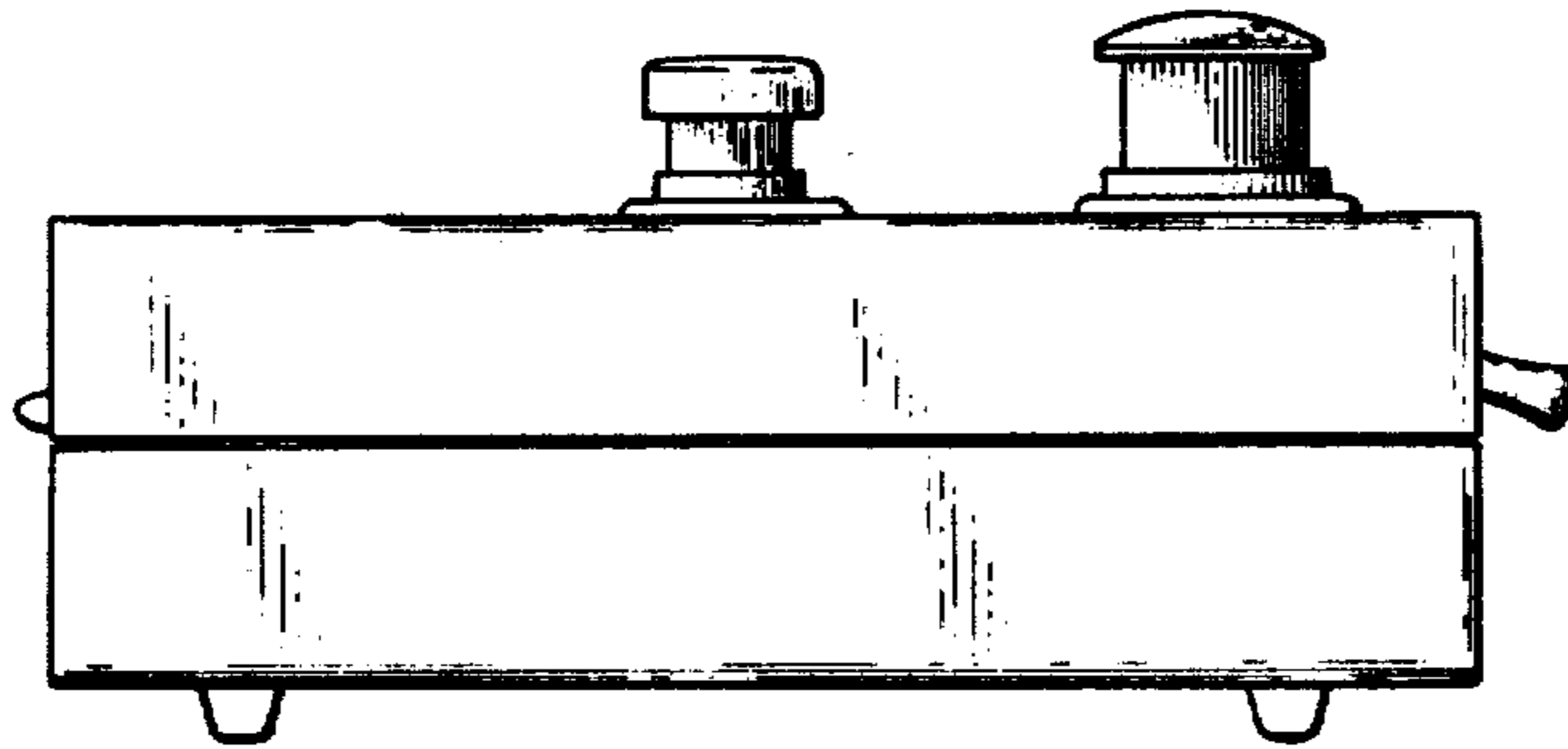

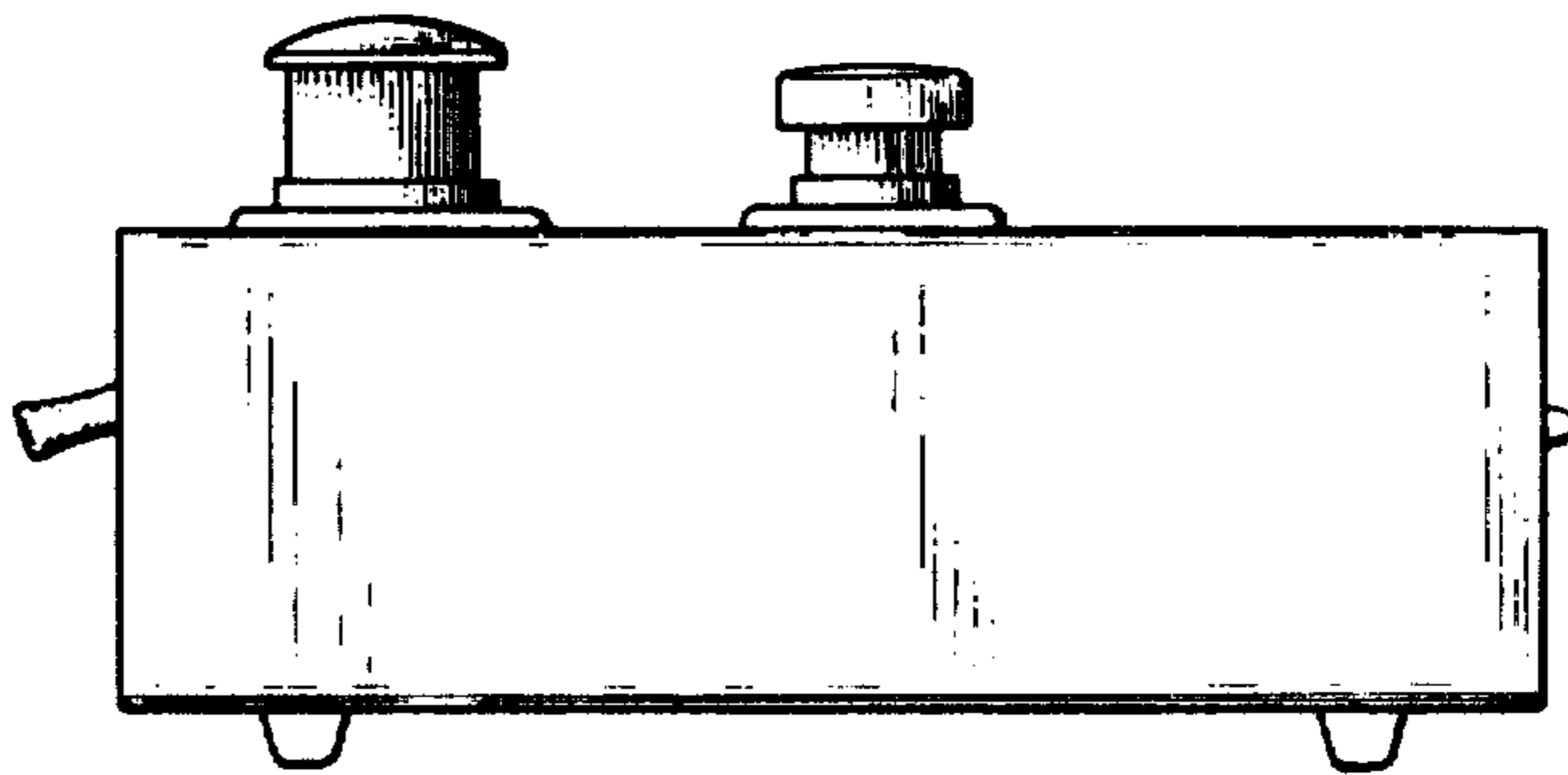

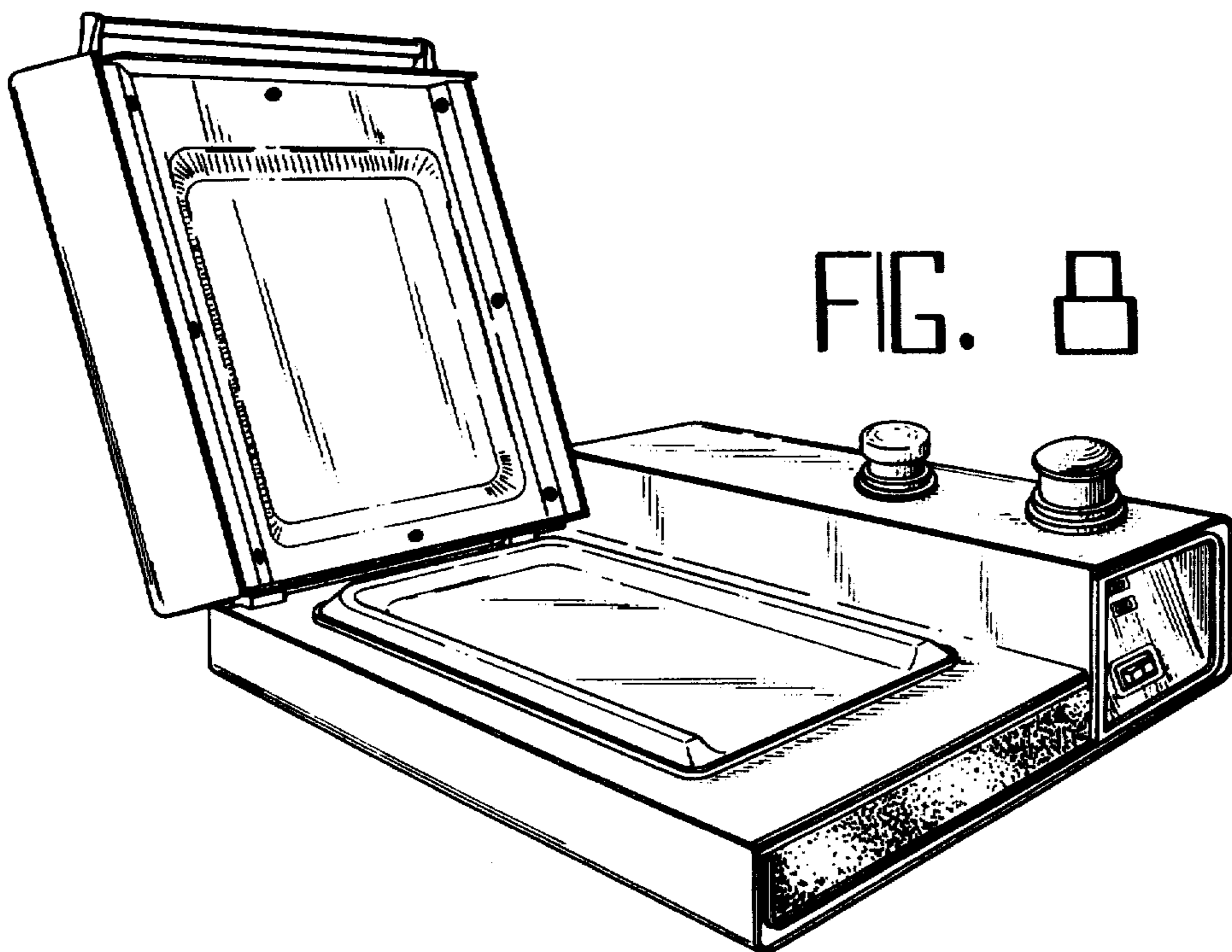
