appearance.

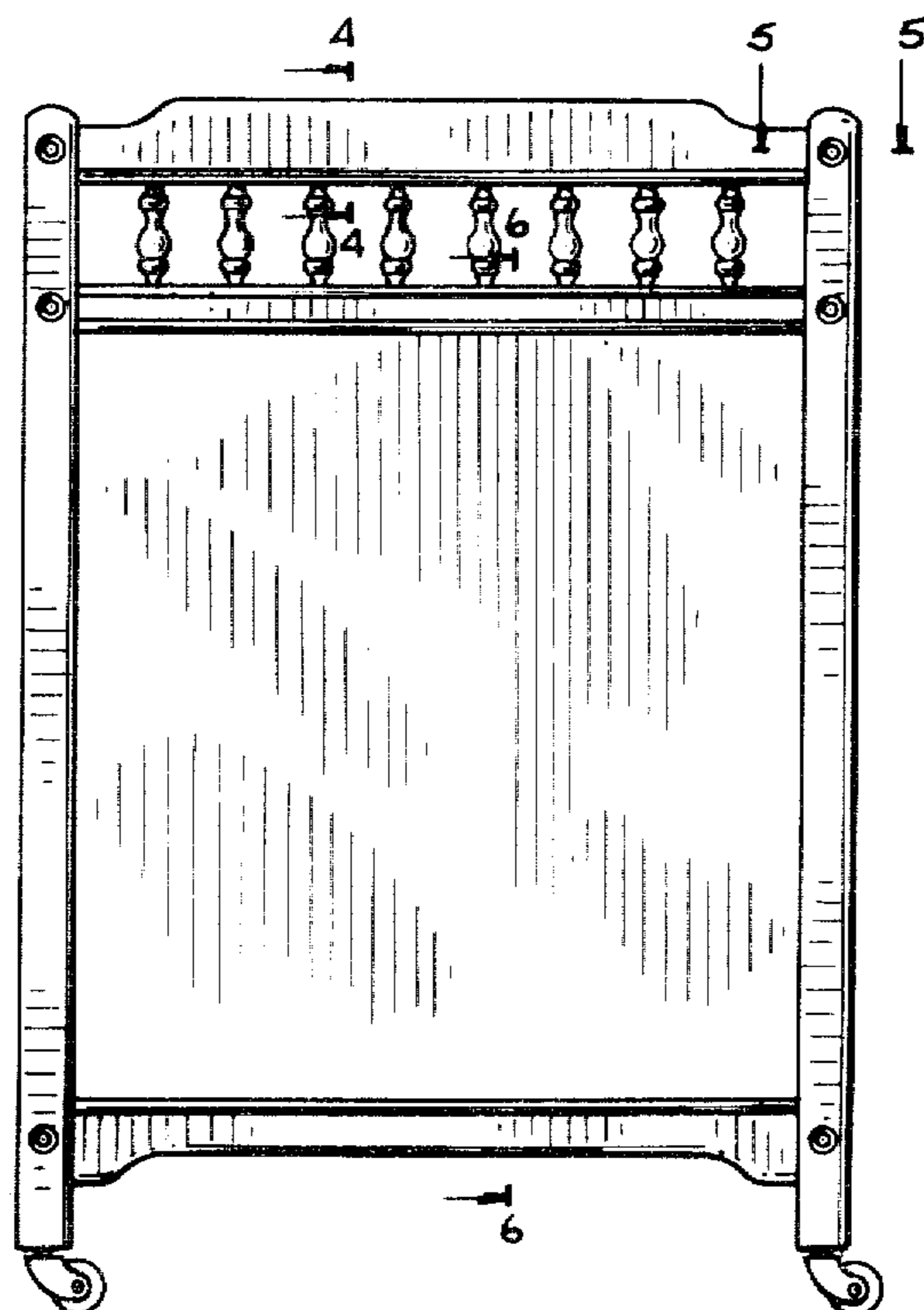

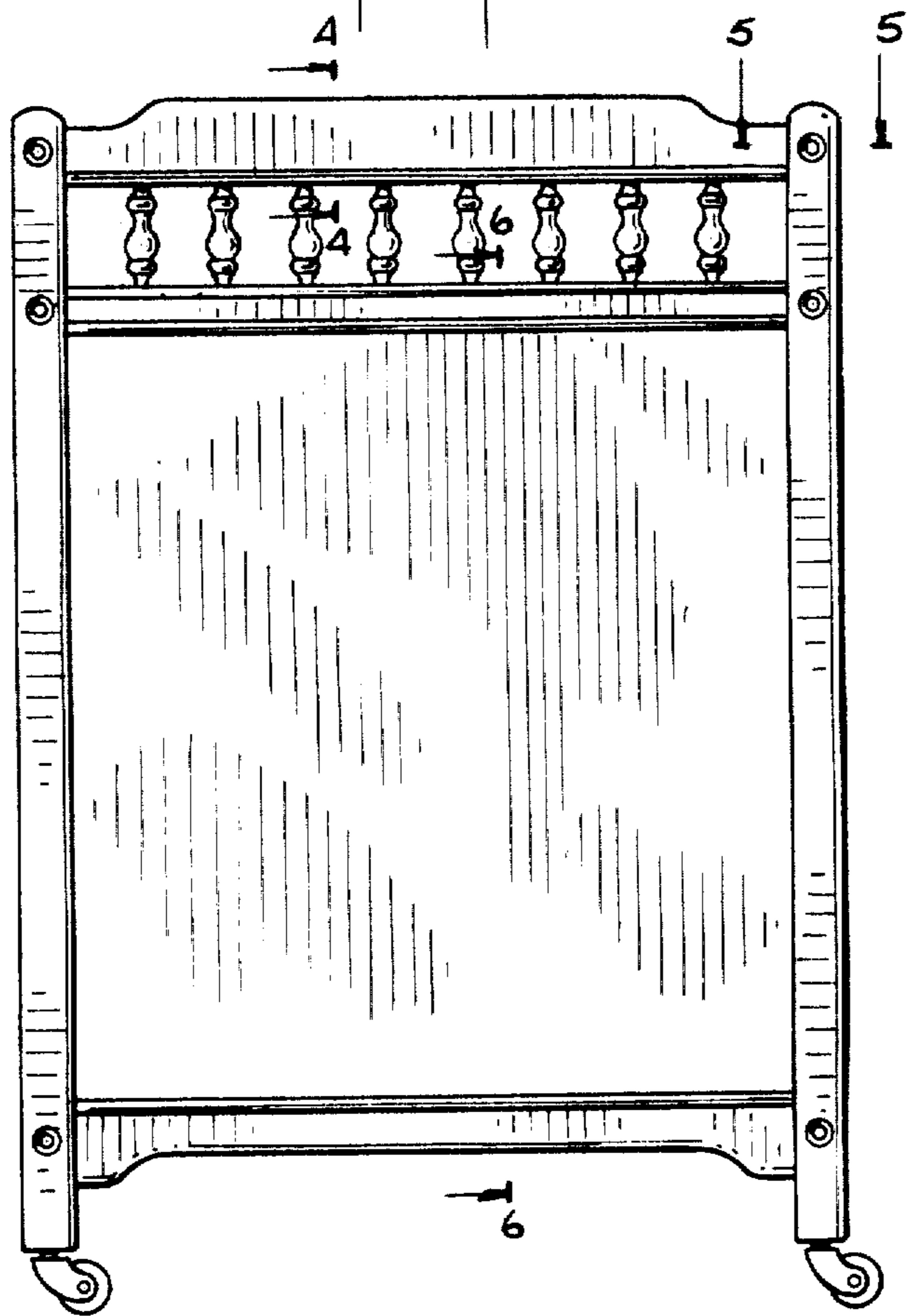

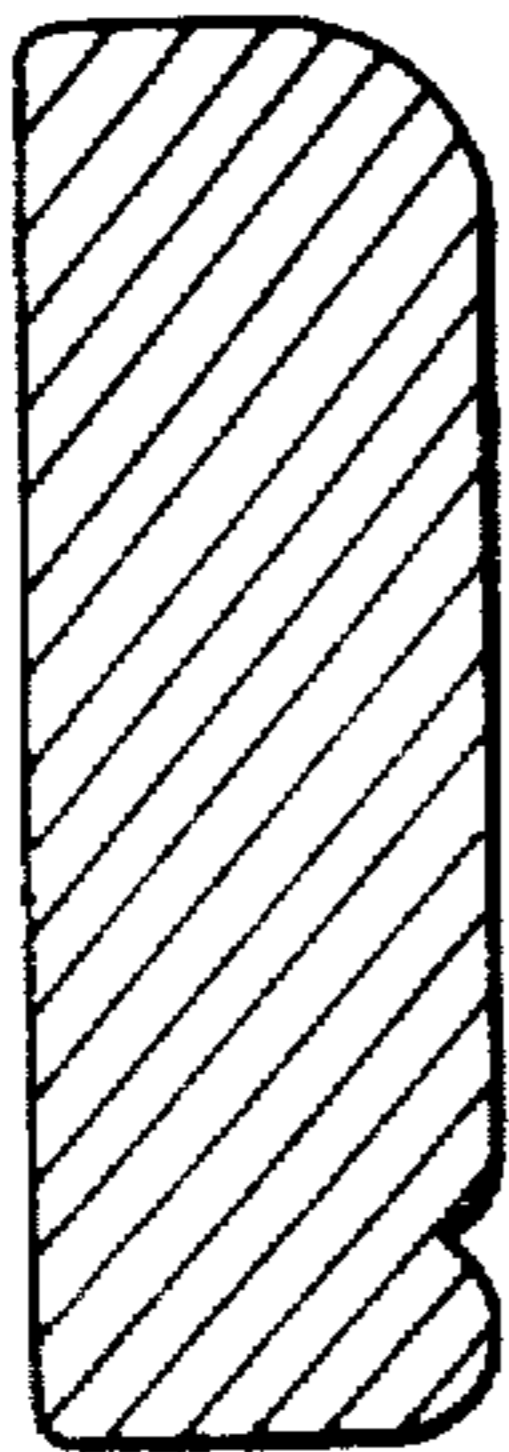

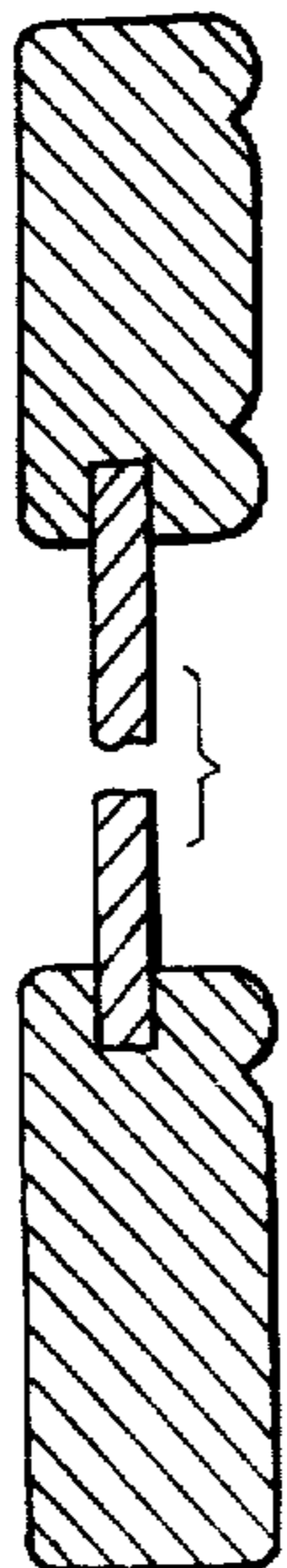

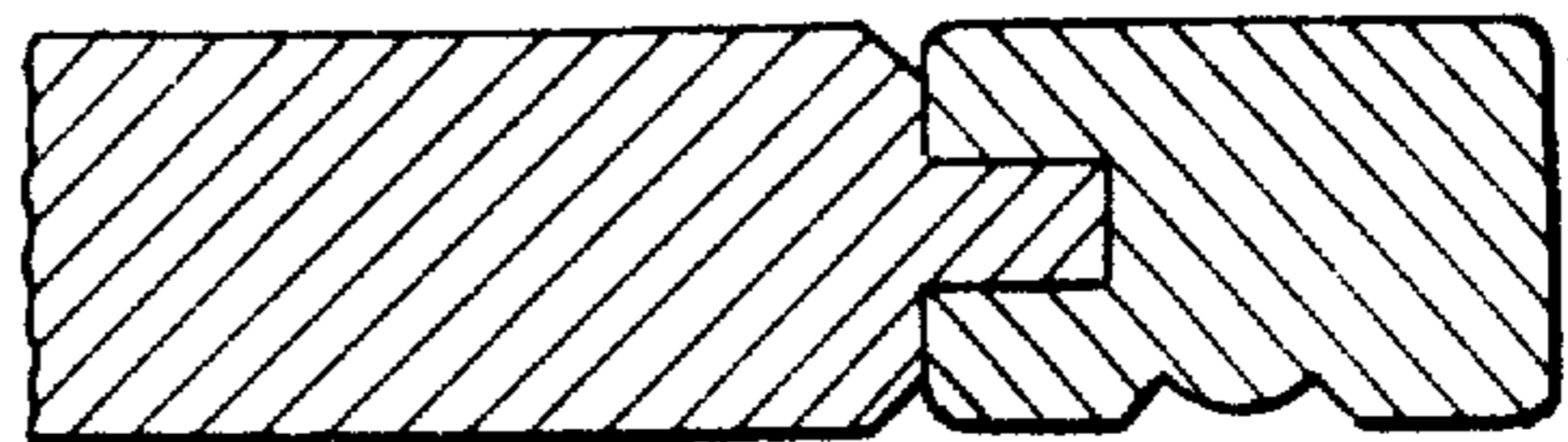
