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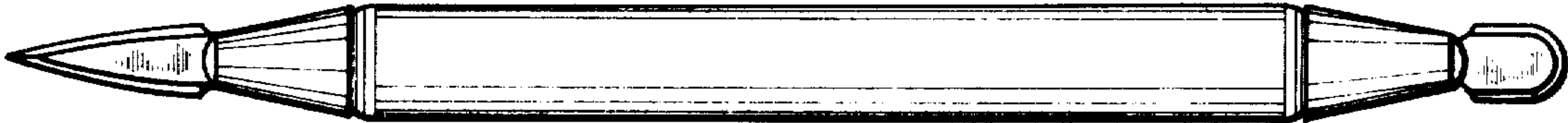

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a ceramic clean-up trim tool showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof with the tool rotated 90° from the position shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is an end view taken from the left side of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 4 is an end view taken from the right side of FIG. 1.



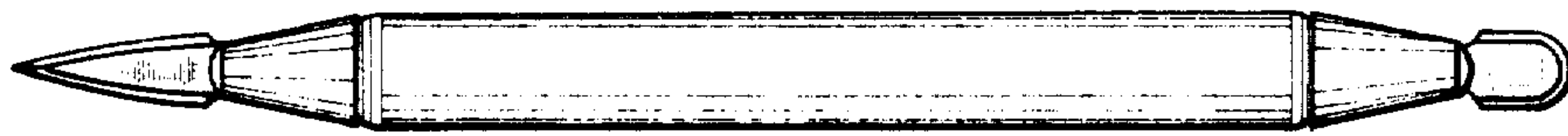

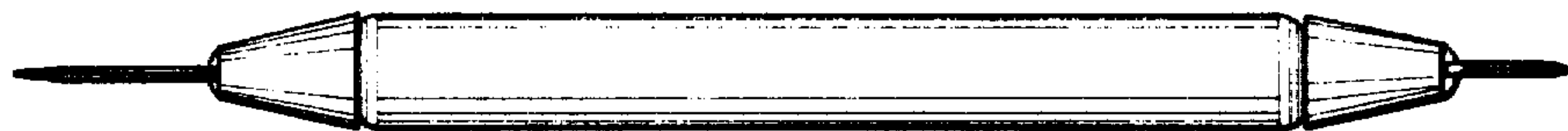

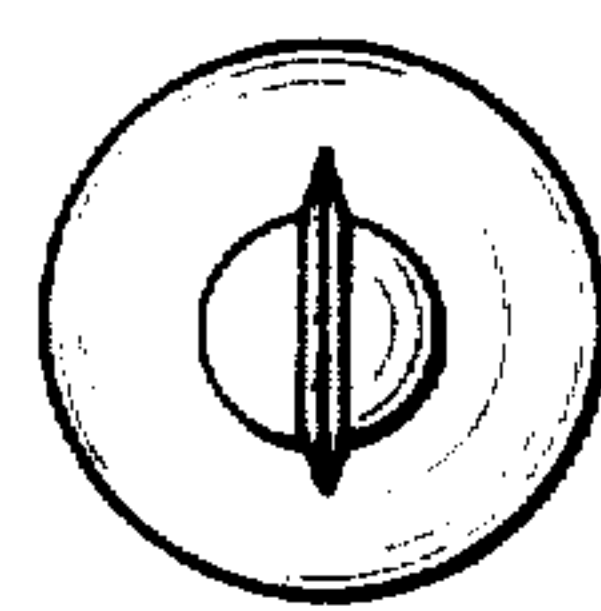
