FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 2.

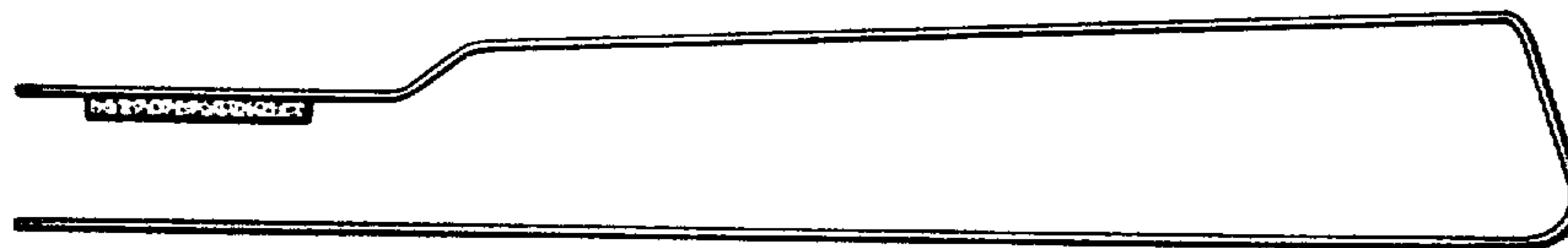
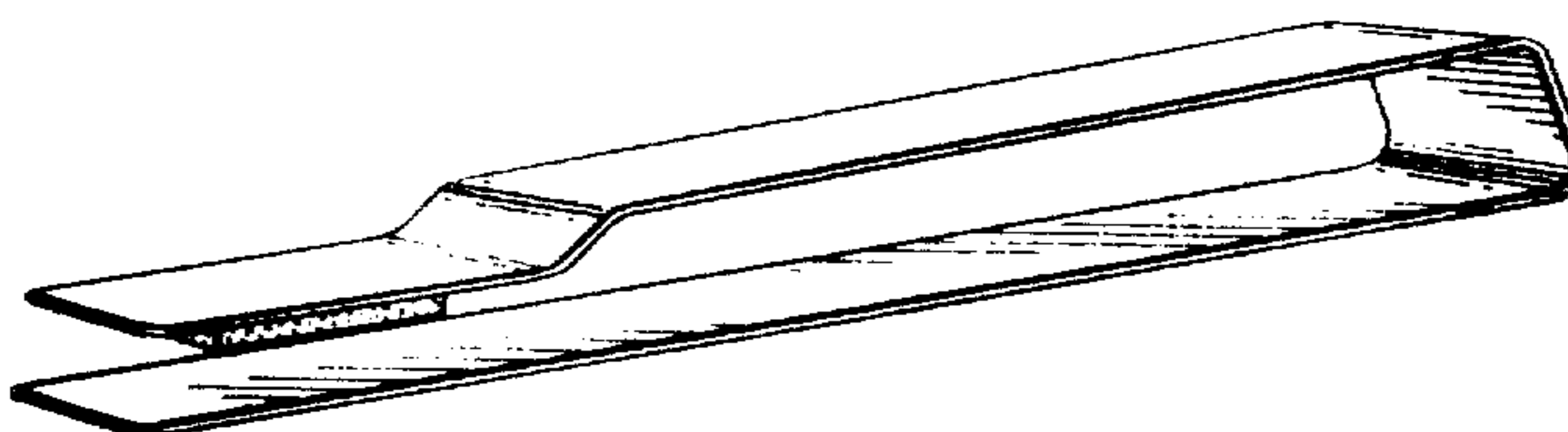

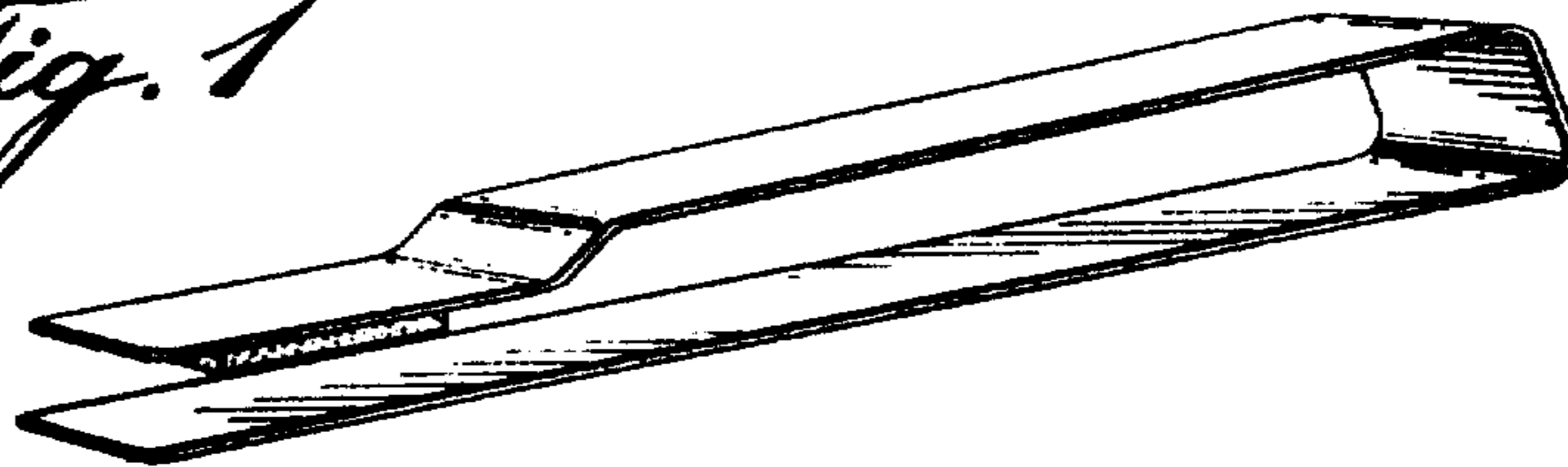

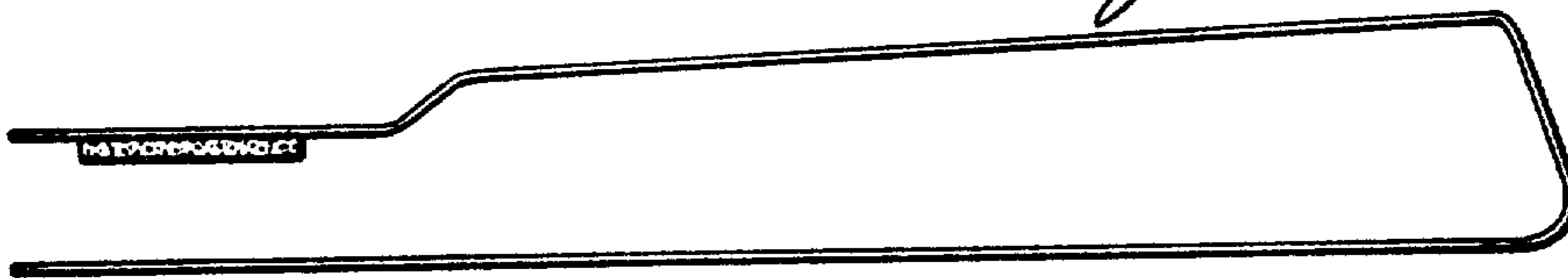

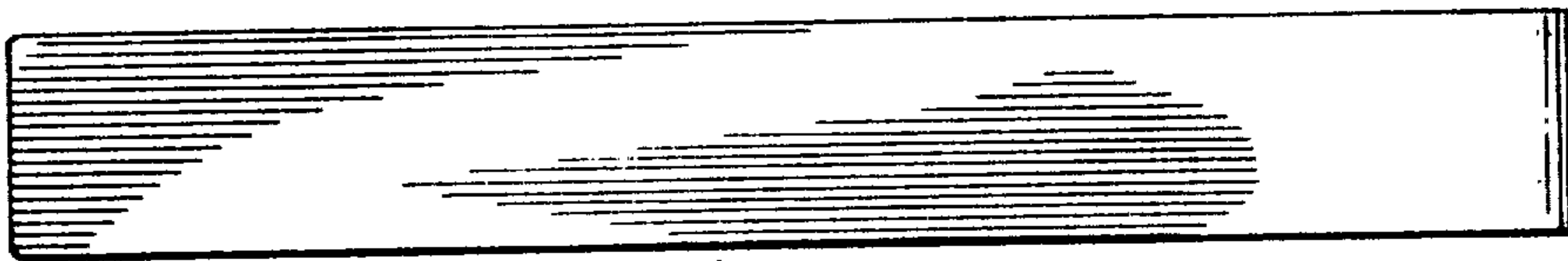

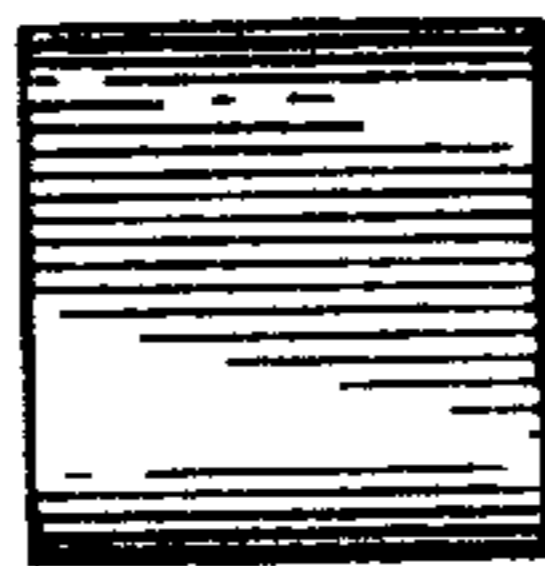
