FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the quizzer toy.

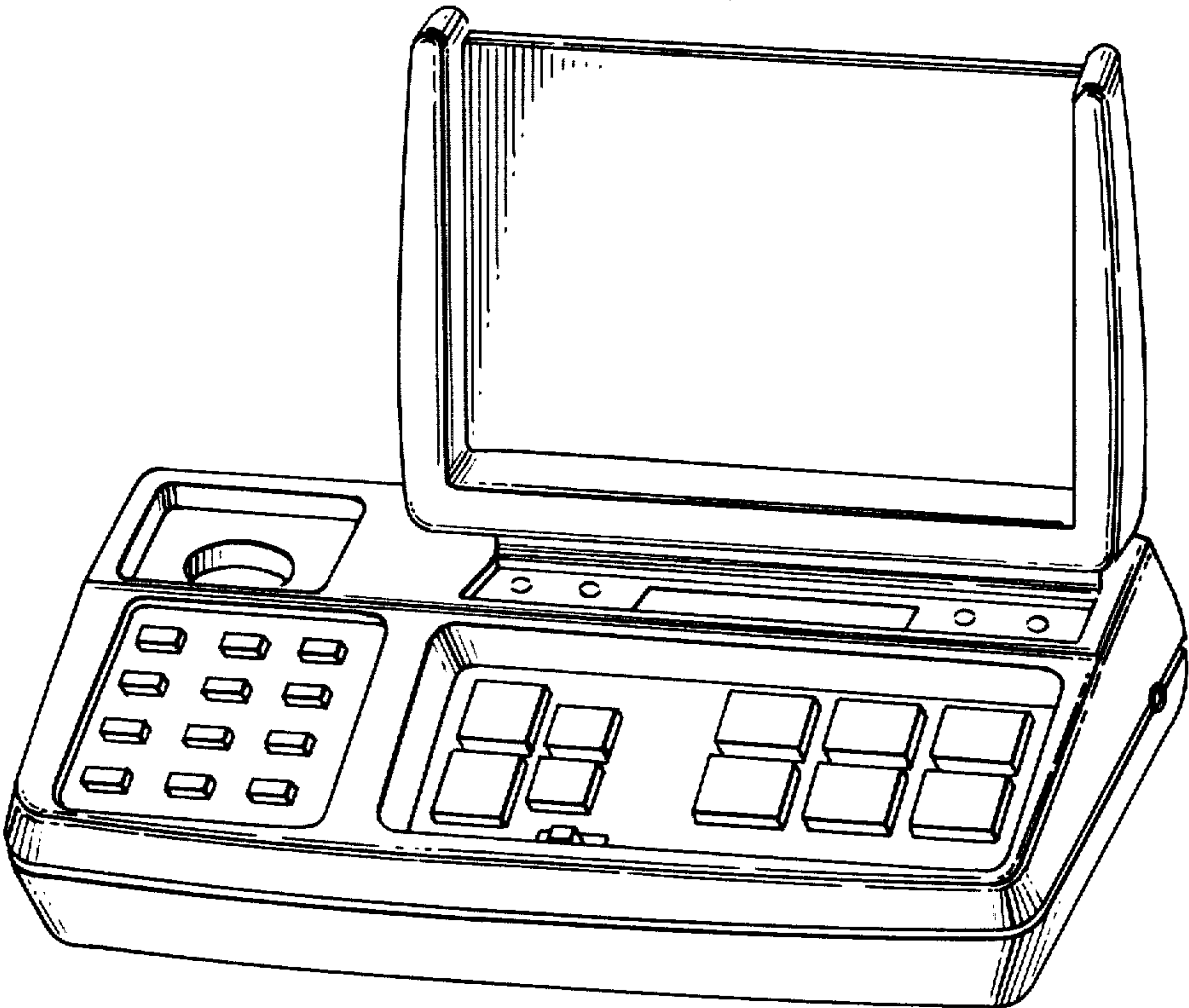

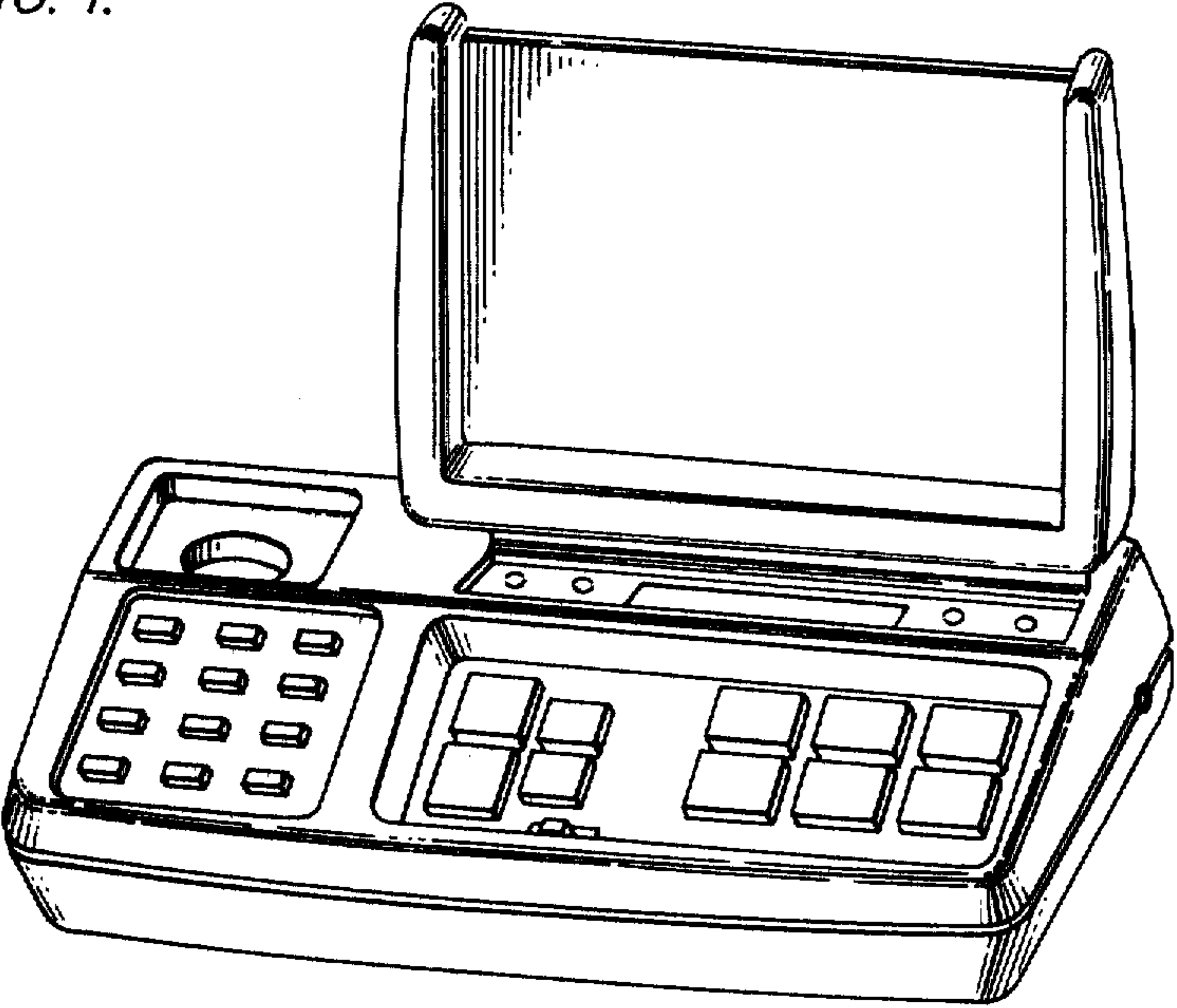

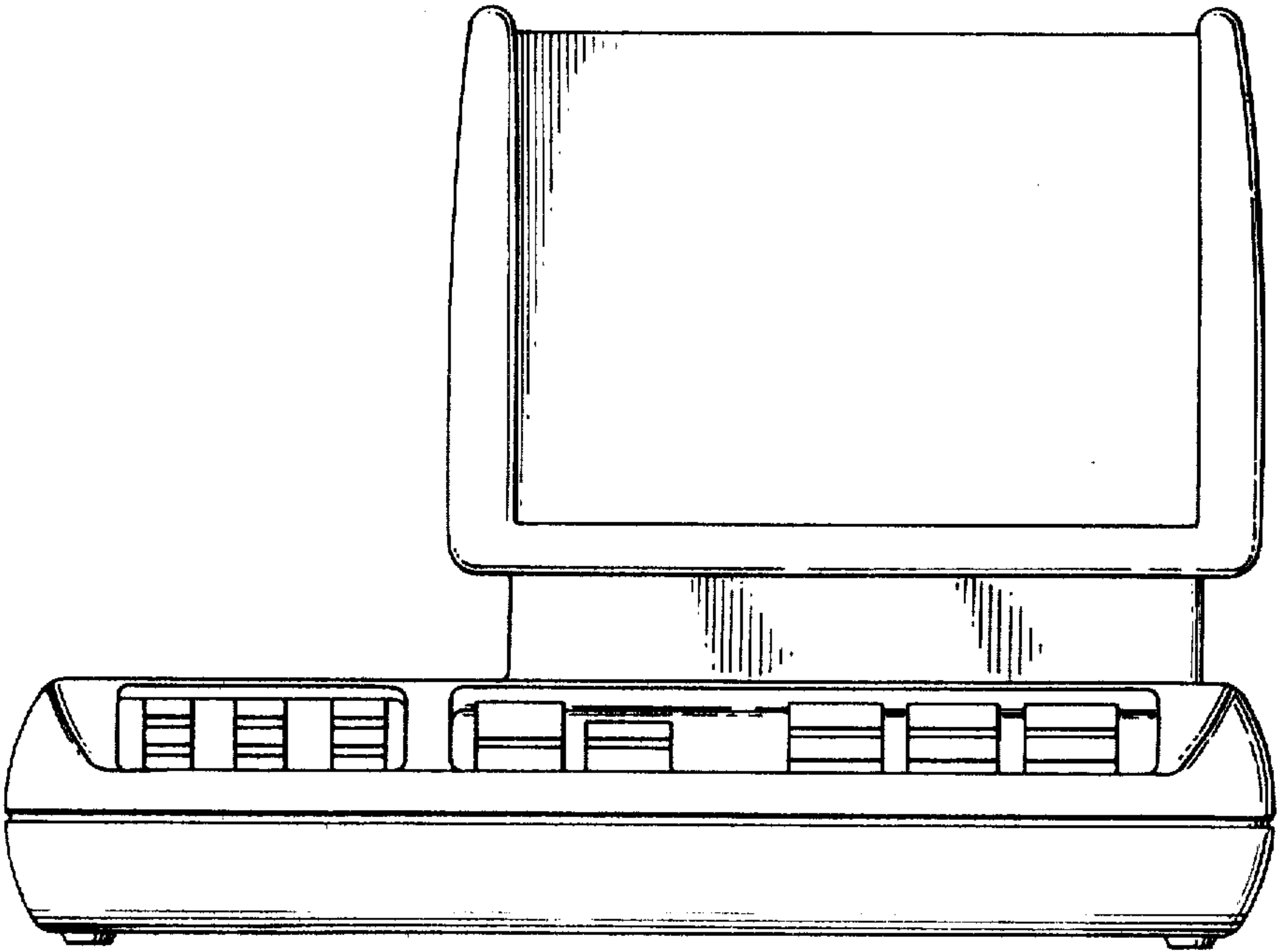

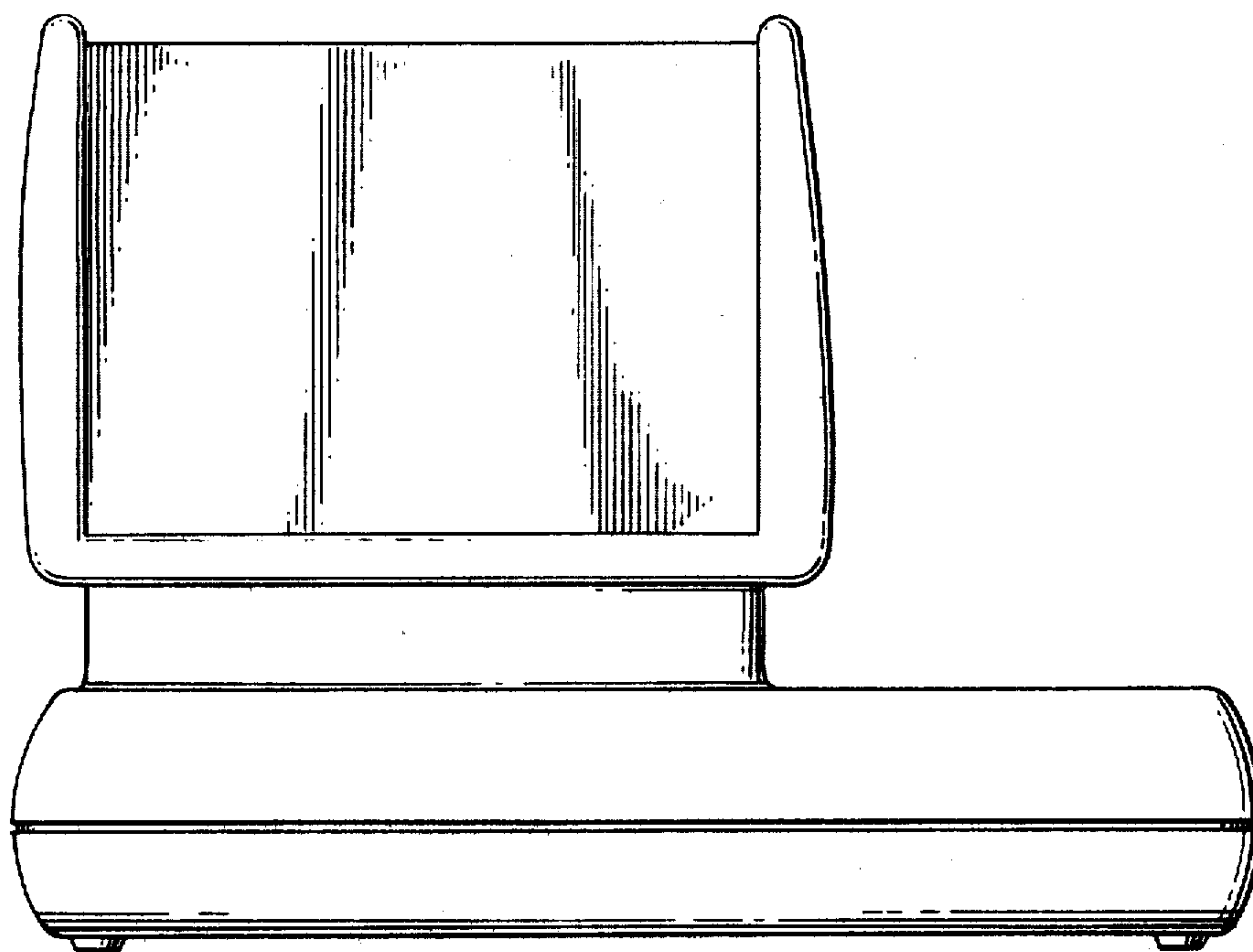

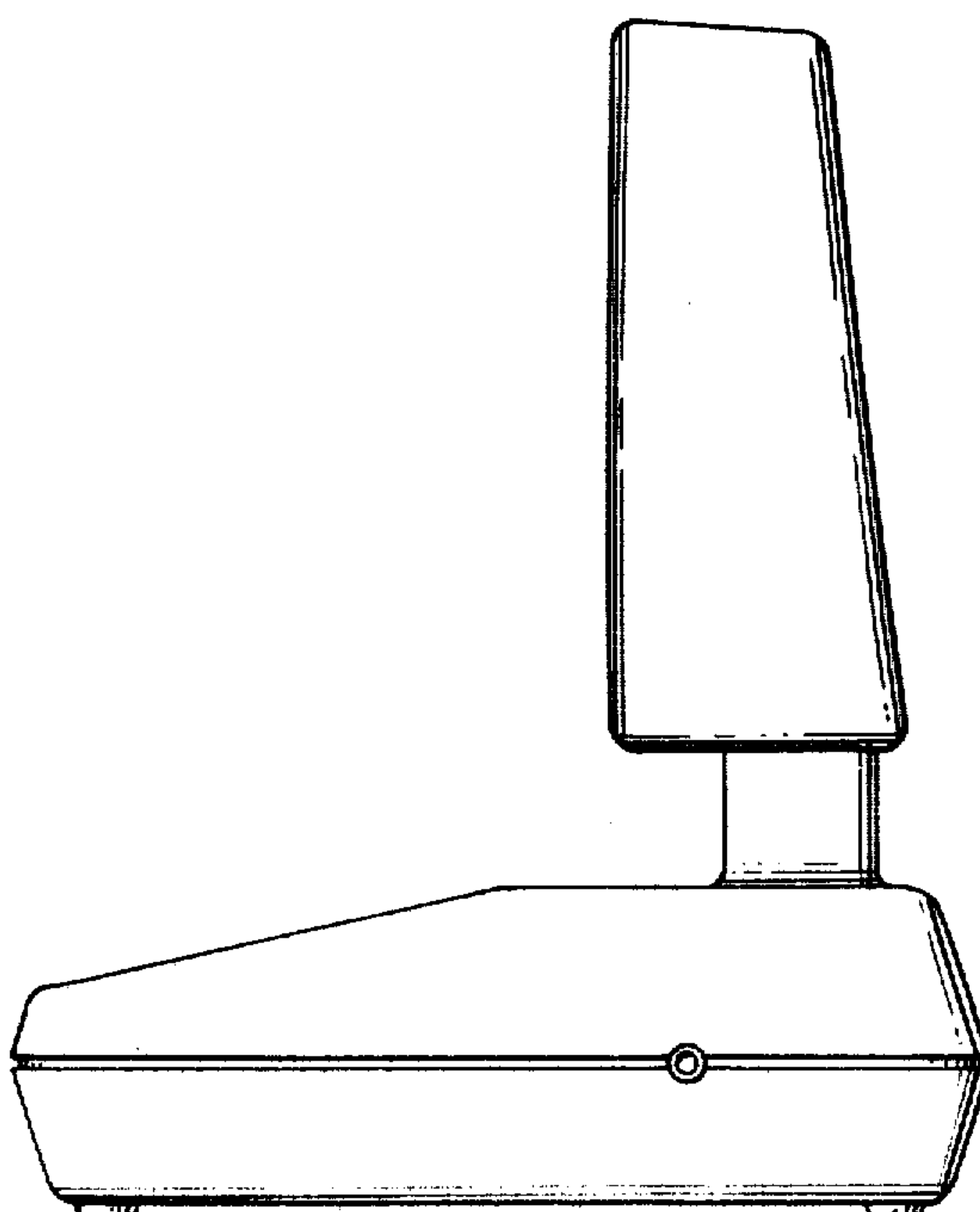

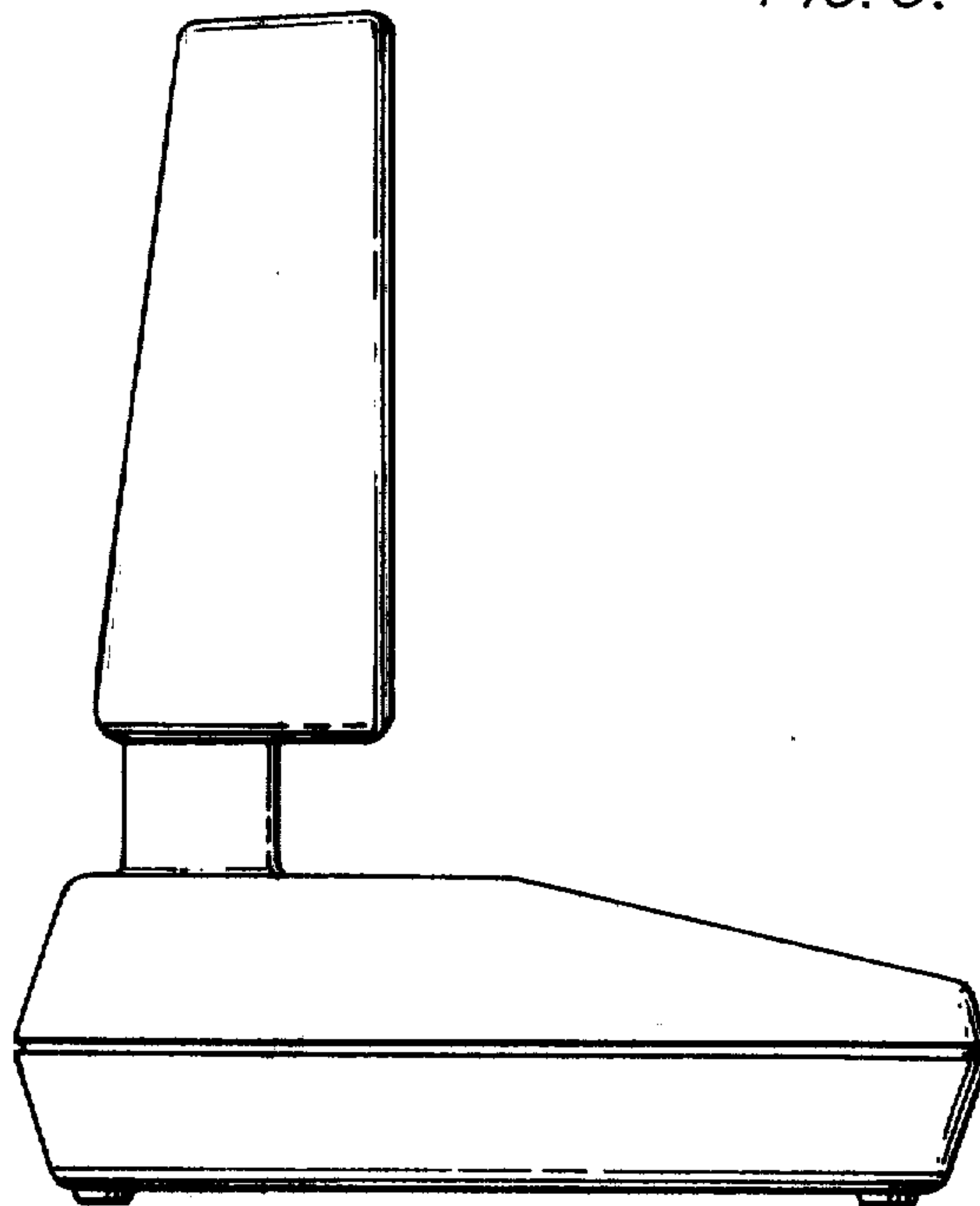
