FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a hydrotherapy spa showing our new design;


FIG. 2 is an alternative top perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a further alternative top perspective view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;




FIG. 7 is a fragmentary cross-section taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 4.


The fragmentary broken lines representing the bathroom island installation are shown for illustrative purposes only.















