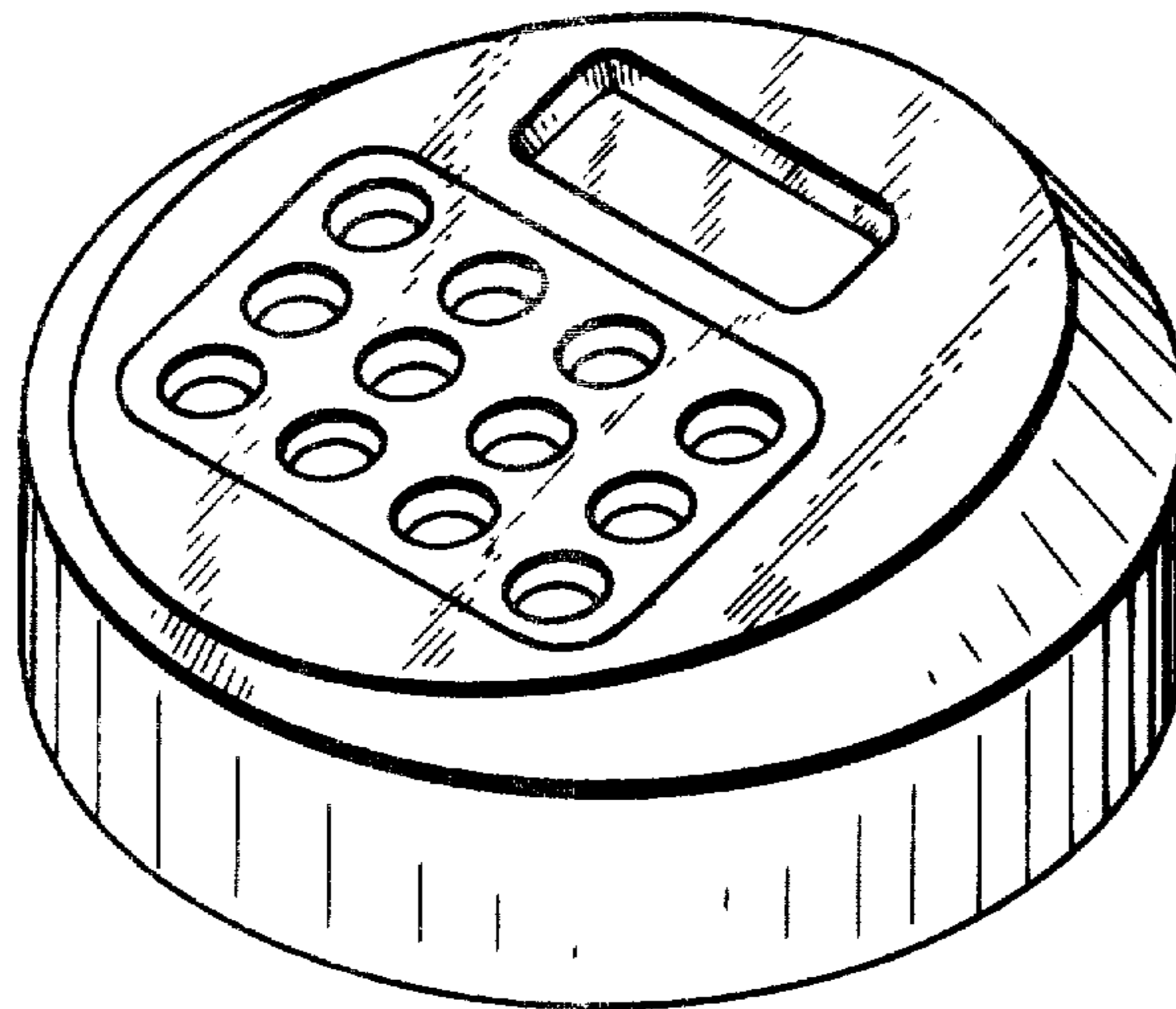

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of an electronic timer showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



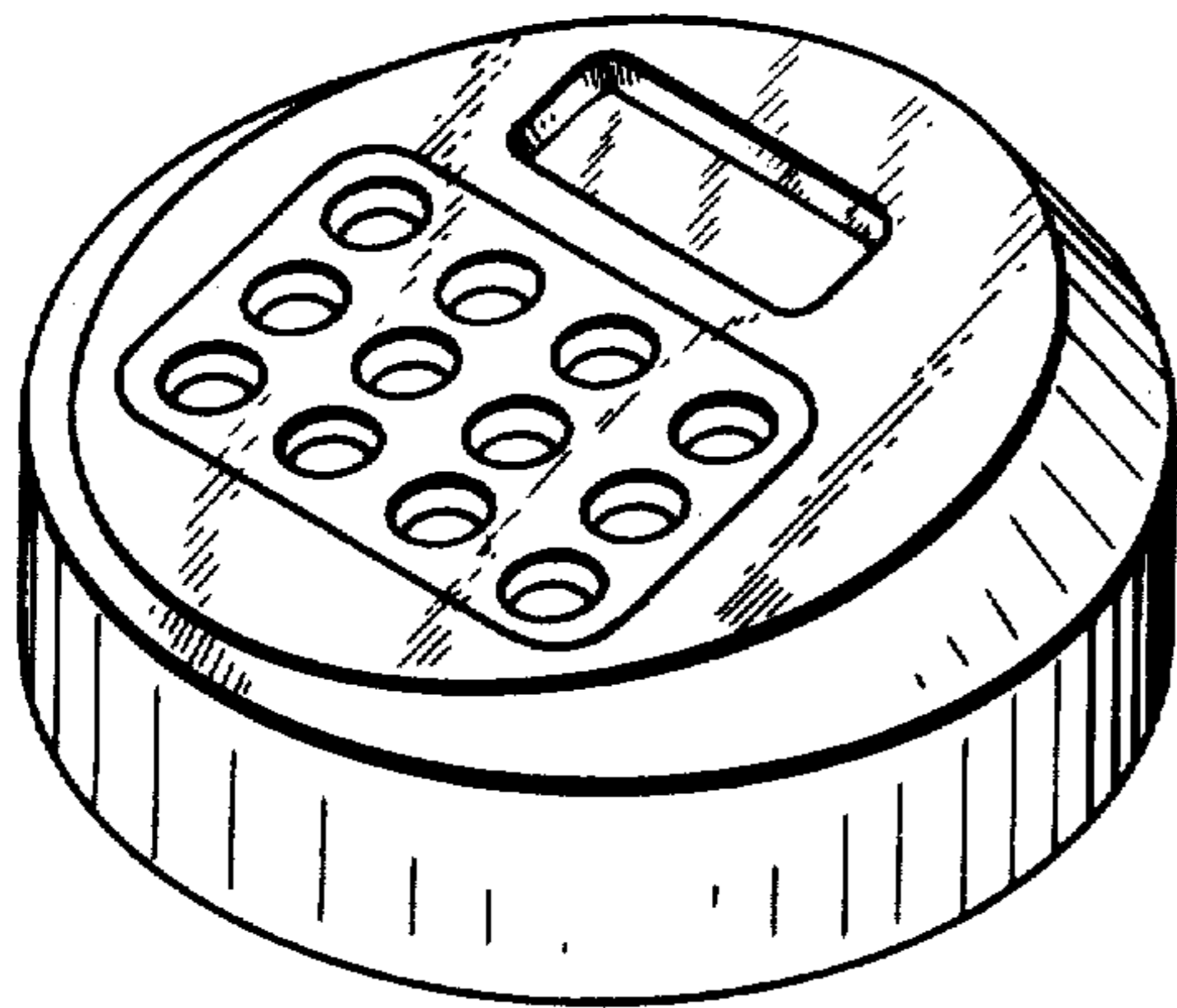

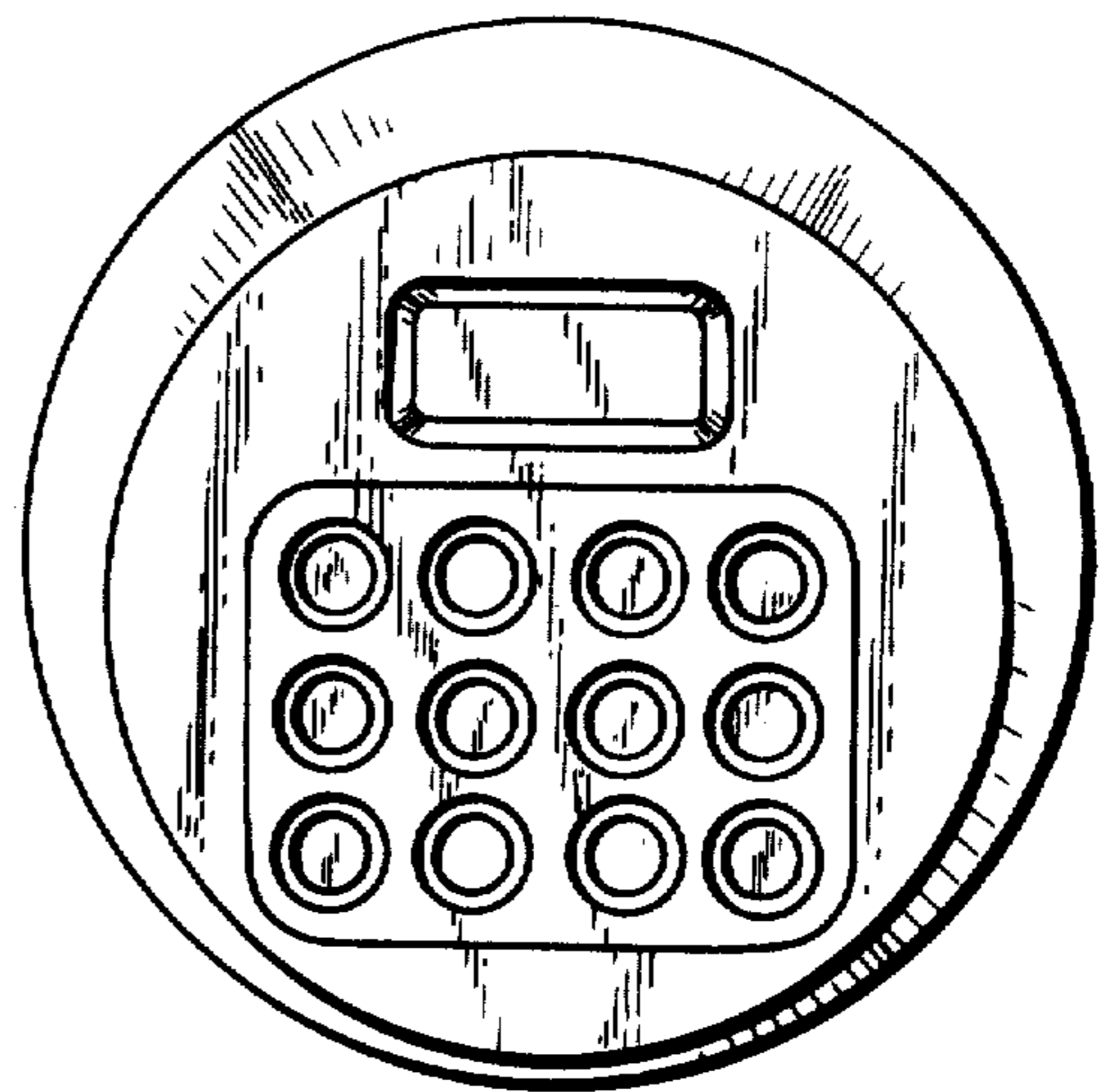

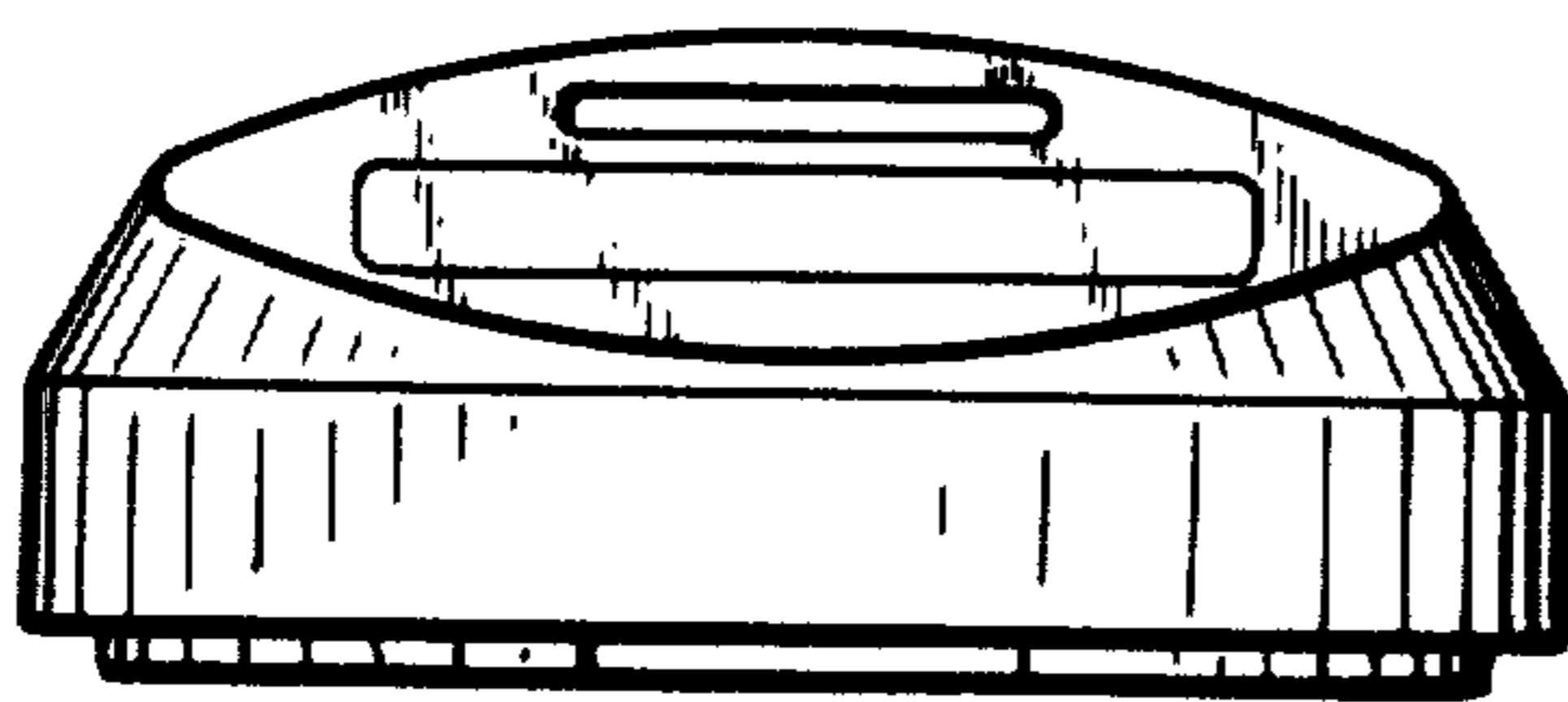

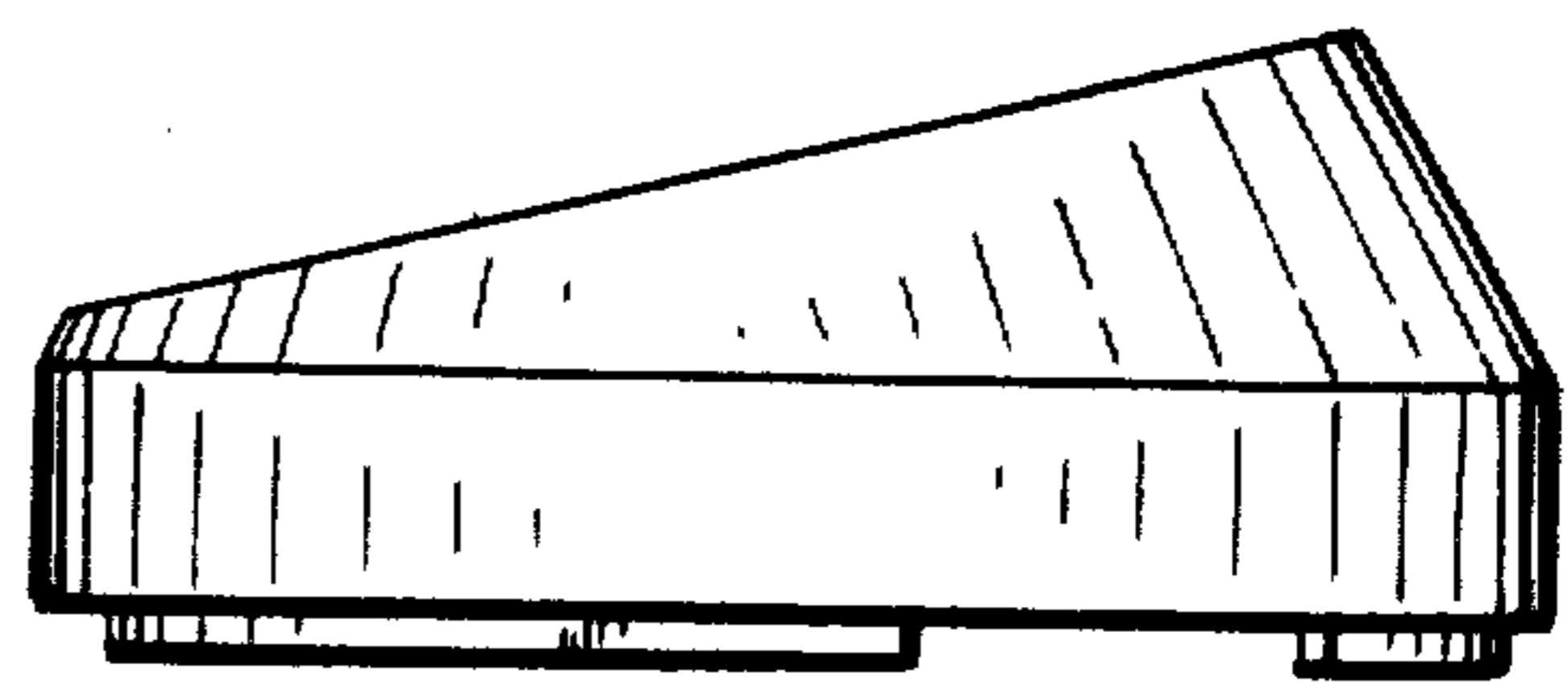

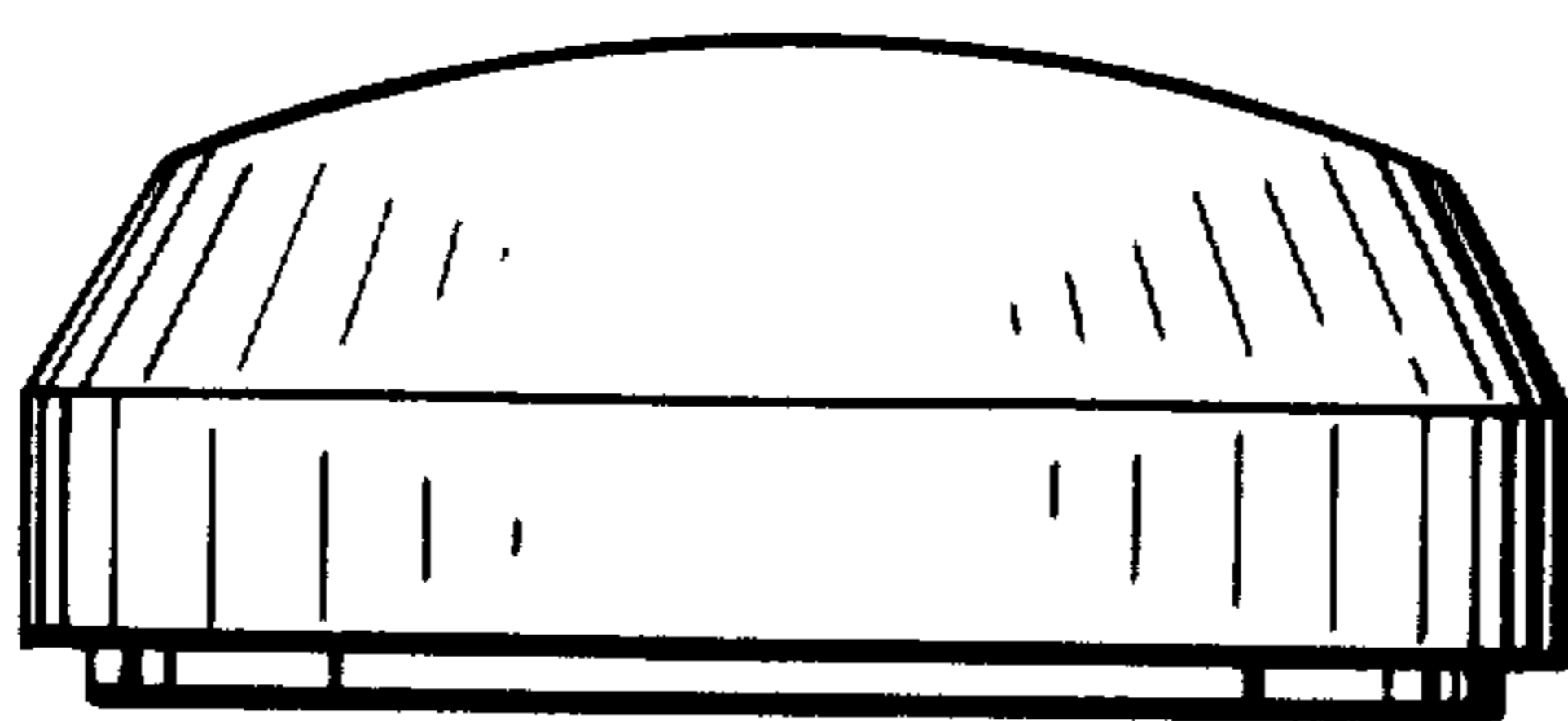

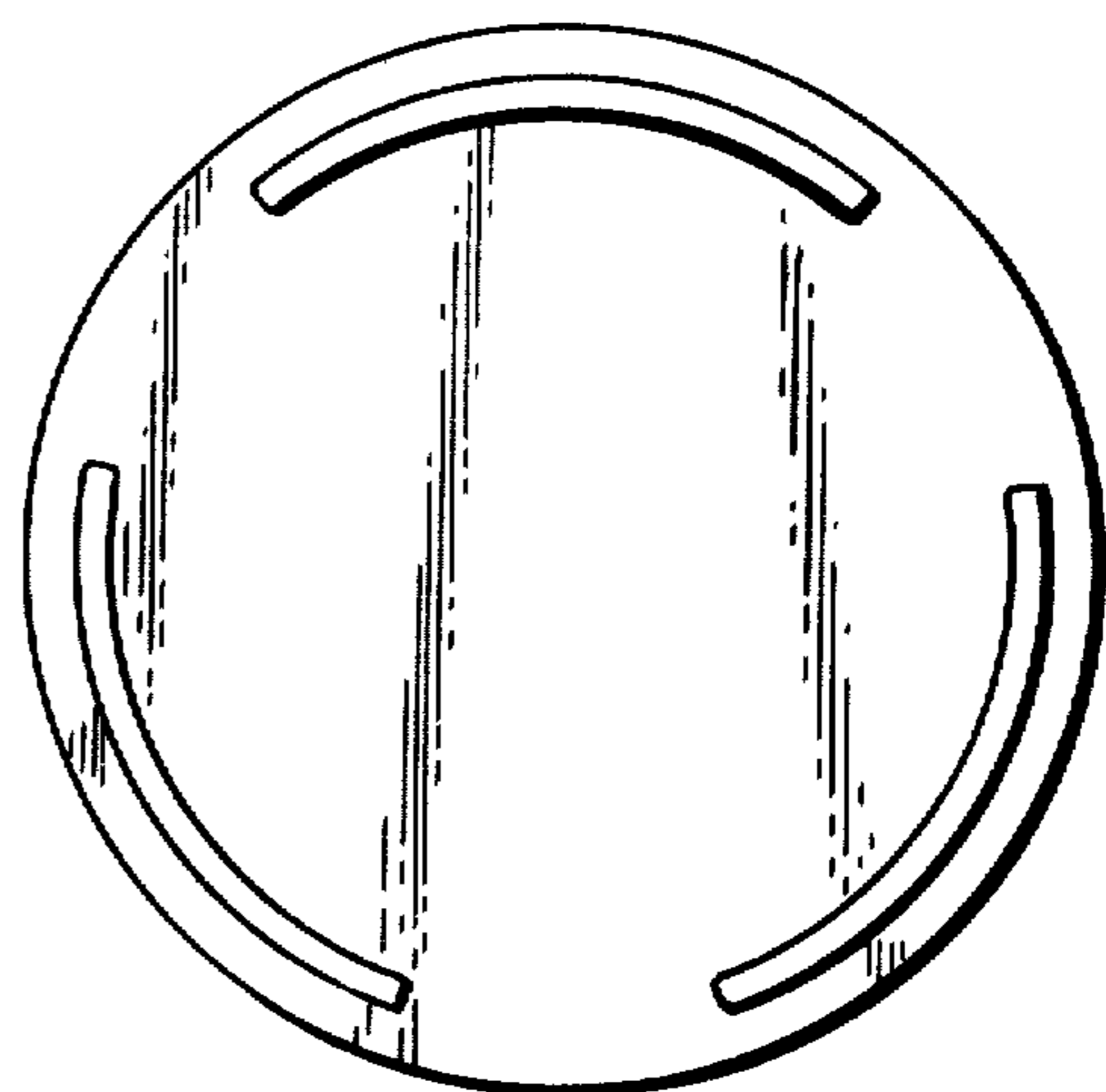
