FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the mount.

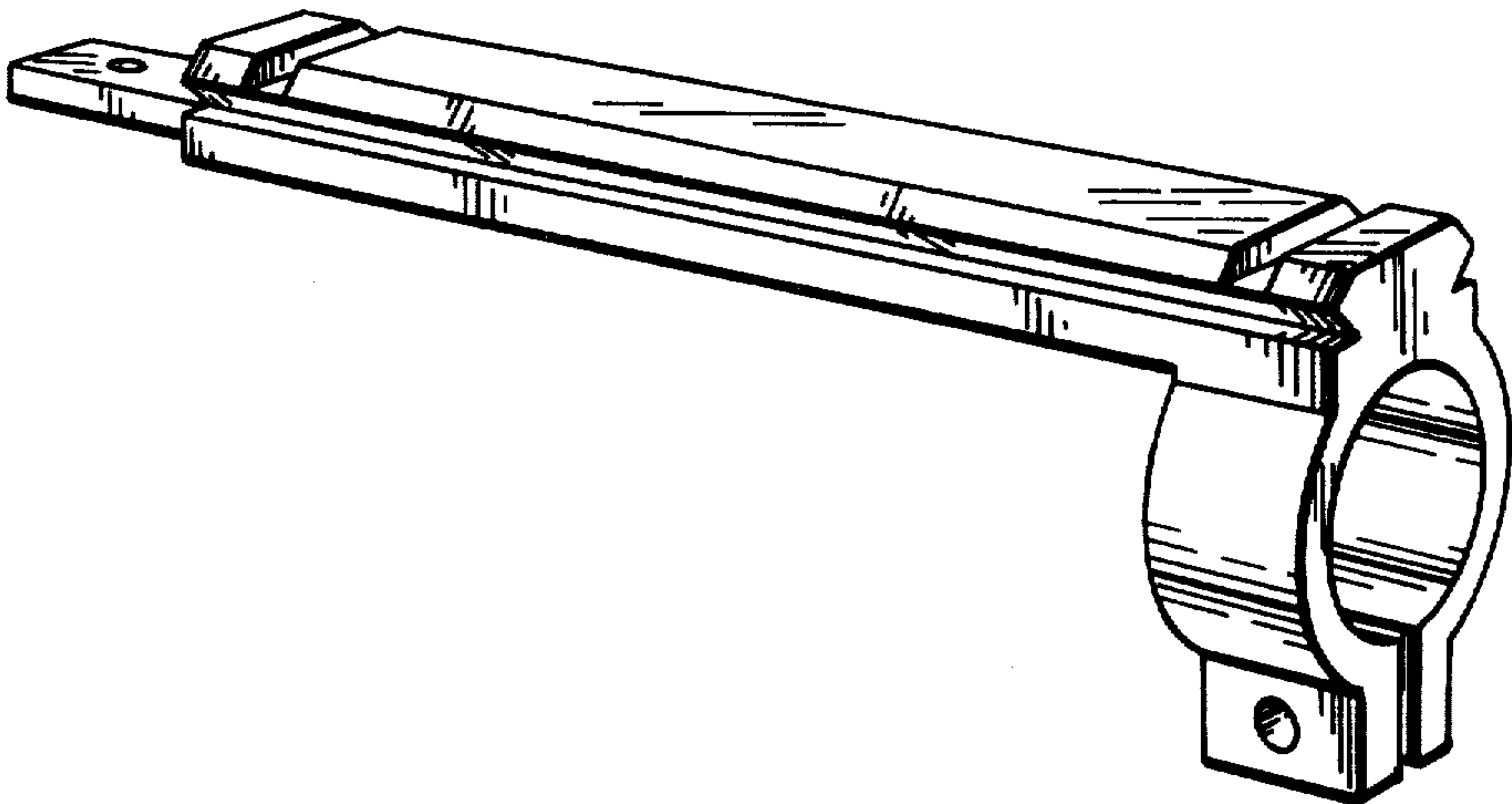

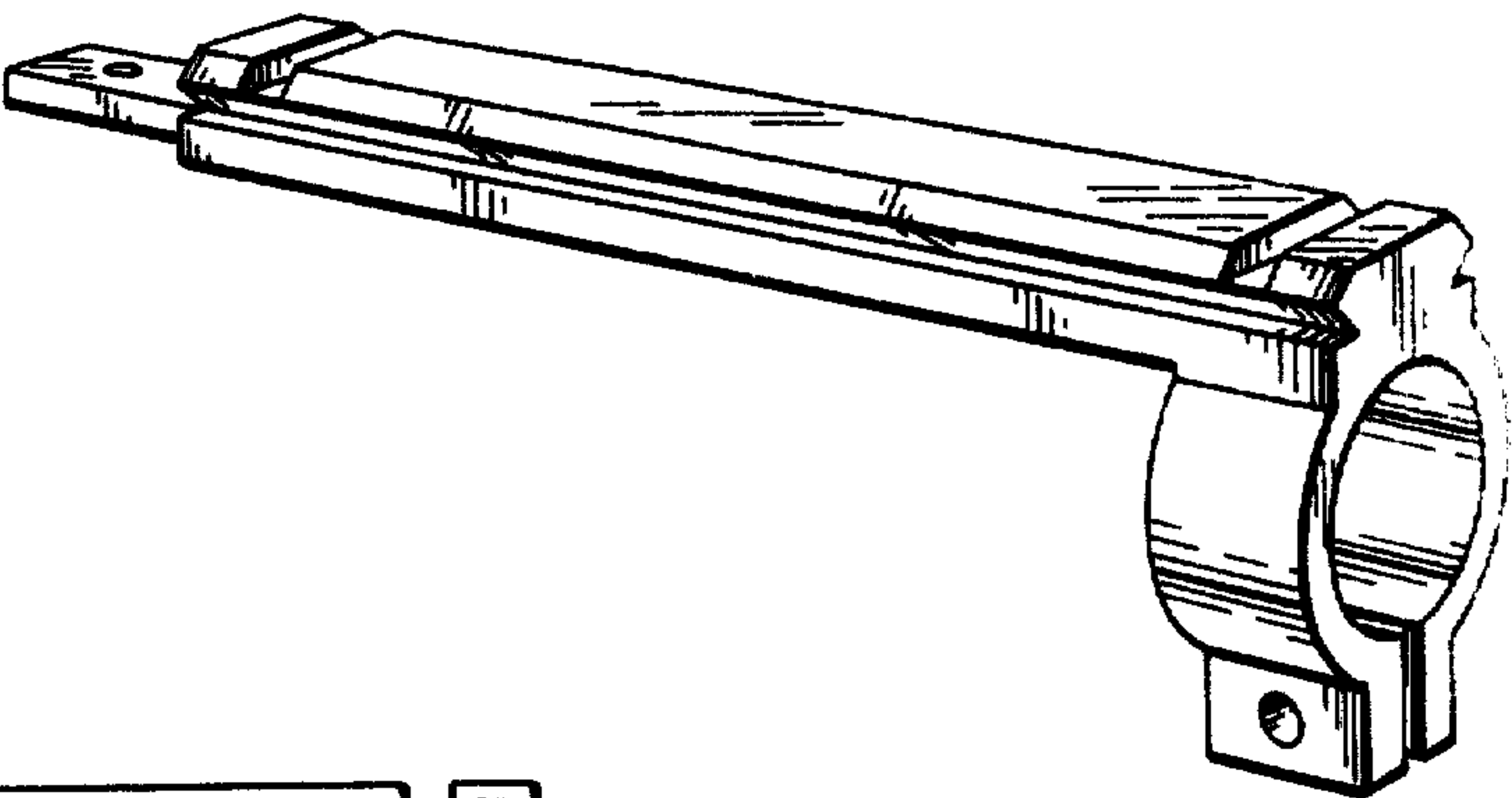

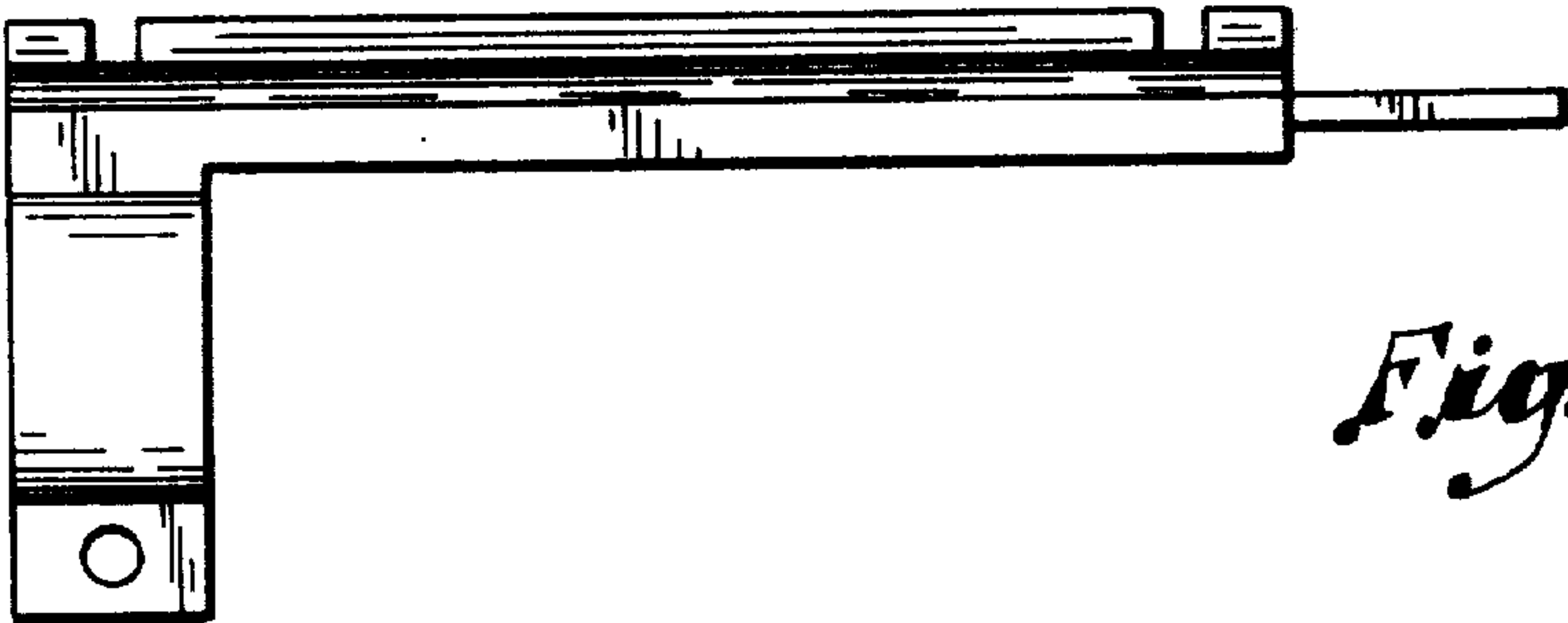

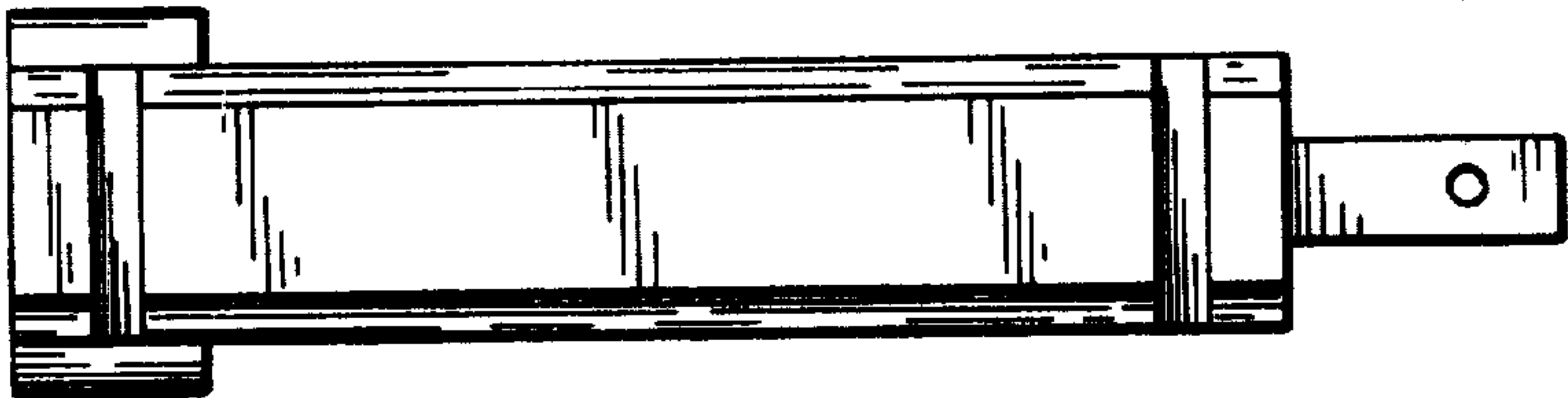

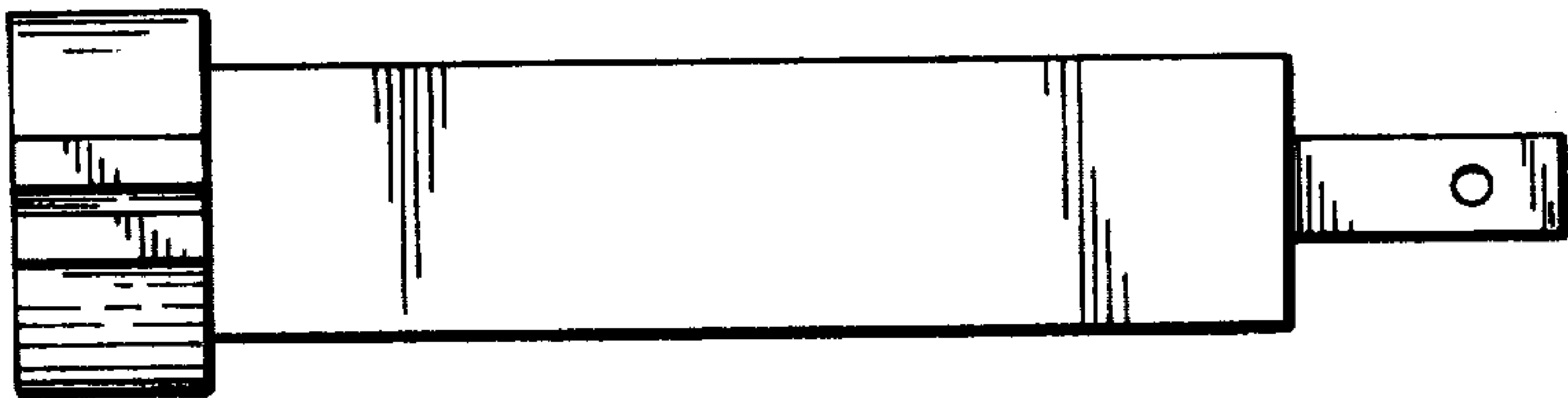

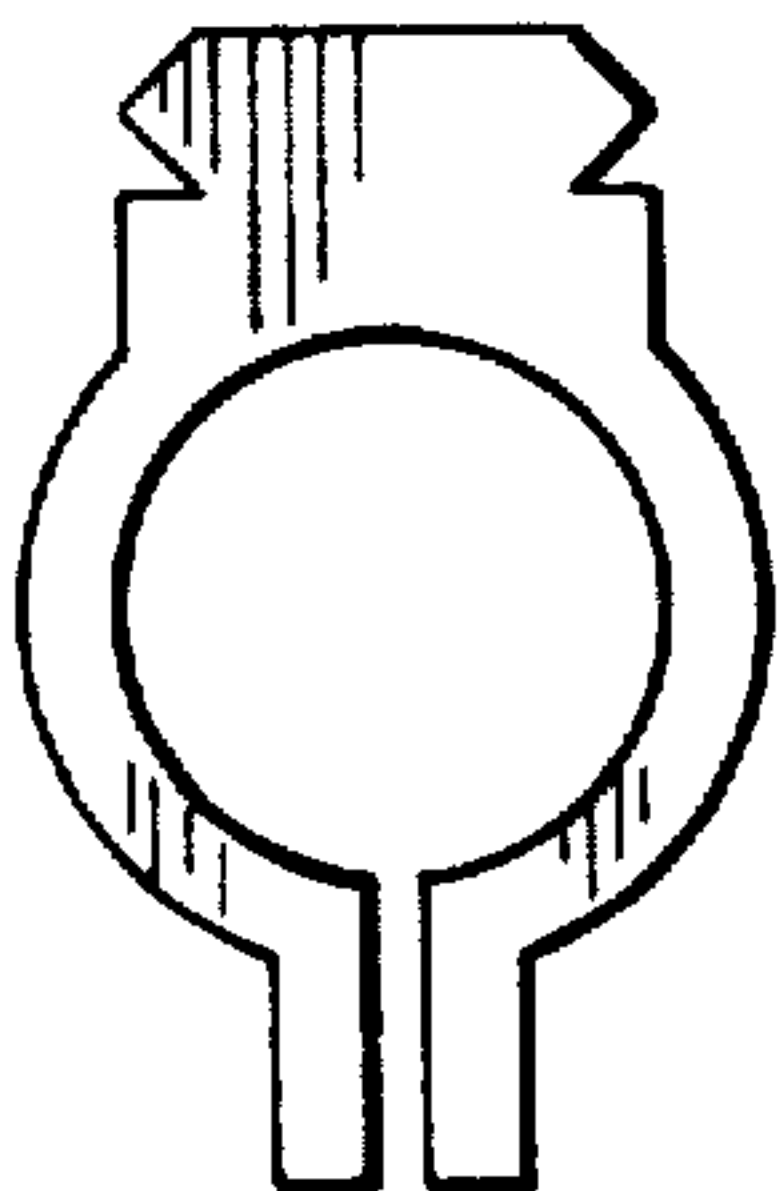
