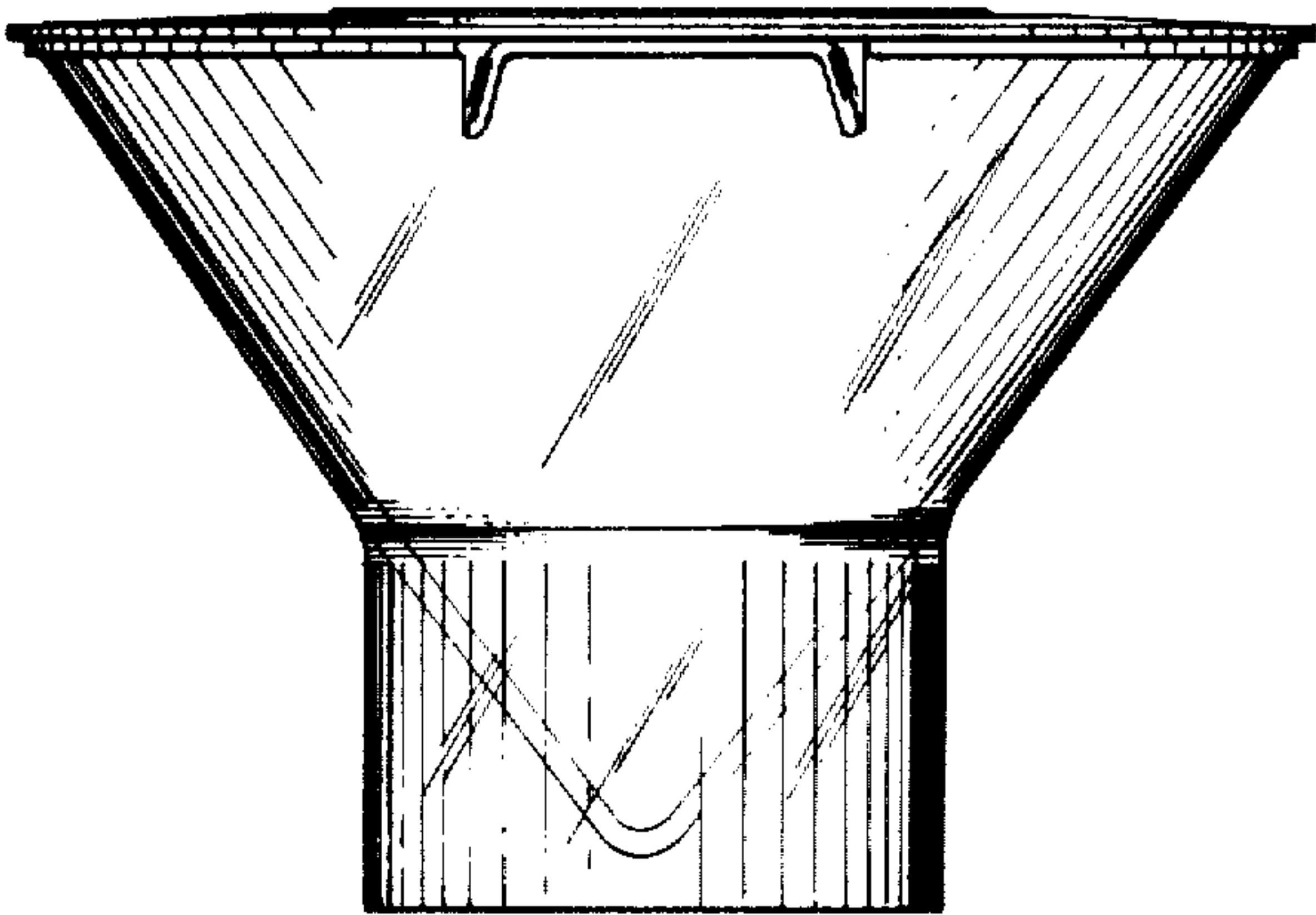
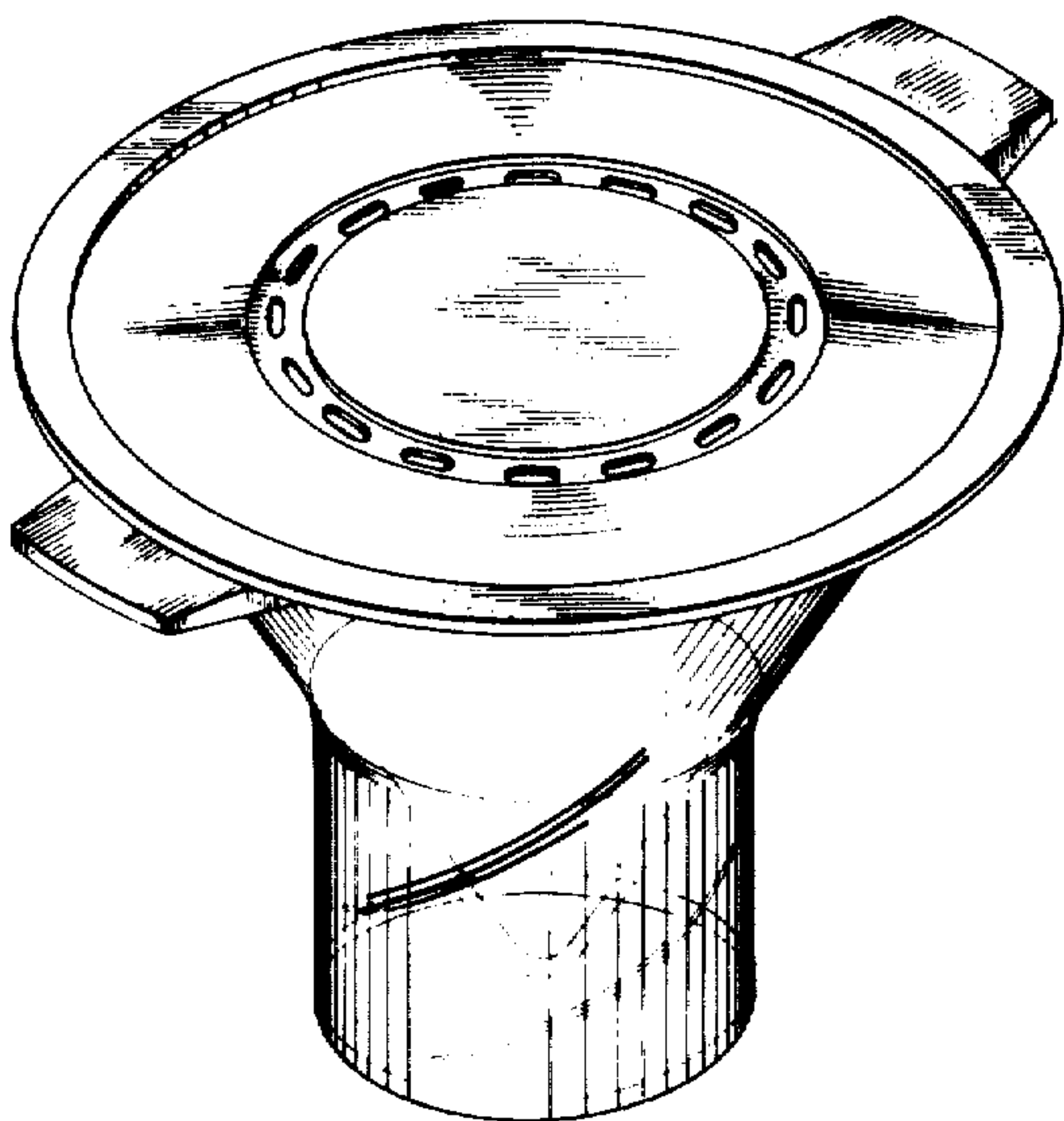

FIG. 5 is a left or right side elevational view thereof.



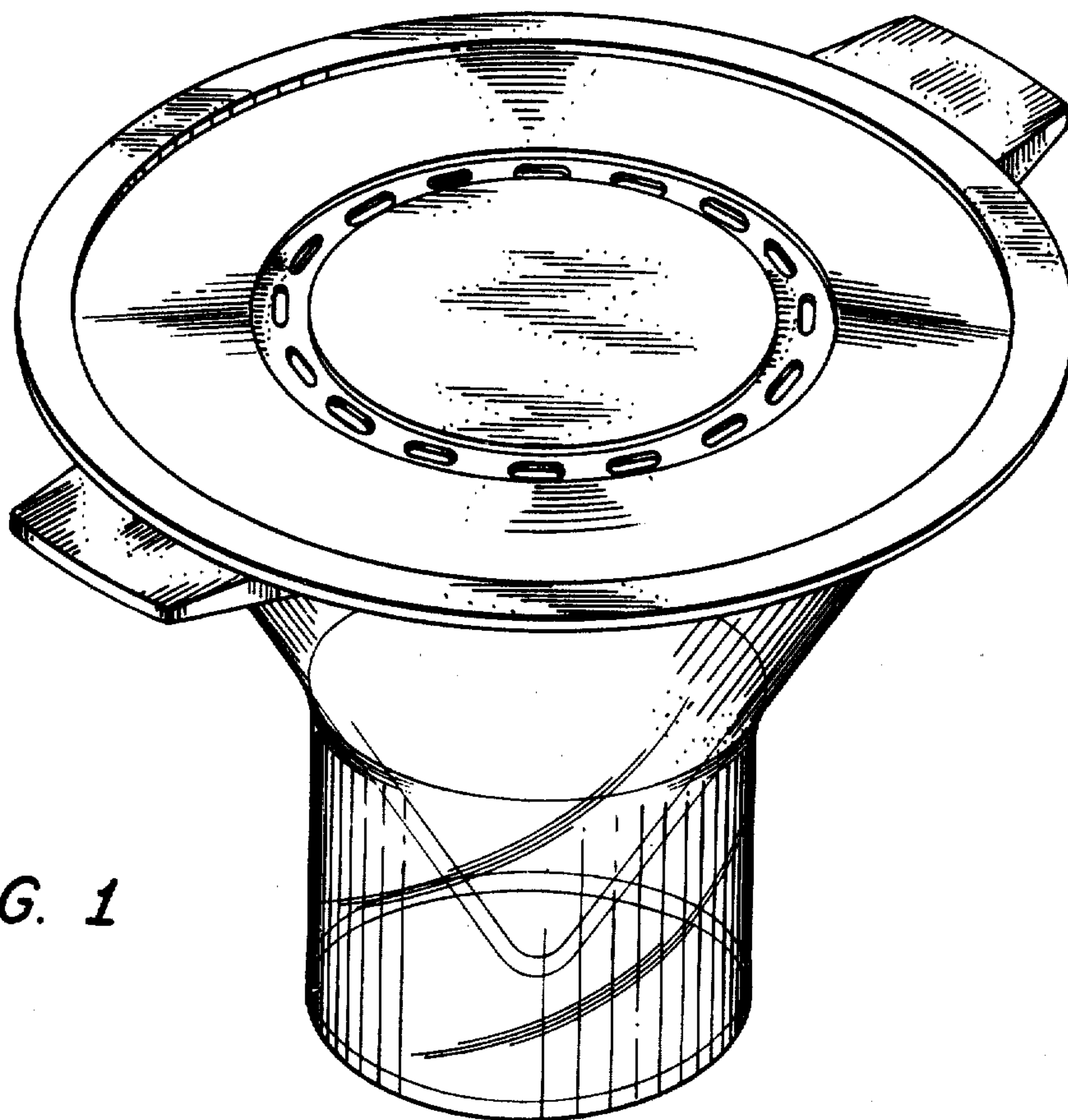

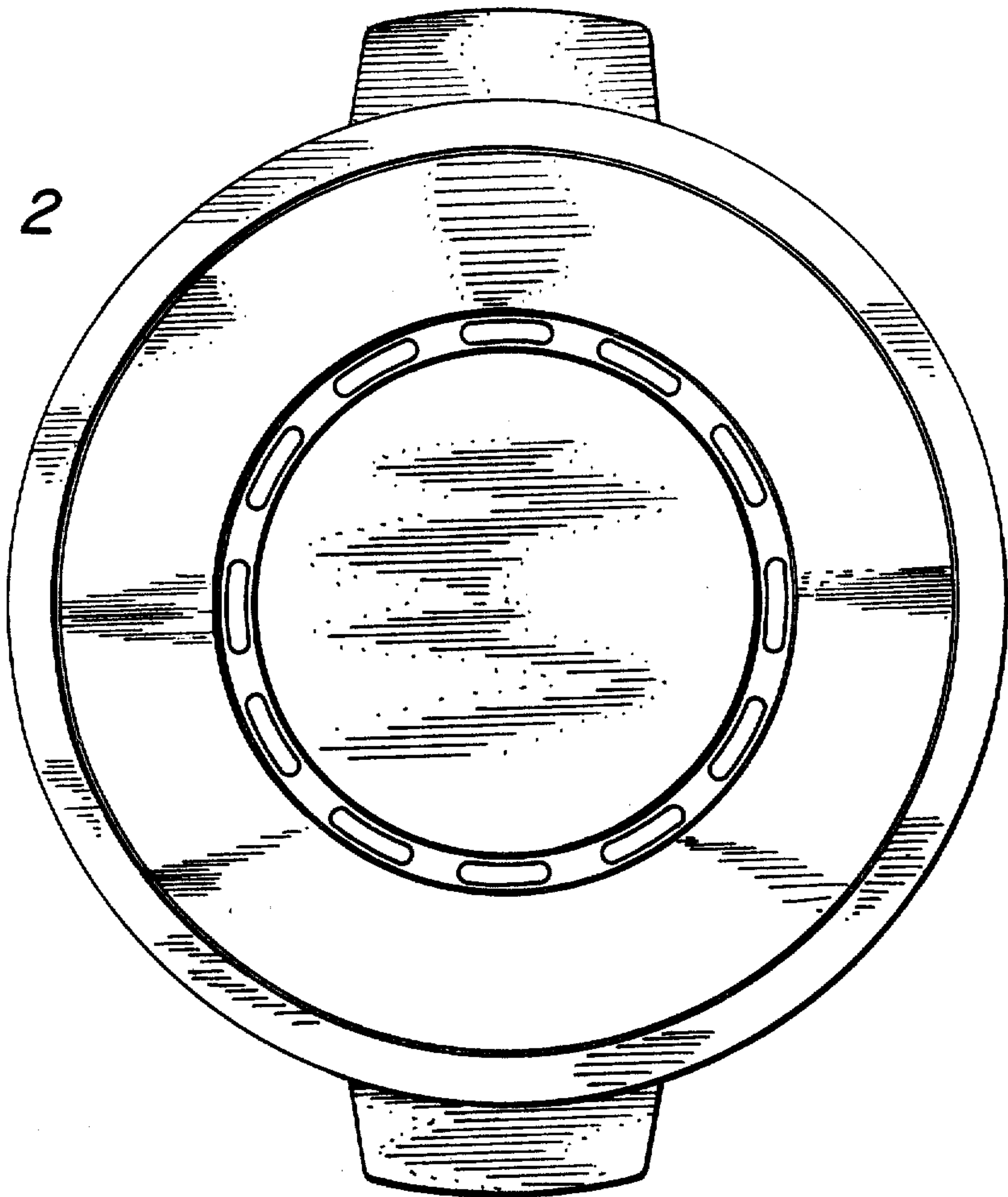
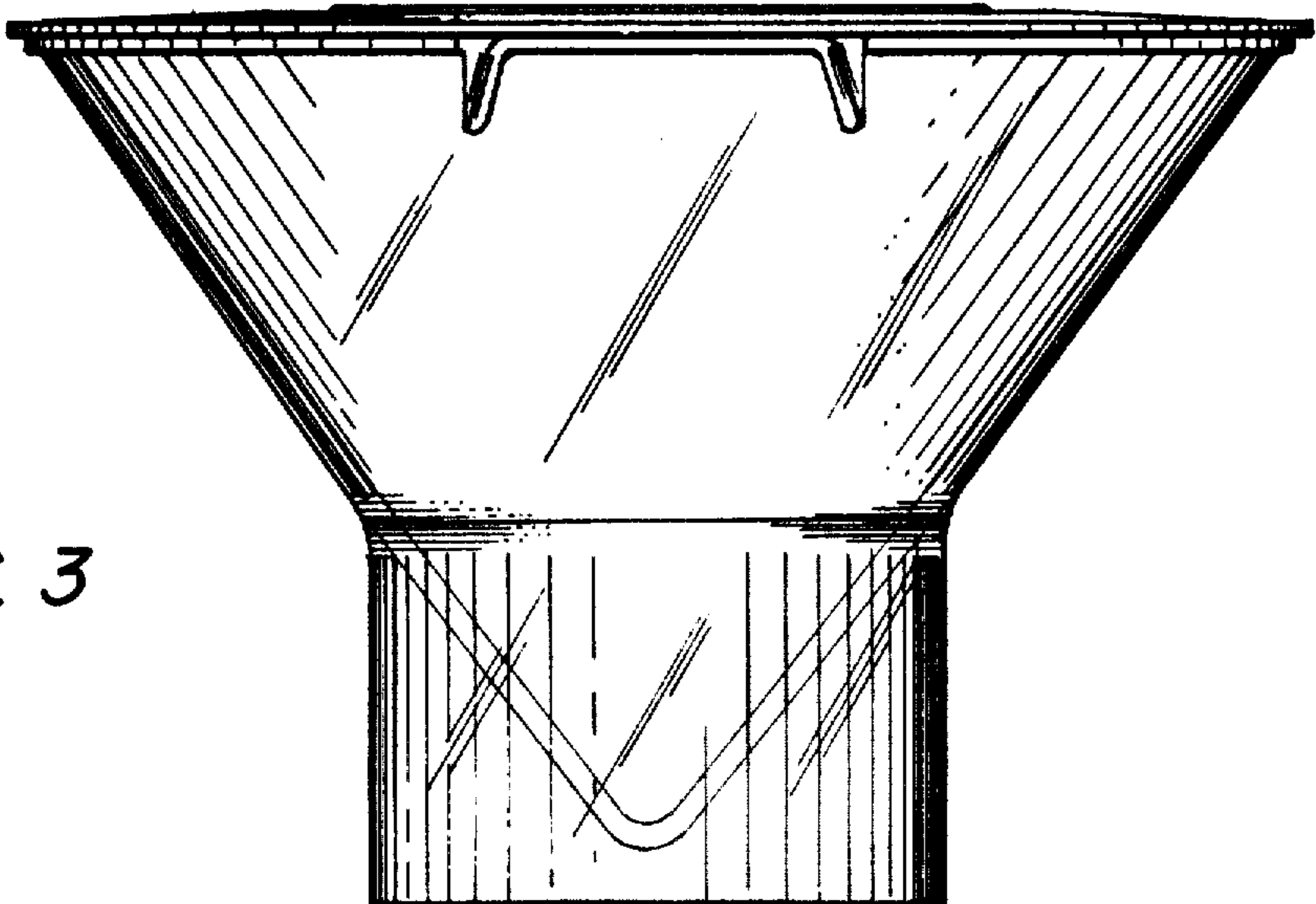

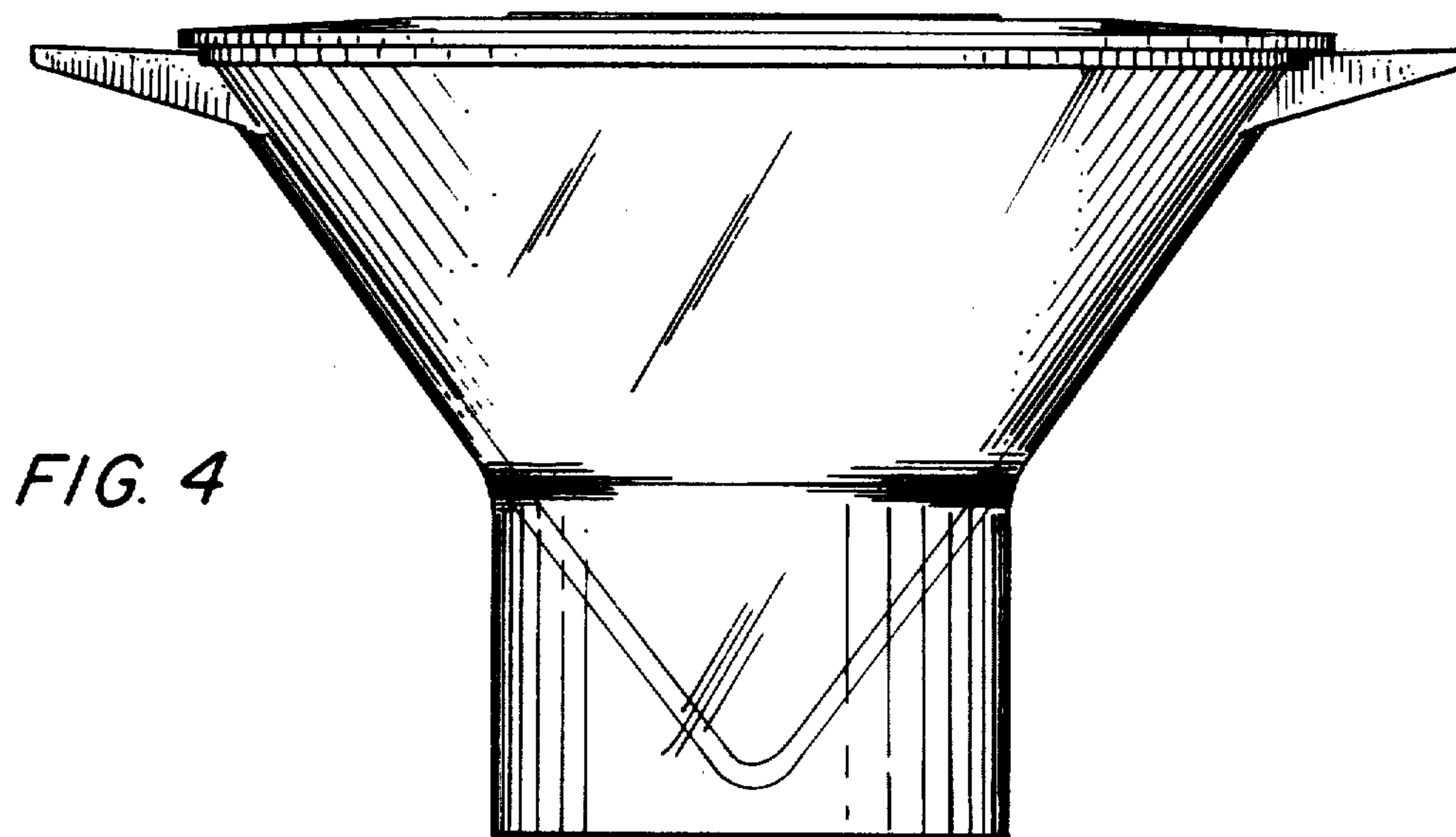

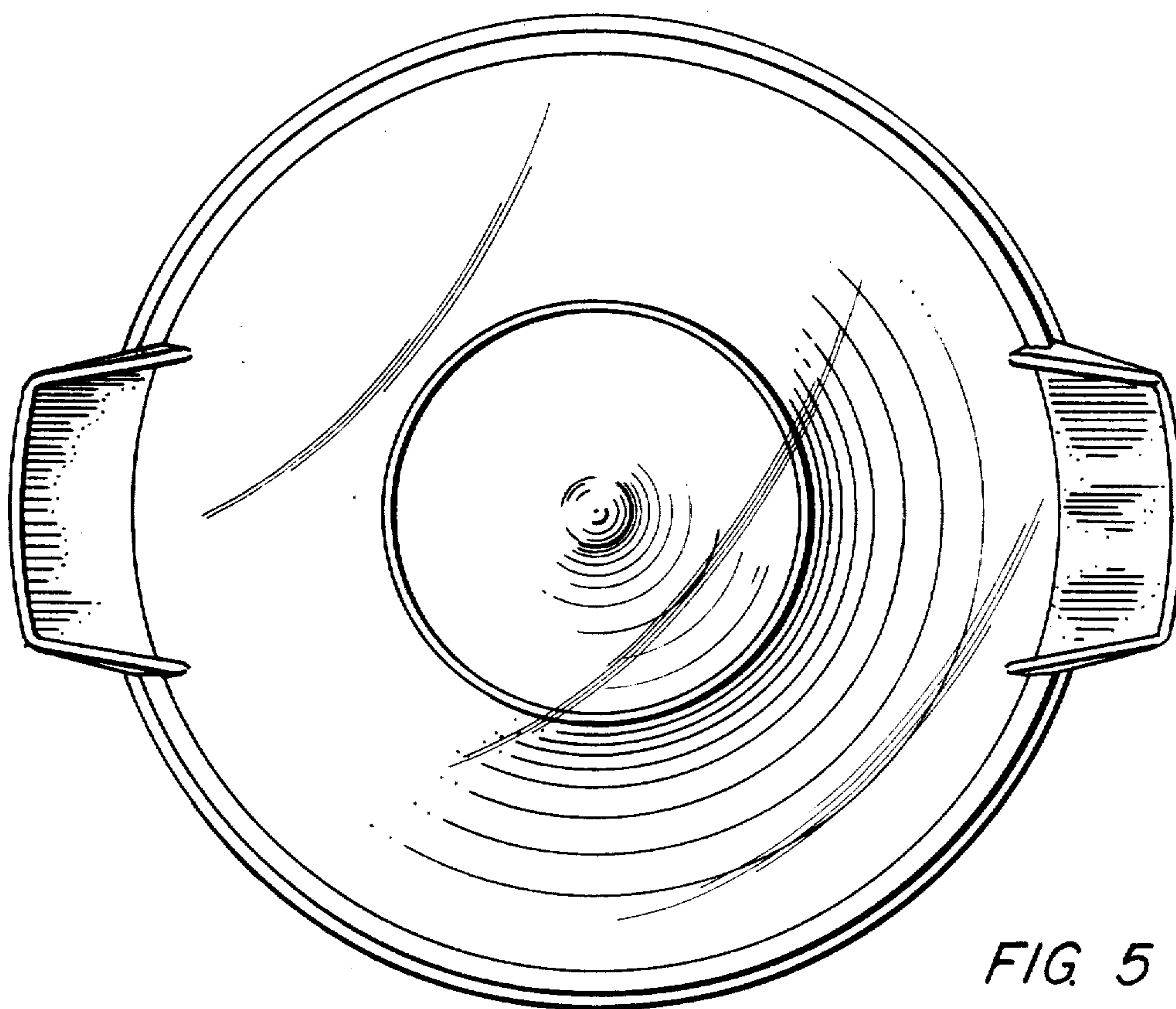
