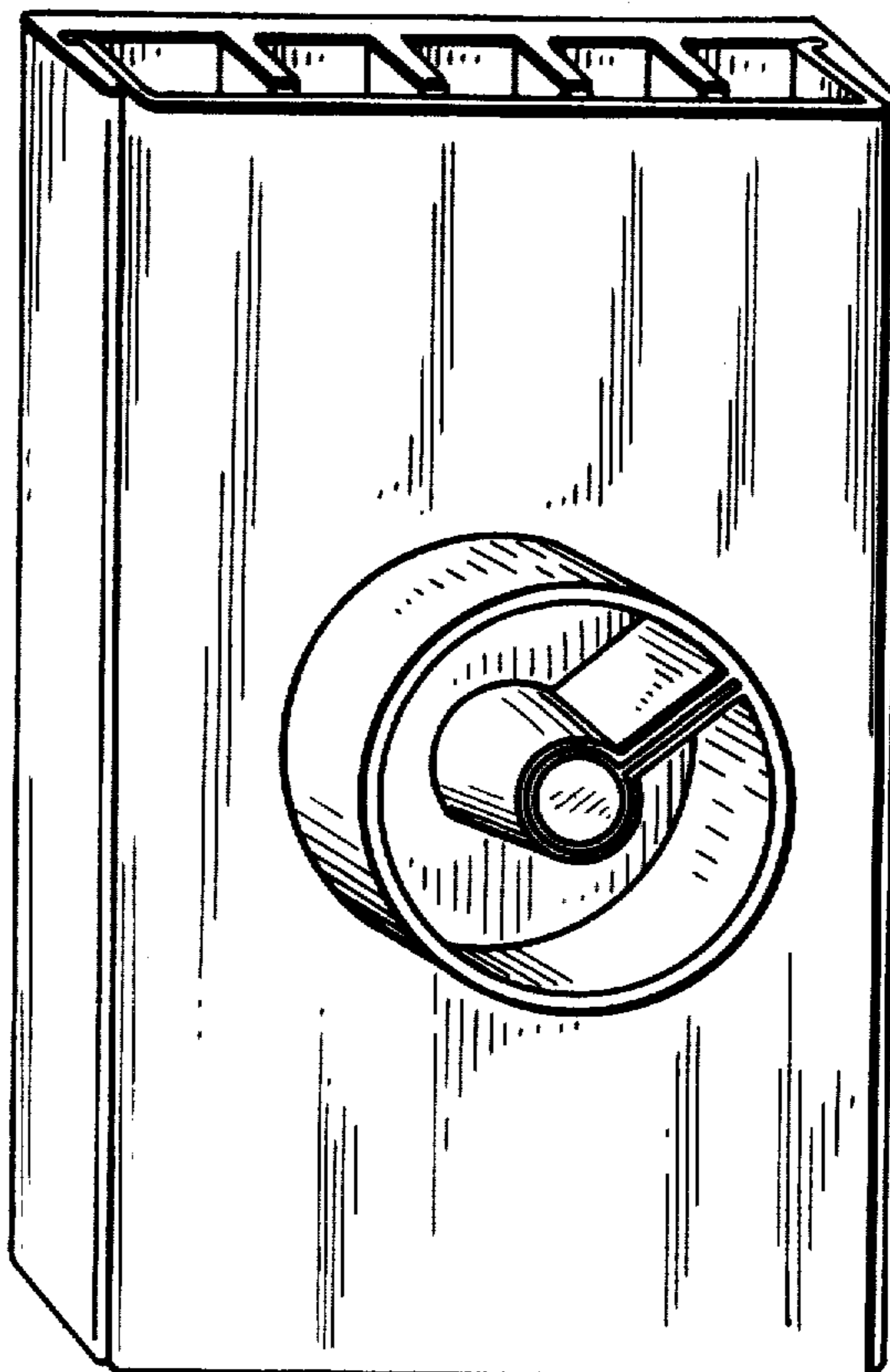

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined light dimmer knob and escutcheon therefor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined light dimmer knob and escutcheon therefor showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being flat and unornamented;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 3.



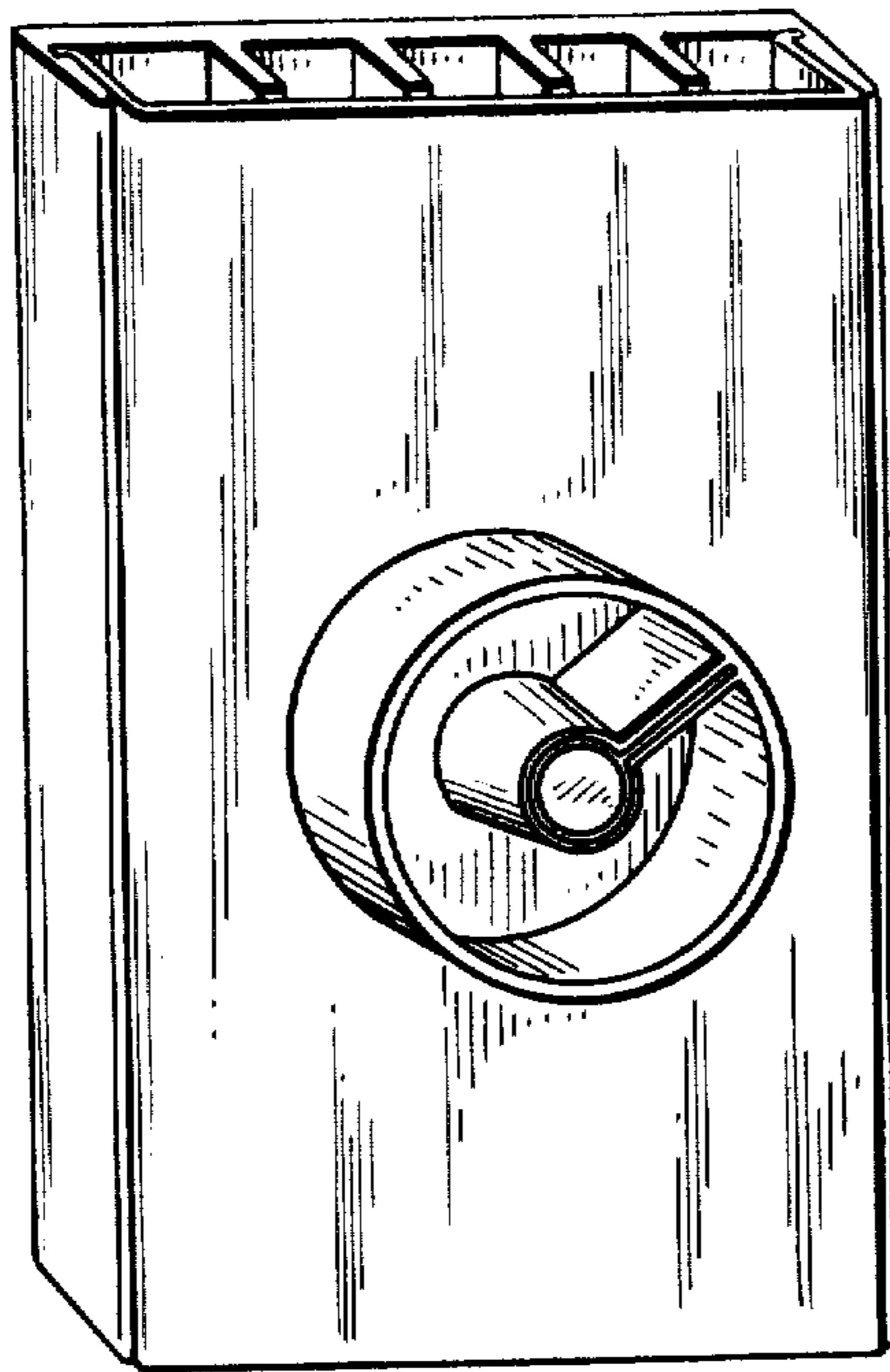

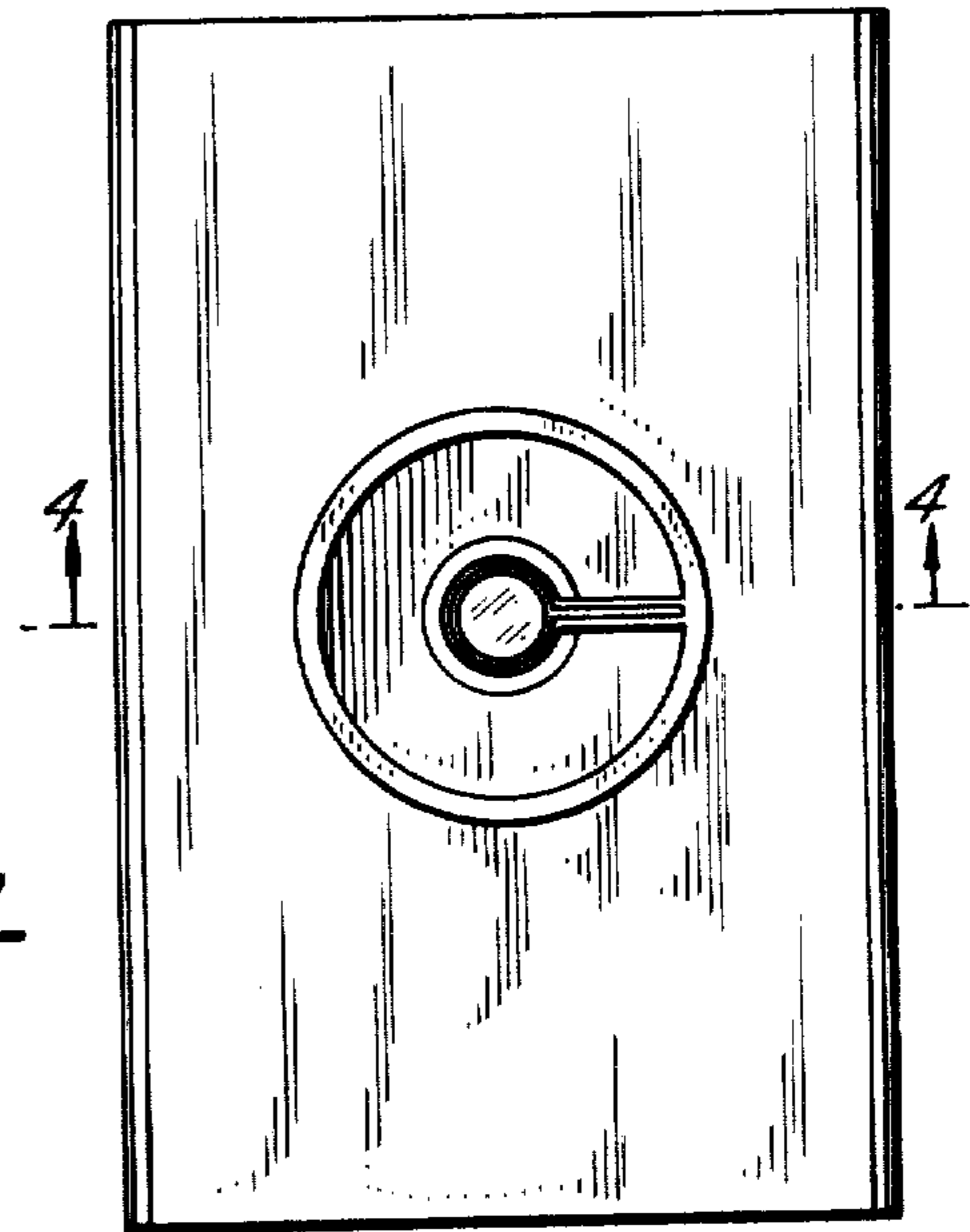

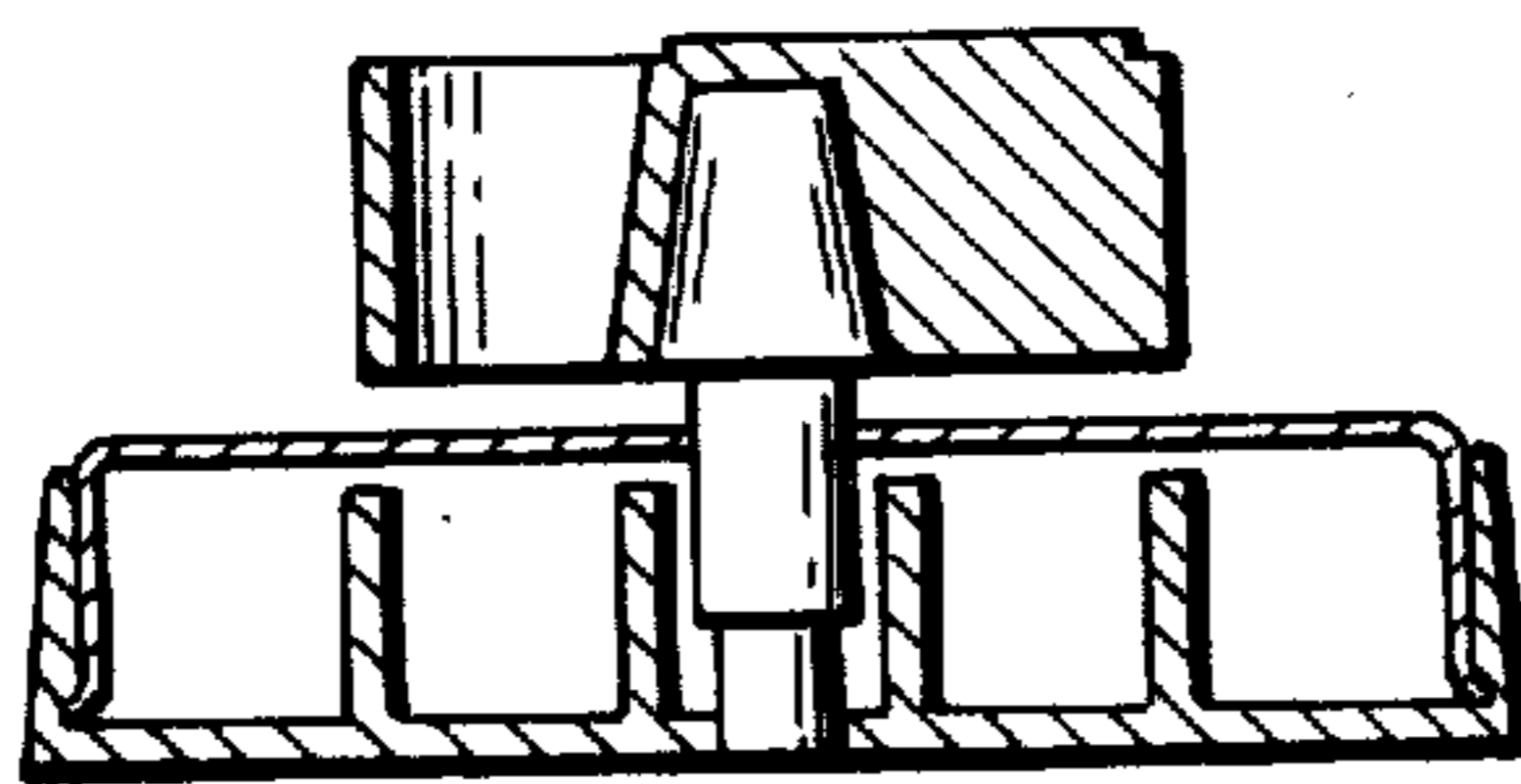

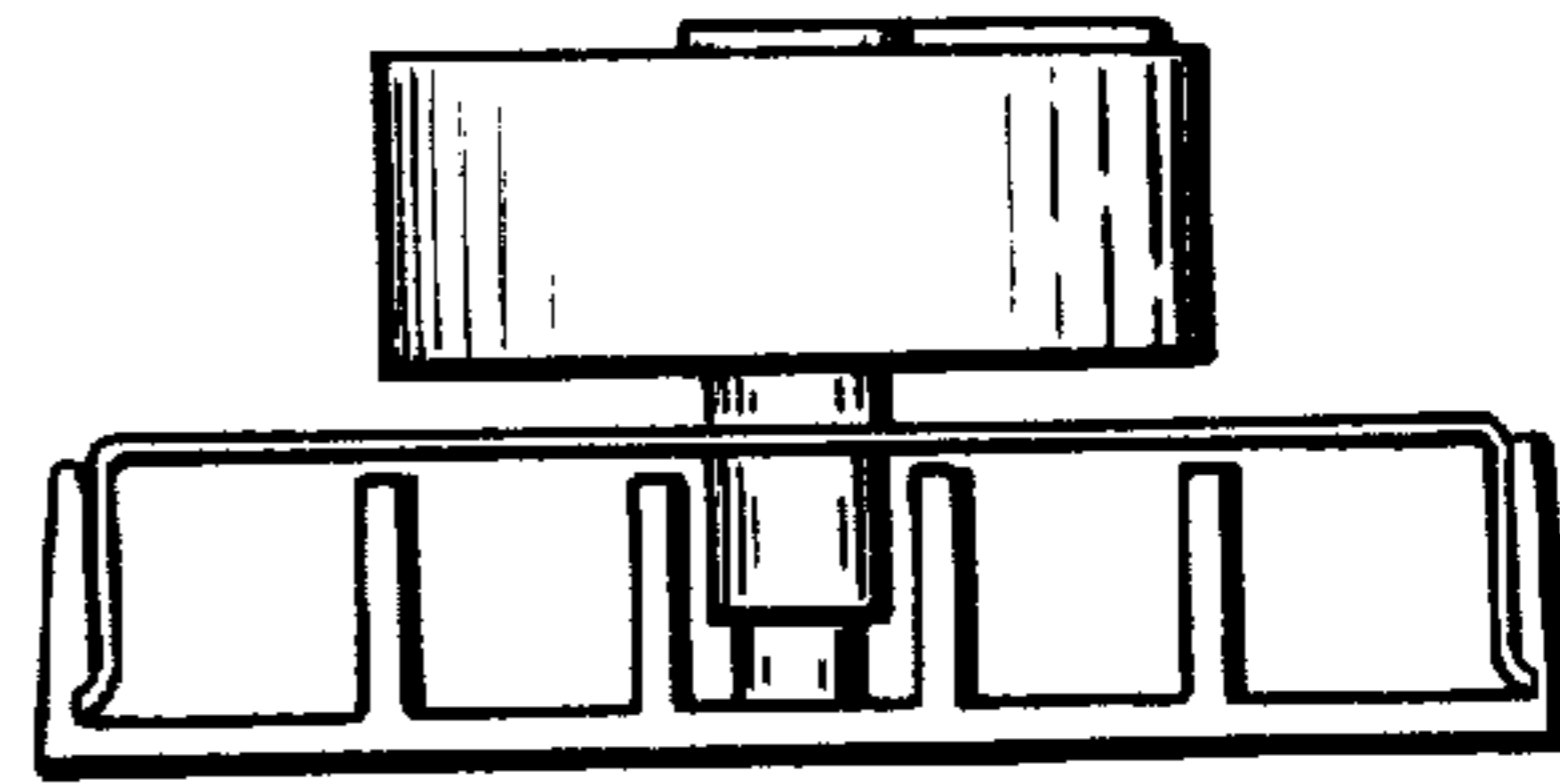
