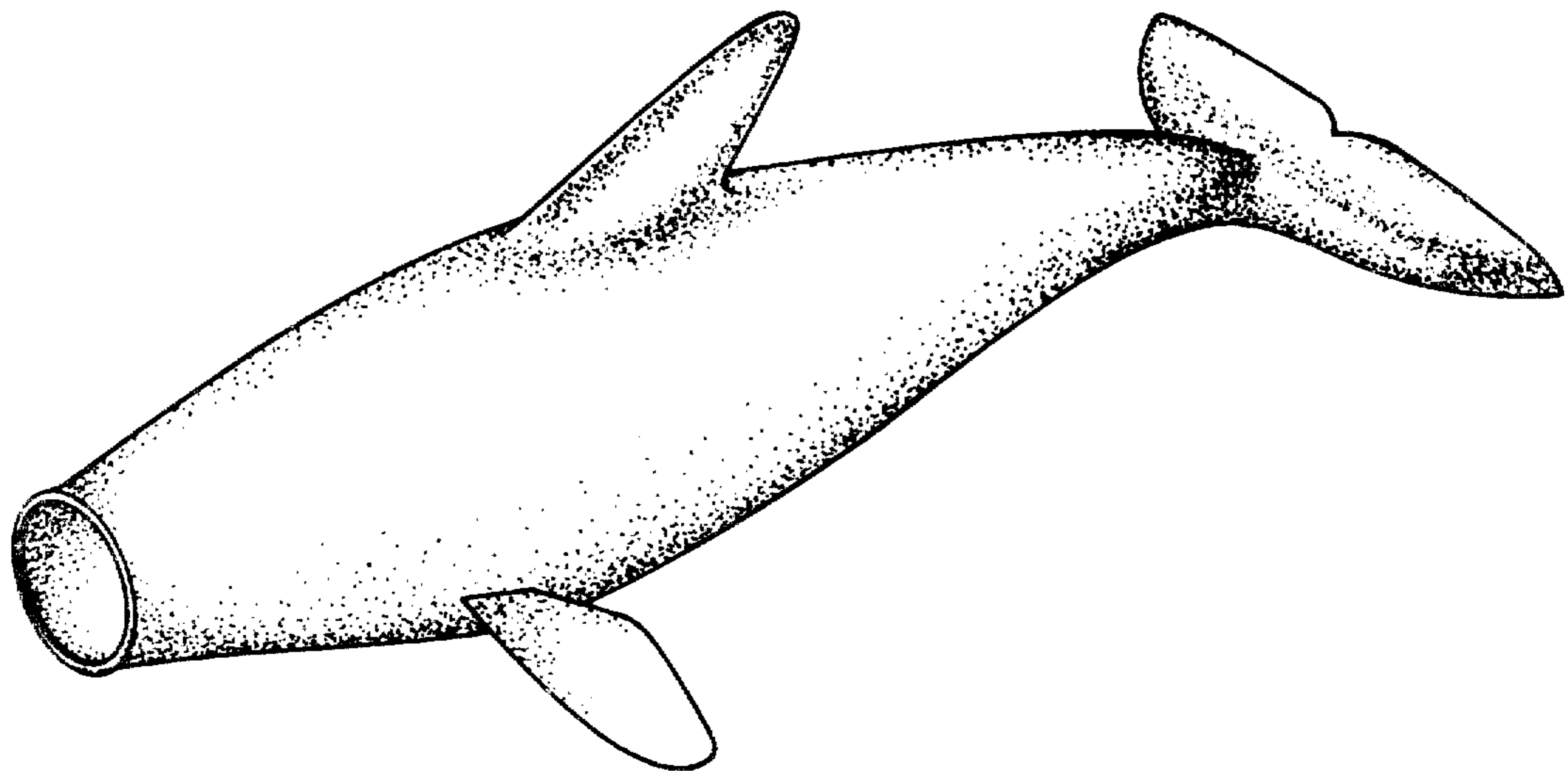

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wind sock, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right front perspective view of a wind sock showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereto; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



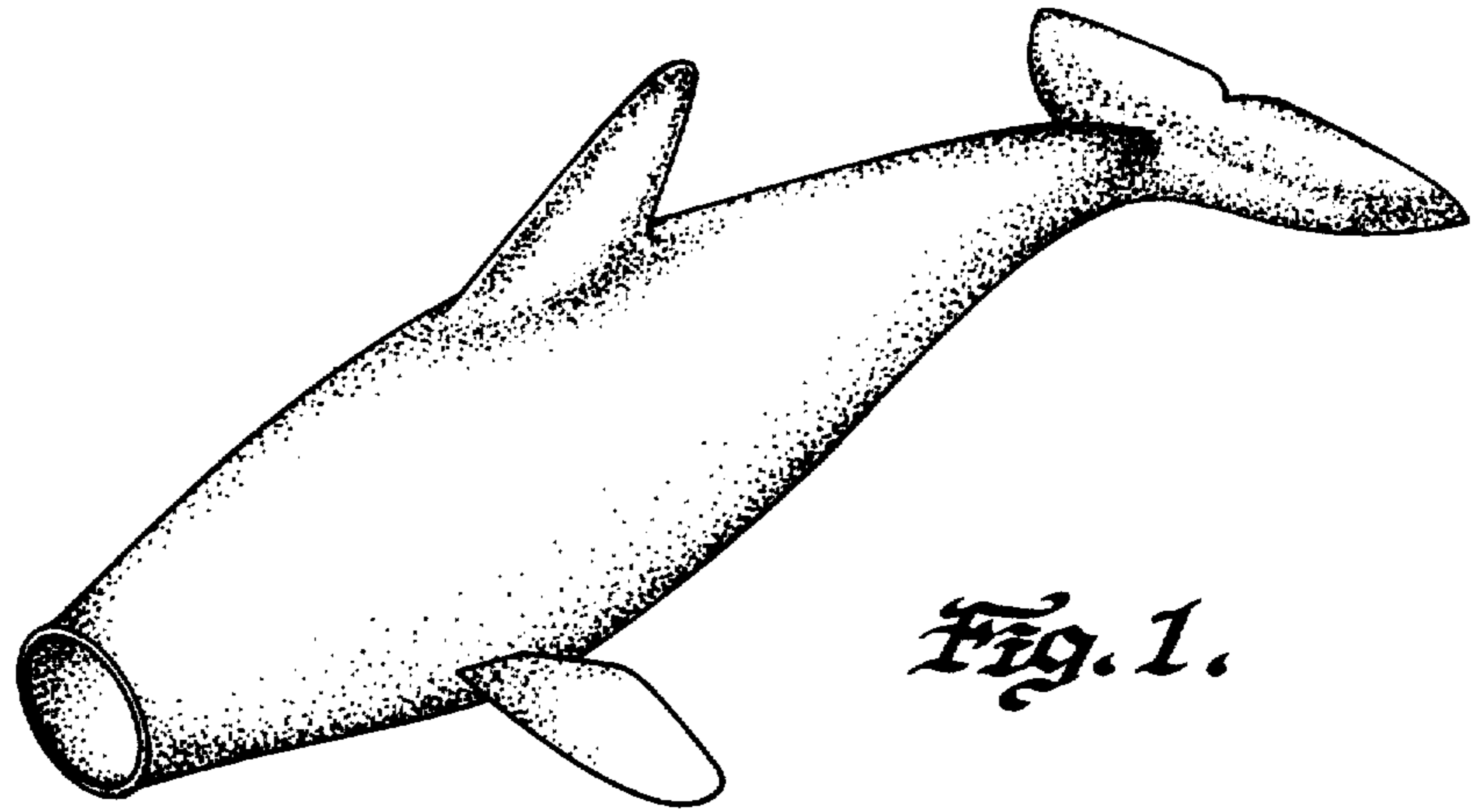

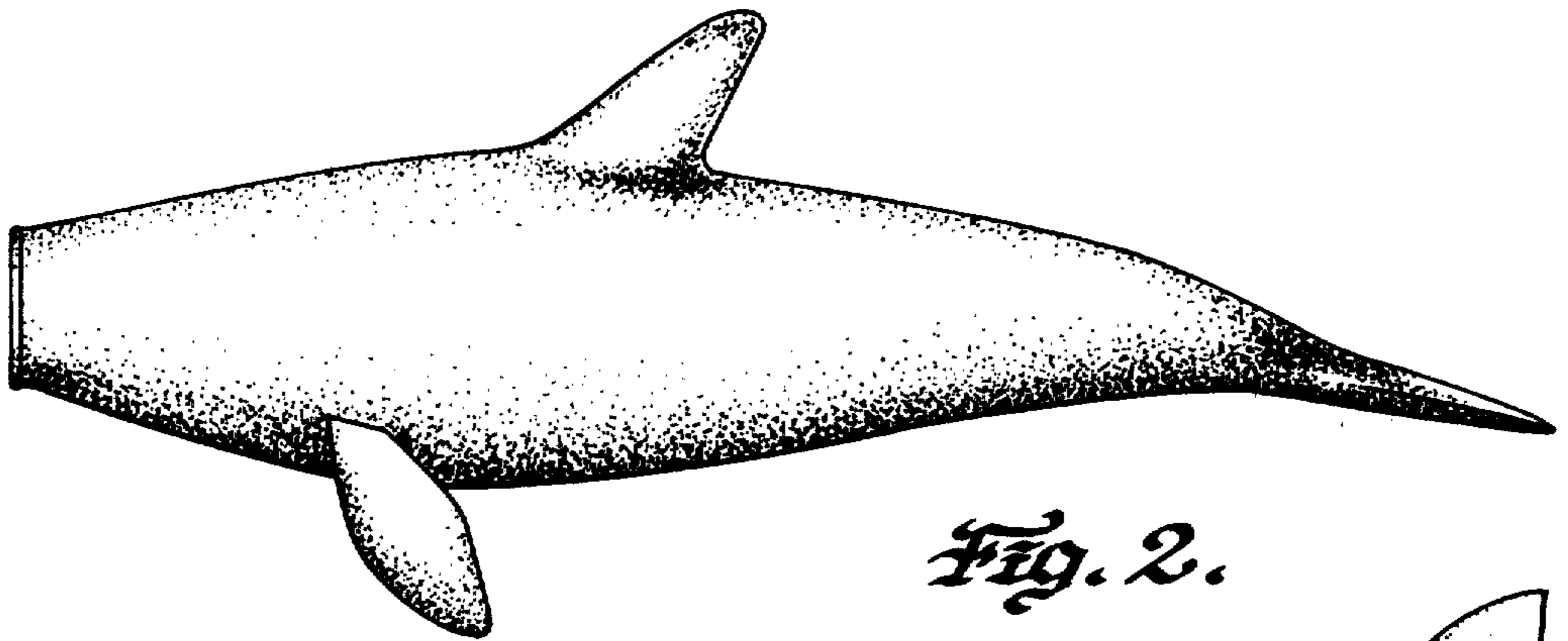

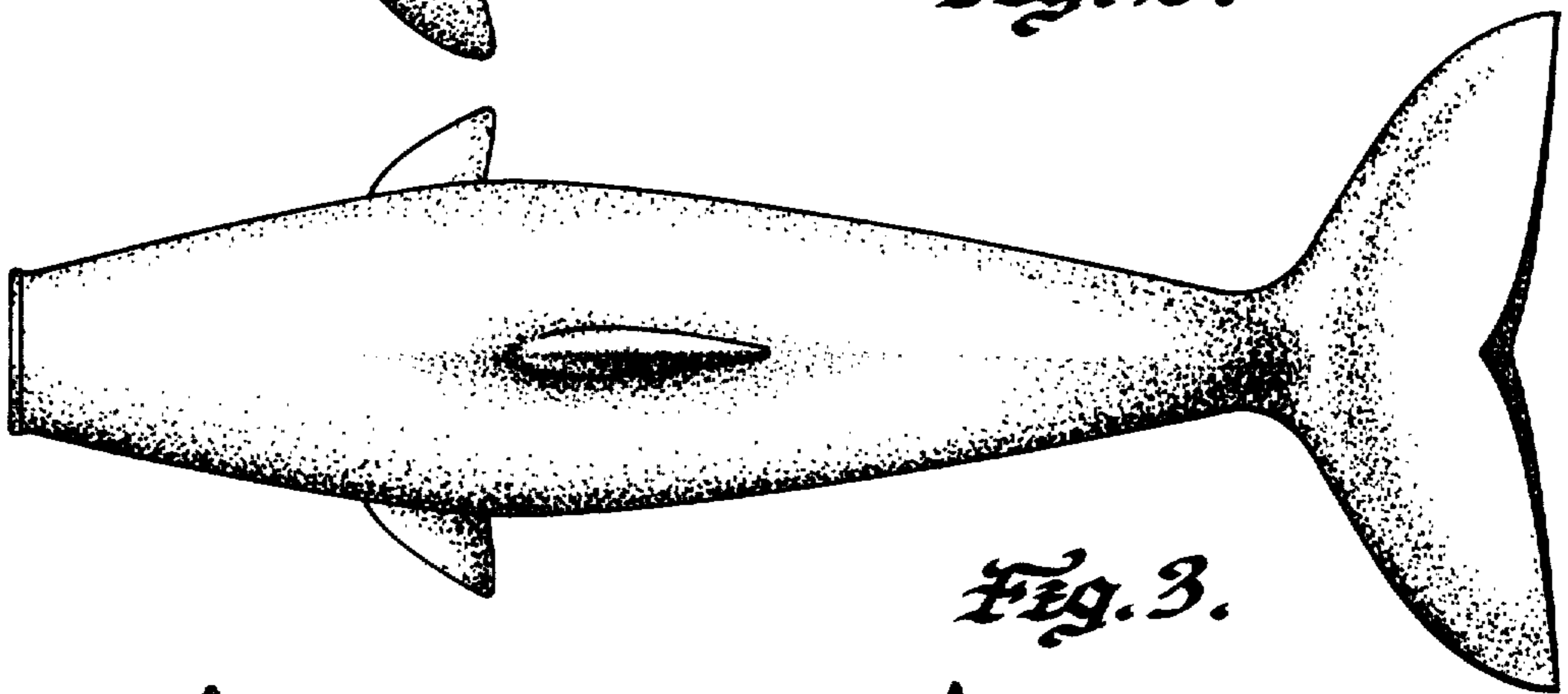

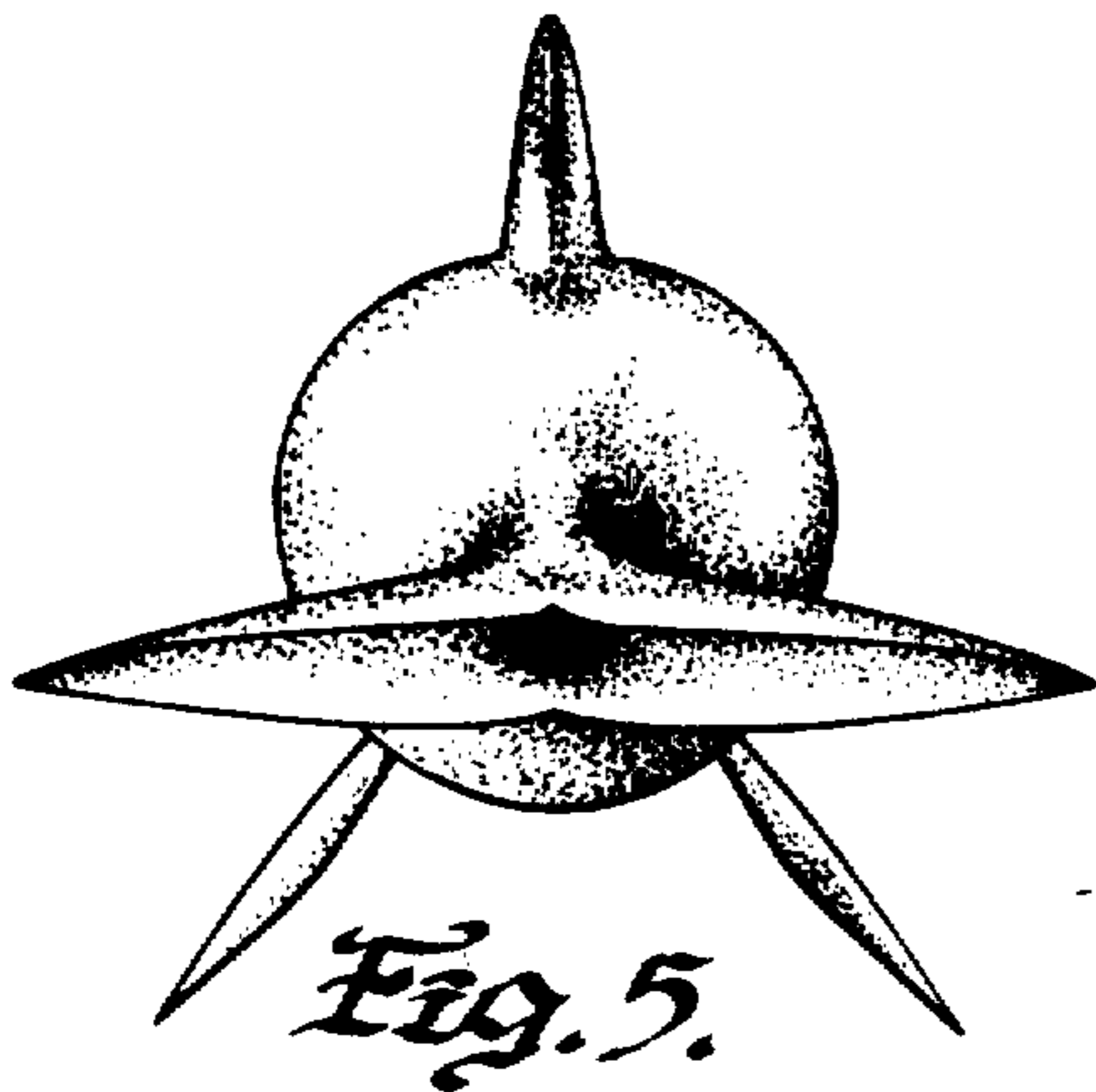

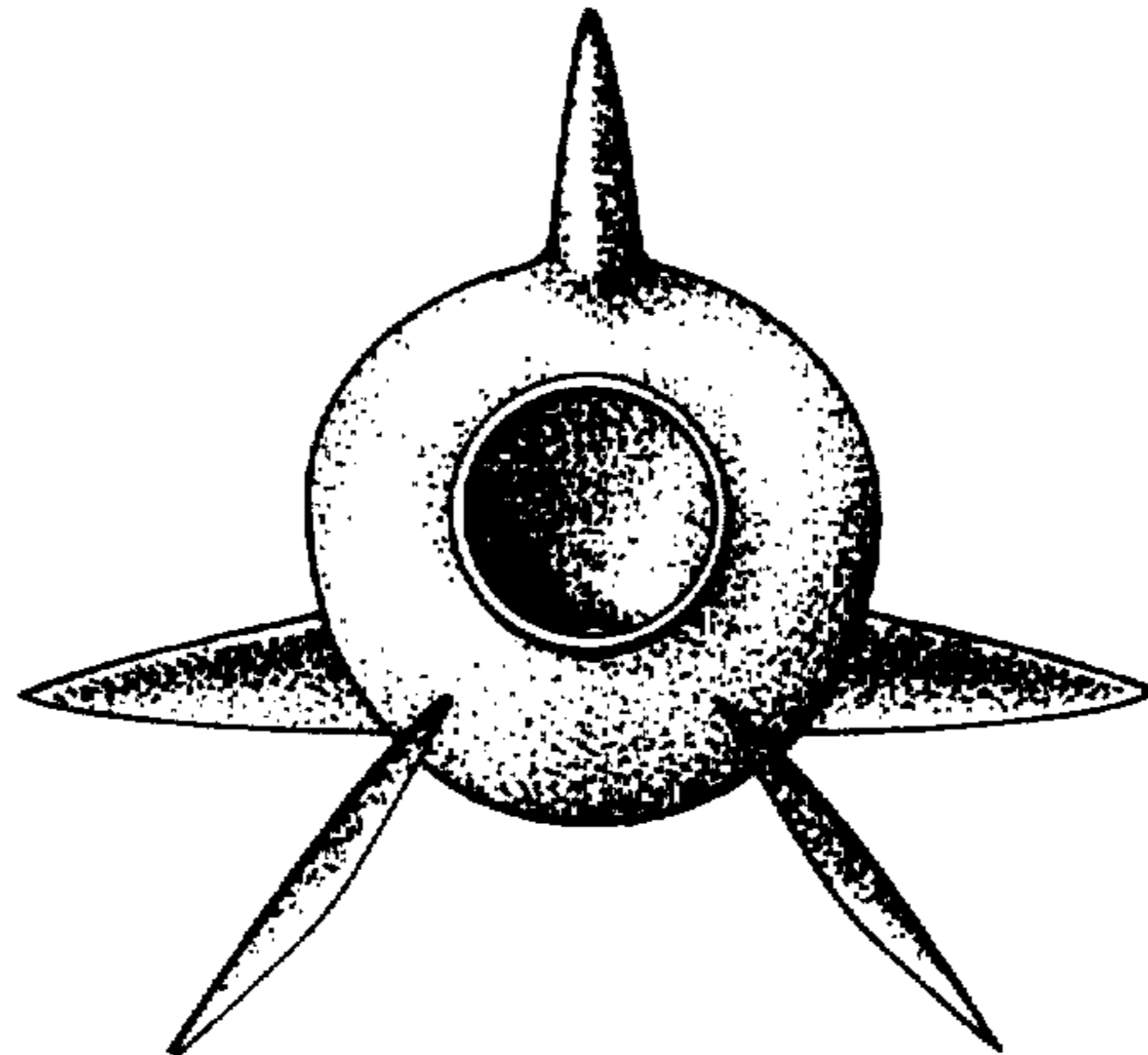
