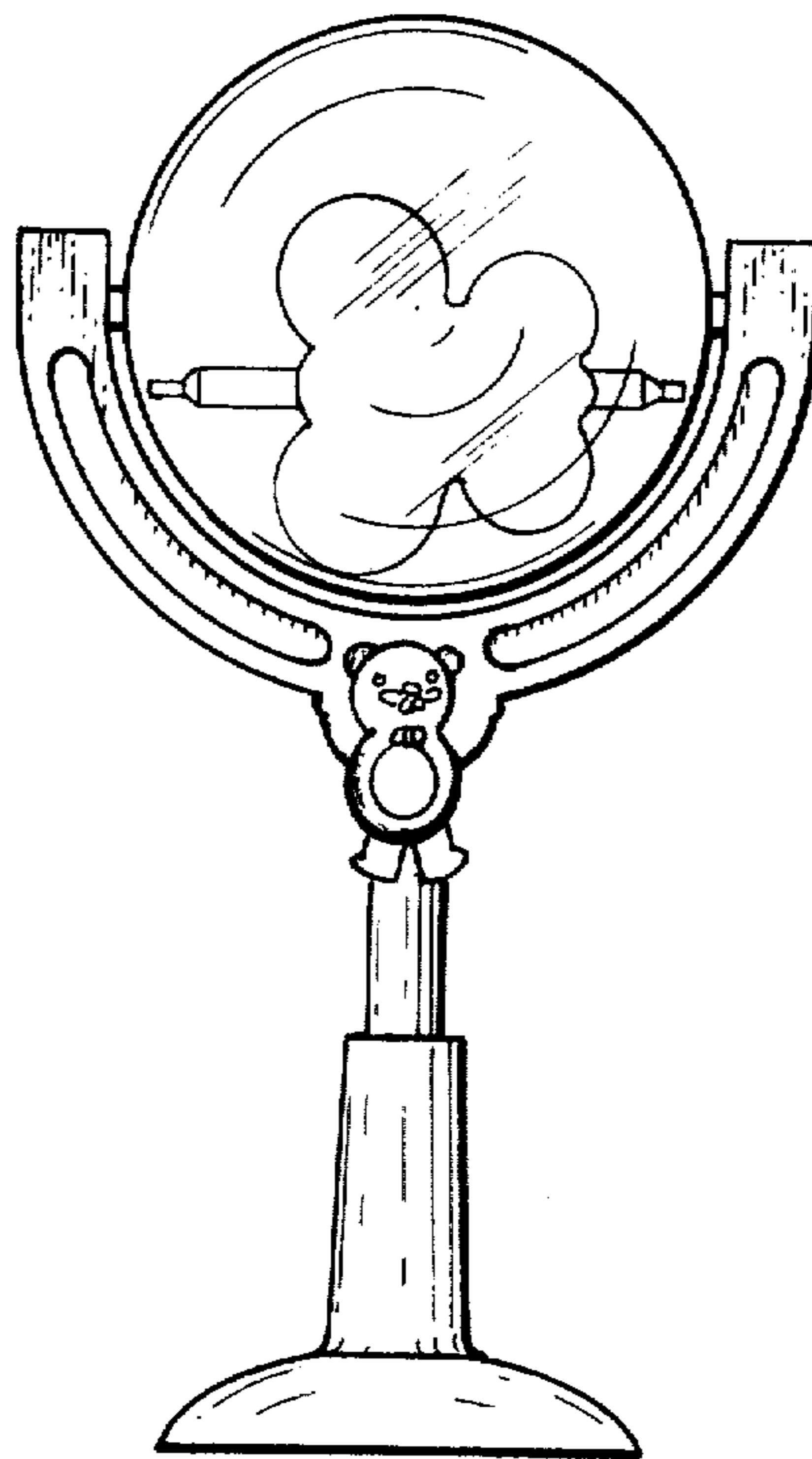

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a spinning toy, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spinning toy showing my new design, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



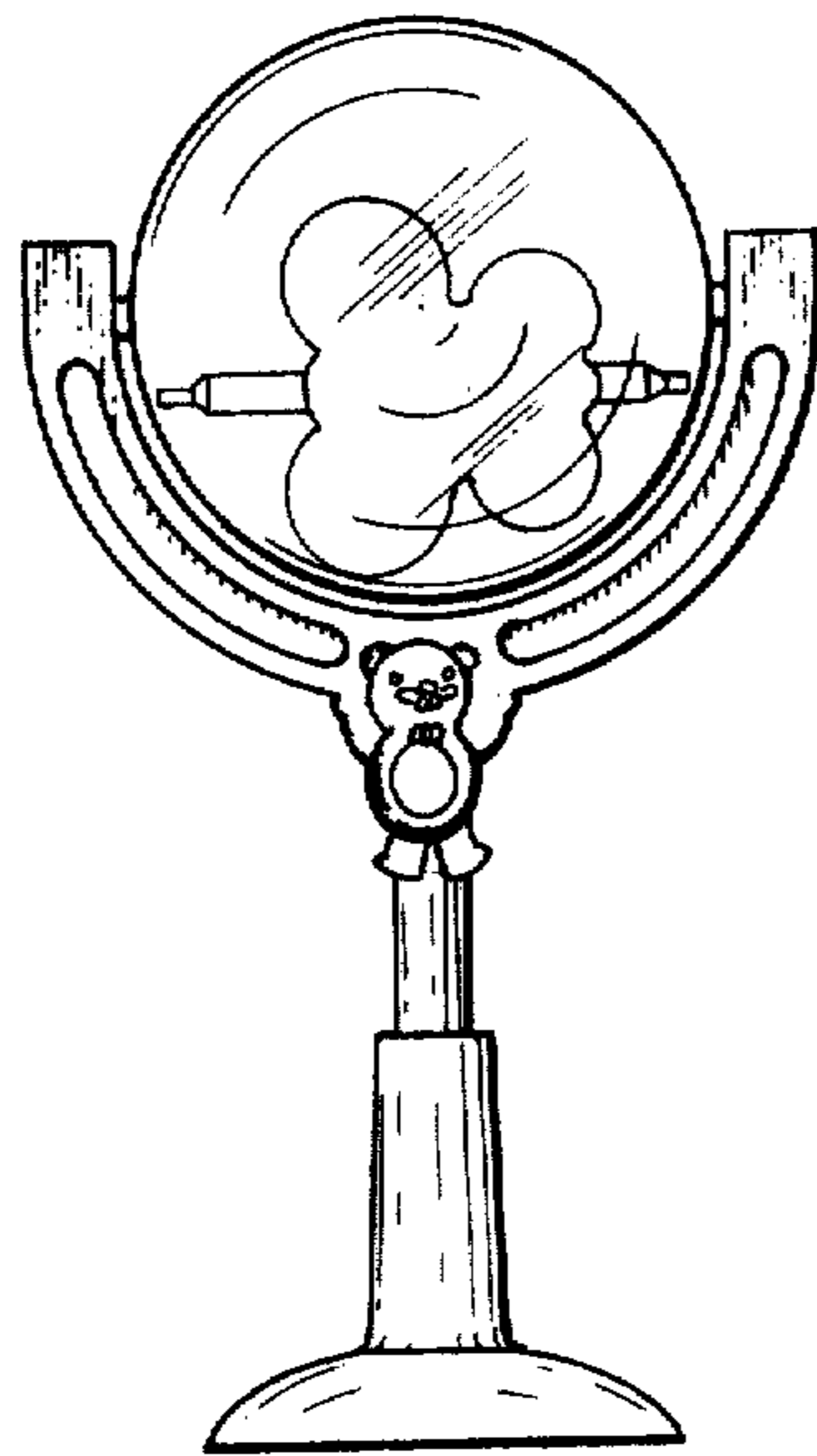

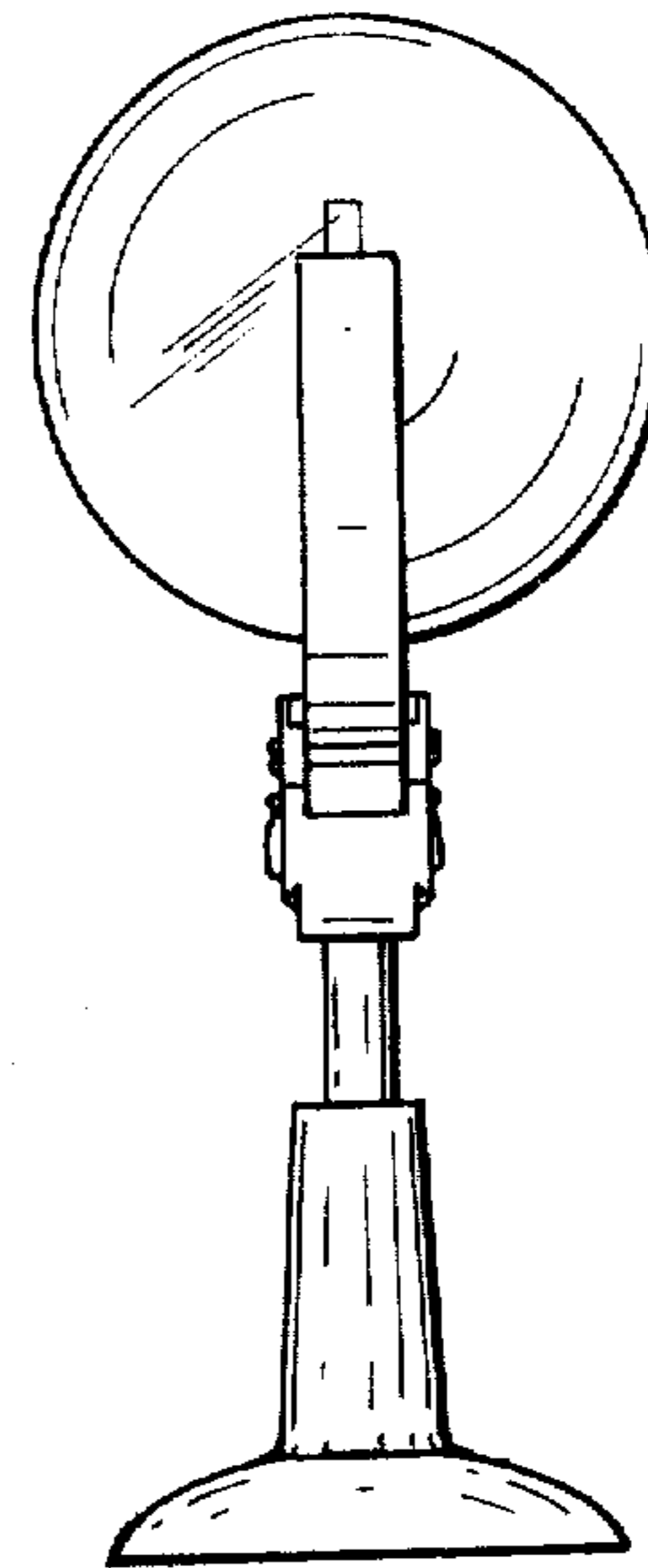

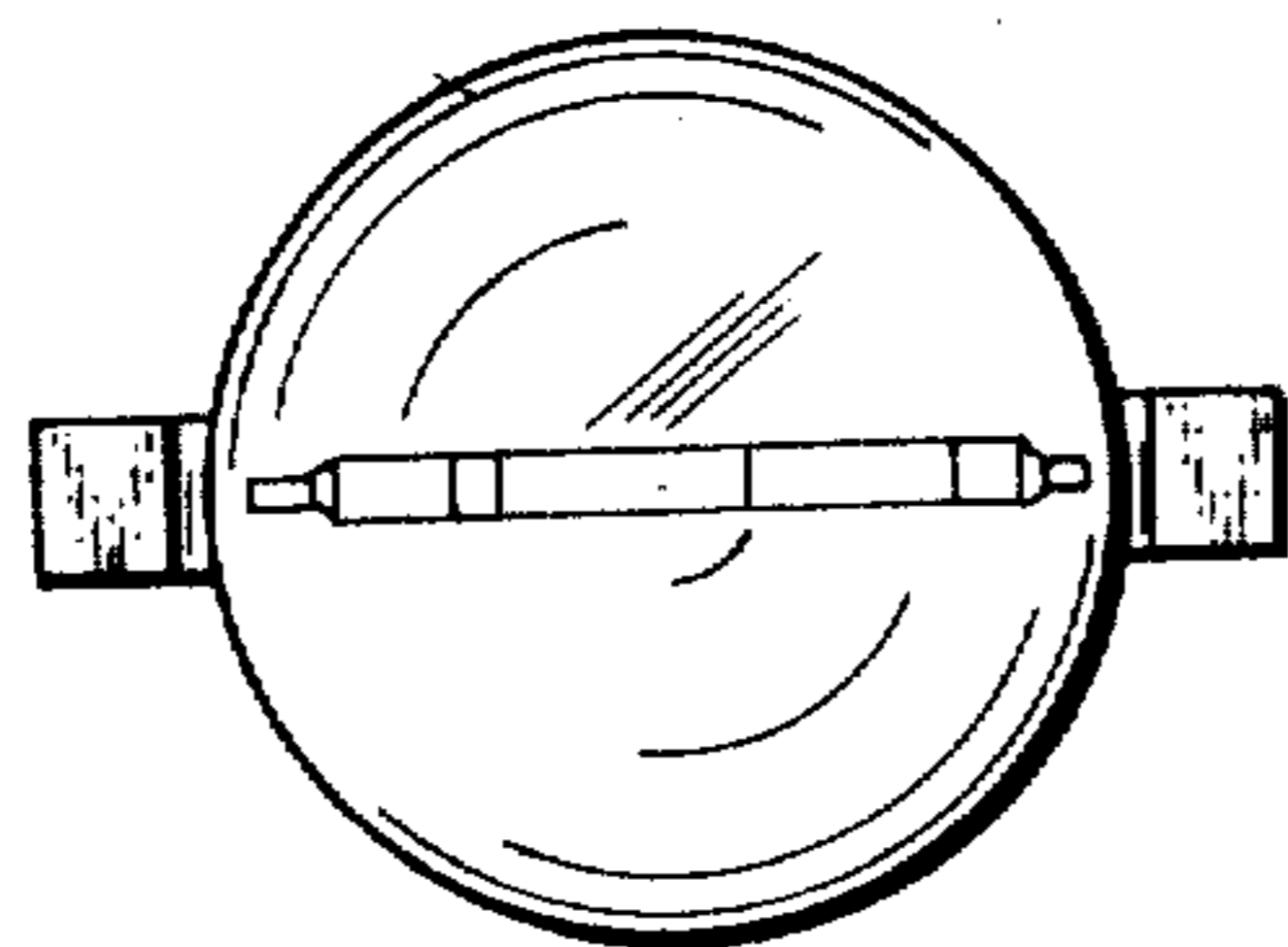

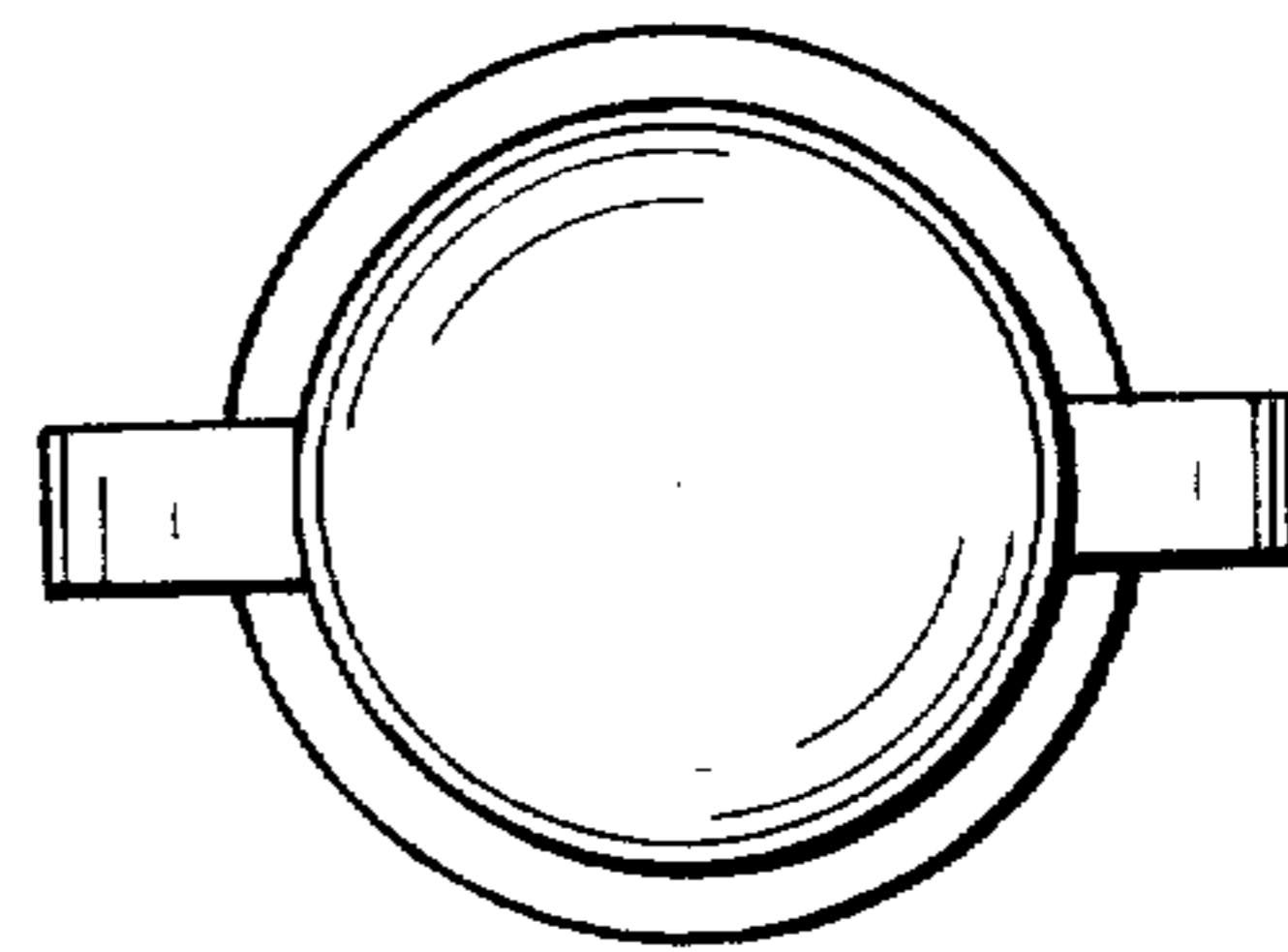
