DESCRIPTION

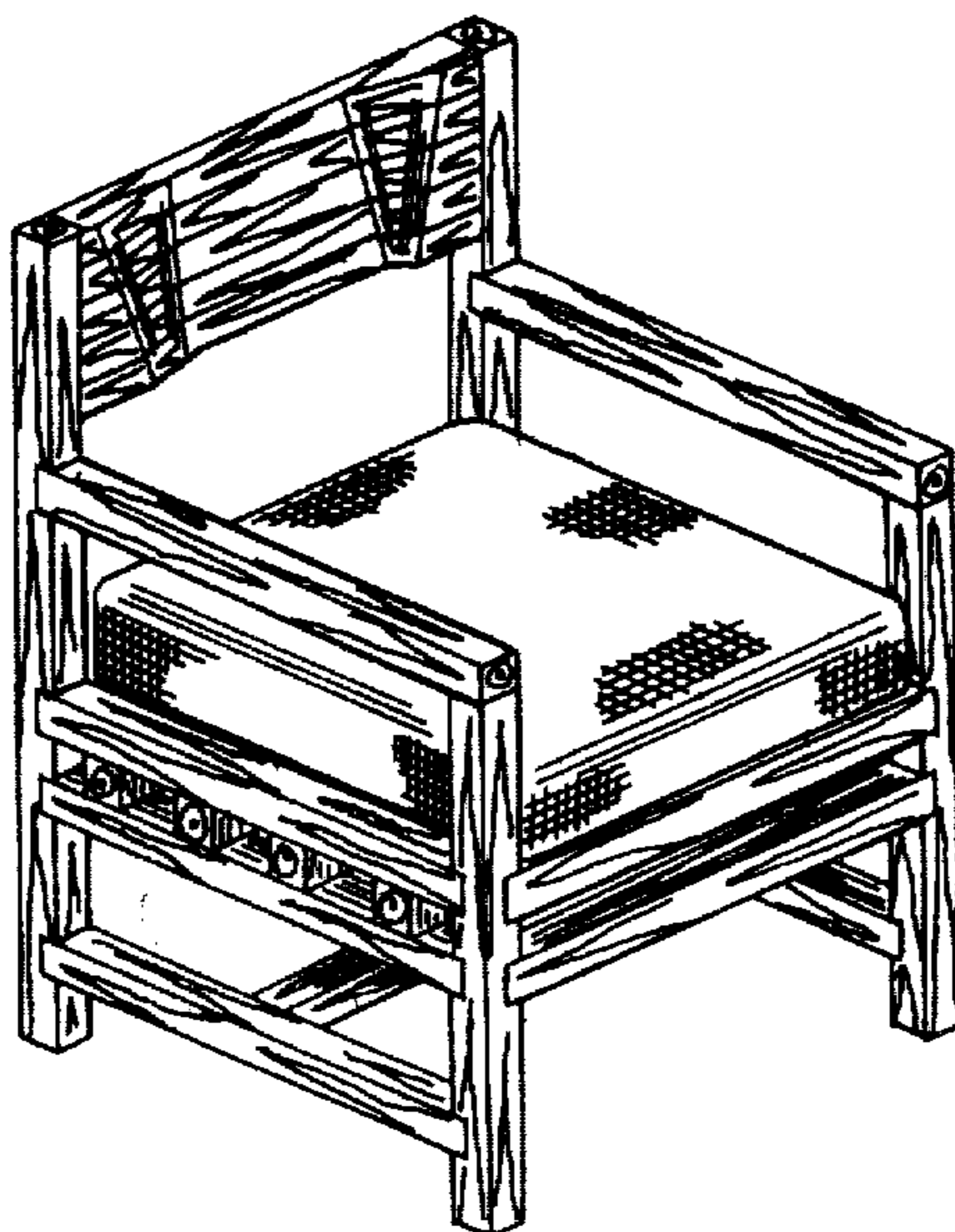
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing the design of the present invention.

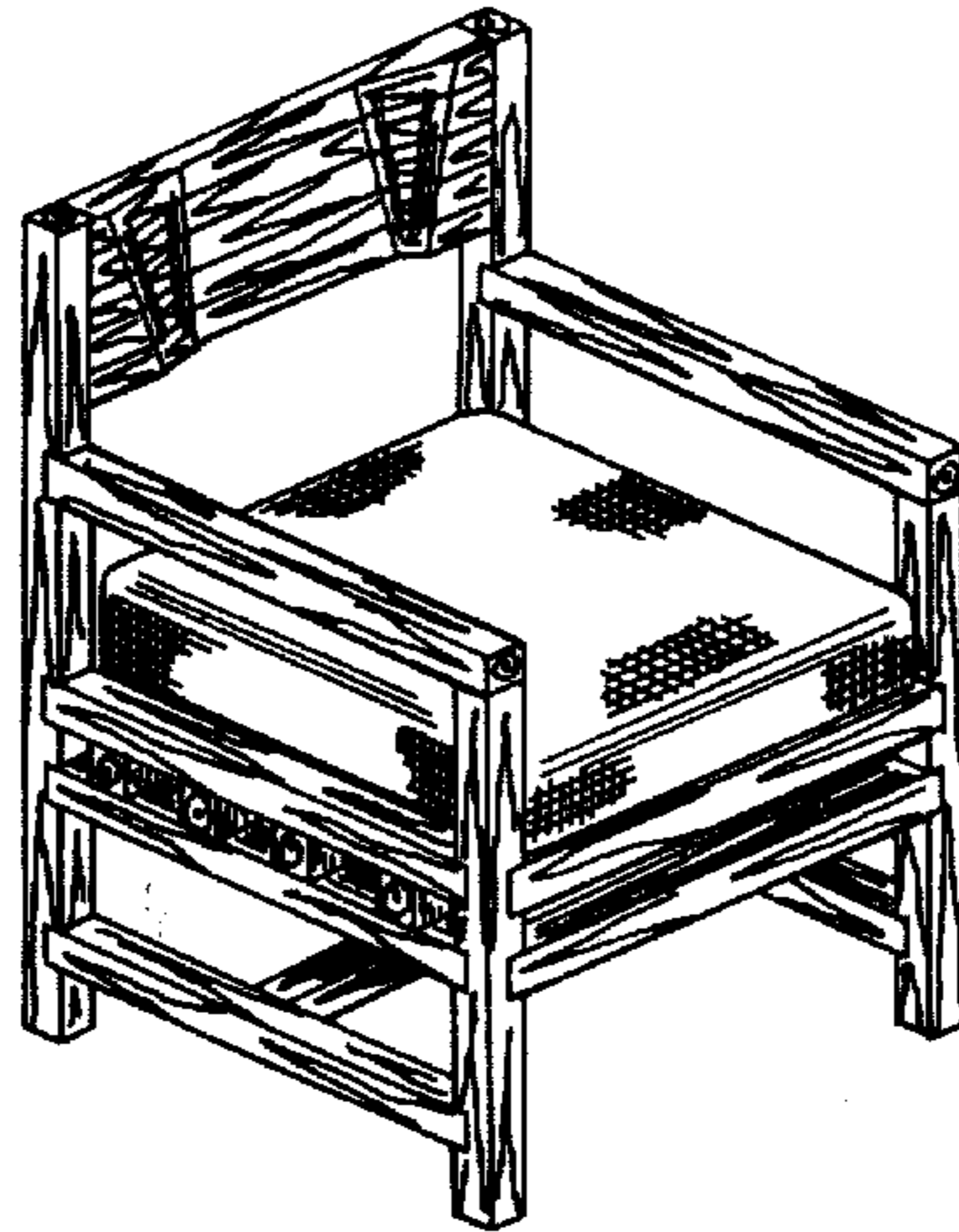
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1.

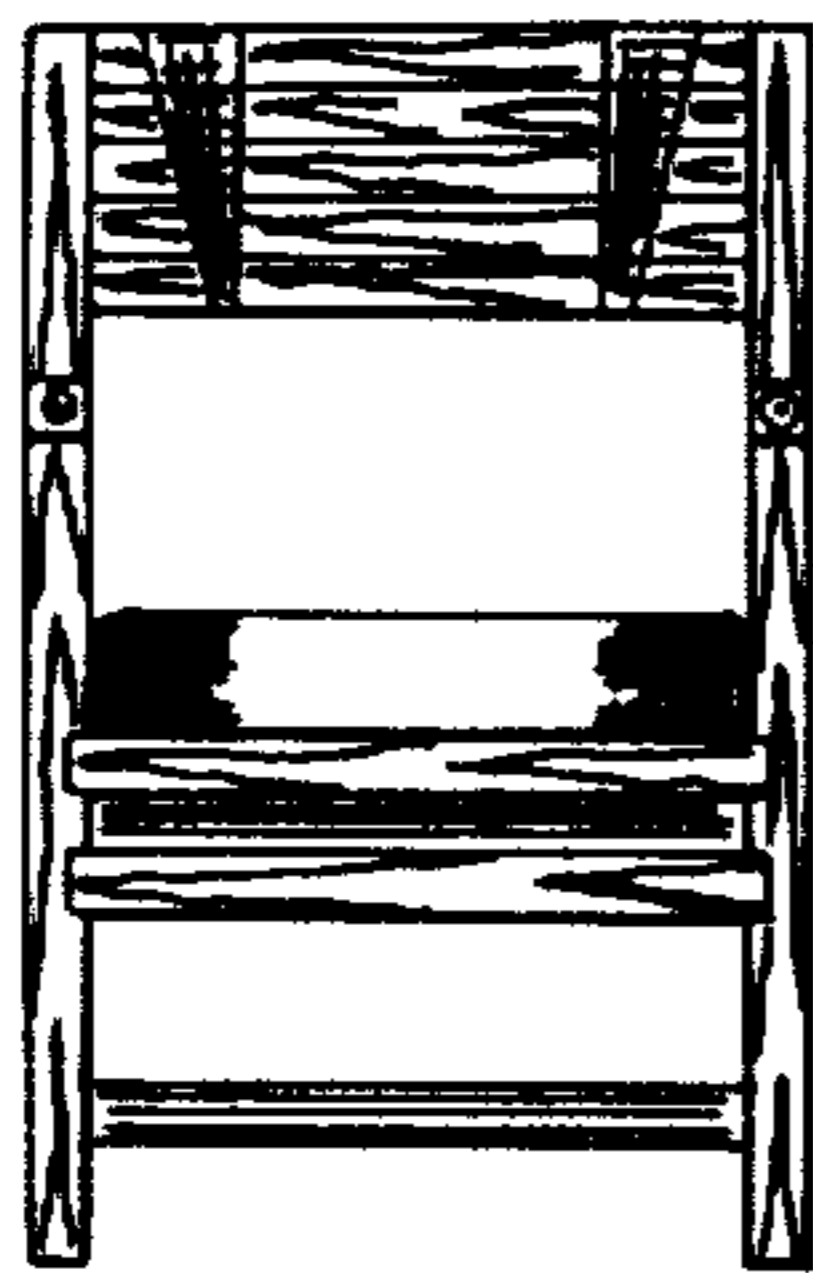
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1.

The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 4.

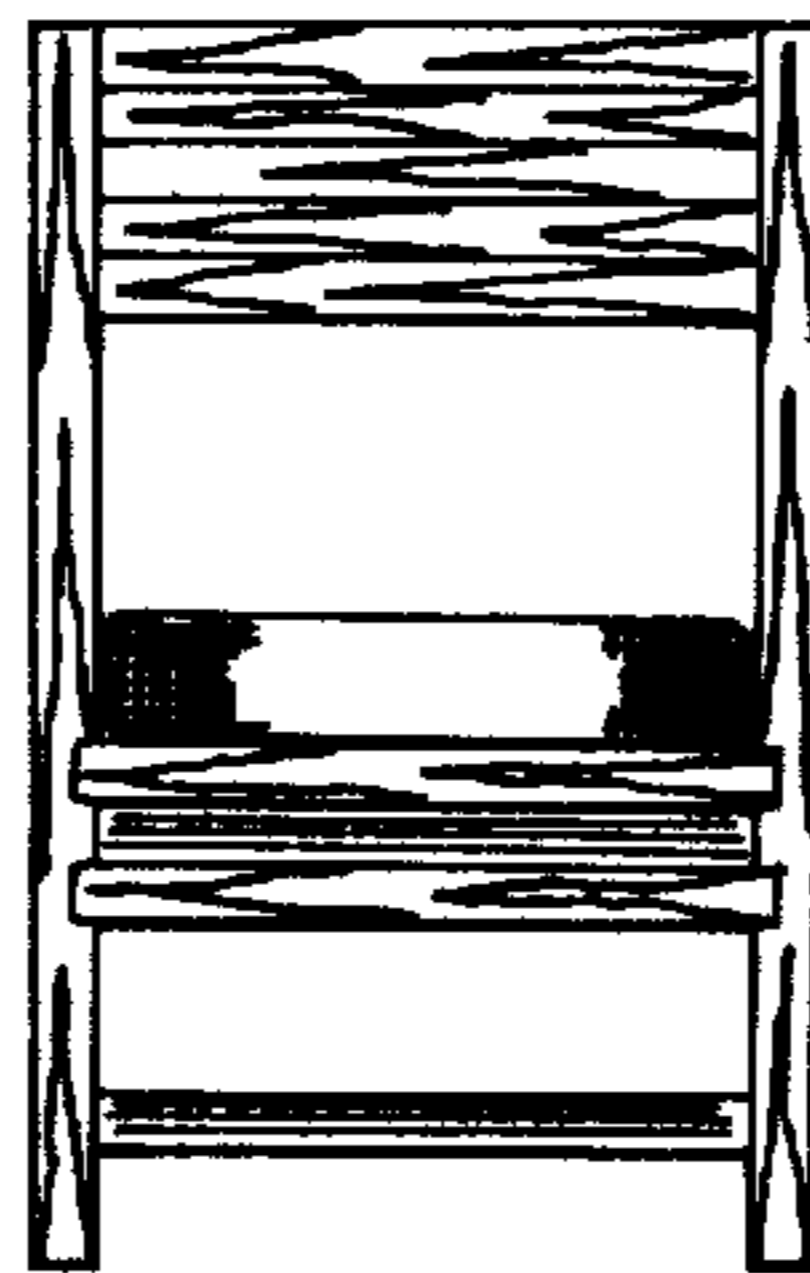




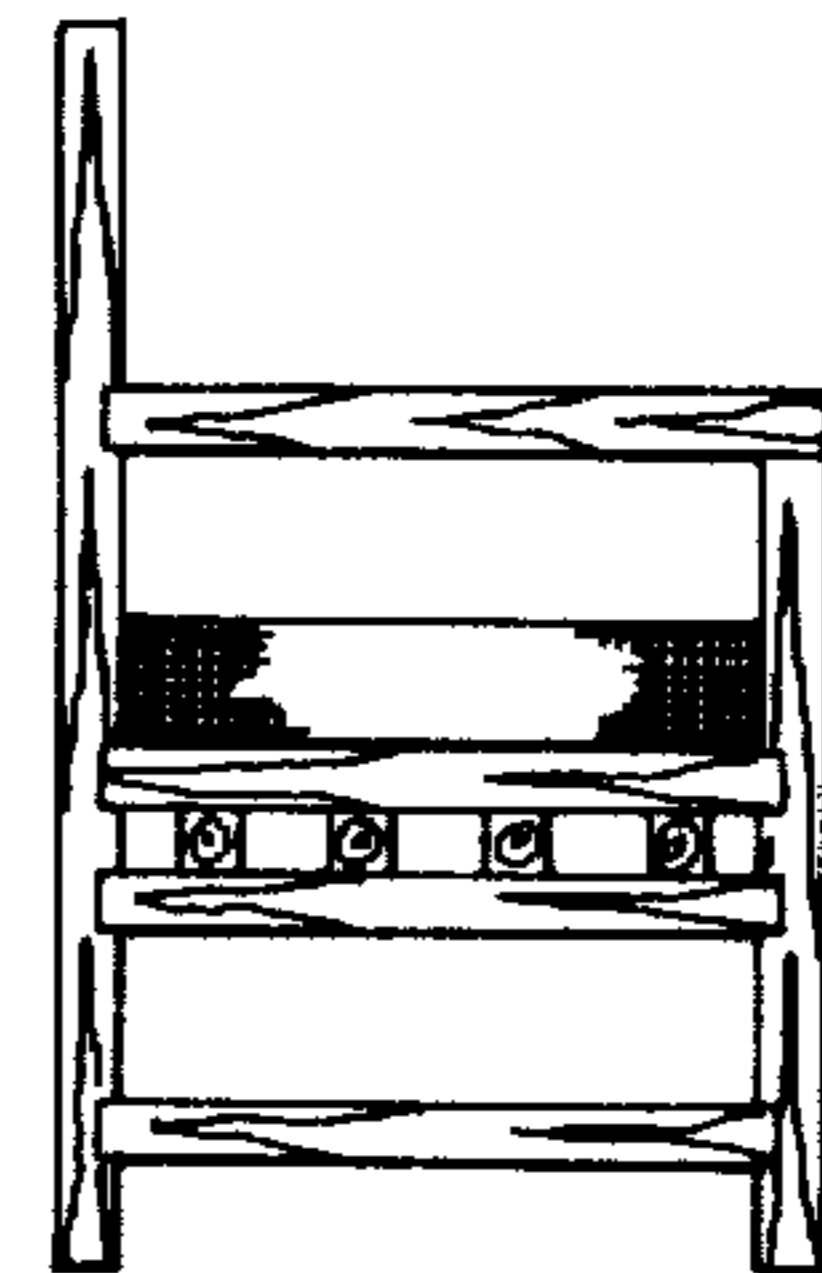
