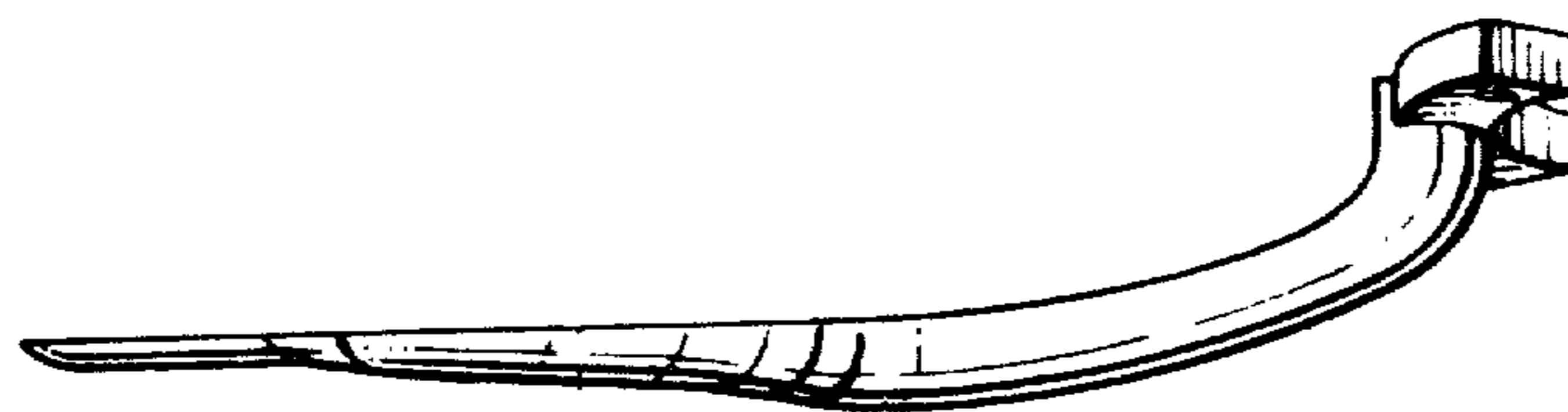
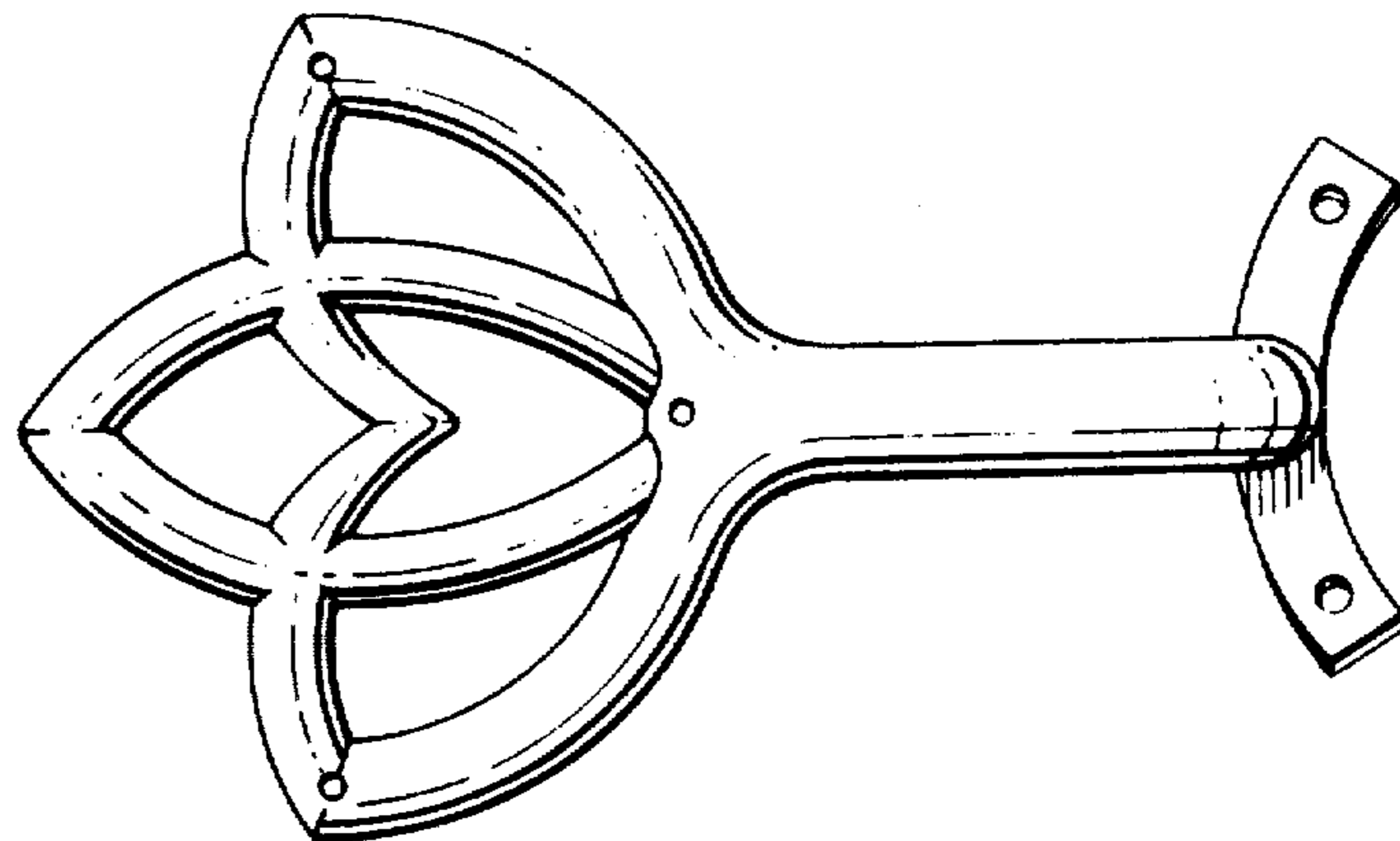
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ceiling fan blade holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective of a ceiling fan blade holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof; and
FIG. 4 is an elevational view taken from one end thereof.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a ceiling fan in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



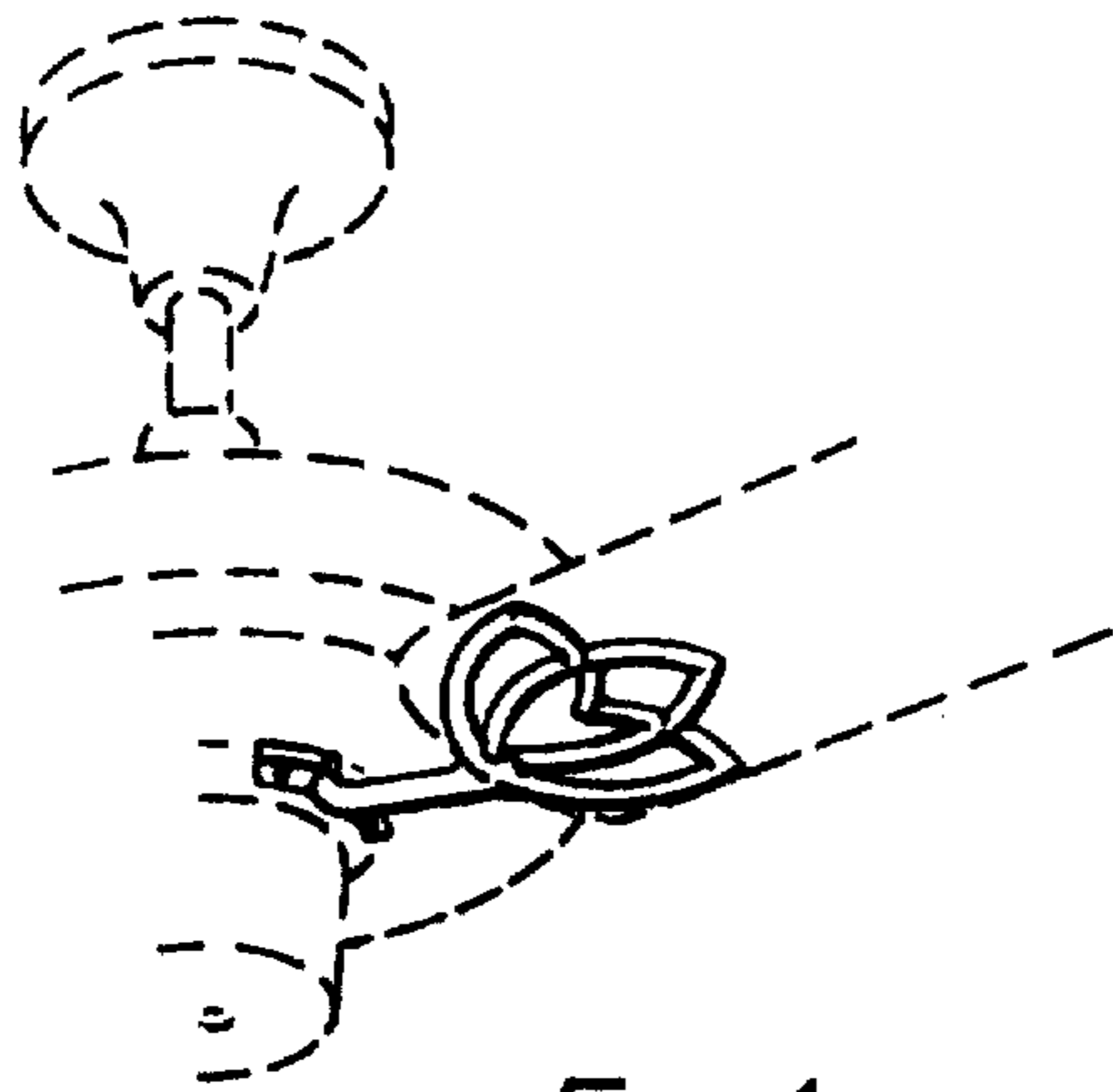

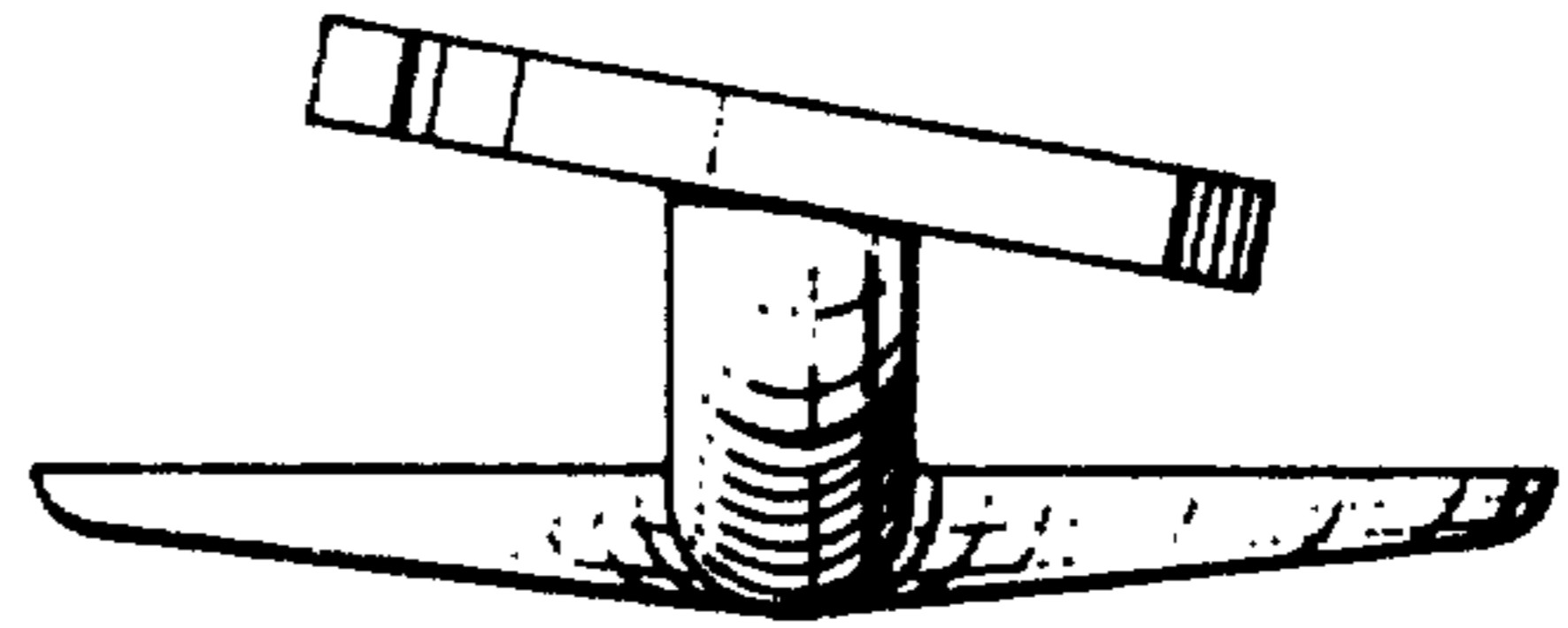

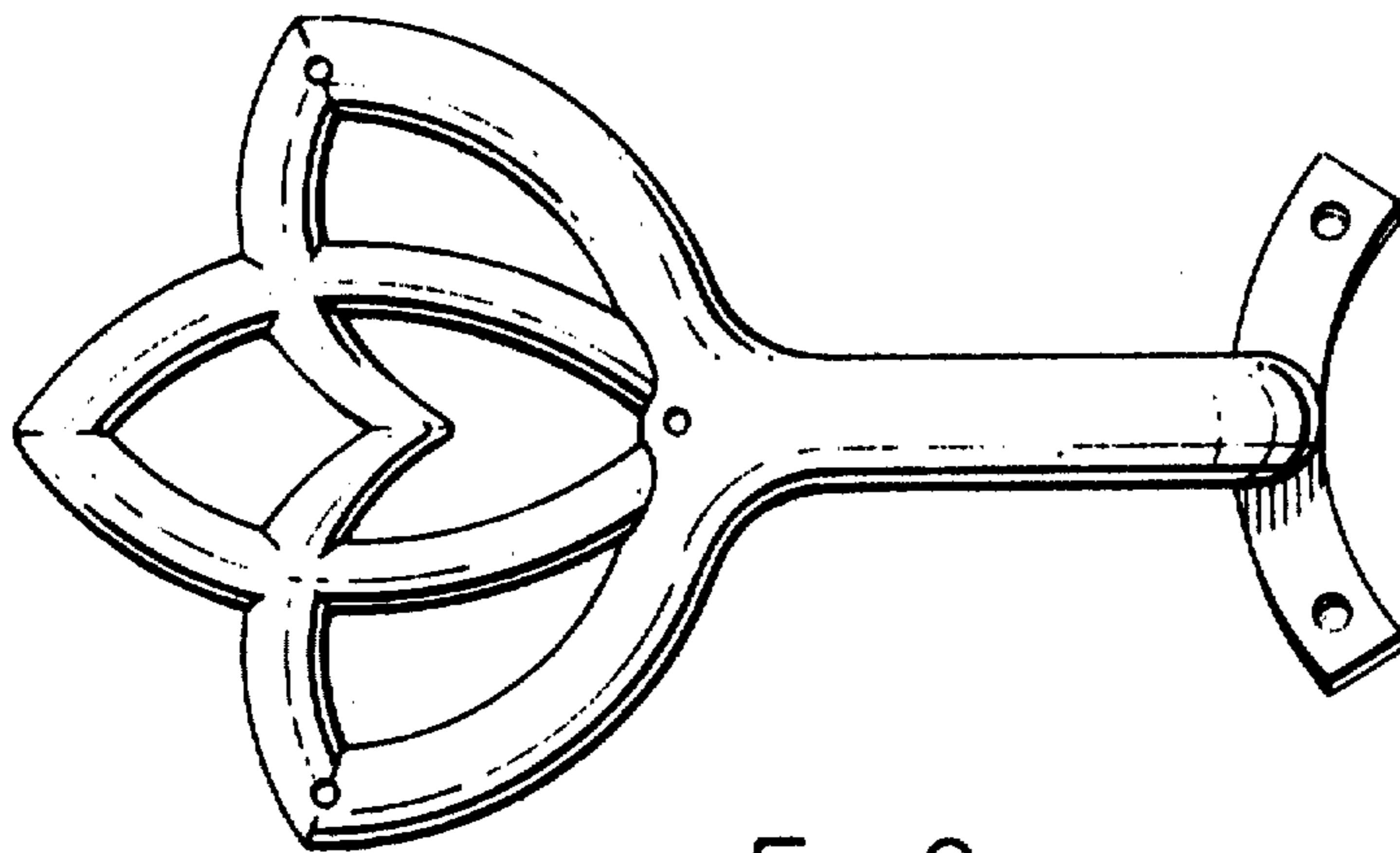
