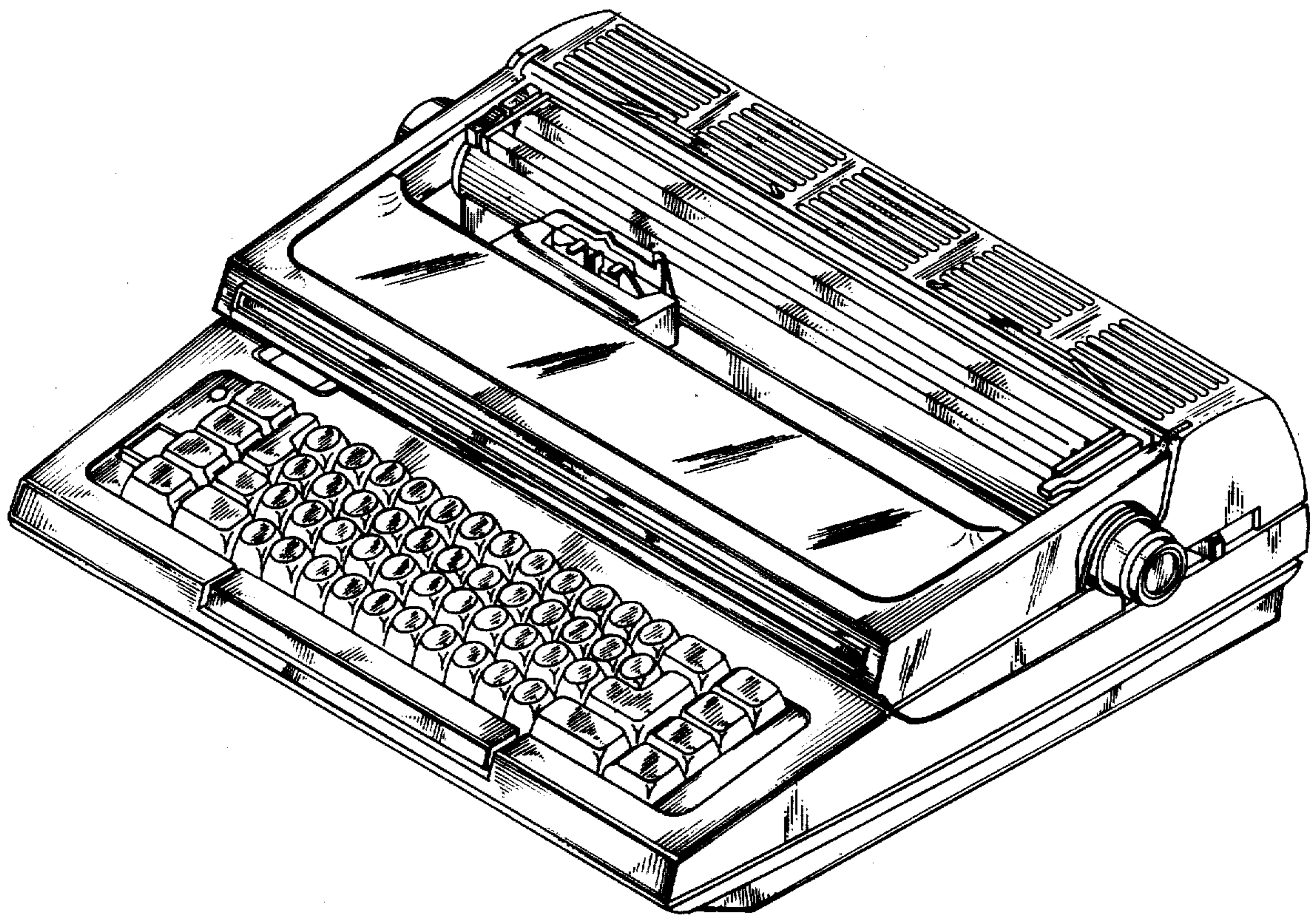

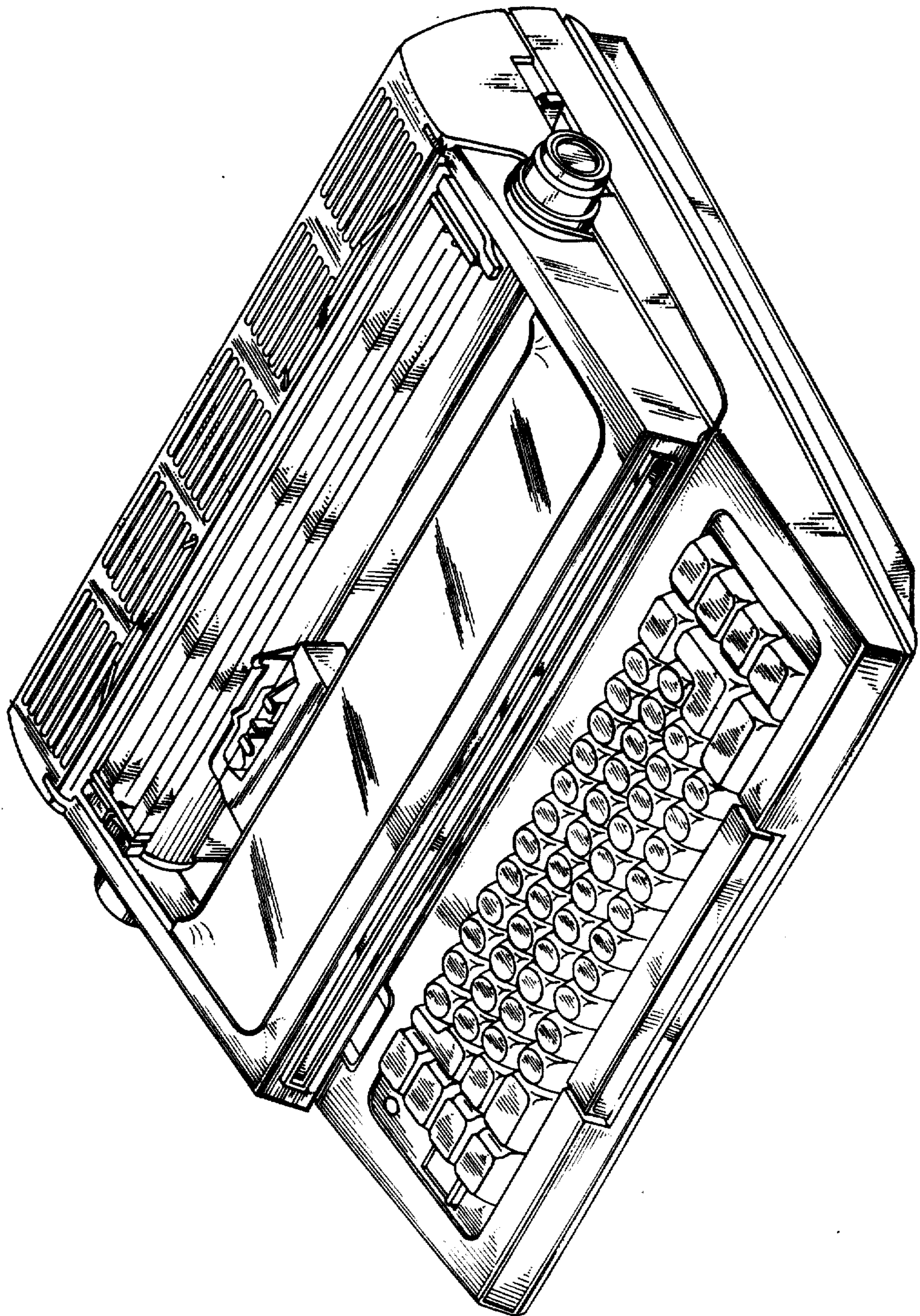

The ornamental design for a typewriter, as shown.

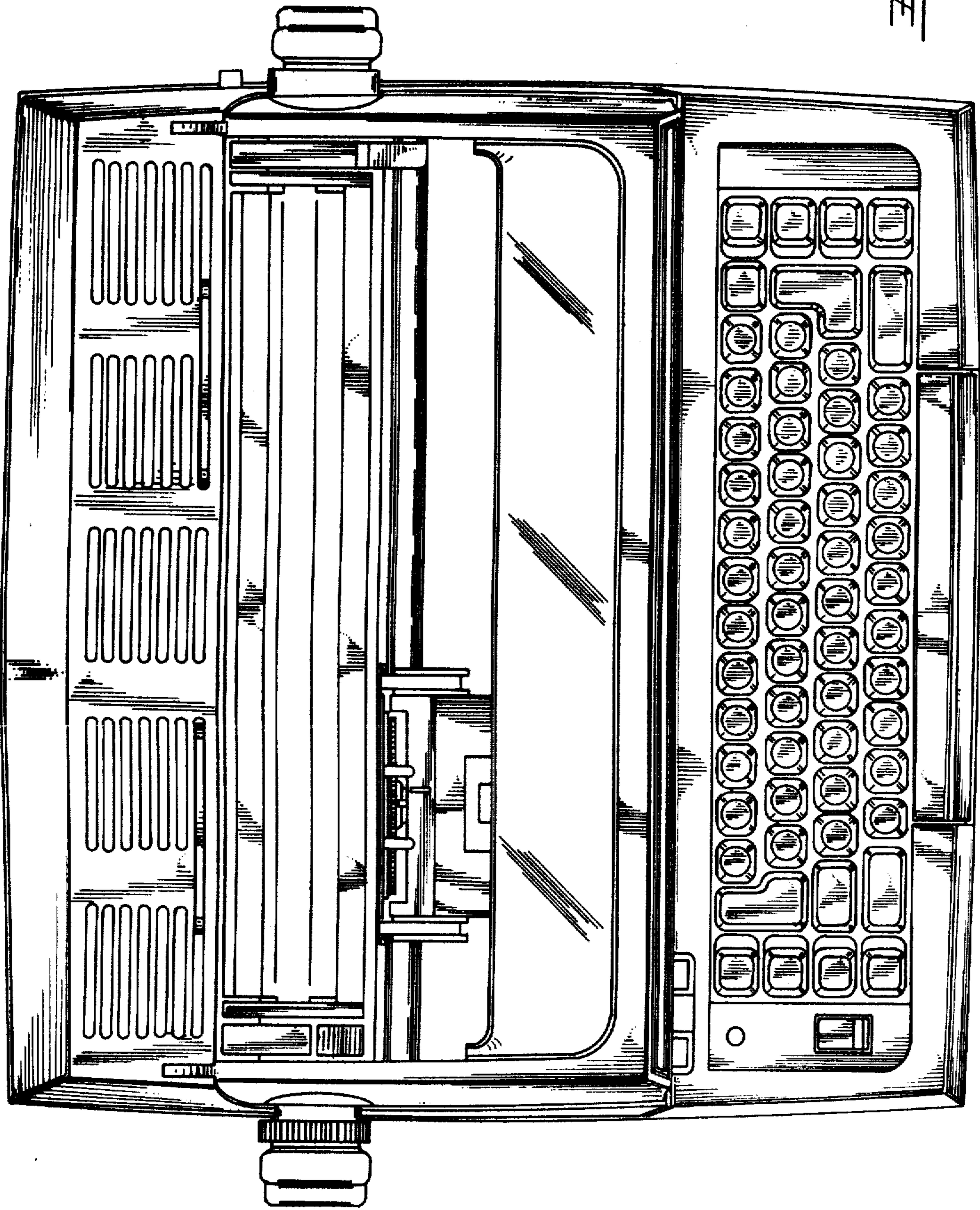
DESCRIPTION

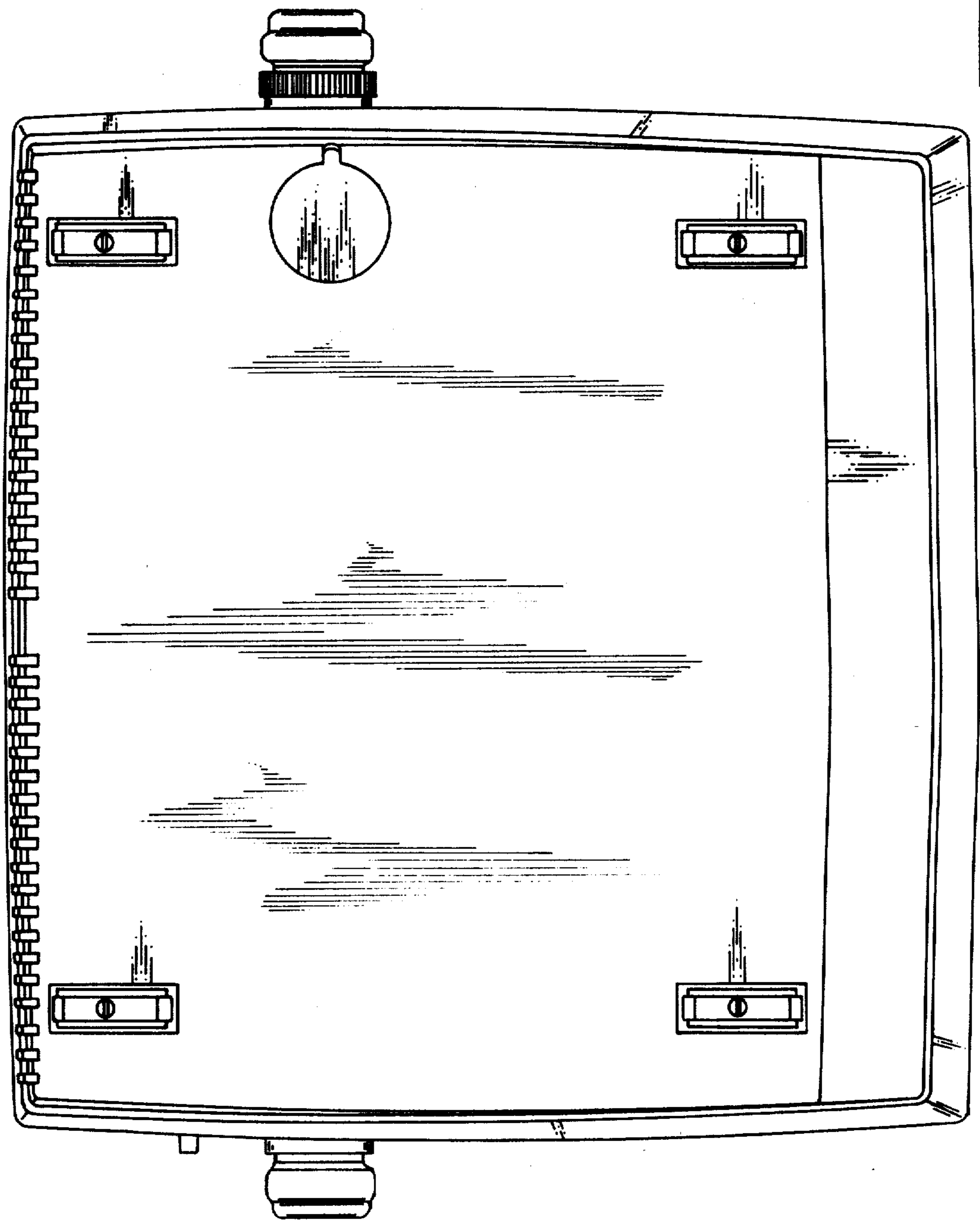
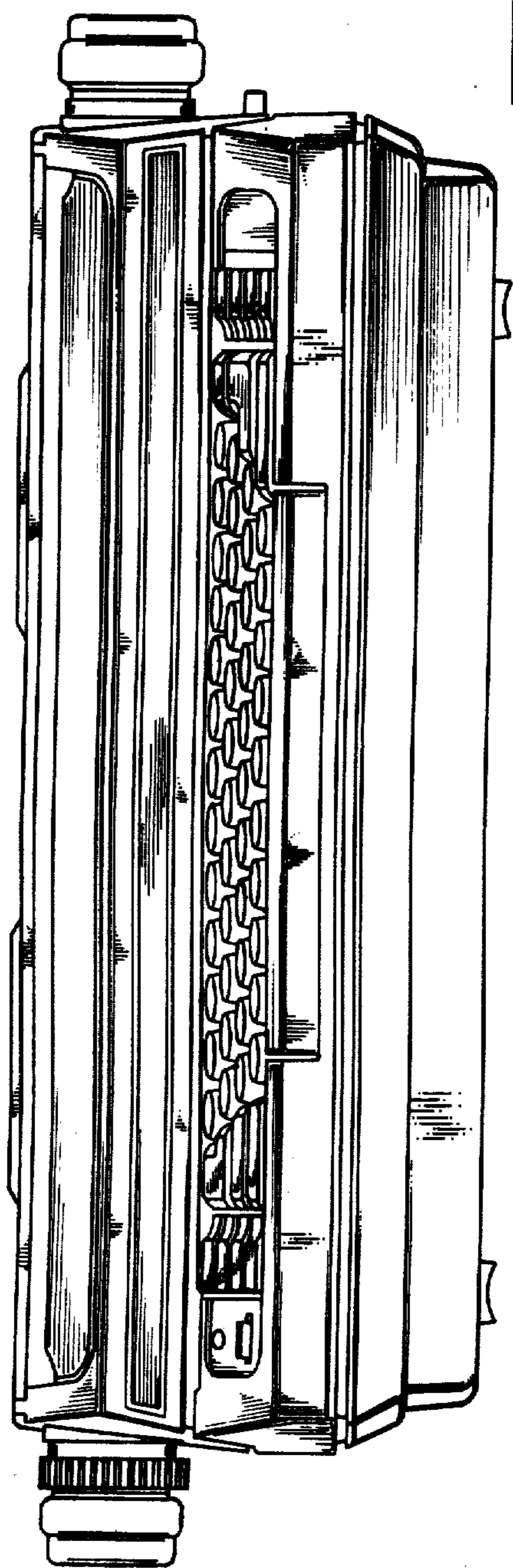
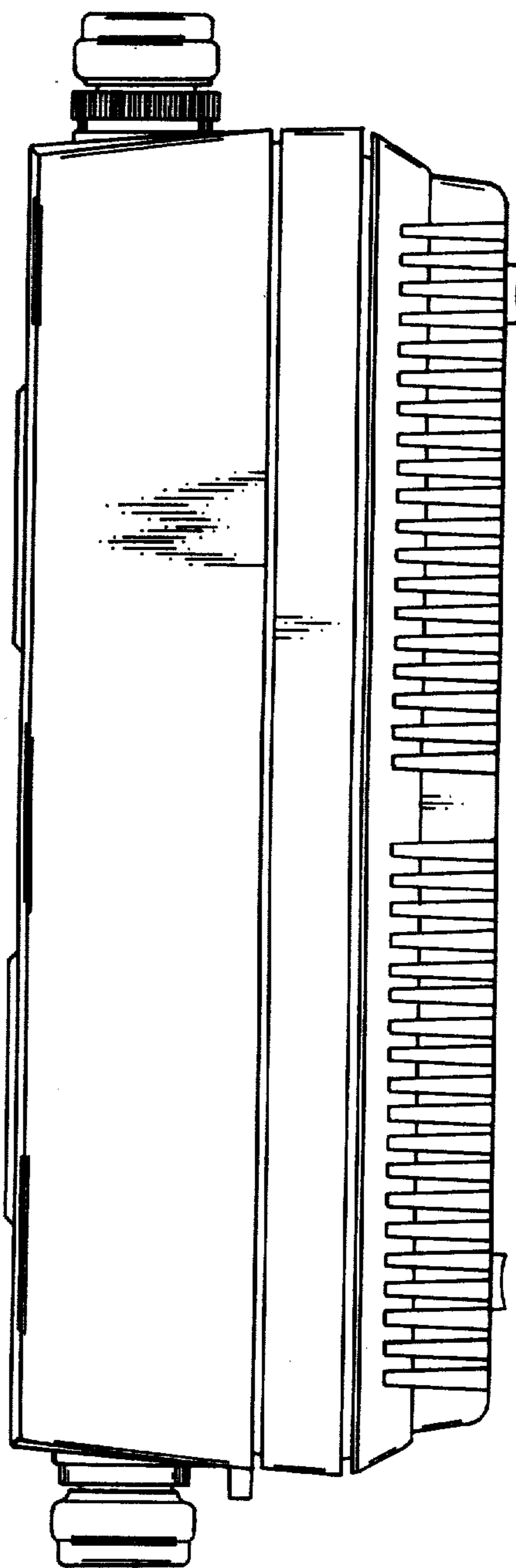

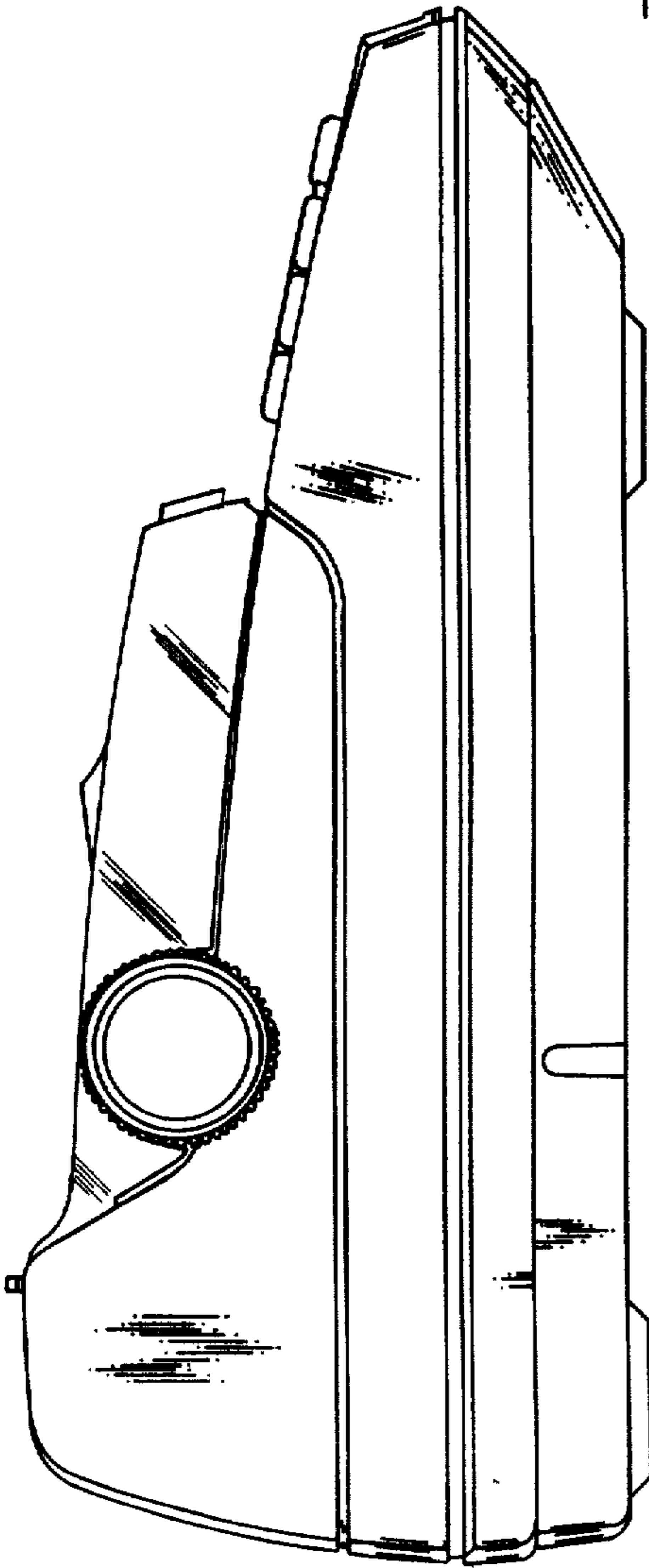

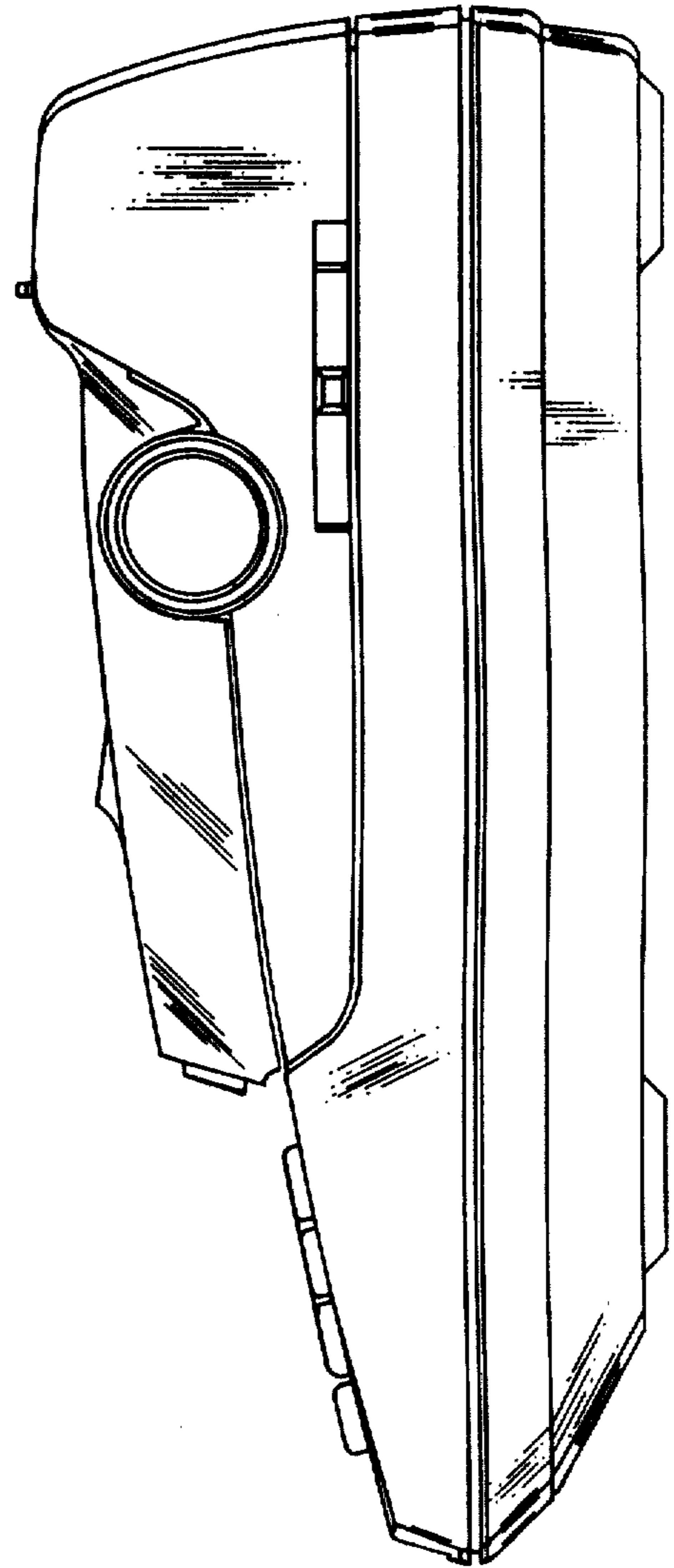
