The ornamental design for a computer disk drive, as shown and described.

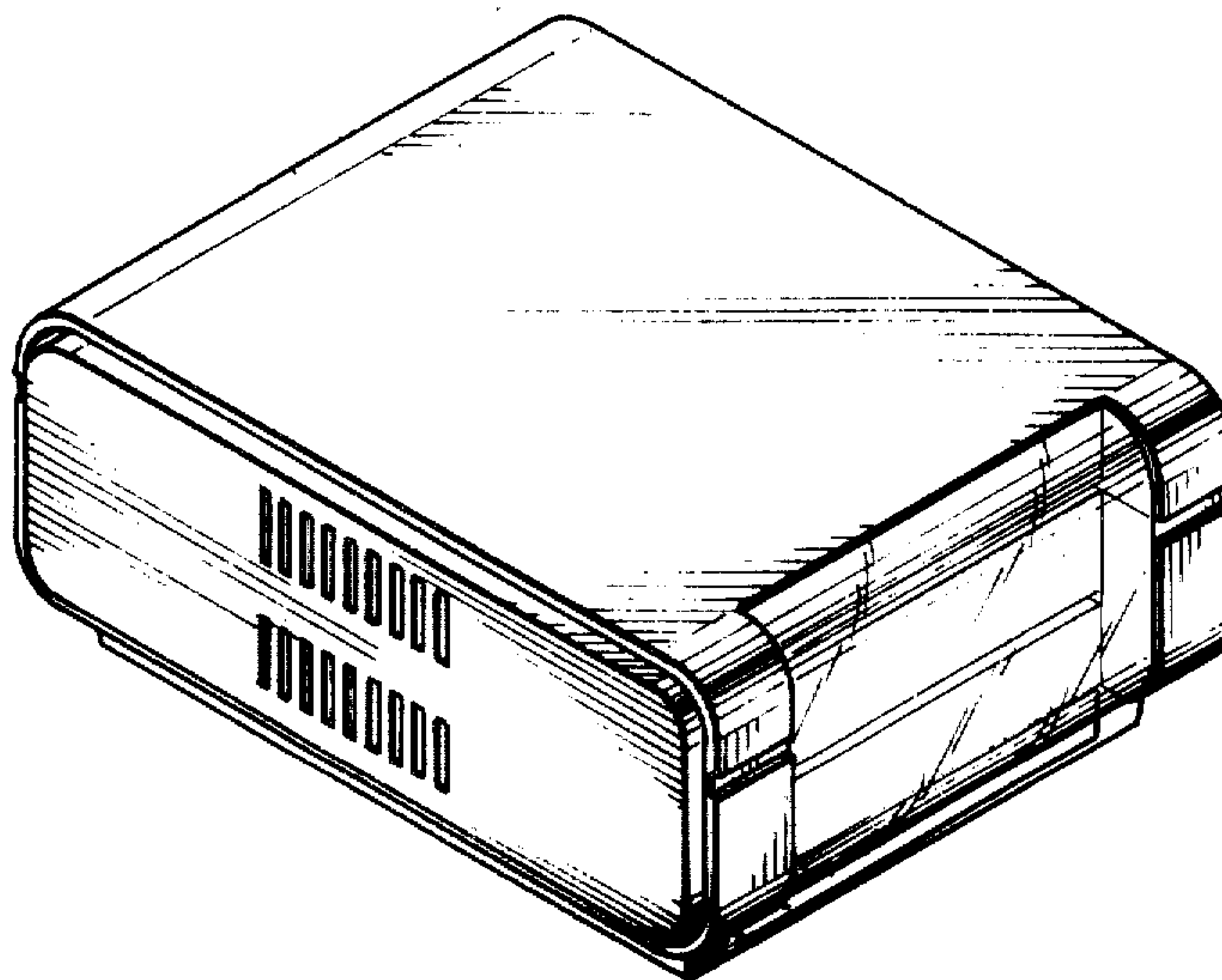
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof on an enlarged scale.



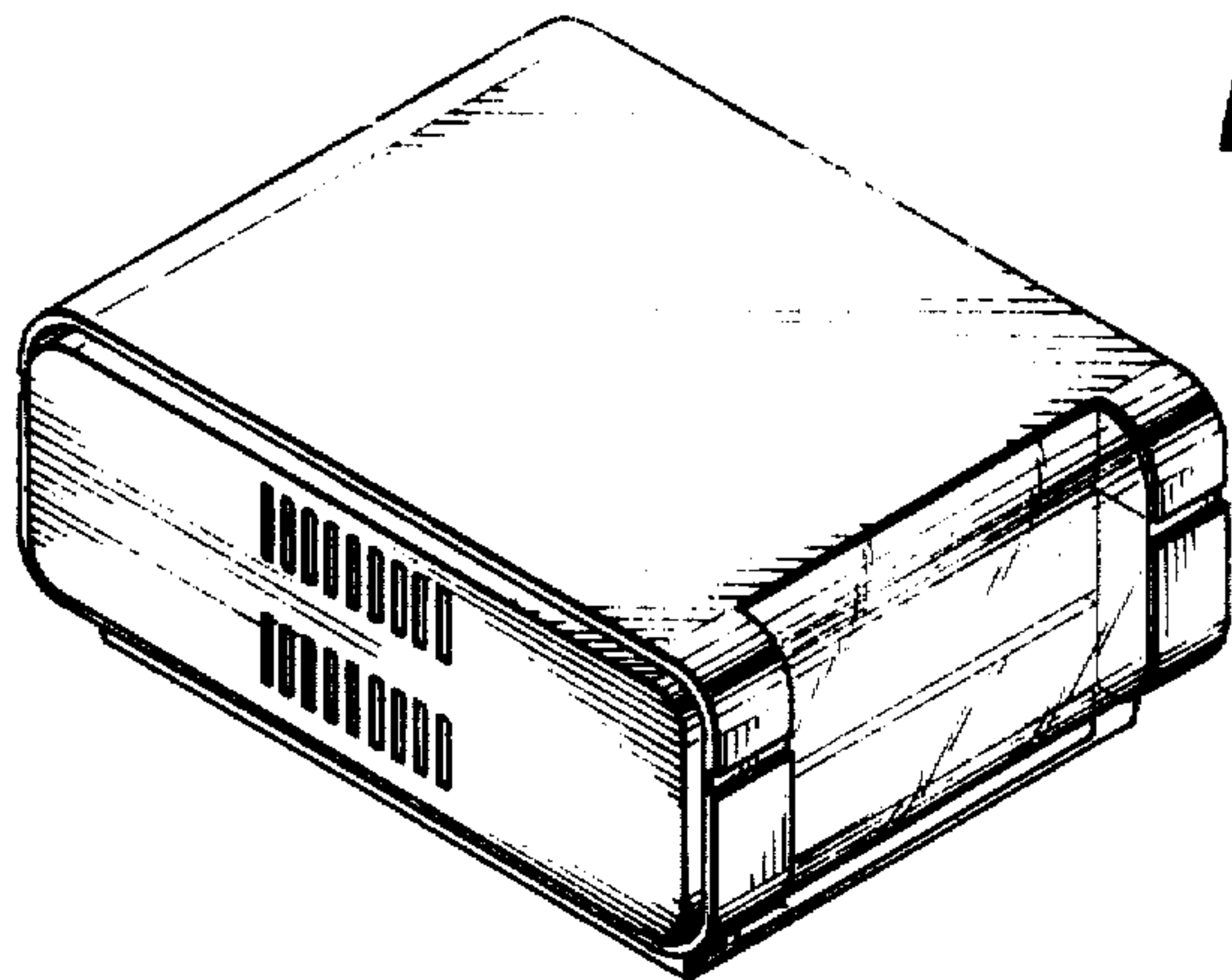

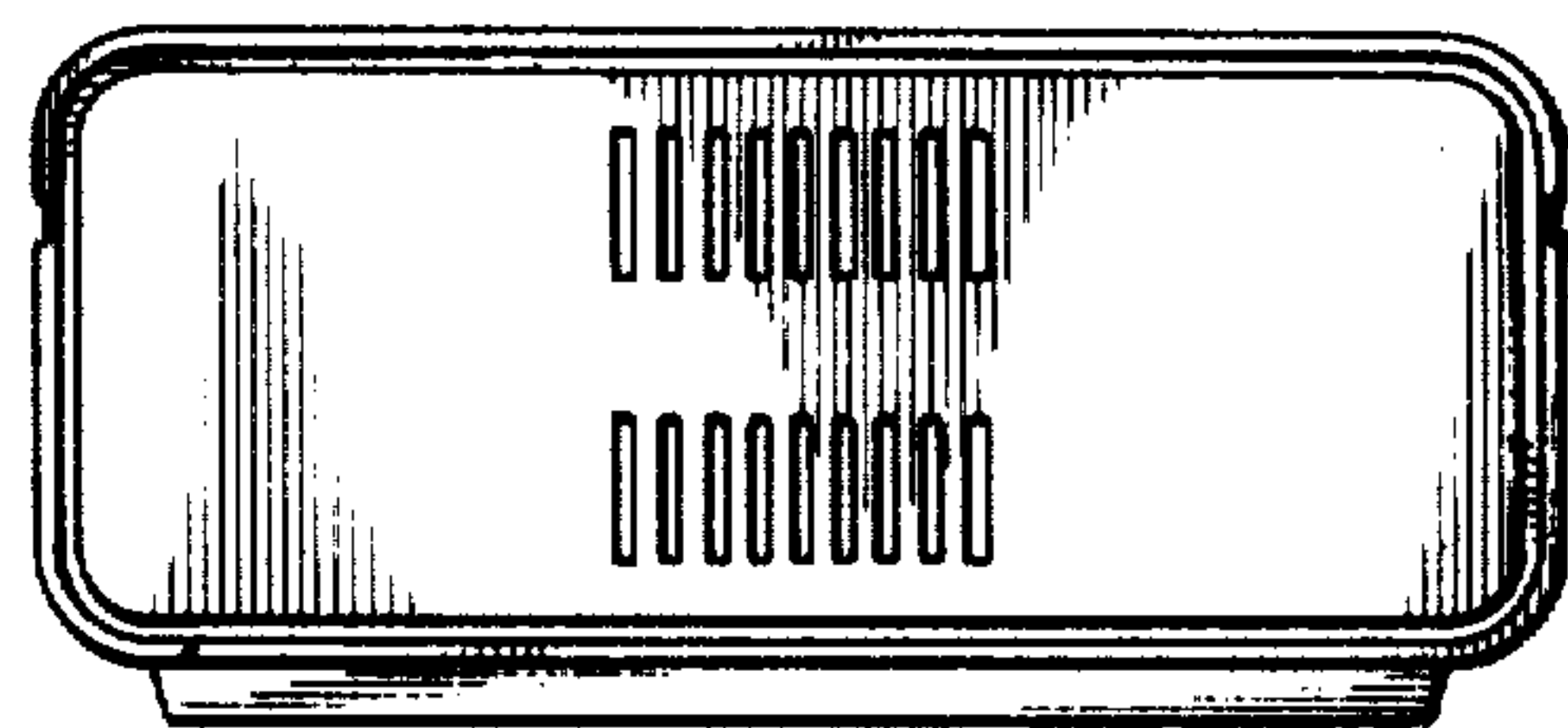
